Pursuant to 47 CFR § 73.3526(e)(11)(ii) and changes the Federal Communications Commission made in July 2019, broadcasters, cable operators and DBS operators are permitted to file their certifications of compliance with the commercial limits for children's programming under the Children's Television Act annually rather than quarterly.
