

**DESIGNATION OF CHIEF OPERATOR FOR KIRO-TV**

April 11, 2021

The Federal Communications Commission requires that the Licensee of a TV Broadcast Station designate a person employed by the Station to serve as **CHIEF OPERATOR**. Accordingly, the person named below is the Designated Chief Operator for KIRO-TV. You will be guided in your duties by the FCC Rules, Article 73.1870.

In the event of Chief Operator absences, the FCC requires there be an alternate Chief Operators assigned on a temporary basis.

As required by the FCC, a copy of this letter is kept in the front of the Station license notebook in Master Control. A second copy is kept in the Master Control SOP notebook.

According to the Rules, one of the duties of the Chief Operator is to inspect the Transmitter Operator logs weekly. This means that the logs must be inspected before 8 days have lapses since the log was created.

The inspection of the Transmitter Maintenance logs should be handled in the same way.

The remainders of the responsibilities are outlined in the FCC rules, Part 73.1870(c)(1)(3)(4)

Your Assignment is to perform the duties of the Chief Operator as defined in the FCC rules so as to meet compliance with these Rules.
