**(a) Initiative: Job Fair Participation**

**(b) Initiative: Internships**

Feb – Apr 2016 we had an intern from the University of Charleston. She was required to spend 40 hours in the areas of sales, events and social media. She made sales calls with our AE's, developed target lists, worked remotes and events, handled our 36<sup>th</sup> anniversary party invitations (on line) and RSVP's, did facebook posts and videos. Supervised by Dotsy Klei, General Manager.

Aug – Nov 2015 our Sports Director, Dave Miller, supervised an intern responsible for helping support our annual high school football efforts called "Rock This House". Duties included online posting of school locations, monitor voting and winning school, board operation during remotes, onsite at remotes interacting with listeners, live cut ins, set up and tear down. The WVSU intern from Rock This House is now a part time board operator for our cluster – he can run the board during remote broadcasts and sporting events and had filled in for an on air shift during a syndicated program.
