Issue covered: Green Bay House of Hope

Dates aired: January-March

Program: Bill and Rookie did sports trivia with WealthPlan after their segment. Bill and Rookie earned money to be donated to Green Bay's House of Hope for each correct answer. Bill and Rookie earned \$420 and Mike from WealthPlan matched up to \$1,000 in donations from Fan Nation

Issue covered: Wisconsin Humane Society
