The State's Attorney has 48 hours to charge the offender with a crime or release him. There may be conditions attached with the release. Were there any prior arrests? Next, a court date is set. Charges may be dropped for lack of evidence. Then a preliminary hearing is next. Grand jury decides if there will be an indictment. The defendant appears before the judge for a plea of guilty or not guilty. Evidence is presented in the discovery phase. A trial date is set. Then the trial begins. Miranda rights explained.

**Issue: Legal Matters** 

Discussion of issue: Recently an 18 year old was arrested in connection with the murder of a 15 year old. Defense attorney Kevin Sullivan outlined the steps of any case such as, securing the crime scene to be sure none of the evidence is contaminated or tampered with. Next, they check for witnesses and surveillance cameras, public and private. They may subpoena cell phone records, and ask around for any "word of mouth" information to gather leads on the case. It's a combination of science (forensics) word of mouth, video or audio surveillance, and evidence gathered at the scene. Further discussion was made concerning what a defense attorney may do for a client who is called in for questioning or arrested.
