WE'RE LEARNING MORE ABOUT THE GUNMAN IN WEDNESDAY'S DEADLY SHOOTING AT FT. HOOD

ARMY BASE. SPECIALIST IVAN LOPEZ APPARENTLY HAD A HISTORY OF INSTABILITY AND PSYCHIATRIC ISSUES. THE IRAQ WAR VETERAN WAS BEING EVALUATED FOR POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER. LOPEZ OPENED FIRE AT THE FORT HOOD ARMY BASE KILLING THREE PEOPLE, WOUNDING 16, BEFORE TAKING HIS OWN LIFE. AUTHORITIES ARE NOW TRYING TO FIGURE OUT IF SOMETHING HAPPENED, A TRIGGER EVENT, THAT SET LOPEZ OFF. OUR REPORTER LUIS MEGID IS IN TEXAS WITH THE LATEST INFORMATION ON THIS CASE. AT THIS POINT AUTHORITIES HAVE NOT YET RULED OUT ANYTHING AND WE LOOKED AT HOW SHOOTINGS HAVE A LONG TERM EFFECTS ON VICTIMS.

CONTROVERSY (23 SEC)

BRITISH SCIENTISTS SAID ON THURSDAY THERE IS NOT ENOUGH EVIDENCE TO PROVE THE ANTIVIRAL DRUG TAMIFLU REDUCES THE SPREAD OF FLU. FINDINGS PUBLISHED IN THE JOURNAL BRITISH MEDICAL JOURNAL (BMJ) QUESTION WHETHER GOVERNMENTS WORLDWIDE WERE JUSTIFIED IN SPENDING MILLIONS ON THE DRUG DURING THE 2009 SWINE FLU PANDEMIC. RESEARCHERS AT THE COCHRANE COLLABORATION AND BMJ HAVE LONG ARGUED THERE WEREN'T ENOUGH TRIALS TO PROVE TAMIFLU WORKS AND SAY AFTER GETTING ACCESS TO INTERNAL TRIALS CONDUCTED BY ITS MAKER, ROCHE AG, THEY FOUND TAMIFLU REDUCES FLU SYMPTOMS BY ABOUT

A HALF A DAY IN ADULTS BUT HAS LITTLE EFFECT ON CHILDREN.

=====OBESITY DURING
PREGNANCY RAISES STILLBIRTH RISK (25 SEC)

A NEW STUDY SAYS PREGNANT WOMEN WHO ARE OBESE OR OVERWEIGHT HAVE AN INCREASED RISK OF DELIVERING A STILLBORN BABY. RESEARCHERS CAME TO THAT CONCLUSION AFTER CONDUCTING A REVIEW OF 38 PAST STUDIES. THEY FOUND EVEN A MODEST INCREASE IN AN OBESE PREGNANT WOMAN'S WEIGHT IS LINKED TO AN INCREASED RISK OF FETAL DEATH, STILLBIRTH AND INFANT DEATH. THE HIGHEST RISK WAS IN WOMEN CONSIDERED SEVERELY OBESE.

=====WHAT YOUR SLEEPING
POSITION SAYS ABOUT YOUR RELATIONSHIP (25 sec)

A NEW STUDY, PRESENTED THIS WEEK AT THE EDINBURGH INTERNATIONAL SCIENCE FESTIVAL IN SCOTLAND, SUGGESTS YOUR PREFERRED SLEEPING HABITS MAY REVEAL A LOT ABOUT YOUR RELATIONSHIP. THE STUDY THAT ASKED MORE THAN A THOUSAND PEOPLE TO DESCRIBE THEIR PREFERRED SLEEPING HABITS AND THEN TO RATE THEIR PERSONALITY AND QUALITY OF THEIR RELATIONSHIPS AND IT LOOKS LIKE MOST OF US PREFER TO SLEEP FACING DIFFERENT DIRECTIONS, BUT STILL TOUCHING OR IN CLOSE PROXIMITY. WHEN ASKED THEIR FAVORITE SLEEPING POSITION, 42 PERCENT OF PEOPLE IN THE SURVEY SAID THEY PREFERRED SLEEPING BACK TO BACK AND 31-PERCENT LIKED TO SLEEP FACING THE SAME DIRECTION. ONLY 4-PERCENT OF PEOPLE SAID THEY PREFERRED TO SLEEP FACING EACH OTHER.
