LAST MONTH THE GOVERNOR DECLARED A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY BECAUSE OF A SPIKE IN OVERDOSE DEATHS BY PEOPLE ADDICTED TO HEROIN AND OTHER PAINKILLERS.
