

Ocean Mysteries Season One

Episode 101 – “Mysterious Mantas”

The manta ray is one of the ocean's stealthiest and most awe-inspiring creatures. Amazingly, not much is known about where they go or what they do. Georgia Aquarium is on the cutting edge of research and has developed ground-breaking satellite technology to track the manta's migratory patterns. Join host Jeff Corwin as he and the experts from Georgia Aquarium race to find and tag mantas in the open water in hopes of uncovering some of the unanswered questions about this mysterious animal.

Episode 102 – “Great Gators”

Deep in the wetlands, lives an apex predator that is the designer and keeper of its environment. It is the great American Alligator. Join host Jeff Corwin as he explores the Albino Alligator and its key characteristics at Georgia Aquarium and then ventures out to the Everglades to observe the Alligator in its natural habitat. He'll get hands-on with these amazing creatures that are a part of our national heritage.

Episode 103 – “Turtle Tale”

Animals are genetically designed to care for their young and generally make good parents. But sometimes, they are not destined to stay with and care for their offspring and the little ones become animal orphans. One such orphan is Murphy, a loggerhead sea turtle rescued by Georgia Aquarium. This is the story of Murphy and his journey from rescue, to rehabilitation, and finally to release back into the wild.

Episode 104 – “All's Whale That Ends Whale”

One of the most majestic creatures in the ocean can measure up to 40 feet in length, making it the largest fish in the world. Surprisingly, they are also the most docile. These gentle giants are Whale Sharks and despite their size, they are shrouded in mystery. Not much is known about their migratory patterns, their health requirements, and where they mate and give birth. Join host Jeff Corwin and the scientists of Georgia Aquarium as they strive to understand more about these amazing animals.

Episode 105 – “Birds of a Feather”

Many animals are at the mercy of their environments and when a disaster occurs, these animals and their habitats can become endangered. The Jackass Penguin and the Brown Pelican are two examples of animals in critical condition after catastrophic oil spills. In this episode, host Jeff Corwin visits with a group of well-dressed penguins at Georgia Aquarium, then journeys out to the Breton National Wildlife Refuge in Louisiana to study the Brown Pelican and the efforts in place to protect this precious species.

Episode 106 – “Reef Madness”

Coral reefs are critically important to our Earth's environment as they are home to countless marine animal species and form delicate ecosystems. But they are also in critical condition. Dive with host Jeff Corwin as he explores coral reefs and the work being done by Georgia Aquarium and the Coral Restoration Society to protect and preserve these important marine organisms.

Episode 107 – “Best Of 1”

From the Florida Everglades to the waters off the coast of Mexico, join host Jeff Corwin as he takes a look at some amazing moments on Ocean Mysteries. He'll come face to face with a cantankerous alligator, swim with mighty manta rays, and get up close and personal with the largest fish in the world, the whale shark.

Episode 108 – “Alien Invaders”

Imagine what would happen if an animal is introduced to a new environment with few or no predators. This is exactly what happened with the Lionfish off the East Coast of the United States. It is

reported that the Lionfish was both purposely discarded into the ocean by unsatisfied pet owners and accidentally released after Hurricane Andrew destroyed an aquarium. It has flourished to the point that great measures need to be taken to keep its population at bay. Host Jeff Corwin teams up with Georgia Aquarium and NOAA & together they set out to capture, study, and control this invasive species.

Episode 109 – “Tagging Along”

Even though sharks are at the top of the underwater food chain, their survival is in serious condition due to human activities. Host Jeff Corwin works alongside Georgia Aquarium experts to study sharks and their health. From tagging to drawing blood to performing an ultrasound, the team will work to better understand these apex predators and how conservation efforts can ensure their future.

Episode 110 – “Tough Jobs”

Ever wondered what goes into running the largest aquarium in the world? Join host Jeff Corwin as he finds out. He suits up, and along with the experts and some powerful tools, dives into the depths of the Georgia Aquarium. He learns exactly what it takes to maintain 8.5 million gallons of water and more than 120,000 animals.

Episode 111 – “Marine ER”

If you think emergency rooms are just for humans, think again! Although it's on land, the Marine Mammal Center rescues and rehabilitates injured marine mammals from ailments such as diseases, entanglements, and gunshot wounds. Join host Jeff Corwin as he goes behind the scenes in the emergency room and finds out how harbor seals and other marine animals are treated.

Episode 112 – “Go West – Otters”

Sea Otters are a keystone species in that they help keep their ecosystem in balance. At one point, humans hunted sea otters almost to extinction for their fur. But now, the major threats are pathogens, parasites, and oil spills. Join host Jeff Corwin as he travels to the California Coast as he works with the men and women of the Monterey Bay Aquarium to rescue stranded sea pups, place them in maternal care at the aquarium, and help them develop survival skills for their eventual release. It's a monumental effort, but all worth it, to save these loveable creatures.

Episode 112 – “Marine E.R.”

Episode 114 – “Stand by Your Manatee”

A long time ago, sailors reported seeing mysterious creatures swimming the oceans that they believed to be mermaids. But it is now believed that what they were actually seeing were Manatees. These ethereal animals can measure up to 13 feet, have paddle-like flippers, and are extremely gentle. Join host Jeff Corwin as he explores the world of the Manatee. He'll swim alongside them, examine their unique characteristics, and endeavor to learn just how intelligent they are.

Episode 115 – “Otter the Blue”

The staff at the Monterey Bay Aquarium is on the hunt for a distressed California sea otter that was recently released from the Sea Otter Rescue Program. Will they be able to find the otter, secure him safely, and bring him back in for treatment before it's too late? Join host Jeff Corwin as he helps locate and rescue a California sea otter in this exciting new adventure.

Episode 116 – “Best of #2: Jeff’s Favorite Ocean Memories”

Over the course of the show, we’ve studied many amazing animals, explored incredible marine environments, and made memories we will never forget. Join host Jeff Corwin as he reflects on his favorite moments from Ocean Mysteries and looks forward to creating many more.

Episode 117 – “Circle of Life”

In the hustle and bustle of our daily lives, we don’t always get to see the interconnectedness of the animals that share our planet. Dive in with host Jeff Corwin as he examines the circle of life in the waters off of Monterey Bay. He’ll experience the day in the life of some playful and rambunctious sea lions. And he gets up close and personal with the Ocean Sunfish, the world’s heaviest bony fish and perhaps the most unique looking. He’ll see how these creatures survive and play an important role in their ecosystem. It’s a side of marine life you don’t often get to see.

Episode 118 – “Secrets of the Deep”

Beneath the surface of the ocean lies a world full of mystery. Join host Jeff Corwin as he dives into the unknown and discovers what is hidden in the depths. He’ll uncover fossils from ancient creatures that reveal what life was like thousands of years ago. He’ll also encounter a nighttime spectacle of manta rays and go searching for the stealthiest creatures in order to learn the secrets to their survival.

Episode 119 – “Best of #3: Where Are They Now?”

Throughout the course of the show, host Jeff Corwin has been a part of several amazing adventures. Some of these have included animal rescues and releases. He takes a look back at a few of these memorable stories and finds out how these remarkable animals are doing now.

Episode 120 – “Hawaiian Monk Seals”

The Hawaiian monk seals are in a fight for the survival of their species. Follow host Jeff Corwin as he teams up with a group of dedicated men and women from NOAA to learn more about this native Hawaiian species and how to prevent their extinction. They’ll travel to a remote island to examine monk seals up close and be a part of a rescue effort to save a monk seal in trouble.

Episode 121 – “Hawaii Fly-O”

The native birds of Hawaii face a harrowing future: their extinction. Large populations have vanished due to invasive species. Join host Jeff Corwin as he travels to the rarely seen corners of Hawaii to get an up-close look at the spectacular Laysan albatross and other native bird species. He’ll learn how conservation efforts are striving to increase dwindling populations, and he’ll even get a special peek at a future generation of these amazing birds.

Episode 122 – “Turtle Tale: Part 2”

Once hunted for their meat and eggs, the green sea turtle’s population faced extinction. But thanks to conservation efforts and public awareness, their numbers have bounced back. Travel along with host Jeff Corwin as he works with the foremost experts on green sea turtles. He’ll get an up-close and personal look at these resilient animals and dive into their underwater world.

Episode 123 – “Elephan-TASTIC! Seals”

Every year, Año Nuevo State Park is the mating and birthing grounds of elephant seals. Join host Jeff Corwin as he gets an amazing look at these monolithic creatures, from the 2½ ton males battling for dominance to the newly weaned pups learning to swim. He'll also witness how some pups are not as lucky and end up stranded or abandoned. He'll take part in a rescue and see how The Marine Mammal Center is working to rehabilitate elephant seals and give them a new chance at life. It's an awe-inspiring journey you won't want to miss.

Episode 124 – “Best of 4: A Look Back”

Throughout the course of Ocean Mysteries, host Jeff Corwin has been a part of several memorable adventures. In this special episode, Jeff looks back at some of these amazing moments. It's an adventure you won't soon forget!

Episode 125 – “Dolphin Tale: Part 1”

Bernie Marcus, the founder of The Georgia Aquarium, has always had a vision to bring bottle-nosed dolphins to the city of Atlanta. Through the tireless efforts of the Aquarium staff and volunteers, his vision is turned into a reality. Follow the Georgia Aquarium as they build an exhibit capable of housing dolphins that will teach people of all generations the importance of these animals and the environments they live in.

Episode 126 – “Dolphin Tale: Part 2”
