SECTION 1 – Issues

The stations have identified the following topics as significant issues facing our community this quarter:

- A. **Homelessness/Poverty.** There have been an increasing number of homeless individuals and families in Butte and Southwest Montana and many facing the winter months without basic necessities. Our stations had several discussions on ways people can find shelter, assistance and counseling.
- B. **Drug Abuse/Crime.** Drug abuse and distribution is leading to more and more crime in our area. We had discussions with several high-ranking officials on where the drugs come from, what to do if you see something and what needs to be done to control the problem.
- C. **Addiction.** Along with increased drug abuse comes more and more people facing addiction problems. This quarter we discussed ways to find help and ways to help others who are struggling.
- D. **Tourism/Local Economy.** Butte is seeing a greater percentage of our economy coming from festivals, events and tourism. We discussed the ways that local officials are promoting our community, how citizens can help and what we can expect over the upcoming season.
- E. **Environmental/Pollution Issues.** Butte, our local government, the EPA and the Atlantic Richfield Corporation are discussing ways of dealing with mine waste. We had discussions about the debate on where to deposit mine waste and ways the public can stay informed and get involved.

New Businesses Opening and Eric Saldo Project

We were joined by Stephanie Sorini of the Butte Chamber of Commerce and discussed the opening of a new tavern in Uptown Butte along with the new businesses it is joining in a revitalized corridor. We discussed Uptown restaurants and the number of people they employ along with what preparations they are taking for the three major basketball tournaments that are coming to town. We discussed the Eric Saldo Project where this nationally-renowned artist is creating a jigsaw puzzle that is Butte-based, promotes Butte and Southwest Montana and is available worldwide. Senator Steve Daines - January 2024

We talked with United States Senator Steve Daines who stated that drugs and violent crime are the biggest issues facing Montanans.
