KPLR-TV must broadcast four (4) pre-filing announcements, announcing the upcoming filing of the license renewal application on the following dates: August 1, August 16, September 1, and September 16. At least two of these announcements must air between either 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and/or 4:00 p.m and 6:00 p.m.

SCRIPT

On April 18, 2006, KPLR-TV was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until February 1, 2014. Our license will expire on February 1, 2014. We must file an application for license renewal with the FCC on or before October 1, 2013. When filed, a copy of this application will be available for inspection during regular business hours. It contains information concerning the station's performance from February 1, 2006, to February 1, 2014.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application, and to whether this station has operated in the public interest, should file comments and petitions with the FCC by January 2, 2014.
