<u>Issue One</u>: Depression, Divorce, Suicide, Etc. - Ecuentros Con La Palabra de Dios

KHOY airs an original block program with Host Father Jacinto Olguin, Parochial Vicar of Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Laredo. Every week, on a new episode of the 28-minute program, Father Olguin invites listeners to pay close attention to their relationships with their family, friends, coworkers, and community at large. Common themes include relationship conflict management, spiritual divorce consulting, parent-children relationships, social awareness, diversity and inclusion, overcoming tragedy and addiction, and cultivating positive attitudes, behaviors and responses. This program recognizes strategies to improve one's quality of life and relationships through prayer, observation, compassion, and action. It suggests how to be compassionate and understanding to oneself and those around us dealing with severe circumstances such as chronic depression, anxiety, illness, death, addiction and more. In a society plagued by high divorce, suicide, and trauma rates, Encuentros con La Palabra de Dios stresses the importance of empathy, self-control and inner and outer attempts at peace. The program includes examples and situations of trials in life, especially in regard to family matters, and offers suggestions toward increasing mindfulness in any environment, invoking a spiritual, physiological, and societal journey toward healing.
