The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Kit Kar Luong (Murder) – On January 20, 1998 Kit Kar Luong, along with David Henry Nickle, committed a home invasion robbery in the affluent neighborhood of University Park, Texas, a suburb of Dallas. The home belonged to John Mark Hardy and his mother Mildred Rose Hardy. Luong and Nickle entered the residence with their handguns drawn. Luong shot John to death while Mildred was held at gunpoint by Nickle. Nickle is in custody and is serving a fifteen-year sentence for his part in the offense. Luong likes to look good. He hangs out in bowling alleys and likes to frequent Asian massage parlors. Luong is 21, 5'5" and 140 pounds.

Stephen Howard Anderson (Attempted Murder of a Police Officer) – On October 14, 2001, Bell County, Kentucky sheriff's deputy Scott Elder pulled over Steve Anderson for a broken tail light on his pickup truck. Anderson told the deputy that he was a lieutenant with the anti-government group, Kentucky Militia, and was on duty. He also said he didn't have a license with him and was permitted to have a weapon. When Deputy Elder was about to place him under arrest, Anderson pulled out a rifle and fires 23 shots at him. The deputy took cover behind the patrol car and was not injured. His patrol car was riddled with bullets. Anderson fled into a mountainous area and abandoned his vehicle. He fled on foot and hasn't been seen since. Inside his truck, ATF found 9,000 rounds of ammunition, a rifle and six pipe bombs. They searched Anderson's home and found weapons, explosives and hate material. ATF charged Anderson with weapons violations and the Kentucky State Police have filed charges of attempted murder of a police officer. Anderson had a shortwave radio show in which he aired his hate information. He was also a member of the KKK. Anderson is a survivalist who stocks up on supplies and food often. He claims to have worked as an electrician. Anderson is 55, 6'2" and 235 pounds.

Thomas Deering (Escape) – On February 3, 2000 Thomas Deering broke into a woman's home. The victim woke up and found him in her bedroom. Deering grabbed her and began to choke her from behind. The victim tried to get away, but couldn't. Deering warned her not to scream or he would kill her kids. He then raped her. The victim finally broke away and ran upstairs. Deering was finally located and put behind bars. He was convicted of sexual assault, kidnapping and burglary and sent to a maximum security prison for sixty years. But on October 4, 2002 Deering escaped. He climbed into a wooden palette, was loaded into a truck and then driven right out of the prison gate. He hasn't been seen since. Deering has a small blurry tattoo on his left hand, a coyote tattoo on his left shoulder, and a faded Grim Reaper tattoo on his right shoulder. He likes to drink and gamble, and may be working as a pizza delivery man somewhere in the Midwest. Police suspect that Deering's father gave him a .357 Magnum handgun. Deering is 28, 6'0" and 175 pounds.

Angel Manuel Rivera (Murder) – Rivera murdered three of his tenants on June 26, 1991. Witnesses saw Rivera pull up to the Santa Cruz house he rented out to several tenants. Rivera had an argument with tenant Geronimo Aragon Modesto about working on cars in the driveway of the house. Rivera pulled out a gun and shot him, killing Modesto immediately. Hearing the shots, Juan Rodriguez, a father of two, ran outside to see what the commotion was about; Rivera shot him as well. Rodriguez died at the hospital shortly after. Rodriguez's common-law wife ran out of the house next, leaving their two small children inside. Rivera shot her as she exited the front door, killing her immediately. Rivera then fled the scene. In 1999 Rivera surfaced at the home of a distant cousin, Felix Gusman. The Gusman family offered him a room, telling him he could stay for a few nights or until he found a place to live. Rivera, however, ended up staying for several months. Gusman had heard that Rivera had killed someone and confronted Rivera. Rivera said the shooting was in self-defense and that he was the victim of a stabbing, showing Gusman old surgery scars as evidence. It was during this time that Rivera became involved with the Gusman daughter, Myra. Rivera moved to East Chicago and asked Myra and her 11-year-old son, Orlando Sotomayor, to join him. Gusman warned his daughter of the murders, but she went anyway. Gusman never saw his daughter again. On December 12, 1999, Myra's son said goodnight to his mother and Rivera, then went to sleep. The next morning he woke up to find his mother strangled to death. Since 1999 Rivera has been getting food and shelter from the unsuspecting Puerto Rican Catholic Church. Claiming to be a religious man, he seeks the help of the community and priest for food and shelter in exchange for light yard work and home repairs. Rivera, who has used the aliases Jose Robles, Sylvester Vasquez, Miguel Rivera and Manuel Rivera, has a surgical scar on the right side of his abdomen, a lump on his left shoulder, and may have surgical scars on his left shin and knee. He takes handyman-type jobs and may make money as a day laborer. He is a compulsive liar with a history of battering his women and children. He may walk with a limp, and reputedly collects guns. Rivera is 57, 5'9" and 160-170 pounds. (See Shows #665 and #683, OADs 2/16/02 and 7/13/02)

Dara Marie Llorens (Interference With Child Custody) – Llorens abducted her 5-year-old daughter, Sabrina Allen, on April 20, 2002 in Austin, Texas. Llorens was unhappy with her visitation arrangement and abducted her own child. Dara was married to Greg Allen, an Austin engineer, for three years. Sabrina was their only child. During the divorce proceedings Dara was

diagnosed by a court-appointed psychologist as suffering from a personality disorder and on his recommendation Greg Allen was awarded sole custody of their daughter. Dara began lodging a series of allegations with Child Protective Services that her ex-husband was abusing Sabrina. CPS investigators ruled that there was no evidence of abuse. They were suspicious that Dara was fabricating these allegations and ordered her into therapy. Shortly after this, Dara and Sabrina vanished. Llorens, whose numerous aliases include Deena Marie Guerro, Deena Lamont, Deena Patel, Deena Groves, Deena Patterson, Deena Green, Dara Marie Rose, and the nickname "Marie", has pierced ears, a long deep scar on the back of her right knee, and scars from surgery on both Achilles tendons. She walks with a slight limp from cerebral palsy as a child. She is left-handed, speaks poor Spanish, and typically works in clothing and shoe retail, as a waitress, in auto sales, jewelry sales, secretarial work, child care, cake decorator, and as a live-in nanny. She has a history of melanoma. She can be charismatic and charming, but can be volatile, yelling, stomping and slamming doors. She often tells dramatic stories to elicit sympathy. Llorens is 32, 5'6" and 100 pounds.

Thomas James McCray (Aggravated Murder) – McCray sexually assaulted and murdered his 21-year-old friend Stephanie Evans in Ross County, Ohio. On the night of April 2, 2001, McCray went to Stephanie's home in Richmond Dale, Ohio and somehow persuaded Stephanie to leave her home with her two-year-old son Justin in their Ford minivan. The next morning two fishermen found Justin outdoors, strapped in his car seat near the banks of the Scioto River. Stephanie's body was found a few hundred yards away in the river, covered with large rocks. An examination of the body showed that she had been sexually assaulted and beaten to death. Police soon found Stephanie's van abandoned and partially charred from a fire that had been set inside. Detectives were able to recover a fingerprint matching Stephanie's friend T.J. McCray. McCray had a record of trouble with the law as a juvenile and as an adult. Investigators were able to find McCray's DNA at Stephanie's home, inside the van, and on Stephanie's body. McCray was last sighted in September in Massachusetts where he stole a truck. The truck was later recovered in Gray, Maine. McCray, who has used the aliases Thomas James Ware and the nickname "T.J.", has tattoos of a crucifix on his back right shoulder and a starburst around his left nipple. He smokes cigarettes, and prefers to roll his own, but will smoke filtered cigarettes when nothing else available, breaking off the filter and smoking until there is nearly nothing left. He may travel on freight trains and may associate with the Rainbow Hobo Association, a freight-train jumping organization/gang. McCray is 21, 6'1" and 169 pounds.

Room 118 of the Relax Inn, using his own name. 26-year-old Christina Paddock checked in with him at around 3:00pm. At 5:00am the next morning, Jones checked out alone. Hours later, the cleaning crew entered Room 118 and found Christina strangled, her head covered with a jacket. Jones, who has previous arrests for various sex charges, armed robbery and accessory to murder, has been in and out of prison since 1971. He is 58, 5'10" and 200 pounds. (See Show #678, OAD 6/1/02)

Robert Ellis Cox (Sexual Abuse of a Child) – Cox was a police officer with the West Valley Police Department in Salt Lake Valley, Utah. Cox married a woman who had two young daughters. Shortly after he retired from the police force, the daughters revealed that Cox had been having sex with them. The sexual abuse incidents occurred during the summer of 1995 to June 1996. The oldest girl was eleven years old at the time. An investigation into the allegations was launched, but before it could be concluded, Cox fled the state. He resurfaced in Minnesota and got a job at a Wal-Mart. Police detectives tracked him there and had Minnesota cops make contact with Cox and conduct a video-taped interview about the molestation case back in Utah. Cox was not placed under arrest at the time, and vanished once again after the interview. Cox, who has used the alias Wade Robert Garret, is good at changing his appearance. He smokes, drinks Pepsi, likes to shoot guns and probably has weapons. Cox is 42, 6'2" and 190 pounds.

Gordon Douglas Weaver (Murder) B Weaver is wanted for the October 16, 1999 murder of his wife. Police in White Bear Lake, Minnesota say he set her still-living body on fire. The resulting blaze killed Jean Weaver and destroyed their home. Weaver was arrested on October 3, 1999 and spent two days in jail prior to being released on bond. After posting his bail, Weaver disappeared from the Minnesota area and is believed to have attempted to stage his own death in Illinois. The vehicle that Weaver was driving was found next to a river in Summit, Illinois. Some of Weaver's personal belongings were subsequently recovered near a bus stop in Chicago. On March 15, 2000 a Ramsey County, Minnesota grand jury indicted Weaver in absentia for the murder of his wife. A federal arrest warrant was issued on March 28, 2000. Weaver, who is described as a camera-shy social recluse, has a wealthy family. He has had a full beard in the past, may have dyed his hair and beard a darker color, and sometimes wears glasses. He may be taking medication for depression. Weaver has a computer-related masters degree in Management Information Systems. He may be a soccer fan, player or coach. Weaver is 45, 5'10" and 198 pounds. (See Shows #613 and #638, OADs 12/16/00 and 6/23/01)

Shawn was last seen on October 6, 2002 at around 1:00pm when he left his home on a 21-inch lime-green Next brand mountain bike on his way to a friend's house. Shawn's mother called the friend around 3:00pm but the friend told her that Shawn never arrived. Police began searching immediately but there has been no sign of Shawn. Police suspect that Shawn was abducted. Shawn has a hoop earring in his left ear. His distinctive bicycle, which is in need of repair, has all the reflectors missing, bent handlebars, no kickstand, one bent fender, a black seat with a 2" rip, a missing derailleur guard, and the lettering "Shock Zone" is partially missing. The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

James Sali (Murder) – On November 9, 2001, Kansas City, Missouri police officers were dispatched to an area just south of the Missouri River alongside railroad tracks that run in that area. Also along that area are numerous camps that are inhabited by homeless individuals. Upon arrival officers located the body of a white male that had been concealed up along the edge of the tracks. The victim had received multiple severe injuries that caused his death. The victim and several other camp members had pooled together a sum of money for beer, and had given the money to James Sali and another man to go and buy the beer and bring it back to the camp. Sali had been in the camps for a short time. The victim had been living in the camps in the area for several months. When Sali and the other man did not return right away, the victim left the camps with his dog to go see what had taken so long. About fifteen minutes after the victim left the camps, Sali and the other male returned to the camps alone, with the victim's dog. Sali and the other individual quickly threw some belongings together and hopped a train out of town. The victim was found dead the next day. Detectives interviewed Sali's companion from that night. He said that when he and Sali went to buy beer, they were stopped on the way back to the camp by some police officers who made them pour out the beer. They eventually ran into the victim. The victim confronted Sali and began to yell at him about having stolen some of the victim's liquor. Sali then assaulted the victim and then concealed the victim's body. He then hopped a train to Amarillo, Texas with the companion. After getting to Amarillo the two split ways. Sali has a criminal record in Texas, Florida, Minnesota and Virginia. He has prior convictions for robbery, assault, exhibiting a weapon, resisting arrest and carrying a concealed weapon. Sali is known to move around frequently, hopping trains for transportation. Sali, who has a tattoo of an arrow on his face, wears a bandana and is a member of the "Frequent Train Riders of America". He is 37 and 5'9".

Prescott Sigmund (Explosives violations) – On July 12, 2002, 21-year-old Wright Sigmund went into the garage under his father's insurance office in northwest Washington, D.C. to run an errand and started his father's SUV. The car was booby-trapped with one or more explosive devices, including a pipe bomb underneath the seat. It exploded when Wright turned the key in the ignition. Miraculously, Wright survived, but with disfiguring and nearly mortal wounds. Investigators were convinced the bomb was actually meant for Wright's 62-year-old father, Donald, and that it had been planted within the week. On July 15, Donald's oldest son Prescott, who is Wright's half brother, disappeared. Prescott was known as an affable, mild-mannered suburban father of two. The intense investigation surrounding the bombing brought to light his secret double life. He had apparently been fired seven months before, but pretended to work every day. His wife then discovered he had raided her retirement funds, taken out credit cards in his parents' names, and left the household bills unpaid for months. In October 2002, federal authorities were able to show probable cause to charge Prescott Sigmund with the bombing. Though the affidavit is under seal, investigators say it includes both circumstantial and forensic evidence that ties Prescott to the pipe bomb. Prescott, who goes by the nicknames Scott, Sig, Sean, Jack, and Cole, is an outdoorsman who loves cold wether camping and fly fishing. He drinks inexpensive beer but expensive bourbon. He likes to quote lines from comedies such as Monty Python, Austin Powers, Caddyshack and The Simpsons. He's a meat and potatoes guy who loves to barbecue, doesn't eat seafood, and has allergies to mushrooms, cheese, and mold. He sometimes smokes cigars, and has a space between his front teeth. He has worked in insurance and healthcare software. He wears metal horn-rim Armani glasses with clip-on sunglasses. He plays golf. Prescott Sigmund is 35, 5'11" and 240 pounds.

Unknown Killers of Jam Master Jay – On the evening of October 30, 2002, Jason "Jam Master Jay" Mizell was shot and killed inside his Jamaica, Queens recording studio. He and an unnamed male companion were working in the studio when two men were buzzed into the building shortly after 7:30pm. Once inside, they immediately fired gunshots, wounding the companion and fatally injuring Jam Master Jay. The two suspects escaped and remain at large. No motives have been established.

Michael Alfonso (Murder, Aggravated Stalking) – Alfonso is wanted in Wheaton, Illinois for the murder of Genoveva Franco Velasquez on the morning of June 6, 2001. Velasquez was killed as she approached the entrance to the McDonald's where she worked as assistant manager. Alfonso walked past cars at the drive-thru window, then pulled a gun from his duffle bag, shooting Velasquez in the chest. He then stood over the victim and fired more shots into her. Witnesses say he fled the scene on foot, dropped his gun and jumped into a parked car in a lot behind the McDonald's. The victim worked with Alfonso at her second job with the Pampered Chef. Velasquez had been having an affair with Alfonso, but decided to break it off and remain with her husband and 9-year-old daughter. On June 5th, Velasquez reported for work at the Pampered Chef and was confronted by an angry Alfonso. He refused to leave her alone unless she agreed to talk to him. When Velasquez tried to leave, Alfonso grabbed her arm and pulled her backwards. He threatened Velasquez and her family, saying he might show up at her house. Velasquez called the police, but requested that Alfonso not be contacted, because she was afraid that he would retaliate. Alfonso, whose birth name is Michael Johnson, is 33, 5'6" and 150 pounds. Joel Vidal Urena (murder, assault with a firearm, robbery, false imprisonment) -- On October 5, 1996, Steve Kerston was awakened at 5 a.m. by flashlights in his eyes. Four masked men had broken into his family's Cotati, California home. Police say it was Joel Urena and three accomplices. Steve says the men attacked him and then went into his parents' bedroom. The men demanded money, jewels and guns from Mark and Mary Kerston. When the couple insisted that they had none, one of the men went out to the living room and shot Steve in the leg. When the couple still insisted they had no valuables, the men threatened to shoot Steve in the head. Mercifully, they didn't follow through on the threat. Instead, they grabbed whatever they could get their hands on and took off. Urena has scars on his face from a car accident and another scar on his right hand. Although of Hawaiian heritage, he may appear Hispanic. He may be wearing a moustache. Urena may be driving a 80's-90's silver or blue metallic Chevrolet Blazer or a 80's black Chevrolet Astro van. He is 31, 6'0" and 260 pounds. (See Shows #472, #509 #537, #556, #582 and #628, OADs 11/1/97, 8/29/98, 4/10/99, 9/4/99, 4/1/00 and 4/7/01)

Raul Castro (Murder) -- On November 11, 1987 at approximately 10:30pm, Raul Castro shot and killed Anthony Zaquon Jones. Castro was never arrested for the offense and has been a fugitive ever since. On February 23, 1998 a warrant was issued for the arrest of Castro charging his with second degree murder. Castro has several aliases, including Rodney Castanada, Rodney Castineta, Rod Castanada, Rodney, Castaned, and Antonio Figueroa. Castro is 34, 6'0" and 145 pounds.

AMW ALL-POINTS BULLETINS:

Anthony Fu Yin Chang (Murder) -- The United States Postal Service has issued a warrant for Anthony Chang for conspiring to mail a bomb disguised as a toy dog to Patrick Hsu, the younger brother of Chang's ex-wife, Wendy Hsu. The bomb exploded, killing Patrick Hsu almost instantly. The investigation led to Anthony Chang's friend David Lien who mailed the package from Milpitas, California while Anthony Chang was under house arrest with an electronic ankle control in Las Vegas. Lien is in custody and is awaiting trial for the same charges as Chang. The bombing ended the turbulent relationship between Anthony and Wendy, which had included domestic violence. They were briefly married, and when she filed for and got a divorce, the bomb was mailed within a month. Chang has several tattoos, including the Chinese symbol for Kamikaze inside his left forearm (a Chinese gang affiliation sign), a ying-yang symbol topped by an eagle with "Anthony" above it on his right shoulder, the Chinese

symbol for "Wendy" on his upper left chest and "Wendy" in English characters on his upper right chest. He likes motorcycles, has worked in a mechanic's shop, and had a maroon and cream Suzuki Marauder. He has very thick facial hair, very prominent eyebrows, and sometimes wears a goatee. He has a violent temper and has been known to hit people in public. He may be involved with cocaine and marijuana dealers. Chang is 32, 5'8" and 160 pounds. (See Show #692, OAD 9/21/02)

Anibal Mustelier (Extortion, Bank Larceny) – In 1989, Mustelier was hired to kill Frank Condom, a Miami businessman. On December 22, 1989, Mustelier and another thug, Nelson Cruz, followed Frank in their car as Frank left a nightclub. As Frank drove home, Mustelier emptied a 30-round clip from his machine gun into Frank's car, then sped away. Frank somehow managed to escape the attack with only a gunshot wound to his arm. Mustelier and his crew weren't done. Mustelier and several other men planned to use a bomb to blow Frank up. On August 17, 1990, Cruz and two other men went to Frank's mother's house and put a bomb under Frank's car. When Frank and his family got into the car, the bombers detonated the device. Once again the attack failed. Frank and several members of his family suffered serious injuries but fortunately none died from the blast. Eventually, most of the group was arrested but Mustelier managed to slip away. Mustelier resurfaced in 1996 when he pulled off one of the largest bank heists in south Florida. Mustelier put together a crew of criminals and was able to get safety deposit box keys made for the Sun Trust Bank. On November 18, 1996, two men went into the bank and got away with approximately 8,000 pieces of jewelry valued at between \$5 million and \$7 million from three different safety deposit boxes. The men gave the money to Mustelier, who disappeared. Authorities believe Mustelier fled to Venezuela shortly after the robbery, but may currently be back in Florida. Mustelier has used numerous aliases including Emilio Suarez, Barrero Musteler, Anibal Musieler, Ramon Llercna, and Anivan Mutelier. He has a small scar on his neck, wears contact lenses or glasses, and is known to keep in shape and work out at gyms. He may be taking ballroom dance lessons or hanging out in dance clubs. There are rumors that he has ties to Castro as a hitman. Mustelier is 52, 5'4" and 135 pounds. (See Shows #664 and #681, OADs 2/9/02 and 6/22/02)

Richard Vallee (Murder of a Government Witness) – Vallee is wanted for the car bomb murder of a government informant named Lee Carter in Plattsburg, New York. Carter was just a part time bartender at a Bowl-Mart bowling alley when he was approached to smuggle cocaine into Canada to its ultimate buyer, Richard Vallee. As a result of Carter's undercover work, Vallee was charged with cocaine trafficking. Vallee retaliated with a car bomb for Carter in the Bowl-Mart parking lot. Vallee was eventually charged in Carter's death. While awaiting extradition into the U.S. from Canada, Vallee devised a plan to break out of prison. He got into a fight and purposely had his jaw broken, knowing that he would be taken to a hospital. Vallee

escaped from Saint Luc's Hospital on June 5, 1997. There is no doubt that wherever Vallee is hiding, the Hells Angels are helping him out. Richard Vallee is on the U.S. Marshall's Fifteen Most Wanted List. Vallee has a violent temper and loves explosives. Vallee, who has used the alias Rick, Rich, or Richard Valley, speaks with a French accent. He is 44, 5'10" and 195 pounds. (See Shows #613 and #642, OADs 12/16/00 and 7/28/02)

CAPTURED:

Thomas James McCray (Aggravated Murder) – McCray sexually assaulted and murdered his 21-year-old friend Stephanie Evans in Ross County, Ohio. On the night of April 2, 2001, McCray went to Stephanie's home in Richmond Dale, Ohio and somehow persuaded Stephanie to leave her home with her two-year-old son Justin in their Ford minivan. The next morning two fishermen found Justin outdoors, strapped in his car seat near the banks of the Scioto River. Stephanie's body was found a few hundred yards away in the river, covered with large rocks. An examination of the body showed that she had been sexually assaulted and beaten to death. Police soon found Stephanie's van abandoned and partially charred from a fire that had been set inside. Detectives were able to recover a fingerprint matching Stephanie's friend T.J. McCray. McCray had a record of trouble with the law as a juvenile and as an adult. Investigators were able to find McCray's DNA at Stephanie's home, inside the van, and on Stephanie's body. McCray was captured in Canada on October 3, 2002, the day following the broadcast. (See Show #695, OAD 11/2/02)

Samuel Jones, Jr. (Murder, Sex Charges) – On November 1, 2001, Jones checked into Room 118 of the Relax Inn, using his own name. 26-year-old Christina Paddock checked in with him at around 3:00pm. At 5:00am the next morning, Jones checked out alone. Hours later, the cleaning crew entered Room 118 and found Christina strangled, her head covered with a jacket. Jones was captured in Chicago on October 5, 2002. (See Shows #678 and #695, OADs 6/1/02 and 11/2/02)

Angel Manuel Rivera (Murder) – Rivera murdered three of his tenants on June 26, 1991. Witnesses saw Rivera pull up to the Santa Cruz house he rented out to several tenants. Rivera had an argument with tenant Geronimo Aragon Modesto about working on cars in the driveway of the house. Rivera pulled out a gun and shot him, killing Modesto immediately. Hearing the shots, Juan Rodriguez, a father of two, ran outside to see what the commotion was about; Rivera shot him as well. Rodriguez died at the hospital shortly after. Rodriguez's common-law wife ran out of the house next, leaving their two small children inside. Rivera shot her as she exited the front door, killing her immediately. Rivera then fled the scene. In 1999 Rivera surfaced at

the home of a distant cousin, Felix Gusman. The Gusman family offered him a room, telling him he could stay for a few nights or until he found a place to live. River, however, ended up staying for several months. Gusman had heard that Rivera had killed someone and confronted Rivera. Rivera said the shooting was in self-defense and that he was the victim of a stabbing, showing Gusman old surgery scars as evidence. It was during this time that Rivera became involved with the Gusman daughter, Myra. Rivera moved to East Chicago and asked Myra and her 11-year-old son, Orlando Sotomayor, to join him. Gusman warned his daughter of the murders, but she went anyway. Gusman never saw his daughter again. On December 12, 1999, Myra's son said goodnight to his mother and Rivera, then went to sleep. The next morning he woke up to find his mother strangled to death. Viewer tips led authorities to Redding, Pennsylvania where Rivera was captured Tuesday night, October 5, 2002. (See Shows #665, #683 and #695, OADs 2/16/02, 7/13/02 and 11/2/02)

UPDATE:

Esat Bici (Murder) – Bici is wanted for the murder of Julio Rivera in Queens, New York. On July 2, 1990, Bici, Eric Brown and Daniel Doyle targeted Julio because he was a homosexual. Brown started a conversation with Julio to lure him into a schoolyard, here three members of the DMS gang attacked Julio with a knife, hammer and wrench. Julio died at the scene from a punctured lung. In November 1991, Bici, Brown and Doyle were found guilty of murder. The convictions of Bici and Brown were later overturned due to small technicalities. Bici was scheduled to reappear in court on May 14, 1996 but jumped bail. A viewer tip alerted authorities to the fact that Bici had been killed in Tijuana, Mexico and his body was in a local morgue. (See Shows #425, #443 and #595, OADs 9/8/96, 3/15/97 and 7/15/00)

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Edward Santana (Murder) – Guiselle Rojas, 39, was returning home from a dance club on June 13, 2002, and was ambushed on the way into her house by Santana, who dragged her into the grass and stabbed her more than fifty times with a screwdriver. Rojas met Santana when they were “paired” up at a salsa class and often went to clubs to dance with a group of friends from those classes. Santana persistently and openly courted Rojas at those classes and gatherings until she finally decided to go on a date at the encouragement of her friends. All of them had nothing but good things to say about Santana. They started dating roughly a year after meeting but Rojas’s sister Michelle said that the relationship wasn’t very serious and Rojas had told her that it wasn’t long-term. She also said that when Rojas bought a new house, Santana became an unwanted guest, practically moving himself in. Santana loves to frequent Las Vegas, and while on a trip there with Rojas, an event occurred that was a turning point in their relationship. Rojas and Santana apparently got into an argument, which is when she first saw Santana’s ugly side. This was probably the first occurrence of domestic violence. Rojas decided to end the relationship and Santana violently threatened her. Rojas was very afraid of this new side of Santana and had a restraining order put on him. Rojas was so afraid of Santana that she changed her phone number, installed an alarm and outdoor lighting on her house. She wouldn’t stay home alone and her mother spent the night often. None of Santana’s friends, Rojas, or even her family knew much about Santana’s past, where he was from, and they even thought his name as “Juan”. They were surprised when authorities told them about Santana’s history of physical abuse with his ex-wife and girlfriends including a brutal assault and battery, stalking and vandalism. Police believe that Santana will continue to attend salsa lessons and frequent salsa clubs. He has no bank or credit card records. Santana, who has used the aliases and nicknames of Juanito, Juan, and Pierre, has a scar on the back of his neck. He is a heavy drinker and speaks

with a distinctive Puerto Rican accent. Santana is 51, 5'7" and 169 pounds.

Steven Anthony Peppaceno (Parole Violation) – On June 21, 2002, Peppaceno introduced himself as an ex-police officer and Vietnam war veteran to two women in a Greenwich Village bar. The women, who only with to be identified as Kelly and Amber, believed he was a nice guy and accompanied Peppaceno to a 24-hour bagel shop. They then agreed to let him spend the night at Amber's apartment because he was too intoxicated to drive home to Long Island. However, Peppaceno was not planning on quietly falling asleep. Kelly, who was to catch an early flight to California, had taken a shower, and when she emerged from the bathroom was attacked by Peppaceno. Peppaceno punched Kelly in the face and held a knife to her throat as he attempted to rape her. When she fought back, Peppaceno began stabbing her. Peppaceno would have killed her had the knife not broken during the struggle. After Peppaceno ran from the apartment Kelly was able to wake Amber, who had fallen asleep on the couch, and call 911. The NYPD did not know Peppaceno's identity until they sent a surveillance photo from the bagel shop to parole officers throughout New York state. A parole officer in Long Island recognized his photo and informed the NYPD that Peppaceno has a lengthy rap sheet dating back to 1979 and had spent ten years in prison after luring a woman from a bar and beating her with a barbell after she refused his sexual advances. They also learned that he was neither a cop nor a Vietnam vet. Peppaceno, who has used the aliases Steven Gallo, Steven Anzalone, Stephen Catapano and Anthony Messina, has a bullet wound scar on his left elbow and numerous tattoos, including Astroboy, a heart and Vietnam vet on his right forearm, Mickey Mouse, a butterfly and a skeleton on his left forearm, an eagle and mace on his upper right arm, a rose and heart on his upper left arm, a black rose on his chest and the Road Runner on his buttocks. He is a compulsive liar who becomes violent when drunk. A high school dropout, he could be working as a landscaper or laborer and is known to frequent biker bars. He is a racist, and works out all the time. Peppaceno is 44, 5'8" and 200 pounds.

Michael J. Coppola (Murder) – In the early morning hours of Easter Sunday, 1997, John "Johnny Cokes" Lardiere was murdered gangland style outside a hotel in Bridgewater, New Jersey. Police knew Lardiere was a member of the Genovese crime family but it would take almost twenty years for them to get a break in the case. That break came in 1996 when another mobster who had been arrested on murder and extortion decided to cooperate with authorities. The mobster told police that Lardiere's killer was Michael Coppola, who was now a top man in the Genovese organization. However, authorities knew they had little weight with the testimony of their informant so they decided to take another look at the evidence. That's when they realized that hair samples had been preserved from a hat found at the scene of the crime. The hair was sent to the FBI lab in Quantico, Virginia where DNA was successfully extracted. A judge then gave a court order for Michael Coppola to provide saliva samples on August 8, 1996. Michael Coppola never showed for his scheduled date. He has since been charged with the murder of John Lardiere. Coppola, who has used the nicknames Mikey Cigars, Filma and Little Mike, is a workout enthusiast who runs and cycles. He is very fit and muscular for his age, and as an avid golfer may be living in a warm climate. He is known to gamble. He has a thick New Jersey Accent, is well groomed and extremely neat, and may smoke a cigar occasionally. Coppola is 56, 5'7" and 160 pounds.

Jennifer Servo Killer (Homicide) – 22-year-old Jennifer Servo was less than three

months into her first full-time job as a TV reporter for the Abilene, Texas NBC station when her colleagues noticed that she was not responding to phone messages at her home. They asked her apartment manager to check on her and that's when she was found dead. Servo had been strangled and had suffered a head trauma. Jennifer was found fully clothes, but an autopsy turned up bruises on her body that indicate she had been sexually assaulted before she was killed. Missing from her apartment was a "Guess" purse with a photo of Anna Nicole Smith on it, three seasons of "Sex In The City" and "Saving Private Ryan" on DVD, and a Kyocera brand cell phone.

Andre Neverson (Wanted for Questioning for Murder) – On Monday, July 8, 2002, NYPD cops arrived at the Brooklyn home of 39-year-old Patricia Neverson. She was found, shot to death. Three days later, on July 11, cops found the body of 34-year-old Donna Davis. Authorities have learned that Andre Neverson had an ongoing argument with his sister, Patricia, stemming from Andre's money which she used to buy her home. Neverson did not want the money repaid; instead, he wanted the house. Donna Davis had been dating Andre, but she had recently broken off the relationship. Neverson did not take the rejection well. The last time Donna was seen alive, she was in Andre's minivan outside a Queens, New York college where she studied. Days after the second murder, cops placed Neverson in Brooklyn, but after that, the trail runs cold. Neverson has used numerous aliases including Troy Michael Anderson, Troy Michael Henderson, Trey Michael Henderson, Andre Humphrey and Andre Henderson. He has a very muscular build and a shaved head, but he may be starting to grow hair again to change his appearance. He does not drink or smoke, is very intelligent and computer literate. At times he is very calm and serene, but he has a violent temper and has served time for attempted murder. He does not drink or smoke, and may be hidden now by one of his many girlfriends. He is originally from Trinidad, but does not have an accent. He has worked as a bouncer in Caribbean clubs and as a security guard at a hospital. He has been know to buy cars, fix them up, then resell them. He may still be armed. Neverson is 38, 6'0" and 225 pounds. (See Show #684, OAD 7/27/02)

Norman Pineda (Attempted Murder, Kidnapping, Rape) – Pineda, aka Jose Ramon Perez, is wanted for the kidnapping, rape and attempted murder of his former wife, Shuntele Mantele. The two were married for about four months during 2001, when Shuntele decided to end the marriage due to Pineda's excessive drinking. Since that time, Pineda has been trying to persuade Shuntele to reconcile. In the months before the attack, Pineda had taken to driving to Shuntele's house, often asking her if he could spend the night. Shuntele refused and turned him away each time, but on April 26, 2002 Pineda forced his way into the house. He proceeded to beat and drug Shuntele, forcing her to swallow a bunch of prescription pills, saying "I'm gonna kill you, I'm gonna screw you up." He then sexually assaulted and sodomized her at knifepoint for four hours. After the assault, Pineda drove Shuntele to an ATM and ordered her to withdraw

\$300 before she was released. At her pleading, Pineda dropped Shuntele off at a local hospital before speeding away. Cops believe Pineda was planning to go to New York and then back to Guatemala. Pineda has tattoos of an orange and blue chameleon on a brnach looking at a fly on his upper arm and shoulder, an S-shaped black dragon on his shoulder blade, and a black Pegasus on his right inner wrist. He is a Mexican national who was born in Guatemala, and his visa had expired before the assault. He is a big drinker and described as a very jealous man. Pineda is 24, 5'10" and 175 pounds.

CAPTURED:

Prescott Sigmund (Explosives violations) – On July 12, 2002, 21-year-old Wright Sigmund went into the garage under his father's insurance office in northwest Washington, D.C. to run an errand and started his father's SUV. The car was booby-trapped with one or more explosive devices, including a pipe bomb underneath the seat. It exploded when Wright turned the key in the ignition. Miraculously, Wright survived, but with disfiguring and nearly mortal wounds. Investigators were convinced the bomb was actually meant for Wright's 62-year-old father, Donald, and that it had been planted within the week. On July 15, Donald's oldest son Prescott, who is Wright's half brother, disappeared. Prescott was known as an affable, mild-mannered suburban father of two. The intense investigation surrounding the bombing brought to light his secret double life. He had apparently been fired seven months before, but pretended to work every day. His wife then discovered he had raided her retirement funds, taken out credit cards in his parents' names, and left the household bills unpaid for months. In October 2002, federal authorities were able to show probable cause to charge Prescott Sigmund with the bombing. Though the affidavit is under seal, investigators say it includes both circumstantial and forensic evidence that ties Prescott to the pipe bomb. Following the broadcast, Sigmund turned himself in to authorities in Missoula, Montana. (See Show #696, OAD 11/9/02)

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Kristina Eaddy (Attempted Murder, Aggravated Assault) – Kristina Eaddy and Donald Williams fell in love and got married but Eaddy couldn't feel secure in the marriage until Williams ex-girlfriend was out of the picture. On July 17, 1999, Williams convinced his ex-girlfriend to meet him at a shopping center in Clifton, New Jersey. Williams pulled up in an SUV and asked the woman for cash. When she noticed the wedding ring on his finger, she got angry and drove off. When the woman arrived at her cousin's residence in Paterson, New Jersey, Williams pulled up in the SUV and Eaddy was in the passenger seat. Eaddy was hiding in the back during the first encounter. Williams cornered his ex-girlfriend near her car and Eaddy began firing a handgun. The woman was shot in the abdomen and chest. She survived the attack. Williams was arrested and convicted of attempted murder and weapons possession. Eaddy went on the run and has not been seen since. Eaddy, who has used the aliases Christina Johnson and Christina Williams, may have her two small children with her. She is a tough girl who is known to get into fistfights with other women. She has a large, unknown tattoo on her left arm. Eaddy is 31, 5'4" and 120 pounds.

Leonard Ray Harper (Murder) – Leonard Ray Harper is wanted for murdering his friend, Jerry Permenter, in August 1997. Harper was seeking revenge when he killed Permenter. Permenter struck Harper's pregnant girlfriend, Francesca. After the incident, Francesca decided to abort her baby. About a month and a half after the incident Harper picked Permenter up in his car, drove him to a deserted field, put a gun to Permenter and shot him. Harper and Francesca hopped on a bus and traveled across the country. Francesca continued to work as a dancer to support their life on the run. Francesca says Harper became more and more possessive. He

wouldn't let her out of his sight, and she began to fear for her own life and she was pregnant again. At one point Francesca convinced Harper to let her go to the restroom of a Pizza Hut in Shamrock, Texas. While in the bathroom she used a napkin to scribble a note asking for help. She left the note behind with a manager. He called the police and they pulled over Harper's car a short time later. Harper was arrested and brought back to San Antonio. Harper was officially charged with murder, but bonded out of jail and took off. Before leaving, he threatened Francesca and promised that he would be back for his daughter someday. Harper, who goes by the nickname "Hap", has a scar on his right cheek. He is a Jekyll and Hyde personality who drinks heavily and is often high. He bites his fingernails. Harper may have a trust fund, and his grandmother may be supporting him on the run. He likes sushi and likes to cook. He is a scuba diver. Harper is 32, 5'9" and 160 pounds.

Heather Catherine Tallchief (Bank Larceny)

Roberto Solis (Bank Larceny) – The Nevada FBI and Las Vegas police are looking for an armored car driver and her male roommate who disappeared on October 1, 1993 along with a Loomis Armored Inc. van filled with \$3.15 million dollars. Heather Tallchief, a native of Buffalo, New York, was hired by Loomis in Las Vegas as an armed guard/driver. On October 1, 1993 Tallchief drove a Loomis armored van to Circus Circus Hotel and Casino, where she dropped off two co-workers to make a delivery. The co-workers went inside to fill ATM machines, while Tallchief waited for them outside in the van. When they came back out of the casino, the van, Tallchief and the money had disappeared. The van was found abandoned in Las Vegas on the morning of October 13. Investigation of Tallchief's residence, which had been vacated the day before the robbery, indicated that she was living with her boyfriend, Julius Gabriel Sauve. The FBI positively identified Sauve through fingerprints as Roberto Solis. Agents traced Tallchief and Solis to Denver, Colorado the day of the heist. Approximately one week later, they were traced to Miami, Florida where authorities intercepted two passports in the mail on their way to Tallchief and Solis. The FBI believes the couple may be in the Caribbean. Tallchief, who also uses the names Heather Sonny Tallchief franco and Heather Franco, is a Native American of the Seneca Tribe. She has long hair which she sometimes wears in a ponytail, multiple piercings in her left ear and she also wears a nose ring. She wears clear glasses. Tallchief is 30, 5'8" and 140 pounds. Solis' aliases include Julio Garrett Sauve, Roberto Ignacio Zelaya, Pancho Aguilila, Pancho Agila, Pancho Aguilar, Miguel Angel Dominguez and Joseph Anthony Panura. He has tattoos on his right forearm of the Spanish words "esta vida loca". He has curly hair, but his most noticeable feature is his eyes. He has an eye disease called "exophthalmos", which renders his eyes very sensitive to light. He sometimes looks "bug-eyed", sometimes wears a patch over one eye, and may wear glasses or blue contact lenses over his naturally brown eyes. He enjoys writing poetry and fancies himself an art collector. Solis is 57, 5'10" and 152 pounds. Authorities warn that both Tallchief and Solis should be considered

Jenny Liang (Murder) – Liang and her boyfriend Patrick Sheen were together over a year when they bought their home in Las Vegas, Nevada. Patrick owned his own insurance company, and Jenny worked as a dealer at the Mirage Casino. Jenny's 14-year-old son lived at their home and attended school in the area. Patrick's sister Ruby was close with the family. She visited her brother often and they had a very close relationship. On October 2, 2000 Jenny called Dennis Lam at the insurance company to tell him that Patrick would not be at work that day. Later that evening Jenny called Dennis again and said Patrick would be out of town for a meeting and would not return until Friday, October 6, 2000. The same day Jenny called Dennis, she also called her work and spoke to a scheduler at the Mirage. Jenny called out sick from work on October 2 and 3. Then on October 4, Jenny called the Mirage again and said she was hospitalized and would not be able to return to work. Shortly after that phone call, Jenny picked up her 14-year-old son and dropped him off at her ex-husband's house. She also gave her ex-husband and her son the 1999 Mercedes-Benz she owned with Patrick. She told her son he would have to take care of himself and that she had to go. Within this week Ruby, Patrick's sister, told cops she was trying to contact him and his family, but no one could be reached. On October 11, 2000, Ruby was getting nervous and she called the police station to file a missing person report on her brother. It wasn't like him not to call or stop by her house. The police, Ruby and a locksmith went to Patrick's home. As soon as they entered they knew there was a problem because of the smell that was coming from the bedroom. The cops found Patrick's body in his bed. He had been shot multiple times in his head with a .357. Patrick's fingers were starting to mummify, the home was not ransacked, there was no forced entry, and there was \$925 in his pocket. The only thing missing was Patrick's girlfriend, her son, and their Mercedes. An investigation tracked Jenny to Los Angeles where she made a withdrawal from an ATM and purchased a plane ticket to Hong Kong. She may be in China, and may be using the names Zhen Yu Liang or Yu Zhen Liang as aliases. Jenny Liang is 40, 5'2 and 110 pounds. (See Show #671, OAD 4/6/02)

Ahuma Tavita (Parole Violation, Rape) – Ahmua Tavita is wanted for rape and parole violation. He molested a 15-year-old boy from September - November of 2001. The child finally reported the incidents of sexual abuse in March of 2002. But, by the time the warrant came through, Tavita had left town. Police believe Tavita is traveling with his girlfriend, Julie Tupu, and her small child. Tupu's second child, an infant, was left with family in the Lansdale area. Tavita, who uses the nickname "Monty", has numerous tattoos including an eagle, a photo of a woman, Asian writing, "pride", "Bruce, and "AJAY" on his right arm, a dragon, "Brown", "Keisha", and "Samoan" on his left arm, "Julie" and "In loving memory of Juliату Mua" on his chest, the face of a woman with red lips on his left breast, "Samoa", "Tavita", and "My love, my

Samantha Burns of West Hamlin, West Virginia went missing November 12, 2002. Burns was last seen by her aunt at the Huntington Mall, where she worked part-time at J.C. Penney, around 7:30 pm on Monday, November 11, 2002. Burns called her mother at 9:46 pm on November 11, 2002 to say she was on her way home from visiting friends at the University Courtyard apartments in Huntington. Burns has not been seen or heard from since. On Tuesday, November 12, 2002, Samantha's vehicle was discovered in northern Wayne County by the Wayne County Sheriff's Office. The vehicle was located in a secluded area and had been burned. Investigators began looking at the two Kentucky fugitives, Chadrick Fulks and Branden Basham, who may have come through the area about the time Burns came up missing and could possibly link this case to them. The two escaped November 4, 2002 from the Hopkins County Correctional Facility. The inmates also are suspects in the abductions of a Kentucky man and a South Carolina woman, along with a burglary in South Carolina and numerous car thefts between the states. Branden Basham was caught on November 17 by police in Ashland, Kentucky after he fled police and jumped into a river. Chadrick Fulks, however, continued to evade police in Madison County, Ohio on the night of Monday, November 18. Ohio troopers thought they had spotted the fugitive sleeping in the blue BMW at a rest area. The man sped off when ordered out of the car, nearly running over an officer. The pursuit was halted to make sure the officer was okay. Chadrick Fulks was apprehended in Elkhart, Indiana on November 20, 2002. Family, friends and local businesses have chipped in to create a \$35,000 reward for Burn's safe return or for information leading to the arrest and conviction of anyone responsible for her disappearance. Samantha has a butterfly tattoo on the small of her back.

On November 14, 2002 Alice Donovan was abducted from outside a Wal-Mart in Conway, South Carolina. The perpetrators, Chadrick Fulks and Branden Basham, escaped on November 4 from the Hopkins County Jail in Madisonville, Kentucky. Surveillance video caught a stolen white pick-up truck trolling the parking lot. The duo was looking for someone to accost and decided upon Alice Donovan. She had just finished her shopping when she was overwhelmed by the two men. They forced her into her BMW and took off with her in the car. Later that same day, Alice's ATM and credit cards were used in North Carolina. She also made a phone call to one of her children. Police determine from that phone call that she was obviously under stress and unable to speak freely. She did say she was okay, but that was the last contact anyone has had with her. Branden Basham was caught on November 17 by police in Ashland, Kentucky after he fled police and jumped into a river. Chadrick Fulks, however, continued to evade police in Madison County, Ohio on the night of Monday, November 18. Ohio troopers thought they had spotted the fugitive sleeping in the blue BMW at a rest area. The man sped off when ordered out of the car, nearly running over an officer. The pursuit was halted to make sure the officer was okay. Chadrick Fulks was apprehended in Elkhart, Indiana on November 20, 2002. Alice Donovan hasn't been located.

CAPTURED:

Regina DeFrancisco (Murder) – Regina DeFrancisco dated truck driver Oscar Velazquez, 32, for about three weeks in May, 2000. On June 6, 2000 Regina called Oscar to her home and lured him into the basement, where she began to talk to him at the bottom of the stairs. As they were in conversation, a witness said that Margaret came from behind and shot Oscar in the head with a .380 semi-automatic. The shot to the head killed Oscar almost instantly. Oscar was known to carry a large amount of cash on him. After the sisters shot Oscar, they removed approximately \$600 in cash from his pocket, a silver chair, and keys to his new 2000 Camero Z28 that was sitting outside. The sisters rolled his body in plastic, then carried Oscar's body to his car. The trunk would not shut, so Regina went back inside to get a dog leash to use to hold the trunk shut. The witness also told police that Regina and Margaret got a bucket of bleach and washed down the sidewalk where blood had dripped. The girls jumped into the car. After driving around for a while Regina pulled the car into a vacant lot where the girls attempted to pull the body out of the car. The body was heavy and Margaret had to brace the front seat and use her body weight to push the body out of the trunk. Regina found a bottle of nail polish

remover and decided to destroy the body by using the acetone as a fuel and set the body on fire. An anonymous caller called 911 to report a fire in the vacant parking lot. When the tipster ran out to dump water on the fire, he noticed an arm sticking out and called 911 again. The body was later identified as Oscar Velazquez. The girls drove off and attempted to sell the victim's car. Once they realized that no one wanted to buy it, they lit the car on fire. When authorities questioned the women they had different stories, and later fled the area. A viewer tip led authorities to an apartment building owned by relatives of the DeFrancisco sisters, where Margaret was arrested. The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Henry Corral (Escape) – 22-year-old Henry Corral was awaiting sentencing on a manslaughter conviction when he escaped from the Adams County Detention Center around 6:30pm on Wednesday, November 20, 2002. Corral escaped with three other maximum security inmates while they were in the jail's open-air exercise yard. They jumped onto the building's roof, changed their clothes from orange jumpsuits to blue, then crawled down from the roof and over a perimeter fence. The three other inmates were caught within five blocks of the prison, but Corral was able to get away. Corral may have arranged for a car to be waiting for him. He may be headed for Los Angeles, where his girlfriend lives, or to his father's hometown in Juarez, Mexico. Corral had recently cut a deal with prosecutors, pleading guilty to the stabbing death of 22-year-old Charles Abreo, a former Marine, in July 2000. Corral stabbed Abreo and another man multiple times outside a friend's house; he did not know either of the victims. Corral, who goes by the nickname "Crook", has numerous tattoos including "EMHS" in big letters on his chest, "Beatrice" high on his chest, a marijuana leaf on his left arm, "My Love Janet" on his right arm, "EM" on the back of his neck, "Janet" on his left arm" and "C" on both hands. He may also have facial hair. He has gang ties in Los Angeles. Corral is 22, 5'3" and 140 pounds.

Unknown Miami Serial Rapist – An unknown serial rapist still lurks the streets of Miami-Dade County, Florida. He comes out of nowhere, armed and dangerous. He pulls the weapon on the victim, takes them to a secluded place, then rapes them. His victims are vulnerable. They are mothers with their children being picked up from a church pre-school or just outside their pediatrician's office. The last incident happened on October 16, 2002. A 31-year-old mother with her infant son had just picked up her daughter at a church pre-school. All of a sudden a man with a knife jumped out of a wooded area. He drove her to a secluded place,

ordered her to get undressed in front of her kids, and then raped her. Then he wanted money. They drove to the bank and withdrew \$400. The attacker then drove the woman and her kids back to the church where he abducted them, and then he disappeared. The rapist's MO is to take the women where he finds them, take them to a secluded place, rape them and return the victim to where he abducted her. Police suspect the same rapist may be responsible for at least five other attacks in the area. The suspect has stolen his victim's driver's license, one victim's one-carat wedding ring, and goes about bold and unmasked. He is described as being in his mid- to late-30's with dirty blond to brownish hair.

Annette Hernandez (Murder, Robbery, Escape) - California Department of Corrections is searching for a female fugitive who escaped from the California Institute for Women in Frontera, California. She's been on the run for more than 30 years, since her escape on May 1, 1972. She was serving a sentence for murder and robbery. On December 17, 1970, Steve Smith, a husband and father of two young children, was out Christmas shopping with his friend, Dave McAlhinney, in San Bernardino, California. Afterwards, they stopped by a party that acquaintances, Annette and Art Hernandez, were throwing. When they arrived, Annette answered the door and let Steve and David inside. Once in the house, they found Art tied up with duct tape and two gunmen, Gerald Schnabel and Charles Hill. The gunmen demanded money and pointed their guns at Dave and Steve's head. Dave got on the ground while Steve struggled with the gunmen. The gun went off and Steve was fatally wounded with a gunshot to his neck. The gunmen fled, while Annette and Art helped Dave carry Steve to his VW van. They rushed him to the hospital. Before all four got to the hospital, Annette ordered Dave to stop the van and she got out because she had an outstanding parole violation. At the hospital Steve was pronounced dead. Dave told detectives he thought the robbery-murder was a set up. Later, all four involved were convicted. Annette was sentenced to five years to life for second degree murder and first degree robbery. Annette Hernandez was assigned to the California Institute for Women on March 10, 1972. A few months later, on May 1, 1972, Hernandez and inmate Susan Sutcliffe escaped by crawling through a damaged fence. Sutcliffe, also convicted of murder, was captured in 1976, but Annette is still at large. There has been no information on Hernandez since her escape. Hernandez, who has used numerous aliases including Annette Bullis, Annette Hermalene Potter, Annette Betty Thompson, Ann Vicki Brown, Annette Garcia, Annette Thatcher, Candice Castaneda, Lerma Annete Hernandez, Annette Griggi and Gale Potter, has "Property" tattooed on her left hip and an arrow on her right shoulder. She has three children from her first marriage: Raymond, Robert and Renee Bullis. She reportedly performed with the circus as a teen. Hernandez is 59, 5'5" and 130 pounds.

Amer El-Maati (Wanted for Questioning) - El-Maati is a Kuwaiti national who the FBI believes to have a connection to Al-Qaeda. He is thought to have information about terrorist

threats in the USA and abroad. He has trained as an airline pilot, and the FBI says he has participated in terrorist training camps. Documents found in Afghanistan link El-Maati to Canada, where he is a naturalized citizen. However, authorities have not been able to locate him. He may have slipped across the border, and should be considered armed and dangerous. El-Maati has used several aliases, including Amro Badr El-Adin Abou El-Maati, Abu Omar, and Abu Umar. He usually wears a full beard and mustache, but may have shaved them off. He requires corrective lenses and may be wearing glasses. El-Maati is 39, 6'0" and 209 pounds.

Patrick Michael Gleeson (Murder, Kidnapping) – In late November 2002, Patrick Gleeson picked up his two children, Joshua and Ashley, for a court-ordered visit. He was supposed to have the children back to their mother in Dwight, Illinois by 11:00am on November 25. He never showed. On November 29, cops in Holland, Michigan found the body of Gleeson's live-in girlfriend, 43-year-old Dena Lynn Fuglseth. They believe Gleeson shot and killed her days before. They estimate the date of the murder was November 26. His two children may have witnessed the execution. Gleeson, who has "Patriotic" with an American flag tattooed on his left biceps, usually wears a beard but may have shaved it. When last seen he had dyed blond hair. He has a "biker" lifestyle, and may be driving a 1995 light or metallic blue Ford Aerostar van with Illinois Plates CKT 754. Gleeson is 48, 5'7"-5'9" and 175 pounds.

Yolanda Ricaforte (Plunder, Fraud) – Ricaforte is wanted by NBI officials in the Philippines on plunder charges. Ricaforte was the personal bookkeeper/auditor for former president Joseph Estrada. Estrada was recently impeached on plunder charges stemming from accusations that he was running a racket and stealing money from the country through a long-running illegal lottery game in the Philippines. Estrada formed an illegal gambling ring called the "Midnight Cabinet" made up of high-powered government figures and personal friends of Estrada, such as Charlie Atong Ang and Governor Singson. The official Cabinet met during the day, while the Midnight Cabinet met nearly every night to discuss backroom deals and bribes. The group would play mahjong while drinking expensive bottles of wine, often gambling several million pesos at a time. Yolanda Ricaforte kept tabs on all the money coming in from the lottery and she kept books on how that money was distributed between the president and his associates. She opened accounts totaling 270 million pesos for the former president at six different bank branches, sometimes passing herself off as someone in real estate, travel business or in the export of prawns. Those officials involved in the Midnight Cabinet often competed for their piece of Estrada's operation. In early 2001, relations between some of the officials fell apart and the illegal activity was revealed to Philippine authorities. Ricaforte was called to testify at Estrada's impeachment trial, but she fled the country shortly after her appearance in court. Ricaforte hopped a plane to the United States, along with another one of Estrada's cronies, Charlie Atong Ang. The two got working visas through a fish company in Los Angeles owned by one of Ang's

Burgess is 32, 6'1" and 195 pounds.

Unknown (murder) -- Nebraska authorities have the face of Leah Rowlands' killer caught on tape, but they need the public's help in identifying the murderer. Rowlands was working as a cashier at a gas station convenience store in Cozad, Nebraska on March 10, 1997. At 10:30am, a man in a red Pontiac Grand Am pulled up and pumped gas. Rivera, however, ended up staying for several months. Gusman had heard that Rivera had killed someone and confronted Rivera. Rivera said the shooting was in self-defense and that he was the victim of a stabbing, showing Gusman old surgery scars as evidence. It was during this time that Rivera became involved with the Gusman daughter, Myra. Rivera moved to East Chicago and asked Myra and her 11-year-old son, Orlando Sotomayor, to join him. Gusman warned his daughter of the murders, but she went anyway. Gusman never saw his daughter again. On December 12, 1999, Myra's son said goodnight to his mother and Rivera, then went to sleep. The next morning he woke up to find his mother strangled to death. Viewer tips led authorities to Redding, Pennsylvania where Rivera

Glen Stewart Godwin (Murder, Escape) -- In 1980, Glen Stewart Godwin turned on his best friend in a robbery, and the double-cross turned to murder. After stabbing the victim 26 times, he attempted to cover his tracks by dragging the lifeless body to a remote desert location, and there detonated homemade bombs next to the evidence. The attempt failed - instead of incinerating the body, the explosion catapulted it into the night, where it was later discovered. Godwin was convicted and got 26 years to life for his crime. Prison officials say that he wasn't one to play by the rules, so he was soon transferred to what convicts call "the end of the world" - California's infamous Folsom prison. Only a handful of convicts have gotten clear of Folsom's high walls - but that didn't stop Godwin. He carefully examined the security and surroundings, and realized that he could get out by turning the problem on its head - no one could get out of this prison, but what if someone broke in? Godwin enlisted an ex-con by the name of Lorenz Karlic to work his way into Folsom by way of a tunnel running underneath the prison. Folsom was built on a stream that empties into a nearby river - and while the tunnel is secure in one direction, no one was watching as Karlic cleared a path for his friend. In June 1987, the tunnel was ready, and Godwin was away. But Godwin was far from rehabilitated. Just five months after his escape, he was captured in Mexico and charged with possession of 30 grams of cocaine. Once again, he was convicted, and sentenced to seven years at the Puente Grande Federal Prison in Guadalajara. The FBI was in negotiations with Mexican authorities to bring Godwin home when they say he clouded the legal waters by killing a fellow inmate. A short time later, the FBI learned that he had escaped yet again. On December 7, 1996, Godwin was named to the FBI's Ten Most Wanted list. Agents believe he is still in Mexico, but may have slipped back into

California. Godwin, who use used the aliases Dennis McWilliam and Glen S. Godwin, frequents bars and drinks champagne. He is also an alleged marijuana and cocaine user. Godwin is a tennis player, a sharp dresser, and has worked as a model, mechanic, and construction worker. He collects firearms. Godwin is 44, 6'0 and 170 pounds. Alvaro Israel Alvarado (Murder - 3 counts; Attempted Murder) -- In 1988, Amanda Alvarado moved her three children from Los Angeles to Portland, Oregon. She gave only one reason to move - her husband. He had reportedly grown increasingly violent and jealous, his temper always ready to explode. Alvarado's jealousy, Amanda's relatives say, now turned to obsession. He hunted her down and found her living in the same complex as her cousin, Otto. Now, he reportedly convinced himself that she was sleeping with her cousin, and became even more determined to get her back to Los Angeles. Amanda moved, had her car repainted, and covered her tracks. Meanwhile, Alvarado was cruising the streets, peeking in backyards, and calling her relatives. Finally, he returned to Los Angeles to execute a scam he knew would lead him to his wife. Alvarado contacted Amanda's sister, Gloria, in a panic. He told her that Amanda was sick in the hospital, and they drove up together. Even though her sister wouldn't lead Alvarado directly to Amanda, he got enough information to carry through the next stage of his plan - getting her back. The determined husband allegedly rented a U-Haul to move Amanda and her belongings back to L.A. Then, police say, he acquired a gun to make sure she couldn't refuse. On August 15, 1989, he burst through Amanda's door to find Amanda watching T.V. with Otto, her sister, and a friend. Police say it was Otto's presence that made him abandon his plan. He allegedly flew into a jealous rage, cutting down his wife, her cousin, and her sister in a barrage of bullets. The friend managed to escape, while the children were there as their father killed their mother before their eyes. Paramedics and police were on the scene quickly. As Otto's life slipped away, he reportedly told police who had pulled the trigger - Alvaro Alvarado. Hours later, Otto, Amanda, and Gloria were dead. Alvarado, who has used the aliases Luis Medina and Alvaro Alvarado-Olivas, walks slowly, almost shuffling. He wears flashy clothes and gold chains, and frequently wears baseball caps. He smokes Marlboro Gold 100's and enjoys Mexican food. He has worked as a truck driver. He has a quick temper and may carry a Smith & Wesson 9mm pistol. Alvarado is 38, 5'5" and 195 pounds. Dennis Schley Lilly (Aggravated Assault of a Police Officer, Escape) -- Lilly is being sought for the December 13, 1986 escape from the Missouri State Penitentiary. He was serving fifteen years to life for shooting a police officer. In 1981 Lilly, along with seven other inmates,

Enrique "Kike" Coropuna (Armed Robbery, Attempted Murder) -- Coropuna is one of the leaders of a South American gang believed to be responsible for several jewelry store robberies on the east coast committed in 1992. On November 11, 1992 Coropuna and a woman entered the Kornspan Jewelers in Linden, New Jersey. After asking to view a tray of jewelry, as many as three more men entered the store. The robbers began to handcuff the owners of the store to furniture and scoop jewelry into bags. According to police reports, when police officer Al Goncalvez arrived at the scene Coropuna fired one 9mm round at his chest. Goncalvez escaped serious injury because he was wearing a bulletproof vest. The five robbers fled and were picked up by a getaway driver in a white Oldsmobile. After a brief high-speed chase, the getaway car crashed into a parked vehicle and the suspects fled on foot. Three suspects were eventually arrested. Coropuna and another associate are still at large and have been charged with attempted murder, robbery, and weapons offenses. Coropuna is 42, 5'6" and 200 pounds. Deputy Sheriff Mario Quintinilla observed the stolen white four-door car speeding on Route 10 and began his pursuit. Tello and Carrasco hit the curb of a parking lot and jumped out of the car. The car continued to roll and crashed into a Goodwill store. The deputy discharged his weapon and shot Carrasco because both Tello and Carrasco had guns, and Carrasco was running towards him. Tello continued to run behind a Western Auto store and jumped over a bayou, escaping the scene. Quintinilla took Carrasco into custody, then sent him by ambulance to the hospital for the gunshot wound in his chest. Angel Tello has been missing since the incident and allegedly took Sara Cates, a 13-year-old girl, with him. She is now 15 and might be pregnant with her second child. They might be living in New Mexico or Mexico.. On June 3, 2002 Javier Carrasco pled guilty to the rime and was sentenced to 10 years for the robbery and 10 years for the assault on Quintinilla. Tello, who has used the alias Angel Baccera, is member of th East Side Chellos street gang and probably has a gang tattoo. He is 20, 5'7" and 130 pounds.

Jamal Abeokuto (Extortion, Weapons Charges) – Abeokuto was arrested for various weapons charges and released on \$75,000 bail. After his release, he left town which was a

violation of his release. In addition, Abeokuto has connections to the disappearance and murder of an 8-year-old girl. Abeokuto is the last person known to see Marciana Ringo alive. Abeokuto told police that he drove Marciana to school on December 3 and saw her walking towards the school building when he drove away. School officials say Marciana never got to school. Marciana was not seen alive again. On December 4, police found a pair of bloodsoaked jeans in the woods near Marciana's house. Further information leads police to believe that Abeokuto bought a new pair of jeans the day of the murder. On December 5, Marciana's mother received a ransom note requesting \$5,000 for the return of Marciana. The note was a ruse. Police later found Abeokuto's fingerprint on the note. He has since been charged with extortion for sending the note. On December 12, Marciana's dead body was found by two elementary school students walking home. Police have not yet announced the cause of death. Abeokuto is not charged but is a suspect in the girl's death. Abeokuto has worked as a day laborer loading trucks, and authorities warn that he should be considered armed and dangerous. He is 22, 5'8" and 175 pounds. (See Show #700, OAD 12/14/02)

Uyen Nguyen (Attempted Murder) – On November 19, 2002 New York City police officer Hung Nguyen was visiting a friend at the Miss Saigon Bar in Jersey City, New Jersey. Yuen "Wendy" Nguyen, Mai "Mike" Nguyen, Teo Nguyen and Binh Nguyen, members of a local gang known as O.U.T. (Orientals United Together) were also at the bar that night. When the bartender tried to clear the establishment at closing time they refused to leave and became rowdy. Officer Nguyen then stepped in to remove the four. After the four left the bar they returned and severely attacked officer Nguyen. He was repeatedly beaten with bar stools and suffered two crushed vertebrae in his back. He is currently paralyzed from the chest down and is in rehabilitation. The FBI learned that since the attack the four perpetrators may be trying to flee the country for Vietnam. Binh Nguyen has a discoloration mark on his left shoulder. He likes to party, and may be involved in illegal gambling in the Asian community. He may be trying to find day work in Asian restaurants or retail stores. Binh Nguyen is 19, 5'6" and 100 pounds. Le/Teo Nguyen is 22 or 23, 5'8" and 145 pounds. Mai Nguyen has a dragon tattoo on the center of his back which continues to his upper right arm. He likes to sing karaoke. Mai Nguyen is 25, 5'6" and 165 pounds. Uyen Nguyen, who has used the aliases Wendy U. Lee and Uyen T Le, may have blonde highlights. She is 27, 5'2" and 110-115 pounds.

Omar Arroyo (Grand Theft, Identity Theft, Credit Card Fraud, Forgery) – Los Angeles detectives are on the lookout for Omar Alberto Arroyo. He targeted parents in Hispanic communities with a music school scam, in which Arroyo stole money from hundreds of victims

in excess of \$1,500,000,000 dollars. Arroyo and his associates phoned parents by the thousands, telling them that their children won free accordion lessons at Arroyo's music school. The group gave the children a few free lessons and after a trial period, Arroyo and his goons persuaded the parents to sign on for permanent classes for a small fee or for "free." Arroyo used this premise to get all the parents to give them their financial information, including copies of their credit cards and driver's licenses. He used this information to commit identity theft and that he convinced many of the parents to invest thousands of dollars in bogus company bonds. Arroyo would open a school for a few months and then close it down without telling parents, taking their money and credit card information with him. Then, he would open a new school in a different location in southern California and start his scam all over again. Arroyo and his partners opened schools in Van Nuys, North Hollywood, Toluca Lake, Panorama City, Long Beach, Montclair, Glendora, Riverside and Mission Hills. In October 2001, LAPD conducted a search at two of the locations and arrested two of Arroyo's associates, including his business partner, Mario Alberto Yunis. Investigators say Yunis used his portion of the profits to fund his sex change operation. Officers also recovered thousands of dollars in cash, numerous credit cards and hundreds of parents' financial records. Yunis is now being held in LA County Jail on \$3,500,000 bail. Detectives still need help to locate Arroyo, known in the Hispanic community as the Latin singer Luis Omar. Investigators believe he may still be in Puerto Rico where he was last spotted, promoting the release of his new CD titled "Asi, Asi." Arroyo's CD and music video were financed and promoted with the more than two million dollars he stole from the parents who invested in his music school. Arroyo, who has used the aliases Luis Omar, Luis Omar Ferre, Adalberto Arroyo, Miguel Rodriguez Hernandez, Carlos Tomas Santiago River, and Alberto Miranda, is bisexual. His weight fluctuates, he has been known to get liposuction, and may have had plastic surgery. He likes to sing karaoke and drink Corona beer. Arroyo is 29, 6'2" and 190 pounds.

Jerry Souther – Souther molested a young boy in North Carolina. He may be working in construction. Souther is 56, 5'9" and 155 pounds.

CAPTURED:

William Severs (Murder) – On January 10, 2002 at 7:10pm Severs followed his ex-girlfriend Tina Labriola and her fiancé Ralph Kearney to a friend's house in Vineland, New Jersey. When Tina and Ralph came out of the house, Ralph wanted to put some oil in their car before they left. He asked Tina to get a funnel from the trunk. When she went around to the back of the car, Severs shot her with a high-powered rifle, and Tina collapsed into the street. Meanwhile, Bonnie and Francisco Martin, a nurse and a corrections officer, drove by and saw Tina in the street. They thought she had been hit by a car so they stopped to help. Bonnie began

doing CPR on Tina and prayed with her. Francisco went back to his car, got his service weapon and cleared the area of onlookers. Francisco also realized that the shooter was still out there somewhere. When police arrived they searched the area but didn't find the shooter. Instead they found the high-powered rifle with a scope in a nearby baseball field. They also found a guitar case and a zebra striped strap with Severs' name on it near the rifle. Severs shot Tina from 60 yards away, then fled on foot. He then placed the gun against a fence surrounding the baseball field and either forgot to pick up his guitar case or couldn't find it in the dark where he left it. Tina Labriola died in the hospital several hours later. Seavers, who was going by the name Ed, was located in Ocean City, New Jersey. When the SWAT team entered the house where he was hiding in a closet, he turned a flare gun on himself, setting himself on fire. He survived, and will stand trial. The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Alejandro Santana (Murder, Kidnapping, Carjacking) – On August 22, 2000, Santana and accomplice Anthony Camacho, showed up at Sports Time car lot. Their intention was to steal a Camaro to use for parts for their own car.. Santana and Camacho asked for salesman Thomas Buchholz because he was the Camaro expert. The three got into the car with Camacho driving, Buchholz in the passenger seat and Santana in the back seat. They drove the car onto Interstate 80. That's where Santana pulled a handgun and shot Buchholz in the back of the head. Buchholz's body was then dumped on the shoulder of the interstate, and the pair drove off. Witnesses gave chase but lost them. Just minutes later four men, two of whom are believed to be Santana and Camacho, wiping down a Camaro before escaping into another Camaro. Within two days, cops were able to identify all four suspects, and three are in custody. Santana is the only one still on the run. Santana has used the aliases Alex Santana and Alejandro Arizmendi. He is 22, 5'8" and 200 pounds. (See Shows #610, #616 and #643, OADs 11/11/00, 1/13/01 and 8/4/01)

Fethi Jelassi (Murder) – Jelassi is being sought for the double murder of David Settle and his mother Patsy. Even though he was married, Jelassi had struck up a relationship with another woman. That woman was also dating David Settle, causing Jelassi to become jealous. On June 22, 2000 Jelassi went to a home rented by David and Patsy and shot both of them repeatedly in the head. Jelassi's SUV was found in the parking lot of a car dealership, but he was gone. He travels extensively and is probably out of the country. Jelassi, whose numerous aliases include Frank Jelassi, Frank Adams, Phillip Adams, Phillip Jelassi, Omar B. Messadud, Fethi Messaoud, Omar Messaoud and the nickname "Bashir", has a tattoo of a female face on his upper left forearm. He is a native of Tunisia and has worked as a grocery store manager. Jelassi

is 47, 5'7" and 185 pounds. (See Show #660, OAD 1/12/02)

Oakland Top Cop Unknown Carjacker (Kidnapping, Attempted Robbery) – 34-year-old Laura Sefchovich was in the driver's seat of her white Caravan, leaving a friend's house in the Montclair area of Oakland, California after picking up a package, when she was carjacked. Her passenger window was smashed in by the first suspect, Mark Feathers, a large black man with a gun. He also demanded her credit cards and her jewelry at gunpoint. Laura was pushed to the floor in the back of her van, and the first suspect tied her up and put a sweatshirt over her face. Feathers drove off and began going through Laura's purse in search of money. He soon pulled over again to pick up a second suspect, the fugitive. The second suspect also looked through Laura's purse for cash and then demanded to know the code for her ATM card. Officer Mike Gantt was conducting surveillance in an unmarked police car on a convenience store on a corner in Oakland when the van pulled up to a stoplight in front of him. He noticed some suspicious activity in the van and decided to leave his post and follow the van, despite his supervisor's objections. Gantt then called for help to pull the car over. Another set of officers attempted to pull the van over, but the suspects sped up in an effort to get away. Eventually the van crashed into a fence surrounding a park. The two suspects jumped out and ran in different directions. Officer Gantt helped Laura out of the van and she thanked him for saving her life. The other two officers chased the suspects on foot and succeeded in catching the first suspect, Mark Feathers. The other suspect managed to get away from police and is still on the run. The unknown fugitive is in his 30's, approximately 6'0" and 150-200 pounds.

Mark William Samples (Bank Robbery) – Samples has been charged with the 2001 robbery of a Minnesota credit union, and he may be on the run with his son. On May 3, 2001, Samples entered the Red Wing Credit Union and robbed it, armed with a .45 caliber handgun. After robbing the bank, Samples attempted to make a getaway on a bicycle and then by donning scuba gear and hiding in the Mississippi River. He was eventually arrested and plead guilty to the bank robbery charges. However, when he learned his sentence would be five years, he withdrew his plea. Trial was set for September 4, 2002. On Friday, May 31, 2002 Samples picked up his son Christopher from his estranged wife's home, agreeing to return the child Sunday morning. The pair vanished. Samples has the warrior figure "Genesis" tattooed on his right arm, and has a scar on his back. He is a perfectionist; everything has to be perfectly straight and clean. He shaves with an electric razor, never a blade. When he brushes his hair, he does so very harshly to the point where his scalp will become raw. He has taken Prozac, Interferon and other medication for Hepatitis C, which makes him nauseated and tired. He doesn't cook but prefers to eat fast food or sushi, and his weight fluctuates wildly. He had an apprenticeship to become an electrician, and has worked as a life guard. He has also worked as a phlebotomist, is very interested in veins and will talk extensively on the subject. He likes to camp, mountain climb, or anything outdoorsy and thrilling. He likes football, and the Green Bay Packers are his favorite team. He knowledgeable about computers and the internet, and probably has a laptop with him. He watches the Weather Channel often. He is a Navy veteran. He is probably carrying handguns and rifles, and has told his family that he wants to commit suicide. Samples is 39, 6'0" and 225 pounds. (See Show #693, OAD 9/28/02)

Paul Xavier Stone (Sexual Abuse of a Child) – Paul "Rocky" Stone has a history of molesting young boys in the Madison, Wisconsin area which dates back to the mid-1960's. His

M.O. is to target 12- to 15-year-old boys, usually from single parent homes. Stone befriends them and takes them fishing, skiing and snowboarding. Stone takes Polaroid photos of the boys, clothed at first, claiming he is recording their growth. By the third or fourth meeting with the boys, Stone gives the children LSD and sexually assaults them. Stone has photographed the boys engaged in various sexual acts. Investigations led authorities to Stone's residence in June 1996. Inside they found a box full of Polaroid photos of young boys, semi and fully nude. Police have identified three boys at this point. They believe there are at least 25 unidentified victims in those seized photographs. Stone was charged with two counts of sexual assault and one count of possession with intent to deliver LSD. He was released from custody after a family member posted \$8,000 cash bail. Stone failed to show up for his jury trial on November 18, 1996. He has been a fugitive ever since. Marshals believe he may be molesting other young boys. Stone, who has used the alias Terrill J. Schuette, has a rose tattoo on his upper right arm. He hangs out at parks, and is usually in the company of young boys. Stone is 54, 5'8" and 150 pounds.

Marvin Mercado (Murder, Attempted Murder, Robbery) -- Los Angeles Police say Marvin Mercado and his partner, Sothi Menh, are the ringleaders of a vicious gang called the Asian Boyz. Menh goes by the gang name Player Number 1, and Mercado is known as Shy Boy. On December 3, 1993, the gang entered an LA pool hall which was in rival gang territory. When a member of the Boyz named Leah Mek, who went by the gang name of Kicker, began bragging to rival gang members a gunfight broke out. Kicker was killed that night and the Asian Boyz swore revenge. Police say it was the start of a three year gang war; in one 18 month period, the Asian Boyz pulled 12 murders. Not all the victims were rival gang members. Detectives say Asian Boyz broke into the home of Jon and Jennifer Gregory. When Jon confronted the gang, they killed him. This home invasion robbery was only one of the dozens of similar brutal crimes pulled by the Asian Boyz to finance their ongoing wars, police say. Los Angeles Police formed a special task force to bring down the gang. Little by they infiltrated and gathered evidence and several members were flushed out. One of these was the young man police say was a mastermind behind the Asian Boyz's home robberies - Sam Chan. On February 13, 1997, a warrant was issued for the arrest of Sothi Menh and Marvin Mercado. Menh, thanks to an America's Most Wanted viewer, was picked up in Cambodia and extradited to the United States. Mercado is still on the run. Mercado, a native of the Philippines, has a large dragon tattooed on his back. He is 29, 6'0" and 155 pounds. Authorities say Mercado should be considered armed and dangerous. (See Shows #451, #463, #498, #501, #571 and #602, OADs 5/17/97, 8/30/97, 6/6/98, 6/27/99, 1/8/00 and 9/2/00)

Edward Paul Morris (Murder) – Morris murdered his pregnant wife and three children on a logging road in the Tillamook State Forest in Oregon. Renee Morris, 31, was found 20 yards off the road by an elk hunter and his son in the early morning hours of Saturday, December 21, 2002. The bodies of 10-year-old Bryant, 8-year-old Alexis and 4-year-old Jonathan were

discovered by police nearby when they arrived on the scene. The Morrises lived in Portland, Oregon, about 70 miles east of the forest, and had been struggling financially. The killings occurred sometime between Thursday, December 19 and their discovery on the 21st. Morris is on the run in the family van. The vehicle is a 1993 gray Dodge Caravan with Oregon license plates WSH 171. The car has two stickers on the back windows: "Luis Palau" (a Beaverton, Oregon-based Christian evangelist) and "Promise Keepers". Morris, who is known to be religious, wears prescription glasses and has worked in roofing, landscaping and commercial cleaning. Morris is 37, 6'0" and 200 pounds.

AMW PUBLIC ENEMY #1

Michel Barrera (Attempted Murder, Armed Burglary) -- Barrera is wanted by the FBI for the 1998 armed robbery of two Miami banks, carjacking a Miami man, and the attempted murder of a Metro-Dade police officer during his getaway. Agents say on February 3, 1998, Michel Barrera and his accomplice robbed the Terra Bank in Miami, Florida, of approximately \$19,000. Then, on May 1, 1998 around 1:00pm they robbed the Republic National Bank in Miami at gunpoint. Following the robbery, the two men fled the bank and a high-speed chase ensued with Metro-Dade police officers. During the chase, cops say the two suspects fired on pursuing officers, then carjacked and severely injured a Miami civilian before ditching his car in a canal. Search teams combed the heavily foliated area near the canal and were able to find and arrest Barrera's accomplice, but Michel Barrera was nowhere to be found. Barrera, a Cuban immigrant, comes across as a sweet, nice young boy. However, he is a known gang member who may try to recruit other teenagers to commit crimes and may be hanging out with "punk" teenagers on the street. He has used the aliases Michael Barrera, Rene Caso, and Christopher Montefu. He has a burn scar on his left shoulder and "Maria" tattooed on his upper right rear shoulder, although he may have tattooed over this and grown his hair longer to change his appearance. He is always armed and has been known to impersonate a cop in home-invasion robberies. Barrera is a known drug user and loves to drink Malt liquor. He enjoys playing paintball, and frequents shooting ranges. Michel Barrera is 21, 5'8" and 145 pounds.
