SUBJECT: **AMERICA'S MOST WANTED** – Show #801 (MW-1823) OAD 4/02/05

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Christian Clemente Rodriguez (Armed Burglary, Sexual Battery) -- On March 12, 1999 Rodriguez and an accomplice broke into an apartment just off the University of South Florida campus. Rodriguez tied up two college students and then both men sexually assaulted one of them. On March 26, 1999, Rodriguez sexually assaulted another USF student in her apartment. This time, Rodriguez created a ruse, saying he was collecting signatures from tenants to have a party. When he confirmed the victim was home alone, he pushed his way in and sexually assaulted her. After being charged with the crimes, Rodriguez fled to Miami and authorities missed apprehending him by just minutes. Cops fear that he's since fled to Puerto Rico. Rodriguez, who has used the aliases Chris Rivera, Juan Antonio Rivera-Soto and Chris Rivers, has a scar on his right wrist and an unknown tattoo on his upper right arm. He speaks both English and Spanish, is known to frequent strip clubs and pick up the dancers, and has fathered a child by a stripper. Both his ears are pierced. He has sold drugs and burglarized cars for money in the past but has no solid work history. Rodriguez is 32, 5'9" and 170 pounds. (See Shows #736 and #767, OADs 9/20/03 and 6/05/04)

Jason Derek Brown (1st Degree Murder, Armed Robbery) -- At 10:00 am on Monday, November 29, 2004, 24 year-old Robert Keith Palmares, an armored car guard from the Dunbar Armored car Service, arrived for his regular a pick up from the AMC Theater Multi-Plex in Ahwatukee, AZ following a busy Thanksgiving weekend. While Keith's partner followed procedure by waiting in the armored truck, Keith went about his routine pick up of cash and receipts from the theater. However, on this day, Keith's route was anything but routine. As Keith left the theater complex, a hooded man, fully dressed in black, came running up to him with a gun drawn. Then, without speaking a word, police say the gunman started firing at Keith's head, presumably in a deliberate effort to avoid Keith's bulletproof vest. In all, six shots were

fired, five of them striking Keith in the head. Police say the gunman then grabbed the bag of money and took off towards an alley. In the alleyway, police say the hooded fugitive hopped on a bike and fled. At least one of the eyewitnesses made a desperate call to 911, begging for an ambulance and pleading for instructions for how to help Keith. But, Keith's injuries were far too great. He died just outside the movie theater. In patrolling the area, police quickly found the getaway bicycle. A forensics technician came to the scene and lifted fingerprints from the bicycle. They came back as positive for Jason Derek Brown. But Brown hardly had the profile of a typical killer. The 35 year-old toy salesman from Utah had ties to some of California's wealthiest coastal communities. He was known for his money and lavish lifestyle, with a long list of possessions, including numerous cars, boats, motorcycles, jet skis, and ATVs. But his superficial wealth, masked a mysterious man. The life of the mysterious Jason Brown was finally being revealed. Police say Jason Brown was in serious debt to several creditors and had defaulted on at least one large loan. In November 2004, while living in the Sugarhouse area of Salt Lake City, police learned Brown purchased a Glock semi-automatic 45 caliber pistol. According to officials, Brown had also taken a firearms class while he was in Utah. Firearms instructor Clark Aposhian, who privately trained Brown, described him as "an obnoxious student" who was inexperienced with firearms. According to records, Brown completed the class in early November, but had not yet received his actual permit. Police then discovered that the type of ammunition used in Keith's murder matched the exact type of bullets that Brown purchased on the same day he bought his gun in Salt Lake City. Investigators also learned that Brown had been staying at a hotel located a mile from the murder scene. He reportedly checked in on Thanksgiving Day and checked out the evening of the murder. According to witnesses, in the days leading up to the robbery-murder, they observed Jason Derek Brown sitting in his distinctive BMW M3 in front of the theater for lengthy periods of time, observing the area. But now, the trail has gone cold. Police believe Brown headed toward California via Las Vegas shortly after the murder and now could be in Arizona, Utah, Nevada or even Texas. Jason Derek Brown has used the aliases Derek Brown, Greg Johnson and Greg Harline Johnson. Brown is a big spender who loves the nightclub scene. He enjoys water sports (boating and fishing), loves to go off-roading and collects expensive cars. Brown has green eyes and may have grown a beard or mustache, and may have dyed his hair. He is known to shave all of his body hair. Brown has been spotted in Henderson, Nevada; Las Vegas, Nevada; Dana Point, California; Portland, Oregon. Jason Derek Brown is 36, 5'10" and 170-180 pounds. Peter Hommerson (Arson, Murder) --On January 23rd firefighters battled an arson blaze at the home of Marvin and Kitty Lichtman. Their bodies were found in the rubble, but they had died of gunshot wounds before the fire started. Hommerson, a local handyman and glass installer, had known and worked for the couple for years. Police speculate that Hommerson killed Kitty Lichtman, looted the multi-million dollar house, killed Marvin when he arrived home, then set the fire to cover his crimes. Hommerson has been charged with murder. He is believed to have fled into Mexico, but may have returned to the states. Hommerson is a native of Hungary who used to go by the name Lajohs Farengi. He speaks English with a thick accent. He also speaks Italian, German and Hungarian. Hommerson may have died his brown hair black.

He has a distinctive line tattoo on his left wrist, which he tries to hide under his watch. Hommerson is an outdoorsman and should be considered armed and dangerous. He is 59, 6'0" and 220 pounds. Greisy Valencia (Child Abuse) -- The Hayward Police Department is searching for 49-year-old Greisy Valencia for the alleged torture of her 11-year-old daughter. Police say that Valencia began torturing the girl at the age of four. Police and witnesses say that Valencia would hold the girl's hands and face over the stove as a form of punishment. Police also say that Valencia burned and hit the girl with several different objects. Social workers and police both say it is the worse case of child abuse they have ever seen. The girl is covered with scars from head to toe. Police say on December 9, 2002, Valencia got word that someone close to the girl was going to report her to the police. Valencia abruptly left work and told her employers that she didn't know when she was going to return. The little girl and her two brothers are in foster care and doing well. Valencia works in fast food restaurants and comes across as very witty and hardworking. She has used the alias Yudera Monteel. She likes to hang out with and spend money on men. Valencia is 51, 5'3" and 130-154 pounds. (See Shows #718, #727, #742, #747, and #789, OADs 5/10/03, 7/19/03, 11/22/03, 1/03/04, and 12/18/04)

Mustapha Mohamed Atat (Murder, Drug Charges) -- Atat was driving in a street race that resulted in a fatal accident. He has been charged with second degree murder. On October 8, 2001, Atat and Aaron Reynolds, 34, were street racing at speeds of more than 100 mph in a 35 mph zone. The two were both driving modified Mustangs and had bet \$12,000 on the race's outcome. Reynolds' car went out of control, crossed a sidewalk, and struck three people. The accident killed Denise Jones, 35, and injured Eric Draw, 35, and Rodney Ricks, 32. Atat and Reynolds were charged with second degree murder, failure to stop at the scene of a serious personal injury accident, and two counts of felonious driving and drag racing. During a raid at Atat's residence, police were surprised to find that although Atat received welfare, he owned a large home and several luxury cars. Police attribute this discrepancy to drug dealing after finding several illegal substances on the premises. Atat has failed to appear in court and may have fled the country. Atat has a large scar on his right cheek under his eye and speaks with a Middle Eastern accent. He is 33, 5'7" and 150 pounds. (See Shows #713 and #751, OADs 4/05/03 and 1/31/04)

ALL POINTS BULLETIN:

Mikhail Drachev (Murder, Kidnapping) -- Konstantin Simberg was an informant for Phoenix, Arizona Detective Tom Britt. On December 14, 2001, Tom received a call on his cell phone from Konstantin. While on the phone, Tom heard a scream from Konstantin, then the line went dead. Two days later, Konstantin's body was found in Fossil Creek, Arizona - a rural area more than 100 miles from Phoenix. Through his own phone records, Tom learned that Konstantin called him from a cell phone belonging to an Arizona State freshman named Chris Andrews. Detectives went to Andrews' apartment and found evidence linking him to the

murder. 20-year-old Dennis Tsoukanov and 19-year-old Mikhail Drachev were also involved in the killing. All three are acquaintances of Konstantin's. The three men attacked Konstantin while he was on the phone with Detective Britt. The gang held Konstantin overnight, then drove him to Fossil Creek the next morning. The men stabbed Konstantin in the back with a knife. The men then lit him on fire, covered him with rocks and left him for dead. Andrews and Tsoukanov are in jail awaiting trial. Drachev is currently on the run. Drachev is a Russian national who speaks English without an accent. He may be driving a 1973 Mercedes-Benz 280-SEL with Utah plate 182-XS. Drachev is 22, 5'11" and 170 pounds. (See Shows #689, #721 and #761, OADs 8/31/02, 5/31/03 and 4/24/04) Drachev has drastically changed his appearance since his last profile on AMW. Police recently uncovered a new photograph from Canada. He has dyed his hair blonde and wears glasses. He could be hiding in New York or Canada. (See Show #780, OAD 9/18/04)

Georgina "Gina" DeJesus

Age: 15

Height: 5'1"

Weight: 135 pounds

On Friday, April 2, 2004, 14-year-old Georgina "Gina" DeJesus disappeared as she was walking home from school. Gina left Wilbur Wright Middle School around 2:30 p.m. and headed home, but she never arrived. When her mother got home and realized her daughter never returned from school, she called police. Police say witness last saw Gina at the corner of 105th Street and Lorain Avenue. She was last seen wearing black pants, a white/tan shirt, and a powder blue, hooded jacket. Police have no leads or suspects. Police are treating Gina's disappearance as a missing persons case. Friends and family say she was a happy girl and would never have run away. Police want to talk with a man seen driving along Lorain Avenue in the area where Gina disappeared. The man is described as Hispanic, driving a light-colored, older-model compact car with a license plate that includes the letters SMS. Police are not calling this man a suspect, but he and his car have been described by multiple witnesses. On April 21, 2003, 17-year-old Amanda Berry went missing just six blocks from where Gina was last seen. Police have no reason to believe that the two cases are connected, but they're not ruling anything out at this time. Gina is Hispanic. She has a light brown birthmark on her right leg and her right ear is pierced at the top and the bottom. (See Shows #760, #765 and #798, OADs 4/17/04, 5/22/04 and 3/12/05)

Amanda Berry

Age: 18

On April 21, 2003, Amanda Berry left her job at Burger King and has not been seen since. One week after Amanda's disappearance, her family received a mysterious phone call from an unidentified man. He claimed that he had Amanda and that she would be returned home in a couple of days. Amanda was planning on having a party to celebrate her 17th birthday on April 22nd. Amanda loves shopping, talking on the phone and listening to Eminem. She was last seen wearing a Burger King uniform. Amanda has a scar on her lower abdomen, a double

piercing in her ear and a pierced left eyebrow. (See Shows #741 and #759, OADs 11/15/03 and 4/10/04)

Rashawn Capers (Murder, Attempted Murder, Weapons Possession) -- On March 27, 2005, Officer Wayne Smith faced the ultimate tragedy. That night Officer Smith was called out to investigate a fight at about 3:45 in the morning. Little did he know his entire life was about to change forever. At the scene he encountered a crowd surrounding a person lying on the ground. According to reports, as he approached the victim, things took a turn for the worse. That's because the limp, lifeless body laying on the sidewalk was his 20-year-old Dayshawn Smith. The Officer Smith immediately joined rescue efforts to try to revive the boy. Officials rushed the Dayshawn to the hospital where he was later pronounced dead. According to police, Dayshawn was trying to stop a fight Rashawn Capers was involved in. However, Capers did not respond well to Dayshawn's involvement and allegedly stabbed him fatally. Capers has not been seen since the incident. Rashawn Capers has a long, vertical scar on his forehead and a Chinese symbol tattooed on his left forearm. He is known to wear his hair long and short has been known to wear a mustache and goatee. Capers was last seen in front of an after hours club in Patterson, NJ and has family in North Carolina and South Carolina. Capers is 23, 5'6" and 165 pounds.

CAPTURED:

Jesse James Hollywood (Murder, Kidnapping) -- On August 6, 2000 at approximately 2:30pm 15-year-old Nicholas Sam Markowitz was kidnapped from West Hills, California. He was taken because his brother owed Hollywood and his companions money from a drug deal. Markowitz was taken to the Santa Barbara area where he was held until late in the evening on August 8, 2000. Hollywood and his companions, Ryan Hoyt and Jesse Rugge, walked Markowitz up a trail while a third suspect, Graham Pressley, remained behind at the vehicle. Pressley and Hoyt had been there earlier in the day to dig a grave. Rugge and Hoyt duct-taped Markowitz's hands behind his back and taped his mouth, then put the boy into the grave and shot him in the torso and head. The grave was filled and covered with branches. Hikers found the body on August 12, 2000 and notified officials. (See Shows #602, #614, #626, #637, #660, #700, #736 and #768, OADs 9/2/00, 12/30/00, 3/24/01, 6/16/01, 1/12/02, 12/14/02, 9/20/03 and 6/12/04) Jesse James Hollywood was apprehended in Brazil in March, 2005. He was immediately extradited back to the U.S. where he will face several felony charges including murder.

Screening Report

This will confirm that I have screened the air copy of the above-captioned episode and have the following comments:

Troy Devin Smith (Robbery, Kidnapping, Burglary) -- The Smith brothers are wanted fro the 2003 burglary of a San Francisco Jewelry store. The Smith brothers, along with George Turner and an unknown accomplice, broke through a wall separating two businesses and later restrained the employees of Lang's Antique Store when they arrived to open up the store for business. They made off with more than \$10 million in property. Turner was arrested in June 2003, but the two brothers remain fugitives. Dino usually shaves his head and often wears a goatee. He loves beautiful blonds and dines at upscale restaurants and bars. Troy is a former professional football player who usually follows Dino's lead. On June 4, 2004, San Francisco Inspectors arrested Dino Smith without incident in Queens, New York. However, his brother is still at large. Troy is 42 6'3" and 200 pounds. According to police, Dayshawn was trying to stop a fight Rashawn Capers had provoked. However, Capers did not respond kindly to Dayshawn's involvement and fatally stabbed him. Capers has not been seen since the incident. Rashawn Capers, who is also known as "Rah-Rah," has a long, vertical scar on his forehead and a Chinese symbol tattooed on his left forearm. He wears his hair long or short and has been known to wear a mustache and goatee. Capers was last seen in front of an after hours club in Patterson, NJ and police believe he may be

headed to North Carolina or South Carolina where he has family. Capers is 23, 5'6" and 165 pounds. (See Show #801, OAD 4/02/05)

Michael Robert Soutar (Escape) -- Some people compare Michael Soutar to prince charming. His former girlfriends say he treated them well and showered them with attention and affection. Nevertheless, that only lasted so long. Police say Soutar tricked people out of their money, and nearly ruined their lives. In 1996 Soutar escaped from the New Mexico State Penitentiary where he was serving time for fraud, aggravated assault and forgery. Prison officials released Soutar from jail so he could have knee surgery but he never returned. Instead, he headed for Arizona and worked his way into women's hearts, and then their pocketbooks. His victims say he figured out their credit history and financial background, then borrowed or stole from them using a variety of techniques including credit card fraud, forgery, or simply borrowing money and promising to pay it back with non-existent funds. America's Most Wanted profiled Soutar in 1997, but was captured just before the story aired. Soutar was sentenced to 10 years in prison, with four years suspended. When he was released in 2002, he attempted to start a new life. Soutar married and moved to Las Cruces, New Mexico. However, his fresh start was short lived. After moving to Santa Fe, officials there say he started his latest scam. Soutar used his skills to convince investors to back the opening of a new art market in late 2003. Nine months later it became apparent Soutar was draining the project dry. In August of 2004, police arrested Soutar for probation violations and Santa Fe police piled new charges on him in connection with fraud at the art market. He was indicted on the new charges and was released for work. While on a lunch break one day, Soutar jumped into an unidentified vehicle and has not been seen since. Soutar has a four inch surgery scar on his left shoulder, an eight inch scar above the knee on his right leg and a tattoo of the name "Paula" on his right hip. He is described as a sharp dresser who fancies designer clothing and shoes. His previous employment includes a stint as a car salesman and venture capitalist. Soutar is 46, 6'1" and 195 pounds.

Teddy Lynne Ellis (Murder, Escape) -- Local and federal authorities are searching for Teddy Lynne Ellis, an escapee from the Dick Connors Correctional Facility in Hominy, Oklahoma. Ellis was convicted of murder and was serving a life sentence when he decided to escape. On June 19, 1982, 17-year-old Teddy Ellis and two of his friends were driving towards Norman, Oklahoma when they picked up a lone hitchhiker named Dale Eugene Spurgin. Once in the vehicle, Dale attempts to impress the young men by displaying his antique black-powdered .38 gun. Ellis admires the gun and suggests that they pull over and use it for target practice. While Ellis' friends hang out in the car, Ellis unexpectedly shoots Dale in the head and back killing him instantly. Ellis was arrested and sentenced to life in prison but on May 24, 1986, Ellis and four of his fellow inmates escaped from the Dick Connors Correctional Facility. Ellis hasn't been seen since. A bodybuilder who wore long black hair with a bandana, Ellis has a long scar over his right eye and several tattoos: a teardrop under his left eye, castles and wizards on his arms, "Kay" on his upper right arm and "T.E." on his upper left arm. He has hazel eyes, may

have a mustache or beard, and wears an earring in his left ear. Ellis is described as an introvert who

dislikes African Americans and homosexuals. He carries a buck knife on his belt and is known to be a heavy beer drinker. Ellis is 40, 5'8", 140 pounds. (See Shows #125, #145, and #169, OADS 8/5/90, 1/4/91 and 6/28/91)

Joel Vidal (as) Urena (Murder, Assault with a Firearm, Robbery, False Imprisonment) -- On October 5, 1996, Steve Kerston was awakened at 5 a.m. by flashlights in his eyes. Four masked men had broken into his family's Cotati, California home. Police say it was Joel Urena and three accomplices. Steve says the men attacked him and then went into his parents' bedroom. The men demanded money, jewels, and guns from Mark and Mary Kerston. When the couple insisted that they had none, one of the men went out to the living room and shot Steve in the leg. When the couple still insisted they had no valuables, the men threatened to shoot Steve in the head. Fortunately, they didn't follow through on the threat. Instead, they grabbed whatever they could get their hands on and took off. Urena has scars on his face from a car accident and another scar on his right hand. Although of Hawaiian heritage, he may appear Hispanic. He may be wearing a moustache. Urena may be driving a 80's-90's silver or blue metallic Chevrolet Blazer or an 80's black Chevrolet Astro van. He is 33, 6'0" and 260 pounds. (See Shows #472, #509 #537, #556, #582, #628, #696 and #771, OADs 11/1/97, 8/29/98, 4/10/99, 9/4/99, 4/1/00, 4/7/01, 11/09/02 and 7/10/04)

Sajjad "JJ" Rasheed (Triple Murder, Attempted Murder, Aggravated Battery) -- On Tuesday, April 5, 2005, police responded to a report of shots fired at a home on Alabama Street in Hobart, Indiana. Inside, they found three people face down in pools of blood, murdered execution-style. Two more were in the back of the home, gravely injured. Police were left trying to piece together the evidence at the gruesome scene. Agents say they've figured out how the attack went down, beginning with three friends: Sajjad "JJ" Rasheed, Carl "D" Major and Kirby Oliver. They say the three men busted in to the home of David Williams, 23, and started firing two guns, a .22 caliber handgun, and a .40 caliber handgun. Police believe the men went there to get cash that "JJ" Rasheed told the others he was owed. After entering the house, Rasheed, Major and Oliver killed 19-year-old Edward Espinoza, 19-year-old Brittney Hott and 20-year-old Lindsay Davidson, and continued through the home firing at two more people inside. 23-year-old David Williams, the owner of the home, and a fifth shooting victim, 22-year-old Darryl Mosley were sent to local hospitals, where they have been listed in critical condition. Police found an unclaimed gray Volkswagen in the alley behind the Alabama Street home. They started investigating the suspicious vehicle, and through a series of interviews were able to link the car to Rasheed, Major and Oliver. Shortly after the shooting, Major and Oliver were apprehended. According to police, Rasheed has fled. Meanwhile, his friends Major and Oliver are being held without bond in the Lake County Jail. They have been cooperating with police. Sajjad Q.

Rasheed is also known as "J.J." and "Jake." He has numerous distinctive tattoos on his body which includes an oval-shaped tattoo on the left side of his neck which seems to read "FEE7," a tattoo of the phrase "The World Is Mine" on the upper part of his left arm, and a tattoo

of his initials "SR" on the upper part of his right arm. Rasheed is a known gun collector and is described as quick-tempered. He's also a known drug dealer and police consider him armed and dangerous. Rasheed is likely still in the Northwest region of Indiana, but he could be anywhere. Rasheed is 22, 5'7" and 145 pounds.

CAPTURED:

Randolph Franklin Dial (Escape) -- Randolph Dial is wanted for escape from a medium security prison in Granite, Oklahoma on August 30, 1994. Dial escaped from the prison around 11:30 a.m. and took Bobbie Parker, the deputy warden's wife, with him. Agents believe Dial used Parker's van to leave the prison grounds. After the escape, police say Parker made several calls to family and friends saying that she was okay and that she would be home soon. The last phone call came on September 9, 1994. Neither Dial or Parker have been seen since. The van was recovered in Wichita Falls, TX on September 1, 1994. Dial was serving a life sentence for the 1981 murder of Kelly Hogan in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. Dial confessed to the murder, which he claimed, was a contract killing for the mob. Broken Arrow police never discovered who hired Dial to kill Hogan. In 1998, author Charles Sasser wrote a book about Dial entitled, "At Large: The Life and Crimes of Randolph Franklin Dial." On November 9, 2001, Sasser claims Dial called him on the phone and the two spoke for approximately 45 minutes. Sasser also says he spoke with Parker. Agents were not able to trace the call but they believe Dial made the phone call. Dial's numerous aliases and nicknames include "Doc" Dial, Randolph Franklin Johnston, Randolph Franklin, Randy F. Johnson and "Doc" Franklin. He has a small scar under the left side of his chin, two small scars on his upper left chest, and a small round scar on the back of his left calf. His teeth are in poor condition and he may be missing one or two lower front teeth. (See Shows #717, #741 and #769, OADs 5/03/03, 11/15/03 and 6/19/04) A tip generated by America's Most Wanted led directly to the capture of Randolph Dial on April 5, 2005. Dial, 60, and Bobbi Parker were found in East Texas working on a chicken ranch. Police say Dial was taken into custody without incident, but a loaded pistol was found on a nearby table. Bobbi Parker has been reunited with her husband. According to officials, Bobbi Parker claims to have been held captive by Dial.

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Kenneth Marshall Cofer (1st Degree Murder) -- Even before September 11, 2001, Oklahoma City residents knew the horror of terrorism. Nearly everyone remembers April 19, 1995, when explosives brought the Alfred P. Murrah building down. Since then, Oklahoma City residents have become an even more profoundly patriotic community. That's why when Kenneth Cofer claimed America got what it deserved from the Oklahoma City bombing and 9/11 attacks, Vietnam veteran Larry Buchanan passionately defended his country and beliefs. Police say this was just the beginning in a series of confrontations that would eventually end in murder. The day after Cofer and Buchanan's initial confrontation, the two found themselves face-to-face once again. This time, it was at the Country Palace Bar, Buchanan's favorite local hangout. He was a regular there and all the locals knew him as "Buffalo." When Cofer entered the bar the men began to argue. Buffalo kept his cool but it was clear that Cofer wanted to fight. Buffalo didn't want Cofer there, and the bartender obliged by tossing him out. When Buchanan left the bar minutes later, police say that Cofer was hiding in the shadows. Six inches shorter and hobbled by recent surgery, Buffalo was outmanned, but bravely stood up to Cofer. Police say that Cofer knocked Buchanan to the ground a few times and then drove off. On September 13, 2002, Cofer and Buchanan ran into one another for the third and final time. Cofer was hanging out with a group of men at a rural property outside Oklahoma City when Larry Buchanan showed up. As had happened the previous two days, the two squared off. Instead of a fist fight, Cofer pulled out a handgun and shot Larry Buchanan in the head. Witnesses say Cofer walked over to his truck, stated, "I guess I have ruined my life," climbed in and drove away. Buchanan died at the scene. Months later, cops found Cofer's truck in a ditch near the murder scene. It had been spray-painted black and had receipts inside suggesting Cofer had traveled to Arkansas and back. Cofer hasn't been seen since the day of the murder. With the ten-year anniversary of the Oklahoma City bombing reopening old wounds, this community is once again looking for justice. Kenneth

Marshall Cofer uses the alias "KM Cofer." He wears very thick glasses due to poor vision, has brown hair, and is known to wear a goatee. Cofer has a burn on his chest and several tattoos on his chest including two Vikings on the right side, three skulls on the left and an eagle with a swastika in the middle. He has a magic circle and unicorn on his upper left arm and a Japanese sword, Mt. Fuji and two lightning streaks on his upper right arm. Cofer may be working as a cabinet maker or a roofer. He could also be playing drums in a band. Cofer is 45, 6'2" and 190 pounds.

David Lopez (Murder)

Ruben Lopez (Murder) -- David and Ruben Lopez are wanted by the San Jose Police department for the 1997 murder of Leonard Miller. Police say the Lopez brothers were involved in a business dispute with Leonard's son, Steve. Brother David, Ruben and Efram Lopez operated Red's Hydraulics in Long Beach, California. Steve Miller and his father, Leonard Miller, owned and operated Lowrider Hydraulics in San Jose. The two companies were fierce competitors in the lucrative custom-lowrider car parts supply industry. Detectives say David and Ruben hired three men from Los Angeles and sent them to San Jose to kill Steve Miller. On the morning of March 3, 1997 one of the men entered Lowrider Hydraulics and asked to see the owner. When sixty-year-old Leonard Miller walked out to the counter he was gunned down. The intended target, Steve Miller, was not at work that morning. Within weeks the three contract killers were arrested. The hitmen implicated David and Ruben Lopez as the men who had hired them to kill Steve Miller. Before police could arrest them, the Lopez brothers packed up their families and disappeared from Long Beach. Both brothers have used the surname Ramirez. David Lopez has a stocky build and long, flowing hair. He is married to Clara Elena Lopez; they have four children. David Lopez is 43, 5'4" and 176 pounds. Ruben Lopez wears a goatee and has long flowing jet-black hair. He is described as a workaholic. He is married to Margaret Elaine Lopez; they also have children. Ruben Lopez is 47, 5'8" and 180 pounds. Ruben has been spotted at low-rider shows and conventions while he's been on the run. Police believe he is still selling hydraulics. (See Shows #526, #528, #566 and #667, OADs 1/23/99, 2/6/99, 11/20/99 and 3/09/02)

William Peter Fischer (Murder) -- Billy Fischer met Nancy Hyer on a Manhattan-bound train and opened up his life to her. Nancy soon found that the polite young man sitting next to her suffered from cystic fibrosis - he had been sick most of his life. During this time, he was abandoned by uncaring parents and left to drift from one foster home and group home to the next. The only caring family Billy had was his brother Jayson, who lived in separate foster homes while they grew up. The brothers saw each other as often as they could, and Jayson would fill Billy in on their absent and unpredictable father, William Peter Fischer. Ten years after he abandoned his two sons to foster homes, Fischer remarried and suddenly took a renewed interest in the boys. Jayson maintains that this surge of fatherly love was hollow and motivated by a desire to look better in the eyes of his new wife's family. But the Fischer family reunion was short-lived. Jayson says that his father was deep in the throes of a crack habit and that made his behavior erratic and hot-tempered. The boys decided they would be better off on their own. For four years, Billy refused to talk to his father, but on a trip to New York to see Jayson, he learned

that Fischer was willing to see him. Billy's health had taken a turn for the worse, and when he arrived at his father's home in Southampton he found a father who was supportive all of a sudden. Billy now found a father ready to pay for his medical bills - which had already piled up on Fischer's doorstep - and even ready to buy him a car. But, police say, this was all just a ruse to put Billy off his guard. Nancy, the woman Billy met on the train, was moved by Billy's story and wanted to see him again. She called him at Fischer's Southampton home and arranged to meet him at 8:00 p.m. on December 11, 1986. It turned out to be her date with destiny. Nine days later, police found her body and Billy's in her abandoned car at the Southampton Elks Club. Billy had been shot 18 times, and Nancy had been stripped of her clothing and stabbed in the chest and abdomen. Serving a search warrant on Fischer's home, police say they discovered three bullets lodged in the wall that matched those that had killed Billy. And with the blood-detecting chemical Luminol, they discovered blood traces throughout the house - even in the vacuum cleaner. Fischer, meanwhile, was in the process of getting a second mortgage on his house. When a grand jury indicted him for murder, he had already left with \$60,000 in his pocket. His car was discovered at New York's Kennedy Airport on February 27, 1987. Fischer has a tracheotomy scar on his throat and a receding hairline. He is a fancy dresser and very flirtatious - he reportedly engages in "kinky" sex with multiple partners. He is a heavy drinker, a suspected crack cocaine user, and a smoker. He is a heavy antacid user and may have stomach problems. He has worked as an auto dealer. Fischer is 60, 5'11" and 185-200 pounds. (See Shows #218, #408, #497, #577, #646, #726 and #759, OADs 6/19/92, 5/4/96, 5/30/98, 2/26/00, 8/25/01, 7/12/03 and 4/10/05)

Unknown Angelo Ravella Killer (Muder) -- Angelo Ravella's passion in high school was wrestling. He spent almost every day practicing his sport, dedicated to the rules of fair play and good sportsmanship. As a young amateur, Angelo drew inspiration from pro wrestlers and, in turn, his coach says his devotion to the sport inspired his teammates to be better wrestlers. It was the world of wrestling that helped this awkward teen develop the confidence to make the right decisions in the ring as well as in life. As a co-captain of the Arroyo Dons, Angelo helped lead his San Leandro High School team to a California state championship title. He had literally wrestled his way into the hearts of people in this community, becoming a local sports hero. Angelo Ravella, Sr. had coached his namesake through little league baseball and youth football league. The father and son team often went camping, hunting and fishing together. They were great friends, and Angelo, Jr. was comfortable confiding in his dad. After high school, the popular young man set his sights on college. He needed a way to pay for it, so he worked alongside his dad at a sanitation company by day as he took classes by night. He was excelling in college, making good grades, and advancing through his courses. On March 27, 2003, after acing a college exam, Angelo, his brother and some other buddies went to celebrate Angelo's success. They were having drinks at a bar in Castro Valley, California. At some point in the evening, Angelo's brother Benny left with a female friend. Once outside, the two saw a couple arguing, so Benny asked the woman in the argument if she was okay. This started a loud verbal argument and Angelo came to investigate. He stepped between the unknown man and Benny to break up the argument. But Angelo's efforts only enraged the unknown man and he threatened Angelo with his gang's challenge to a fight, saying "east 7th." To Angelo, a good kid, this meant nothing, so Angelo calmly turned and walked back into the bar. The unknown man and woman

left. After spending a couple more hours at the bar, Angelo left shortly after midnight with a friend. The two were driving through Castro Valley toward San Leandro. They were stopped at a stop sign in San Leandro only four blocks from Angelo's home when a 1980's Cadillac pulled up alongside them. One of the car's occupants yelled at Angelo and his friend. The two looked over at the Cadillac just as gunshots rang out. The two friends were under fire. Angelo Ravello took a bullet to the head. Only hours later, Angelo Ravello's parents were forced to make the decision they never thought they would have to make for their fighter of a son. They decided to have doctors remove his life support. Within minutes, Angelo was dead. Witnesses to the murder say that the shooter was a Hispanic male between 18 and 25 years old. He wore a black watchman's cap and may have some facial hair. Another good clue is that the shooter was not alone in the distinctive 1980's Cadillac. There were anywhere from three to five other occupants in the Cadillac with him that night. Police would like to speak with anyone who drives a 1980's Cadillac or who may have been in the car with the shooter that night.

Sarah Michelle Lunde

Age: 13

13-year-old Sarah Michelle Lunde disappeared from her family's home in Hillsborough County sometime after midnight Saturday, April 9, 2005. According to the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office, Sarah went on an overnight trip to a mission camp with a youth group from the First Apostolic Church in Ruskin, Florida. However, Sarah unexpectedly showed up at the family home, where she lives with her mother and three brothers, around 9pm Saturday evening. That night, Sarah's 17-year-old brother, Alan Lunde, left to pick up dinner. Investigators say he left for a restaurant and then hung out with friends. When Alan finally returned home before dawn on Sunday, he found the front door open and Sarah gone. Sarah's mother Kelly May returned home on Sunday and assumed Sarah was spending the night with a friend. Kelly instinctively went to Beth Shields Middle School Monday to see if Sarah had made it to class and reported her missing when she learned no one had seen her. Her family acknowledges Sarah has had a troubled history. Officials say when she was nine, she had "emotional issues" while she was living in a foster home. According to the Sheriff's Office, Sarah has run away from home before, typically after fights with her mom. However, they say she usually returns after a few hours. Sarah has brown hair and hazel eyes. She was last seen wearing a white T-shirt with orange and blue basketball shorts. She has a bright green half cast on her left arm from a wrist injury.

CAPTURED:

Fabian Smart – Unknown Jason McMann Killer (Murder) -- In April of 1999, 21-year-old Jason McMann's badly bruised and decomposed body was discovered in a densely wooded area outside Lock Haven, Pennsylvania, a small town nestled in the Appalachian

Mountains. He had been missing for three months. Jason McMann was last seen on January 23, 1999 at a party held at a place called the "Football House", an off-campus residence where members of the Lock Haven University football team live and hang out. According to friends and family members, Jason had been involved in an ongoing feud with one of the football players, Fabian Smart, over money owed to Jason's cousin. Eyewitnesses say Jason was last seen fighting with Smart and several members of the football team shortly before his disappearance. Authorities have been stymied in pinpointing exactly what happened to Jason McMann because of alleged threats and a blanket of secrecy that has fallen on this small town. AMW entered the case with retired Miami Beach police Detective Sergeant Joe Matthews, who brings 29 years of homicide experience to assist the Pennsylvania police in their investigation. As a direct result of an AMW investigation by retired Homicide Detective Joe Matthews, on June 10, 2002, Fabian Smart, the former quarterback of LHU's football team, and who cops believed brutally beat Jason McMann to death, was arrested in his hometown Rincon, Georgia for 1st degree murder and kidnapping. Willie Marvin "Diggy" Williams, Jr. a former student at Lock Haven University was also arrested in June 2002 for Jason's murder. Williams was taken into custody at his home in Philadelphia by a fugitive squad. Two other accomplices, Jermaine Ballard and Quincy Teal, also former football players from LHU surrendered to authorities in 2004 and charged for their role in the kidnap-murder of Jason McMann. The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Featured Story:

AMW followed the first nationwide USMS fugitive round up. Hundreds of law enforcement agencies from all across the country teamed up to form Operation FALCON. This national US Marshall sting operation was a major success - more than 10,000 fugitives were arrested in the sting.

William Porter Looney III (Possession of Child Pornography) -- In April 2004, William Porter Looney III thought he was having an Internet chat with a young female. In reality, he was chatting with an undercover member of the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force. Based upon inappropriate sexual conversation the ICACTF member had with Looney, the officer checked his public computer profile and discovered pornographic images of children. Police in Milford, TX obtained a search warrant and confiscated computers and dozens of computer disks from Looney's home. By the time investigators discovered that the computers and disks contained hundreds of pornographic images of children, Looney had already fled Milford. Police determined that before Looney became a fugitive, he traveled to Michigan and Illinois to meet with 12- and 13-year-old girls he encountered in computer chat rooms. William Porter Looney III, who is also known as "Sonny," has a scar on his chin, a tattoo of the name "CORBY" and another unidentified tattoo on his left arm. He has a receding hairline and blue eyes. He is computer savvy and authorities believe he still may be visiting computer chat rooms. He has worked for H&R Block during tax season and may be preparing tax returns to earn money. He is known to drive motorcycles and small foreign cars and may be traveling with a 14 year-old girl he met on the internet. William "Sonny" Porter Looney III is 34, 6'4" and 220 pounds.

Francisco Diaz-Marroquin (Having Sexual Intercourse With a Child Under the Age of 13, 2 counts of Forcible Sodomy) -- Virginia authorities have charged Francisco Diaz-Marroquin with raping and sodomizing a 10-year-old girl for nearly two years. According to family members of the young victim, Diaz-Marroquin sexually abused the girl in Louisiana and Virginia on dozens of occasions between 2002 and 2004 when the girl's mother left home to run errands. Diaz-Marroquin fled to his birthplace, El Salvador, in late March 2005, but police believe he's back in the country. He is a long-haul truck driver who travels throughout the country. Diaz-Marroquin is 47, 5'4" and 180 pounds.

Mark Damon Grossi (Murder) -- Police in San Diego, California are on the hunt for Mark Damon Grossi. According to officials, Grossi was heading down I-5 in San Diego and soon found himself on a collision course that left one man dead. Jorge Negrete, a 47 year-old long distance truck driver, was also driving along the same route at the same time as Grossi. At some point, one of the men cut off the other, igniting a fit of road rage that escalated into a war of words between the two men. Witnesses say the two men were swearing at each other while driving along the highway. Suddenly, both men pulled off onto the shoulder. Jorge pulled over in his big rig, and Grossi stopped behind him. Police say Jorge's size, at over 300 pounds, may have intimidated Grossi, because witnesses have said Grossi returned to his truck as Negrete continued to approach him. The enraged Grossi put his pick-up truck in reverse, backed up a distance, then put it in gear and stepped on the gas. Police say he slammed into Negrete with an impact that forced the 300 lb Negrete into the air and then sped off. Sadly, Negrete died on the way to the hospital. Hours after the vicious road rage murder, Grossi was captured on ATM surveillance tape withdrawing everything he had in his savings account and hasn't been seen since. Police believe he could be anywhere in California, or could have fled to the East Coast. Grossi is 42, 5'8" and 170 pounds.

Sebastian Roberto Barba (2nd Degree Murder) -- On February 6, 2001, Sebastian Barba was out for a drive when an elderly woman began to make her way across a street at a crosswalk in front of him. Police say that Barba struck the woman with his square-model Cadillac. Although Barba was only driving between five and ten miles-per-hour, there was enough force to throw the woman on the hood of his car. Instead of stopping to help the woman, witnesses watched in horror as Barba slammed on his brakes in an apparent attempt to force the woman off his car. Even after taking such a violent hit, the woman was still alive, lying on the pavement and attempting to get up. Police say this is when Barba's "accident" turned into murder. Witnesses say Barba did not intend to stick around to help the woman. Despite several warnings from bystanders, Barba revved his engine and drove directly over the woman's head, killing her instantly. Barba high-tailed his car out of sight, and hasn't been seen since. Barba has ties to areas in Florida, as well as family in California, Chicago, and Ecuador. Barba is 27, 5'8" and 154 pounds.

Gerren James (Armed Robbery, Aggravated Battery) -- Authorities in Collier County, Florida are looking for the half-brother of Edgerrin James of the Indianapolis Colts. His name is Gerren James. According to officials, Gerren James and his cousin broke into an apartment on September 1, 2004. James fired his gun repeatedly out of frustration when things didn't go the way he planned - one of the shots hit 19-year-old Domingo Matos, an innocent victim who was

at the apartment visiting his friend. Now, Matos is a quadriplegic, paralyzed for life. Police arrested James' cousin, but haven't been able to track him down. Edgerrin James has been questioned by police and claims that he does not know where his brother is. Gerren has the tattoo of the word "outlaw" on his left arm. Gerren James is 22, 5'5" and 160 pounds.

Marcelo Montalvo (Aggravated Burglary, Aggravated Assault) -- Irina Montalvo nearly bled to death the night of September 18, 2003. Irina's husband, Marcelo Montalvo is accused of trying to kill her by repeatedly slashing her with a box cutter. Montalvo not only jabbed the blade through Irina's skin, he also squeezed the bloody wounds to make sure she bled hard and fast. Irina had a restraining order against Montalvo, but Montalvo convinced their kids into letting him inside the house the day of the murder. Fortunately, Irina survived the brutal attack. However, Marcelo Montalvo managed to evade arrest. He allegedly headed for Georgia to collect \$4000 in cash from his brother and may have headed for Ecuador or Puerto Rico. Montalvo is 46, 5'7" and 130-150 pounds.

Ronald Fischer (Escape) -- Authorities in East Greenwich, RI are on a nationwide manhunt for Ronald Fischer. Fischer is a wealthy Rhode Island doctor and a convicted rapist. Fischer started placing personal ads on-line in 1992 after he got divorced. According to officials, in 1994, Fischer was charged with meeting a woman on-line and raping her aboard his yacht, "The Lion King." Fischer was arrested and pled guilty to lesser charges to avoid jail time. In 2003, he met a college English professor on-line. He invited her to his yacht and wooed her with drinks and dinner. However, the romantic date soon took a dangerous turn. Fischer forced himself on the unsuspecting woman and raped her in the bedroom aboard his yacht. Fischer was arrested, charged and his case went to trial in 2005. However, midway through the trial, Fischer sent an e-mail titled "Goodbye" to his attorney, telling him he was leaving the country. Fischer hasn't been seen or heard from since. A jury convicted him in absentia of two counts of first-degree sexual assault and one count of second-degree sexual assault, meaning that the former anesthesiologist could face up to life in prison. Fischer is an intelligent man who is Ivy League-educated and had an impressive career as a doctor. He was chief of the ob/gyn anesthesia department at the Rush University Medical Center in Chicago and chair of the anesthesiology department at Pawtucket's Memorial Hospital in Rhode Island. He also held the rank of an assistant professor of anesthesiology at Brown University Medical School. Fischer has plenty of money and lots of worldwide connections. Fischer's victims say that he has a pock-marked face, a bad comb-over, a fiery temper and described himself as "handsome, blue-eyed and loveable" in the personal ads he posted on websites and in newspapers throughout the New England area. Fischer is balding and has red hair that may appear blond. Fischer enjoys playing computer chess, playing tennis, and working out with a trainer. He also enjoys boating and spending time on the water. Authorities believe he may be hiding out in a marina. People who know Fischer say that he passionately denounces France for not supporting the war in Iraq. Fischer is 49, 5'10" and 180 pounds.

Daniel William Hiers (Criminal Sexual Conduct with a Minor) -- Local and federal officials are searching for Daniel Hiers. Hiers was supposed to turn himself in on March 15, 2005 after warrants were signed for his arrest charging him with criminal sexual misconduct with a minor and committing a lewd act on a minor. Hiers is accused of sexually assaulting a 9-year-old

girl he met at a karate center in West Ashley, South Carolina. The former school resource officer is accused of sexually assaulting the girl at her house and in his car. North Charleston police arrested Hiers in late November, but he was released from jail on a \$25,000 personal recognizance bond. However, when he was supposed to show up for his prearranged surrender, Hiers vanished. When Hiers didn't show, his mother went to his house to check on him and her daughter-in-law's lifeless body in the bedroom. Ludimila Hiers had been shot in the back of the head sometime between 7 and 12 am. Police have not charged Hiers with the murder of his wife, but they are calling him an "extreme person of interest." Hiers met Ludimila, on a trip to Brazil in 1994. She was 14 at the time, but they married when she turned 18. From 1993 to 1998, Hiers was a certified firefighter for the Town of Hampton. He was also a police officer for the Town of Hampton, his first job in law enforcement. After leaving Hampton as an officer, Hiers worked at the Town of Allendale Police Department and then for the Charleston Police Department. Daniel William Hiers has blue eyes and blonde hair. He may speak Portuguese or Spanish. Hiers is 32, 6'2" and 190 pounds. (See Show #800, OAD 3/26/05)

Raul Garcia-Gomez (Murder) -- On May 7th, 2005, Detective Donald Young, a 12-year veteran in Denver, Colorado, headed out to the Solano Ocampo Hall with another cop, John Bishop, to work security at a baptismal celebration. It was supposed to be a simple detail. It would become anything but. In what can only be described as an ambush, witnesses say a man approached Young and Bishop from behind and began firing. Young was struck in the back. By 1:33am, he was dead. It is unclear what led to the execution, but a newspaper reported that Young and his partner had thrown four people out of the hall, for trying to crash the party. Police do not know whether the incident prompted the execution. With the help of witnesses at the scene, police developed a composite of the man they believe is responsible for the murder of Detective Donald Young. Detective Young was not just another cop. He was the recipient of the Medal of Honor Award, Distinguished Service Cross Award, ten Official Commendations, and two Commendatory Letters. Authorities descended on the crime scene in full force and within the first couple of days, and eventually named a suspect. They have charged Raul-Garcia Gomez with the shooting. In fact, according to the Rocky Mountain News, Garcia confessed to his girlfriend that he committed the shootings. Reports say that a white Dodge Neon that was linked to the Raul has been located in Southern California. As the dragnet for Raul stretched into its third day, investigators continued to work around the clock, determined to make an arrest. Raul Garcia-Gomez has a tattoo on the back of his left hand. He is described as having a stocky build, slightly arched eyebrows and a light brown complexion. He was last seen wearing a white shirt with sleeves down to his elbows and either Khaki or light brown pants. Raul Garcia-Gomez is 19, 5'6" and 160 pounds.

Ivan Villa (Kidnapping, Person of Interest) -- Kristi Black was found dead in her Ruidoso apartment on the evening of May 8, 2005 and her 18-month-old son Justin was missing. Earlier that day, police were called to investigate a domestic dispute between Villa and Black. The next time police were called about the couple, it was because one of Kristi's friends had discovered her body. When they arrived, the toddler was not in the apartment. Police immediately issued an AMBER Alert. However, on Friday, 5-13-05, Justin was found safe in Durango, Mexico- hours after his mother was laid to rest in El Paso. Police are still searching for 22-year-old Ivan Villa, the child's alleged abductor and a person of interest in the murder. Police

are not releasing details of the recovery at this time as they may jeopardize the search for Villa. Police think Villa was believed to be driving a silver or gray 2000 Ford Mustang (with the New Mexico license plate GBN805) that was possibly seen on U.S. 70 near Alamogordo headed southbound. However, on Tuesday evening, 5-10-05, the car was found abandoned. Authorities are now looking for a pearl white Cadillac Escalade that tried to tow away the Mustang on Tuesday morning in Juárez. The Escalade had Texas plates similar to 120-REL, though that plate does not exist according to Texas Department of Public Safety records. Witnesses say four well-dressed men were in the Escalade. The FBI has now joined the search. Investigators said Villa has ties to the Houston area and may be headed back there.

A heavy metal band has joined in the efforts to locate a missing Maryland woman. Tracey Gardner-Tetso was on her way to a Motley Crue concert, but she never made it and hasn't been heard from since. Now, Motley Crue is matching a reward put up by Tracey's employer and Metro Crimestoppers in hopes of generating some information about Tracey's whereabouts. Nikki Sixx of Motley Crue hopes that the band's involvement will bring more attention to this case. Motley Crue will be returning to suburban Washington DC on August 13th and hope that Tracey will be at that show – they will be holding a pair of front row tickets for her. The 33-year-old Rosedale, MD woman was last seen March 6, 2005 before she failed to meet friends at a Motley Crue concert at the MCI center in DC. Tracey never made it to the concert, and when her friends tried to call her cell phone, it was turned off. On Monday, March 7, Tracey's friend, Christian, who she was supposed to go to the concert with, called her office to see if Tracey had shown up for work. Tracey's supervisor and friend, Monika Barilla, told Christian that Tracey wasn't in yet. Christian told Monika that Tracey had never made it to the concert. By Tuesday, March 8, Tracey was still missing and no one had heard from her. Her friends decided to call the police. The only clue police found was a record of Tracey's car passing through the southbound tube of the Baltimore Harbor Tunnel at 7:48 p.m. the night she went missing. Her last outgoing cell phone call was at 3:05 p.m. when she phoned her friend, Christian, who had bought her the Motley Crue tickets for her birthday. According to officials, Tracey's car was later found in the Glen Burnie area at a local Days Inn. The person who drove the car there was not Tracey. So far, police have few leads as to Tracey's whereabouts and are hoping with national attention, someone might come forward with additional information that might lead them to Tracey. Tracey is a Caucasian female. She has blue eyes and long blonde hair at the time of her disappearance.

CAPTURED:

Russell Earl Winstead (Murder, Robbery, Unlawful Flight) -- Eighty-five-year-old Ann Branson was known as a pillar of the Madisonville, Kentucky community. Family and friends became concerned when Ann missed a planned lunch date on January 13, 2003. When they couldn't reach her by phone, they had police go to her home in downtown Madisonville to check on her. Inside, officers found Ann's lifeless body down in her basement. Ann had been brutally stabbed dozens of times and bludgeoned in the head. Police say there was no sign of forced entry and nothing seemed missing in her home. Medical examiners on the scene estimated she had been killed the night before. Madisonville Police carefully catalogued everything in the home, hoping there were clues that could lead to Ann's murderer. Ann Branson was an astute and sharp businesswoman. She owned over 40 rental properties and kept very particular financial records. Every transaction was recorded before and after trips to the bank. When detectives began sifting through Ann's financial records it became obvious that she was lending her nephew, Russell Winstead, an inordinate amount of money. There was no record of Winstead's repayments until two days before Ann's murder, when her ledgers say she received a check for \$12,000. Ann's records showed that she intended to deposit that check on Monday when the banks reopened. Police say that if Ann had lived to deposit that check it would have bounced. Police say Winstead was leading a double life. He was a high-stakes gambler with a million dollar addiction. His gambling habits were traced back to nearby casinos. He was even caught on surveillance cameras at a high-stakes blackjack game the day after he'd written the bad \$12,000 check. He lost \$10,000 that night. A clear motive was developing. Investigators believe Winstead killed Ann and stole the check to cover his tracks and then became a fugitive when the investigation began to focus on him. While on the run Russell Winstead relied on family money. His father, Earl Winstead, was charged with conspiracy and hindering prosecution after authorities discovered that he took money from Ann's estate and sent wire transfers to Russell at locations in Costa Rica. He pleaded guilty in March 2004. Winstead uses the aliases Russ, Craig Conway and Milena Perez. (See Shows #795 and #799, OADs 2/29/05 and 3/19/05) On May 3, 2005, authorities arrested Russell Winstead in San Jose, Costa Rica after he spent nearly two years on the run.

This will confirm that I have screened the air copy of the above-captioned episode and have the following comments:

Phillip "Hollywood" Williams (Homicide, Tampering with Evidence) -- Phillip "Hollywood" Williams is no stranger to handcuffs – he has been arrested 41 times and unfortunately, none of the charges ever stuck. Hollywood's good luck became the deadly misfortune of a woman in New Mexico named Josephine Chacon. Josephine was a single mother of two teenagers who worked at the Sandia Casino in Albuquerque, New Mexico as a cashier. The Sandia Casino was where she first met Phillip Williams, a high roller craps player who frequented the place. Friends say Williams swept Josephine off her feet. For a while, things were going well between the two and they eventually moved in together. In time, Williams' true nature surfaced and Josephine slowly began to realize the man she loved was not who he claimed to be. When Williams stopped coming home at night, Josephine decided to end the relationship. Although Josephine had begun to suspect Williams was a bad seed, police say there's no way she could have known who Williams really was. The real Phillip Williams is a violent, crack-smoking rapist and murderer. The charges on Williams' shocking arrest record range from pandering to rape and murder. In nearly every case, the alleged victims were prostitutes or homeless women who failed to show up to testify against him. On August 5, 2003, at approximately 3:30 a.m., Josephine Chacon was found slumped over the back of a car in a remote parking lot of the Sandia Casino by a co-worker. The woman called 9-1-1 for help, but sadly, Josephine died on her way to the hospital. She had been stabbed at least 18 times in her neck, chest, and arms. Police believe that Phillip Williams is responsible for her death. Not only did they find two bloody fingerprints on driver's side window of Josephine's car, they also located a knife and jacket which had Josephine's blood on them and Williams' finger prints. Detectives believe Williams murdered Josephine three days after he received a letter from her which informed him that she was ending their relationship. He has been charged with murder but has not been seen since the murder. Phillip Williams goes by the nickname "Hollywood" and has used the aliases Phillip Simmons, Glen Rivers and Gregory Simmons. He has a gap between his front teeth, may have a goatee, usually keeps his head clean

shaven, and often wears a hat. He smokes Marlborough cigarettes, crack, and may be attending AA meetings. He loves to play craps at casinos and is known to eat chicken necks every night. He's

trained to drive big rig trucks and has worked as a delivery truck driver. He drives a red Ford Fetsiva with New Mexico Plate 004MXL. Phillip Williams is 46, 5'10" and 190 pounds.

Unknown Idaho Triple Murderer (Three counts of Murder) -- Authorities were called about 6:15 p.m. on Monday, May 16, 2005, by a neighbor who reported "suspicious circumstances" at the house in located southeast of Coeur D'Alene, Idaho. When the police arrived, they found the slain bodies of Brenda Groene, her 13-year-old son Slade Groene, and her fiance Mark McKenzie. The bodies bore obvious signs of injury, but the cause of death remains undetermined. An Amber Alert has been issued for Brenda's two missing children, 8-year-old Shasta Groene and her 9-year-old brother, Dylan Groene. Both children lived at the house with their mother. Police questioned Robert Roy Lutner, Brenda's eldest child, 18-year-old Jesse Groene and her ex-husband Steven Groene, but they have not received any information that might help them solve this crime.

Emanuel Carlos Veiga (Sexual Battery, Sexual Battery On A Child, Lewd Or Lascivious Acts On A Minor, Lewd Molestation) -- A man who was arrested for preying on children at a popular tourist spot near Disneyworld is on the run. Police say 31-year-old Emanuel Veiga, a Brazilian citizen has disappeared and police fear he's victimizing more children. In 2003, there had been dozens of sexual assaults near Disneyworld. Most of the juvenile victims had been ambushed in hotel elevators or stairwells. For months, the predator stalked, attacked, and violated numerous small children. Then the predator attacked a young girl in a YMCA parking lot. The teenager was on her cell phone talking to her father when the predator attacked. The brave teenager fought back by repeatedly hitting the attacker until she managed to free herself. As the young victim ran away from her attacker, she was able to get a good look at his face. Even more importantly, she saw the suspect's vehicle. Her conscientious efforts helped police produce a sketch of the suspect and gave the team of investigators a major lead in their manhunt. Investigators were now looking for a red Ford Explorer. An undercover task force set up surveillance on several hotels for weeks in search of the SUV. When the undercover unit finally found the suspect's vehicle, they had a marked patrol car pull him over. The suspect had to hand over his driver's license. Now, investigators finally knew who he was - Emanuel Carlos Veiga. After being cited for not having a valid vehicle license plate, Veiga drove off with no idea he was being trailed. Meanwhile, armed with the picture from his driver's license, detectives quickly arranged a photo lineup for several victims. The young girl who was attacked in the YMCA knew right away that they had the right person. The positive ID gave police what they needed. Veiga was charged with kidnapping a child, sexual battery, lewd and lascivious molestation, and rape. When police searched Veiga's home, they got a look at what might have been the next step in his devious plan. Papers cops found on his desk indicated Veiga was writing, or pretending to write, a book about child safety called "Protect Your Kids." He also claimed to be producing a safety video called "Don't Go With Strangers." He was planning to seek

celebrity endorsements - including one from John Walsh! After posting \$72,500 bond, Judge Carolyn Freeman decided it would be safe to place Veiga on house arrest with a monitoring device attached to his ankle while he awaited trial. Six weeks after being allowed to go home, Veiga cut

off the monitoring device and walked away. He hasn't been seen since. Emanuel Carlos Veiga is an avid surfer who is most likely living by the water. He spends a lot of time at the gym, likes martial arts (especially Jiu-Jitsu), and may be working as a janitor. Veiga may be traveling with his girlfriend, Janaina Borges and their one-year-old son Lucas. Veiga is 32, 5'9" and 220 pounds.

Carolina to live with her dad. Pamela never made it to the West Coast. When she first went missing, authorities considered her a potential runaway. However, when they learned Pamela didn't have her medication, they knew something serious had happened. Pamela needs to take her medications regularly. Pamela was last seen leaving her home on Glen Canyon Drive. Her

clothing and a backpack was found in February at Fort Bragg. Military and local police conducted an extensive search at Fort Bragg as well as surrounding areas. Nothing in the area was found that could direct authorities to Pamela's location.

CAPTURED:

David Ralph Saracino (Rape of a Child, Dealing in Harmful Material to a Minor) -- David Ralph Saracino has a long sordid past, racked with instances of sexual child abuse. What this suspected pedophile doesn't have is a long jail record- and that's what police say needs to change as soon as possible. Saracino started his sexually deviant behavior when he was a mere eight or nine years old, when he would abuse several neighborhood girls who were between age six and nine. Saracino was persuaded to seek counseling, and no charges were made. It would be 20 years before he started molesting again. Once he did, what followed was a disturbing pattern. Saracino was accused of sexual abuse on two separate occasions. In Los Angeles and then again in San Diego, Saracino denied the charges. He agreed to take lie-detector tests but never showed up for the test. Each time, police were forced to decline to press charges because of insufficient evidence. In 2000, after the series of prior cases involving allegations of child sexual abuse, Saracino ended up in Lehi, Utah, living with his half sister until he could find a place of his own. Saracino met a 10-year old girl who lived nearby, and began sexually assaulting her. He befriended the girl's mother to get closer to the child, and eventually moved in with them in Kearns, Utah. The family went to church regularly together, yet all the while, Saracino continued to rape the girl, forced her to watch pornography, and even acted inappropriately toward the girl's friends when they came to visit. Police say that like most victims of sexual abuse, Saracino's 10-year-old victim was emotionally distraught by the abuse, and her mother began to notice her child acting out. The abuse was clearly taking its toll on her, and in the spring of 2001, the little girl gathered the courage to write a letter describing the abuse that had been taking place right under her mother's nose. When police in Utah looked into Saracino's past, they immediately learned of the pattern of abuse that had been occurring since Saracino was in his 30's. (See Show #798, OAD 3/12/05) An AMW tipster informed authorities that David Saracino was in Orange County, Texas. U.S. Marshals and the Orange County Sheriff's Department arrested Saracino. He was indicted for aggravated rape and sexual battery by Louisiana authorities, and recently, extradited back to Utah to face child rape charges.

Unknown Sgt. Greg Martin Killer (Murder) -- On October 4, 1996 Sgt. Greg Martin worked a 12-hour 7pm to 7am shift in Jonesville, NC. His partner had the day off, leaving Sgt. Martin with the sole responsibility of patrolling Jonesville. In the early morning hours, he left a local restaurant to pick up a stack of newspapers at a grocery store. Police believe he was on his way to the Elkin Police Department to deliver the papers when he pulled over a suspicious vehicle. Sgt. Martin requested assistance on the traffic stop. When Trooper Van Tate reached Sgt. Martin's location, what he saw was shocking. Sgt. Greg Martin lay dead on the side of the interstate with multiple gunshot wounds to his head. Police dissected Martin's last conversations with dispatch and ran the tag of the "suspicious" red Dodge pick-up truck Martin had pulled over. The truck, with West Virginia license plate 4SD-629, was later recovered in the neighboring town of Elkin. Police determined that three days prior, on October 1, the tag was stolen off of a Chevy Blazer from a transmission hop in Princeton, West Virginia. The Dodge truck was stolen from Princeton's Ramsey Motor dealership. Witnesses at the Ramsey Motor dealership say two men requested to see the pick-up truck. After a salesman met with them, one of the two men got into the truck, started it up and checked it out. Police believe that the truck was stolen that night. Investigators would like to talk to the two individuals. They believe they may have information that may lead them to Sgt. Martin's killer. With the help of a witness, a forensic sketch artist drew images of what the men may have looked like. Since the drawings were done in 1996, and most likely dated, AMW is teaming up with investigators and witnesses to create new composites. Police did not receive many leads regarding the two men. Agent Terry says that he's not sure who was driving the truck the night Sgt. Greg Martin was shot to death, but he does know the pick-up truck was definitely used. Police continued to follow the trail of the truck from Princeton, West Virginia to Elkin, North Carolina. Reportedly, the pick-up truck was found abandoned in Elkin behind the

Lucia company plant. Then the trail went cold. Sgt. Greg Martin left behind a wife and three children. Despite the odds, police have not given up in their search for justice.

Walentina Knappek (Felony Theft, Larceny) -- Knappek is wanted in seven states for theft and larceny charges. Knappek poses as a deaf mute and performs a till-tap scheme in which she gestures to the cashier to give her change for a bill. Knappek then starts making noises, grunts and point to the register drawer, and removes handfuls of \$20 and \$50 dollar bills. Knappek appears to put the money back, but the cashier is confused and unable to communicate so Knappek takes advantage of the situation by palming wads of cash. By the time the cashier figures out that she's been had, Knappek is long gone. Knappek has been arrested for till-tapping in Maryland, new Jersey and South Carolina. She fools authorities as to her identity by using one of more than forty aliases, including: Maria Antoska, Maria Antonesko, Lidia Czevsna, Krystena Dolinska, Dorothy Evans, Elki Hoffman, Minnie Howell, Minnie MacHowell, Christina Idcago, Maria Lee, Drobn Kanu, Elizabeth Kemenski, Walentna Kwiek, Christina Kofflske, Ros Korolski, Rose Kovolske, Ros Kowalska, Zosia Kropinska, Valentina Kwick, Walentina Kwick, Cica Lee, Lula Lee, Maria Lipinska, Krystyna Madzian, Virginia Nilson, Kristian Moaziar, Ksali Rli, Patty Geno Roznowska, Marta Starzewska, Glory Tainkow, and Gloria Tycoon. By the time police figure out that Knappek is a career criminal spanning the Northeast, she has already posted bond and disappeared. She has been positively identified as the main suspect in several till-tapping incidents, many caught on surveillance tape, and reportedly committed by a deaf mute woman. Knappek is wanted for theft in Connecticut, Illinois, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania and Wisconsin. Knappek frequently changes her hair color. She has a prominent nose, a scar on her right cheek, and a heavy Eastern European accent. She often wears long skirts and aprons with big pockets. She may have accomplices. Knappek is 53, 5'3" and 150 pounds. (See Shows #553 and #568, OADs 8/14/99 and 10/23/99)

Martin C. Altamirano (Manslaughter) -- On July 1, 2000 Altamirano was intoxicated and unlicensed when he crashed into a vehicle driven by 38-year-old Goretta Doyle, killing her and injuring her 8-year-old daughter. Altamirano was fleeing the scene of a minor car accident when he ran a red light a crashed into Doyle's car. Altamirano was taken to a nearby hospital where he was arrested and charged with him with driving while intoxicated. He was also issued a summons for driving without a license and driving an uninsured car. After Altamirano posted bail he fled and has not been seen since. Altamirano, who has used the name "Colorado", has a scar on his left cheek. He speaks Spanish and English, and works as a day laborer for construction companies. Altamirano is 26, 5'6" and 160 pounds. (See Shows #691 and #737, OADs 9/14/02 and 9/27/03)

James T. Moran (Murder) -- Police in Kennewick, Washington are on a hunt for James Moran. Moran allegedly went to the home of his in-laws, Glenn and Debbie Carr and shot the two of them. He then left with his daughter, 7 year old Jaime. Neighbors say they saw him and the girl drive away. Moran's other children were staying elsewhere, but were picked up by their father. Police say he took all four of them on the run with him. An AMBER Alert was immediately issued for the Moran children, and a description of Moran, and the car in which they fled was circulated. The next morning, police in Moses Lake, Washington got a call from Moran's mother, saying the children were safely in her custody. Police say Moran had been driving back from Arkansas with his wife Mandy. At some point, Moran allegedly attacked his wife and abandoned her. He then returned to the Northwest to get his kids. Mandy is now in protective custody, fearing for her life.

Neighbors of Moran in Kennewick reported seeing a car that may have belonged to Moran near his house. Police immediately swarmed the area, evacuated the neighbors and surrounded Moran's house. A SWAT team entered the house, but found no one inside. Police now do not know whether Moran was ever in the house. Moran has a tattoo of the letters "MJM" on his left wrist and has scars on his abdomen and right hand. He uses thyroid and diabetes medication and may try to obtain a prescription for the medication. Police believe Moran may still be in the Tri-City area of Kennewick, Paco or Richland and may possibly be driving a Pontiac Grand Am with Wyoming plates. Moran is considered armed and dangerous. Moran is 33, 5'8" and 220 pounds. (See Show #773, OAD 7/24/04)

John Patrick Addis (Murder, Kidnapping) -- Addis is wanted for the 1995 kidnapping and murder of his girlfriend in the Nevada desert. On August 19, 1995, police say Joann Albanese disappeared from her residence in Las Vegas along with her boyfriend, John Edwards. Police later determined that Edwards was in fact, John Patrick Addis, a former Alaskan state police homicide investigator. Police say Addis was working as a personal trainer in Las Vegas, when he became involved in a romantic relationship with Joann. On the day she disappeared, Joann, a single mother of two, was scheduled to have dinner with Addis to inform him that the relationship was over. Joann's car was discovered several days later, abandoned in Little Hell's Canyon near Prescott, Arizona. Police say Addis strangled Joann in a fit of rage and hid her body. Police say Addis has a history of traveling around the country finding work in fitness clubs, so he can meet women, romance them, and live off their money. On July 31, 1998, three years after Joann disappeared, a grand jury in Clark County, Nevada charged Addis with her murder and kidnapping. On October 9, 1998, hunters discovered Joann's body. Police determined she had been murdered. Addis, who has used the aliases John H. Edwards and John Elliott, is an avid body-builder who works in gyms as a personal trainer. He is a small plane pilot, outdoorsman and marksman, and is skilled in forensics and criminal investigation. He believes in UFO's and the god RAH, and often claims he's a science fiction writer who writes screenplays on UFO's. His ex-wives say he has a history of domestic violence and fraud, and he has served time in jail for custodial interference. He is adept at manufacturing false identification and Social Security cards. Addis is 54, 6'0"-6'1" and 200 pounds. (See Shows #519, #555, #571, #641, #687, #709, #722, #750, #776 and #788, OADs 11/21/98, 8/28/99, 1/8/00, 7/21/01, 8/17/02, 3/8/03, 6/7/03, 1/24/04, 8/21/04 and 12/11/04)

Shasta is 3-foot-10 and 40 pounds. She has long auburn hair and hazel eyes. Dylan is 4 feet and 60 pounds. He has a blond crew cut and blue eyes.

Phillip "Hollywood" Williams (Homicide, Tampering with Evidence) -- Phillip "Hollywood" Williams is no stranger to handcuffs – he has been arrested 41 times and unfortunately, none of the charges ever stuck. Hollywood's good luck became the deadly misfortune of a woman in New Mexico named Josephine Chacon. Josephine was a single mother of two teenagers who worked at the Sandia Casino in Albuquerque, New Mexico as a cashier. The Sandia Casino was where she first met Phillip Williams, a high roller craps player who frequented the place. Friends say Williams swept Josephine off her feet. For a while, things were going well between the two and they eventually moved in together. In time, Williams' true nature surfaced and Josephine slowly began to realize the man she loved was not who he claimed to be. When Williams stopped coming home at night, Josephine decided to end the relationship. Although Josephine had begun to suspect Williams was a bad seed, police say there's no way she could have known who Williams really was. The real Phillip Williams is a violent, crack-smoking rapist and murderer. The charges on Williams' shocking arrest record range from pandering to rape and murder. In nearly every case, the alleged victims were prostitutes or homeless women who failed to show up to testify against him. On August 5, 2003, at approximately 3:30 a.m., Josephine Chacon was found slumped over the back of a car in a remote parking lot of the Sandia Casino by a co-worker. The woman called 9-1-1 for help, but sadly, Josephine died on her way to the hospital. She had been stabbed at least 18 times in her neck, chest, and arms. Police believe that Phillip Williams is responsible for her death. Not only did they find two bloody fingerprints on driver's side window of Josephine's car, they also located a knife and jacket which had Josephine's

blood on them and Williams' finger prints. Detectives believe Williams murdered Josephine three days after he received a letter from her which informed him that she was ending their relationship. He has been charged with murder but has not been seen since the murder. Phillip Williams goes by the nickname "Hollywood" and has used the aliases Phillip Simmons, Glen Rivers and Gregory Simmons. He has a gap between his front teeth, may have a goatee, usually keeps his head clean shaven, and often wears a hat. He smokes Marlborough cigarettes, crack, and may be attending AA meetings. He loves to play craps at casinos and is known to eat chicken necks every night. He's trained to drive big rig trucks and has worked as a delivery truck driver. He drives a red Ford Fetsiva with New Mexico Plate 004MXL. Phillip Williams is 46, 5'10" and 190 pounds. (See Show #805, OAD 5/21/05) Soon after America's Most Wanted aired Williams' story, two Philadelphia police officers who'd watched the broadcast spotted Williams on a street corner near a city homeless shelter on Sunday afternoon. Williams' fingerprints proved a match. Now, there is new hope that Josephine's two children will have justice in their mother's murder.

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Unknown Casey Jo Pipestem Killer (Murder) -- On January 31, 2004, Grapevine Police Detective Larry Hallmark was summoned to a Texas highway overpass. A father and daughter walking along a creek stumbled upon a shocking sight - the dead naked body of a young woman. The woman had no identification and very little was left at the scene. Since the body was at the bottom of the highway overpass, Hallmark suspected the body had been dumped post mortem from a vehicle. If his suspicions were correct, it meant the real crime scene was somewhere else. Detective Hallmark knew identifying the victim, let alone the killer, was going to be an uphill struggle. Hallmark wasn't at a complete loss. The victim had a series of distinctive tattoos which was key to unlocking Jane Doe's identity. One tattoo read "Bonez" on her left arm. On the inside of the victim's left arm, Hallmark found a large tattoo that read "Seminole." Hallmark figured his victim was Native American. After researching the Seminole Nation, Detective Hallmark learned that just north of Grapevine, in Oklahoma, lay a Seminole community. He figured this was a good place to start his investigation. Someone in the community recognized those tattoos. Less than a week later, Detective Hallmark's victim now had a name and a story. She was 19-year-old Casey Jo Pipestem. Growing up, Casey Jo Pipestem was a thin, spindly girl, earning her the nickname Bonez. As she grew up, her happy childhood gave way to teenage years full of disappointment and heartbreak. She was close to two members of her family, her grandmother, and her stepfather. When both of them died, Casey's life was thrown into turmoil. Bouncing back and forth between Oklahoma City and the small Seminole community, Casey never seemed to fit in anywhere. Facing disappointment at every turn, Casey ended up on the street, trying to be self-sufficient and trying to belong. When she finally found an occupation that she thought filled both roles, the career change cost her life. Police say Casey began working truck stops as a prostitute, using the CB handle "Sugar." Detective Hallmark concluded Casey got into someone's truck, and that was probably the person who killed her. Detective Hallmark dug into the world of truck-stop prostitution, he learned Casey's case had shocking similarities with other murders of other prostitutes. The Unknown

Casey Jo Pipestem Killer is possibly a male truck driver who does business in or around Dallas-Forth Worth International Airport. His truck may have a separate right-side door leading directly to the sleeper compartment.

John Dallas Lockhart (Child Rape) -- According to police, John Lockhart raped a four-month-old infant and took pictures of the horrific crime. Police had been taking part in an ongoing fraud investigation aimed at John Lockhart's law practice, when they discovered the grossly appalling photos on his computer. Police say that the files were retrieved when a computer software maintenance company was attempting to recover business and financial files from Lockhart's work computer. According to investigators, they found a lot more. Company employees say they discovered more than 100 pornographic photos on his hard drive, including pictures of child and infant rape. The software company immediately contacted the Akron Police Department. Once Lockhart got wind of the fact that police had his computer, he took off. The accused pedophile is a father of two. Family and friends say they had no idea Lockhart lead a double-life as a child predator. Police and close associates fear Lockhart will settle in a new community, where he could deceive potential victims and their families. The US Marshals Service has named this accused pedophile to their Top 15 list. Lockhart has a scar on his back and scarring on his front left calf. He was a real estate attorney who is described as outgoing and internet-savvy. Police say that he is a bisexual "swinger" who likes to meet people on-line or at clubs. He enjoys multiple sex partners and likes to be called "My Lord" during bondage and S&M. Lockhart likes to drink single-malt Scotch, prefers Oban Glenlivet on the rocks and can't stand olives. He has been diagnosed with Crohn's disease (an intestinal disorder) but does not take medicine for it. Lockhart is 36, 6'10" and 185 pounds.

ALL POINTS BULLETIN

Artur Martirosyan (Murder) -- Artur Martirosyan is wanted in connection with the murder of two men in Aurara, Colorado. On September 7, 1998, Martirosyan drove Michael Martinez and Alex Pogosyan and an unnamed friend to the home of Edgardo Morales. Martinez was seeking revenge on the people he believed "snitched on him." Edgardo Morales and Zach Olbert were sleeping in the basement of the house when Pogosyan and Martinez entered carrying 12 gauge shotguns. Pogosyan and Martinez open fired killing Obert and Morales. After the killings the Martinez and Pogosyan split from the group, went to the home of Penny Bowman-Medla and shot her to death along with her 16-year-old son, Greg Medla and his 16-year-old girlfriend Marissa Avalos. Later that day, police responded to tips that unexpectedly led them to the discovery of the body of Michael Martinez - who had been shot to death. Martirosyan and Pogosyan were later arrested but due to lack of evidence, they were forced to release Martirosyan. Pogosyan was convicted for his involvement in the crime and now police have the evidence they need to arrest Artur Martirosyan. Martirosyan enjoys getting tattoos which include the word "Armenia" on his right elbow; "Armenian Pride" on his front right bicep; "A4I" on his back right bicep; "A.M." and a series of Armenian letters or numerals; and a panther on his left arm. Martirosyan is 25, 5'5" and 125 pounds. (See Show #773, OAD 7/24/04)

Anibal Mustelier (Extortion, Bank Larceny) – In 1989, Mustelier was hired to kill Frank Condom, a Miami businessman. On December 22, 1989, Mustelier and another thug, Nelson Cruz, followed Frank in their car as Frank left a nightclub. As Frank drove home, Mustelier emptied a 30-round clip from his machine gun into Frank's car, then sped away. Frank somehow managed to escape the attack with only a gunshot wound to his arm. Mustelier and his crew weren't done. Mustelier and several other men planned to use a bomb to blow Frank up. On August 17, 1990, Cruz and two other men went to Frank's mother's house and put a bomb under Frank's car. When Frank and his family got into the car, the bombers detonated the device. Once again the attack failed. Frank and several members of his family suffered serious injuries but fortunately none died from the blast. Eventually, most of the group was arrested but Mustelier managed to slip away. Mustelier resurfaced in 1996 when he pulled off one of the largest bank heists in south Florida. Mustelier put together a crew of criminals and was able to get safety deposit box keys made for the Sun Trust Bank. On November 18, 1996, two men went into the bank and got away with approximately 8,000 pieces of jewelry valued at between \$5 million and \$7 million from three different safety deposit boxes. The men gave the money to Mustelier, who disappeared. Authorities believe Mustelier fled to Venezuela shortly after the robbery, but may currently be back in Florida. Mustelier has used numerous aliases including Emilio Suarez, Barrero Musteler, Anibal Musieler, Ramon Llercna, and Anivan Mutelier. He has a small scar on his neck, wears contact lenses or glasses, and is known to keep in shape and work out at gyms. He may be taking ballroom dance lessons or hanging out in dance clubs. There are rumors that he has ties to Castro as a hitman. Mustelier is 54, 5'4" and 135 pounds. (See Shows #664, #681, #721 and #756, OADs 2/9/02, 6/22/02, 5/31/03 and 3/13/04)

Malaika Tamu Griffin (Murder) -- Malaika Tamu Griffin is wanted for the murder of 25-year-old Jason Horsely. In the winter/spring of 1999, Griffin was renting a room in a house next door to Jason and his girlfriend, Deborah Loiselle. On April 20, 1999, Deborah had her first encounter with Griffin as the two women were standing in their front yards separated by a fence. Deborah says Griffin, whom she'd never seen nor met before that day, immediately threatened to kill her dogs and began cursing and hurling racial slurs. Jason and Deborah are Caucasian; Griffin is African-American. Over the next 28 days, Griffin had several other run-ins with Jason and Deborah that they say she initiated over parking on the public street and Jason unloading his tools on the public sidewalk in front of her house. None of the arguments made any sense to Jason and Deborah because they insist they never trespassed on her property and the parking spaces should have never been a matter of dispute because Griffin didn't even own a car. Hers had been repossessed. On the evening of May 18, 1999, Jason was organizing his carpentry tools on the sidewalk in front of Griffin's house when she came outside and began screaming at him. Deborah heard the commotion and came out of her house to stick up for Jason. After a brief but intense argument, both women stormed back into their respective homes and Jason continued organizing his tools. Griffin came back outside minutes later armed with a laser-sighted 9mm pistol and shot Jason in the back at point-blank range. He never saw her coming. The bullet pierced Jason's heart and killed him almost instantly. Then, Griffin ran to the home of an acquaintance, Monique Thomas, and carjacked her at gunpoint. Griffin abandoned the car in Iowa and hopped a bus to Chicago where her trail went cold. When police searched Griffin's room in Denver, they were shocked to find a stockpile of ammunition, diffused hand grenades, a 9mm assault rifle and books

commonly associated with terrorists, The Anarchists' Cookbook and The Poor Man's James Bond. They also found spiral notebooks full of Griffin's secret writings about a coming race war and the killing of white people. None of her colleagues or close friends ever heard her express the types of racist rhetoric she wrote about in her notebooks. Griffin is a world-traveled lady with a Magna Cum Laude degree in chemistry. She has worked in laboratories and a pharmacy in the past. Griffin is an avid outdoorswoman and survivalist who buys top of the line camping gear and firearms. She has bad credit and declared bankruptcy in 1999. She doesn't smoke, but may drink occasionally. She prefers going to museums to clubs or other nightlife. She usually carries a backpack wherever she goes. Griffin is 34, 5'4" and 145 pounds. (See Shows #575, #599, #646, #726, #759 and #765, OADs 2/5/00, 8/12/00, 8/25/01, 7/12/03, 4/10/04 and 5/22/04)

Daniel Andreas San Diego (Maliciously Damaging and Destroying By Means of Explosives) - Daniel Andreas San Diego is wanted by the FBI for two bombings in the San Francisco Bay Area of California. On August 28, 2003, San Diego placed two pipe bombs outside the Chiron Corporation in Emeryville, California. Both bombs exploded, causing damage to the lab, but no one was injured. Then, on September 26, 2003, San Diego placed another bomb outside the Shaklee Corporation in Pleasanton. The bomb went off around 3:22 a.m. Once again, the bomb caused some damage to the building, but no one was injured in the explosion. Through an investigation, they were able to link San Diego to both bombings. They began tracking San Diego hoping that he would lead them to where the bombs were made, or to other people involved. Agents believe that San Diego must have been on to them because on October 6, 2003, he parked his car in downtown San Francisco and walked away and had not been seen since. The FBI says that San Diego planted the bombs because the two corporations have had ties with labs that use animals for the testing of medications and other products. After both bombings, an animal rights group called the "Revolutionary Cells-Liberation Brigade" posted an e-mail taking responsibility for the bombing. The group also threatened that if Chiron and Shaklee didn't sever their ties with animal testing labs, the bombs would increase in size and the employees' homes and families would be targets. Agents cannot directly connect San Diego to the emails, but they do know that he has ties to the group who sent them. San Diego goes by the name Andreas as is believed to be armed. He has a round tattoo of a forest fire in color in the middle of his chest, a tattoo of buildings on fire on his lower back and a tattoo of a lone tree on his lower spine. He is smart, clean cut, strict vegan who is known to wear glasses. San Diego is 27, 6'0" and 160 pounds. (See Shows #745 and #755, OADs 12/20/03 and 3/06/04)

Police believe that Brooke was abducted on May 24, 2004, while cleaning outdoor lamp posts outside the Oak Park Apartments. She was visiting her sister and brother-in-law in Corvallis, who are residential managers of the complex. When police arrived, they found signs of a

possible struggle leading them to believe she may have been kidnapped. Her sandals were found askew near a bucket of water. Her purse, keys, and other personal items were left in her sister's apartment and her car was still in the parking lot. Compelling evidence leads police to believe that she did not leave willingly. Brooke Wilberger just completed her freshman year at Brigham Young University. She is enrolled for next fall term to continue her studies in speech pathology. She is a graduate of Elmira High School near Eugene, Oregon. Brooke is a devout Mormon, an honor student, an athlete and described as very responsible, reliable and likeable by her friends and family. She was last seen wearing a Indigo hooded sweatshirt, a gray Brigham Young T-shirt, dark blue jeans, small hoop earrings, possibly a silver watch, a ring with "CTR" engraved on it and no shoes. Brooke has a scar on her right forearm that extends from her wrist to her elbow. She also has a piercing on the top of her right ear. Local authorities have identified Sung Koo Kim as a possible suspect. Kim has been arrested for burglarizing a dorm room at Oregon State, near where Brooke disappeared. Evidence found on Kim's person ties him to the building where Brooke was staying. Kim, however, has not been charged in connection with Brooke's disappearance. (See Show #770, OAD 6/26/04)

Natalee Holloway

Age: 18

Height: 5'3"

Weight: 103 pounds

Natalee Ann Holloway is a graduating senior from Mountain Brook High School in Birmingham, AL. On an unofficial annual senior trip Natalee and approximately 130 of her classmates ventured thousands of miles away to enjoy the white sands and blue waters of Aruba. For five days the recent graduates and seven chaperones relaxed, sun bathed and enjoyed the Aruba nightlife. Dressed in the same blue and green striped low-cut blouse and jean miniskirt that she wore at the beach earlier in the day, Holloway spent Sunday evening partying at Carlos 'N Charlie's, a popular restaurant and dance spot where tourists and locals meet in the capital, Oranjestad. Monday morning, May 5, 2005 when the rest of the group gathered to catch their flight, Natalee was no where to be found. Carlos N' Charlie's master of ceremonies, Jose Hernandez, saw Natalee leave about 10 minutes before the restaurant's 1 a.m. closing. He reports that nothing seemed out of the ordinary. Meanwhile, some of Natalee's friends say they saw her getting into a vehicle outside the nightclub. According to Natalee's stepmother, Robin Holloway, friends say Natalee was last seen with a local resident who claimed to be a foreign exchange student. Police questioned and released three Aruban students who said they dropped Holloway off early Monday at the Holiday Inn where she had been staying, about three miles from Oranjestad. However, police have been unable to verify whether Natalee actually made it back to the Holiday Inn at all. Police found Natalee's passport inside her hotel room, narrowing the possibility she left the island.

CAPTURED:

Juan Roberto Nieto (Attempted Intentional Homicide, Kidnapping, Sexual Assault) -- Police in Wisconsin are on the hunt for Juan Roberto Nieto. On August 19, 2003, Nieto and his friend, Gregorio Morales, snatched a Green Bay woman from the parking lot of a local nightclub. She put up a fierce fight but was overpowered by the men. According to investigators, the two men drove the woman to a rural area in Rockland, Wisconsin. There, the men took turns raping her in a grassy ditch. Once they were finished, Nieto strangled her until he believed she was dead, then doused her with lighter fluid and set her on fire. However, the woman was only pretending to be dead. According to the woman, though her body was on fire and she was in excruciating pain, she somehow managed to wait until the men had sped off in their truck before attempting to put out the flames. She rolled on the ground, managed to put out the fire, and used her last ounce of strength to crawl to a nearby house for help. At first, all investigators had to work from were two sketches based on the survivor's description of her attackers. That all changed when Wisconsin dairy farmer Dick Binish saw the sketches in the paper and immediately called police. He recognized the two suspects as two men who worked on his farm: 27-year-old Gregorio Morales and 23-year-old Juan Roberto Nieto. Playing an amateur detective, Binish offered Morales a soda. After Morales had taken a sip, Binish saved the bottle and gave it to the authorities to obtain a DNA sample. The sample from the bottle came back a match from DNA left by the rapists. But Morales had fled by the time the results came back. Morales was captured in New Mexico. Nieto is still on the run, but police say he had been in New Mexico. In fact, police want to question Nieto about the rape and murder of 26-year-old Katie Sepich, a New Mexico State University graduate student. Katie was last seen alive on August 31, 2003 at a party in Las Cruces, New Mexico. In a crime very similar to the Green Bay abduction and rape, police say she was kidnapped and taken to an abandoned dumpsite in the desert. She was strangled, and her body was set on fire. Unfortunately, Katie did not survive. Nieto has a scar on his face and scars from acne. He has large ears that stick out, bad teeth and is described as having a rough, beat up appearance. Nieto may be traveling with his brother, Mario, who is taller. He is described as polite. The two may be in Georgia or New Mexico. Juan Roberto Nieto is 20, 5'8" and 165 pounds. (See Show #785, OAD 11/13/04) On Monday December 6, 2004, Juan Nieto was apprehended in Georgia.

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Elby J. Hars (Criminal Sexual Conduct with a Minor: 7 counts) -- Elby Hars is a convicted sexual predator with a record stretching back to the 80's. In 1986 Hars was convicted of molesting his daughter Terri Hars. When Elby was released from jail, Terri became an accomplice by going out and finding young girls for her father to abuse. Hars is now wanted in South Carolina for the rape of a 13-year-old girl. He faces seven counts of criminal sexual conduct with a minor. Elby has worked as a truck driver. He has hazel eyes and gray & white hair. Police say he is balding and may have shaved his head. Elby Hars is 61, 5'8" and 245 pounds.

Domingo Valdez (1st Degree Murder) -- Authorities in Arizona are trying to track down an accused killer. According to officials, Domingo Valdez got into an argument with 27-year-old Omar Cardenas in July 2004 and shot him to death. Valdez stuffed Omar's body in a car and left it along Highway 260 in Cottonwood, AZ. Two days after the murder, an officer on duty noticed a parked car alongside the highway. When he approached the car, he found Cardenas' body inside and called for backup. After tracing calls on Omar's cell phone and following leads, detectives went to Domingo Valdez's house to question him about his relationship with Omar. There, the officers found dried blood on the cement just outside the front door. The crime lab determined the blood taken from the home was from Omar and authorities issued a warrant for Domingo's arrest. Authorities believe Valdez may have fled the area in his black 1994 Ford Ranger pickup shortly after the homicide. He has ties to Mexico, California and Arizona, but police have not been able to track him down. Domingo Valdez also goes by the alias Domingo Valdez Anguiano. He has brown hair, brown eyes and may have a mustache and a goatee. Valdez is 41, 5'10" and 190 pounds.

Rogelio Deaquino (UFAP) -- A young mentally handicapped woman wanted independence and a new life. After receiving her parents blessing, the young woman moved to a

controlled environment where she had her own apartment close to several peers. She was able to find employment and rode the bus to her job at a local grocery store. Things were going well and the

young woman was establishing her life on her own. However, her new life of independence was tragically shattered by her neighbor Rogelio Deaquino. Deaquino lured the 25-year-old woman to his apartment, saying they were going to watch cartoons. There, Rogelio Deaquino brutally raped and sodomized the 25-year-old woman. Deaquino was arrested and charged, but fled in the middle of his trial. He was convicted in absentia and sentenced by a jury to 100 months but police have been unable to locate him. Deaquino has brown hair, brown eyes and may have a mustache and a goatee. Rogelio Deaquino is 44, 5'6" and 160 pounds.

Douglas Holler (Aggravated Vehicular Homicide) -- On May 22, 2004, Douglas Holler allegedly ignored a stop sign and killed a motorist named David Neff. Police say Neff, a proud father and husband, was headed westbound on a road in Fort Recovery, Ohio when Holler struck his vehicle. Rescue units managed to free Holler from his vehicle but their heroic efforts were not enough to save Neff. He was pronounced dead at the scene. Holler checked into a hospital for treatment after the collision. Police say they didn't file charges immediately because they were waiting for results from a blood alcohol test - they suspected Holler had been drinking. Holler didn't wait around for the test results. He took off and a warrant was issued for aggravated vehicular homicide. Holler frequents campgrounds and lakes and may be traveling with a woman named Marcia Franz. Holler is 46, 6'1" and 185-220 pounds.

Unknown Lake Pontchartrain Jane Doe Killer -- In 1986, two fishermen on Lake Pontchartrain, Louisiana alerted authorities after they discovered the body of a naked woman floating in the water. The woman was naked except for a white plastic bag over her head, which had been attached by duct tape around her neck. She also had a red 22 lb. weight attached to a string around her neck. The initial autopsy estimated that the woman had only been in the water for a couple of days and revealed that the cause of death was asphyxia. She was determined to be Caucasian, with reddish-brown hair. She was 20-30 years-old, 5'2"-5'5", and about 120 lbs. She had perfect teeth, expensive silicone breast implants and was about 8-12 weeks pregnant. The pathology report also showed that she had markings on her left ring finger consistent with wearing a ring. After an extensive investigation, the police were unable to identify the woman and the case went cold. She was labeled "Jane Doe," was buried at a public cemetery in Slidell, Louisiana. A plain white cross was assigned to an unmarked grave in a portion of the cemetery called Potter's Field. Seventeen years later, police in Ohio who were searching for a missing woman discovered information about the Lake Pontchartrain Jane Doe and attempted to link the two cases. They exhumed Jane Doe's body and ran a DNA test for a possible match. Unfortunately, police soon learned that she wasn't the missing woman from Ohio. After examining the body, Jane Doe's nose appeared to be in excellent condition, even though the rest of her face was fairly decomposed. Police say it's possible that Jane Doe may have had some sort of plastic surgery on her nose. Now, new technology has provided police with more information, including a "photograph" of the woman, created by famous forensic anthropologist, Mary Manhein of the LSU "Face Lab." A bust was created by the lab in hopes of identifying the Lake Pontchartrain Jane Doe. (See Show #794, OAD 2/05/05)

Andre Neverson (Wanted for Questioning for Murder) -- On Monday, July 8, 2002, NYPD cops arrived at the Brooklyn home of 39-year-old Patricia Neverson. She was found, shot to death. Three days later, on July 11, cops found the body of 34-year-old Donna Davis. Authorities have learned that Andre Neverson had an ongoing argument with his sister, Patricia, stemming from Andre's money which she used to buy her home. Neverson did not want the money repaid; instead, he wanted the house. Donna Davis had been dating Andre, but she had recently broken off the relationship. Neverson did not take the rejection well. The last time Donna was seen alive, she was in Andre's minivan outside a Queens, New York college where she studied. Days after the second murder, cops placed Neverson in Brooklyn, but after that, the trail runs cold. Neverson has used numerous aliases including Troy Michael Anderson, Troy Michael Henderson, Trey Michael Henderson, Andre Humphrey and Andre Henderson. He has a very muscular build and a shaved head, but he may be starting to grow hair again to change his appearance. He does not drink or smoke, is very intelligent and computer literate. At times he is very calm and serene, but he has a violent temper and has served time for attempted murder. He does not drink or smoke, and may be hidden now by one of his many girlfriends. He is originally from Trinidad, but does not have an accent. He has worked as a bouncer in Caribbean clubs and as a security guard at a hospital. He has been know to buy cars, fix them up, then resell them. He has a "L" shaped scar in the middle of his forehead and is now known to wear dreadlocks. He may still be armed. Neverson is 41, 6'2" and 225 pounds. (See Shows #684, #697, #723, #743, #755, #769, #792 and #797, OADs 7/27/02, 11/16/02, 6/14/03, 12/06/03, 3/06/04, 6/19/04, 1/22/05 and 3/05/05)

Mark Everett (Murder) -- Little Manuel Benitez was just nine years old when he began his transformation into Mark Everett - a child star. As a kid, Everett starred in commercials, television shows, and even motion pictures like "Pee Wee's Big Adventure," and "Stand and Deliver." However, like so many young, successful actors, Everett eventually turned to drugs and his acting career dried out, according to police. In 1996, Everett was 26 years old and trying to put his acting career behind him, when he met Stephanie Spears. Eventually, the two moved in together and Stephanie gave birth to their son, Benjamin. Though Everett and Stephanie were close, there were secrets lurking beneath the surface. Curiously, Everett kept his child star status a secret from Stephanie and her family. But his past wasn't the only thing Everett had to hide. Police say Everett was a drug dealer who showed no signs of stopping. While Stephanie was excelling in college and winning scholarships, Everett was becoming more and more involved in dealing dope. The two were clearly headed in different directions. When Stephanie decided she couldn't take it any longer, Everett made a decision of his own. Police say Stephanie ended things with Everett on Father's Day 2004. Based on crime scene evidence, police were able to put together this scenario. They say that night, Everett waited until Stephanie was asleep and then grabbed Benjamin. Stephanie woke up and confronted Everett. An enraged Everett picked up a dumbbell and began beating Stephanie to death with it. Once she was dead, the former child star took off with his own innocent child. Neither has been seen since. Everett uses the aliases Mike Evers, Manuel Benitez and Manuel Velasco. He speaks German, French, Spanish, and Cantonese. He fancies chocolate cupcakes and plain hamburgers. He may be traveling with his mother Elizabeth Velasco. Everett is

Lisa Marie Sexton

Age Now: 39 (was 14 at the time of her disappearance) Height: 5'8"

In May of 1981, Lisa Marie Sexton left home with an adult male. Over the years, she contacted her mother to check in, but since 1984, she hasn't made any contact. The man she left with eventually returned to Ohio, but without Lisa. In July of 2003, the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office received an NCIC alert about a possible match between the Lake Ponchartrain Jane Doe and a missing girl from Elyria, Ohio named Lisa Marie Sexton. Detectives in Louisiana requested Lisa's dental records and exhumed the body of the Lake Ponchartrain Jane Doe. After careful examination, it was determined that the Lake Ponchartrain Jane Doe was not Lisa Sexton. (See Show #794, OAD 2/05/05)

Ana Luisa Acevedo

Age: 13

Thirteen-year-old Ana Acevedo lived with her father Laurencio Acevedo in the quiet neighborhood of Castle Hayne, North Carolina. Ana, a straight "A" student, was excited about returning to school after the winter break so she went to bed early on the night of January 2, 2005. Unfortunately, Ana did not show up for class on the following Monday. Police believe she was abducted Sunday night. When Ana's father returned home from work at 6am Monday morning, Ana was nowhere to be found. Acevedo immediately called police to report Ana missing. Soon after Ana disappeared, Mr. Acevedo and the police became suspicious of Victor Velasco Hernandez. Victor is a 24-year-old neighbor of the Acevedos'. Ana's father claims that Victor used to stare at Ana. When he disappeared around the same time as Ana, authorities began to question his involvement. Police believe Victor may have taken Ana to Mexico or to a Hispanic populated area in Florida, where he has relatives. New Hanover County Sheriff's Department received a warrant for Victor's arrest for a first degree rape charge not related to Ana. Police are concerned for her safety. Ana is a 13-year-old Hispanic girl with brown hair and brown eyes. She stands at 5'4" and weighs 130 lbs. She was last seen in Castle Hayne, North Carolina at her home. Ana and Hernandez may be traveling in a green pick-up truck.

Benjamin Everett

Age: 2

Height: 4'0"

Weight: 40 pounds

On the afternoon of June 21, 2004, police responded to an anonymous call and discovered the body of Stephanie Spears in her apartment. Her son was missing. Police believe Mark Everett, Stephanie Spears live in boyfriend and father of Benjamin, brutally murdered Stephanie and took off with their son. Police have been unable to locate Mark Everett or Benjamin. (See Shows #782, #789 and #796, OADs 10/02/04, 12/18/04 and 2/26/05)

CAPTURED:

James "Rick" Johnson (Robbery) -- Johnson was the mastermind behind an attempted robbery at Lamco Jewelers in Alameda, California in April 1997. The attempt failed but the owners, Richard and Wanda Cook, were almost beaten to death in the process. Johnson needed his way into the back rooms of a pool hall in San Francisco, making friends with pool hustler and jeweler Richard Cook. When Johnson found out that Cook kept a safe in his store which allegedly had millions of dollars in cash and jewels. Johnson plotted to rob Cook of his money. Johnson recruited a team of six men. Each man had a specific role in the job. Two men scouted out the store. Posing as customers, they visited the store several times checking out security and the Cooks' routine. Two other men were recruited to subdue the Cooks and secure the location. Another man was lookout and the sixth man was recruited to create an accident with the Cooks' only employee so he would not get to work to interrupt the robbery. Planning for the robbery took over a year. Johnson knew Cook would never give up the safe combination, so he created a scheme to take the entire safe. The team of men retrofitted a U-Haul truck with a heavy-duty winch and enough iron to handle the move. When the time was right, the team went into action, equipped with walkie talkies and a police scanner. Each member of the team meticulously did their part. Halfway through the plan something went wrong. The police scanner said there was a disturbance at the location and they were dispatching a car. The team thought they had been had and called off the heist. But they were wrong: the call was for a dispute next door. The team fled and all but Johnson was captured. (See Shows #663, #715, #749 and #777, OADs 2/2/02, 4/19/03, 1/17/04 and 8/28/04) James "Rick" Johnson was taken into custody on December 06, 2004, after leading cops and citizens alike on a wild foot chase in Seattle.

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Unknown Gretchen Perham Killer (Homicide)

Unknown Albany School Girl Attacker (Attempted Murder) -- Fourteen-year-old Gretchen Perham lived only six blocks from school. It is so close that she walked to Hackett Middle School in Albany, New York everyday. On May 13, 2005, Gretchen left her home around 8:30 a.m. for school. She was never seen alive again. Gretchen's body was later found dumped on an embankment across town – she was stabbed 18 times. Police immediately began investigating the brutal murder, but couldn't come up with any solid leads. Then another girl was attacked with a butcher knife along the same route to school. There were many similarities between the two attacks. Both girls were attacked with a knife, both were 14-year-old students at Hackett Middle School, and both were in route to school when they were attacked. However, there was one big difference - this girl was lucky enough to survive the attack. When she screamed for help, it saved her life. Two men who worked at a nearby hospital just happened to be on a coffee break outside the building, when they heard her cry for help. Curtis Frazier and Perry Smith ran toward the girl and chased the attacker away. Albany Police believe these two attacks are probably linked. The second victim gave police enough information for them to create a composite sketch of the suspect. He's described as an African-American man in his 20's, around 6' tall with a medium build. He wore blue jeans and a white "do-rag" on his head.

ALL POINTS BULLETIN:

Stanley Obas (Criminal Homicide, Aggravated Assault, Kidnapping) -- In March 1996, 13-year-old Richezza Williams ran away from her home in Long Island, New York. Five months later, her badly decomposed body was found in a cemetery in Easton, Pennsylvania. On July 28, 1996, about two weeks prior to the discovery of the body, three young men tortured and murdered Richezza in the basement of a house three blocks from the cemetery. After the murder, the men

placed Richezza's body in a box, carried it to the cemetery and hid the body in a storage vault. Two of the men involved in the murder have been arrested and convicted, but the third man, Stanley Obas, is still on the loose. Obas, who has used the aliases Neil Stevenson and Troy Smith and the nickname "Wildman," has scars on his left arm, left leg and face. He is a member of the Cash Money Boys gang, a known drug user, and considered armed and dangerous. He often wears three rings on his hand. Obas is originally from Haiti. He is 27, 5'10" and 130-180 pounds. (See Shows #631, #670, #729 and #745, OADs 5/5/01, 3/30/02, 8/02/03 and 12/20/03)

Victor Manuel Rodas (Murder) -- Rodas attacked his housemate, 60-year-old Juan Ramirez. Rodas had been drinking most of the day and when he ran out of alcohol went to Mr. Ramirez's room looking to borrow money. When Ramirez refused to give Rodas the money, Rodas viciously attacked him with a machete. Ramirez died before an ambulance arrived. After the attack Rodas persuaded two acquaintances to drive him to a Greyhound bus terminal in Delaware. There are no records to show that Rodas ever got on a bus. Police have also learned that the suspect's name may actually be Jose Manuel Medrano. Rodas, who has also used the aliases Hector Ascencio and Victor Manuel Rodriguez, is known to always carry a knife or other blade. He has worked as a day laborer on construction sites and in factories. Rodas is 45, 5'8" and 185 pounds. (See Show # 704, OAD 1/25/03)

Kenneth Marshall Cofer (1st Degree Murder) -- Even before September 11, 2001, Oklahoma City residents knew the horror of terrorism. Nearly everyone remembers April 19, 1995, when explosives brought the Alfred P. Murrah building down. Since then, Oklahoma City residents have become an even more profoundly patriotic community. That's why when Kenneth Cofer claimed America got what it deserved from the Oklahoma City bombing and 9/11 attacks, Vietnam veteran Larry Buchanan passionately defended his country and beliefs. Police say this was just the beginning in a series of confrontations that would eventually end in murder. The day after Cofer and Buchanan's initial confrontation, the two found themselves face-to-face once again. This time, it was at the Country Palace Bar, Buchanan's favorite local hangout. He was a regular there and all the locals knew him as "Buffalo." When Cofer entered the bar the men began to argue. Buffalo kept his cool but it was clear that Cofer wanted to fight. Buffalo didn't want Cofer there, and the bartender obliged by tossing him out. When Buchanan left the bar minutes later, police say that Cofer was hiding in the shadows. Six inches shorter and hobbled by recent surgery, Buffalo was outmanned, but bravely stood up to Cofer. Police say that Cofer knocked Buchanan to the ground a few times and then drove off. On September 13, 2002, Cofer and Buchanan ran into one another for the third and final time. Cofer was hanging out with a group of men at a rural property outside Oklahoma City when Larry Buchanan showed up. As had happened the previous two days, the two squared off. Instead of a fist fight, Cofer pulled out a handgun and shot Larry Buchanan in the head. Witnesses say Cofer walked over to his truck, stated, "I guess I have ruined my life," climbed in and drove away. Buchanan died at the scene. Months later, cops found Cofer's truck in a ditch near the murder scene. It had been spray-painted black and had receipts inside suggesting Cofer had traveled to Arkansas and back. Cofer hasn't been seen since the day of the murder. With the ten-year anniversary of the Oklahoma City bombing reopening old wounds, this community is once again looking for justice. Kenneth Marshall Cofer uses the alias "KM Cofer." He wears very thick glasses due to poor vision, has brown hair, and is known to wear a goatee. Cofer has a burn on his chest and several tattoos on his chest including two Vikings on the

right side, three skulls on the left and an eagle with a swastika in the middle. He has a magic circle and unicorn on his upper left arm and a Japanese sword, Mt. Fuji and two lightning streaks on his upper right arm. Cofer may be working as a cabinet maker or a roofer. He could also be playing drums in a band. Cofer is 45, 6'2" and 190 pounds. (See Show #803, OAD 4/16/05)

Antonio Delacruz, Jr. (Murder) – The Harris County Sheriff's Office is searching for Antonio Delacruz. On August 31, 1998, Jose Garcia and Antonio Delacruz went to rob a house in Houston, Texas. The two men knew the owner of the house, Nicholas Acosta. Acosta was involved in drugs and had recently started dating Delacruz's ex-girlfriend. The robbery turned into violent murder. Garcia and Delacruz stabbed Acosta 17 times. Then Delacruz began beating Acosta over the head with a barbell. The scene was so frightening that Garcia fled, leaving Delacruz at the house. Garcia arrived back at his mother's house where Mrs. Garcia immediately called the police after she saw the bloody mess. Delacruz was on the way back to Garcia's when he heard that police were on the way. Delacruz decided he needed to burn all of the evidence. He fled to burn his truck, but police caught up with him. They put out the truck fire, as well as Delacruz who was also on fire. Jose Garcia was arrested and is currently in Harris County jail. Delacruz was charged with murder on August 31, 1998. A \$100,000 bond was set for his bail. On October 28, 1998, Delacruz was charged with bond forfeiture. Natalee Ann Holloway is a graduating senior from Mountain Brook High School in Birmingham, AL. On an unofficial annual senior trip Natalee and approximately 130 of her classmates ventured thousands of miles away to enjoy the white sands and blue waters of Aruba. For five days the recent graduates and seven chaperones relaxed, sun bathed and enjoyed the Aruba nightlife. Dressed in the same blue and green striped low-cut blouse and jean miniskirt that she wore at the beach earlier in the day, Holloway spent Sunday evening partying at Carlos 'N Charlie's, a popular restaurant and dance spot where tourists and locals meet in the capital, Oranjestad. Monday morning, May 5, 2005 when the rest of the group gathered to catch their flight, Natalee was no where to be found. Carlos N' Charlie's master of ceremonies, Jose Hernandez, saw Natalee leave about 10 minutes before the restaurant's 1 a.m. closing. He reports that nothing seemed out of the ordinary. Meanwhile, some of Natalee's friends say they saw her getting into a vehicle outside the nightclub. According to Natalee's stepmother, Robin Holloway, friends say Natalee was last seen with a local resident who claimed to be a foreign exchange

student. Police questioned and released three Aruban students who said they dropped Holloway off early Monday at the Holiday Inn where she had been staying, about three miles from Oranjestad. However, police have been unable to verify whether Natalee actually made it back to the Holiday Inn at all. Police found Natalee's passport inside her hotel room, narrowing the possibility she left the island. (See Show #807, OAD 6/04/05)

Brooke Carol Wilberger

Police believe that Brooke was abducted on May 24, 2004, while cleaning outdoor lamp posts outside the Oak Park Apartments. She was visiting her sister and brother-in-law in Corvallis, who are residential managers of the complex. When police arrived, they found signs of a possible struggle leading them to believe she may have been kidnapped. Her sandals were found askew near a bucket of water. Her purse, keys, and other personal items were left in her sister's apartment and her car was still in the parking lot. Compelling evidence leads police to believe that she did not leave willingly. Brooke Wilberger just completed her freshman year at Brigham Young University. She is enrolled for next fall term to continue her studies in speech pathology. She is a graduate of Elmira High School near Eugene, Oregon. Brooke is a devout Mormon, an honor student, an athlete and described as very responsible, reliable and likeable by her friends and family. She was last seen wearing a Indigo hooded sweatshirt, a gray Brigham Young T-shirt, dark blue jeans, small hoop earrings, possibly a silver watch, a ring with "CTR" engraved on it and no shoes. Brooke has a scar on her right forearm that extends from her wrist to her elbow. She also has a piercing on the top of her right ear. Local authorities have identified Sung Koo Kim as a possible suspect. Kim has been arrested for burglarizing a dorm room at Oregon State, near where Brooke disappeared. Evidence found on Kim's person ties him to the building where Brooke was staying. Kim, however, has not been charged in connection with Brooke's disappearance. Alexis S. Patterson

John Dallas Lockhart (Child Rape) -- According to police, John Lockhart raped a four-month-old infant and took pictures of the horrific crime. Police had been taking part in an ongoing fraud investigation aimed at John Lockhart's law practice, when they discovered the grossly appalling photos on his computer. Police say that the files were retrieved when a computer software maintenance company was attempting to recover business and financial files from Lockhart's work computer. According to investigators, they found a lot more. Company employees say they discovered more than 100 pornographic photos on his hard drive, including pictures of child and infant rape. The software company immediately contacted the Akron Police Department. Once Lockhart got wind of the fact that police had his computer, he took off. The accused pedophile is a father of two. Family and friends say they had no idea Lockhart lead a double-life as a child predator. Lockhart is 36, 6'10" and 185 pounds. The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Marlon James Winters (Aggravated Sexual Assault, Indecency with a Child) -- One of the most tragic aspects of child molestation is the long-term trauma victims often experience. Perpetrators use mind control to get away with their sick crimes. They "groom" their victims, carefully choosing children who will trust and listen to them. Eventually, the physical abuse begins, and by the time anyone can step in, these children have been violated in ways that continue to haunt them - often for the rest of their lives. Marlon James Winters is one of these sick criminals who prey on the innocent. He uses classic child molestation tactics to commit his crimes slowly gaining a child's trust by taking them on bike rides, teaching them to play the drums, and giving them gifts. Once he has their trust, he makes his move, molesting and raping the children. Winters is able to keep up his behavior by threatening the kids, using his authority as an adult to frighten them into submission. Marlon Winters' perverted behavior started in Germany, where he lived and served in the military. Winters is believed to have molested his own children, then left his wife and kids to come to Orange County, Texas. Orange County Investigators say in his new neighborhood, Winters targeted his neighbor's nine-year-old and six-year-old daughters. Investigators believe Winters began his typical routine of grooming the girls, referring to the molestation as a "game" that little girls in Germany like to play. Eventually, police say he began raping and repeatedly assaulting them. The girls' mother had recently suffered a stroke, and Winters used it to his advantage. They say he told the girls their mother would die if they told anyone about the "games." Winters also used his adult authority to keep them quiet, telling them no one would believe a child's word over an adult's. Winters thought these tactics were enough to keep the girls quiet. However, the younger child didn't understand the "games" and eventually asked her mother about them. In July 1999, Winters was indicted on five counts of Aggravated Sexual Assault of a Child, and two counts of Indecency with a Child by the Grand Jury of Orange County, Texas. Winters was able to post the \$15,000 bond, and then fled. He hasn't been seen since. Police say they are certain Winters is out there continuing to molest and sexually assault

children. During their investigation and search for Winters, they found another child the predator was apparently grooming as his next victim. They say he had been teaching her to play drums in his garage and had already heard him talk about his infamous "games." Police also received reports that Winters had inappropriate contact with some young boys, but they were relatives of Winters and refused to speak about the incidents. Equally troubling was the storage shed authorities found. Winters had stored many of his personal belongings on a relative's property, and among the boxes, police found dozens of newspaper clippings. These weren't random sections cut from newspapers, they all had one thing in common - children. Many of the clippings were of kids from school-related articles, and some even had the kids' names and addresses. Investigators fear Winters was using these clippings to target his next victims. Police are hoping someone will recognize Winters and call in a tip that takes him off the street. They say it's the only way to get him to stop preying on innocent children. Winters has a scar on his forehead, has hazel eyes, and is known to wear glasses from time to time. He shaves off all of his body hair and is known to take several showers a day. Winters might be overly attentive toward other people's children. He plays the drums and is believed to be playing with an unknown band. He speaks fluent German and has worked as a carpenter. Police believe Winters could be staying in a campground environment, or could possibly be working for a contracting company in a refinery setting. Winters is 45, 5'9" and 150 pounds.

Dennis Michael Ervin (1ST Degree Sexual Assault, False Imprisonment) -- On July 19, 1978, Dennis Michael Ervin committed a disgusting crime. He preyed on the compassion of an elderly woman by knocking on her door, telling her some kids up the street were in a car accident, and asking her for a blanket. Wanting to help, the woman complied and gave Ervin a blanket. However, before she could go back into her house, Ervin revealed his real motive for the house visit. He threw the blanket over the elderly woman's head and held a gun to her chin, threatening to "blow her brains out" if she screamed. Ervin forced the woman into her living room and tied her to a chair. The terrified woman sat restrained in her living room for about an hour before she heard the back door open. In walked one of her friends. The victim called out for help, but before her friend could move, Ervin grabbed her and tied her to another chair in the living room. When the victim's friend failed to return home, her husband came looking for her. Ervin met her husband at the back door and shot him with a sawed off shotgun hitting him in the shoulder and neck. When the injured man tried to get away, Ervin beat him in the face with the gun and then restrained him in the house. Ervin held his three victims hostage overnight. At some point the next morning, he raped one of the women all the while threatening to kill her. Eventually, he stopped and suddenly claimed to be hungry for McDonald's. He turned up some music and left the house. The victims say Ervin's behavior throughout the night was extremely bizarre. They say he was pacing and talking to himself the whole time. They also say during certain parts of the ordeal Ervin was very calm and even apologetic, while during others he was irrational and violent. Ervin was eventually arrested and convicted of the crimes. Ervin was sentenced to a mental health facility, and spent time there before he was determined safe enough to be placed in the Bridge Halfway House in Milwaukee, Wis. On August 12, 1988, Ervin escaped from the mental institution and hasn't been seen since. Police say Ervin is undoubtedly a risk to society and is probably still out on the streets committing crimes. The original detectives working Dennis Ervin's case have long since retired or passed away. The case files have been passed around over the years and new leads and information have been hard to come by. At 56 years old, Ervin is still young, and cops working the case

now are confident someone out there knows where Ervin has been hiding all these years. Ervin smokes cigarettes and drinks occasionally. He has smoked marijuana and claims it keeps him "going to work." He enjoys reading and photography. Ervin is 56, 5'10" and 257 pounds.

Donald Edward Lynch (Rape of a Child, Aggravated Sexual Battery) -- Tennessee authorities are searching nationwide for a man they say brutally raped two young girls he was supposed to be babysitting. In February 2003, two sisters age 7 and 11 reported to authorities they were repeatedly molested by 64-year-old Donald Lynch. According to officials, Lynch forced the girls to sleep in his room, watch X-rated movies and participate in sexual acts. Lynch often took photos and videos of the young girls and threatened them with a gun. Authorities questioned Lynch in 2003. He denied the allegations, but admitted he took many photos and made videos of naked women over 18 years old. Lynch told officials he paid these women for their services. However, what cops found when they searched his house shocked even veteran officers. Police raided Lynch's house, seizing more than 600 video tapes, 300 Polaroids, pornographic magazines, a video camera, a loaded handgun, and magazine clippings of young girls. The photos and videos seized showed numerous girls in sexually explicit positions. Investigators examined the evidence and discovered that Donald not only sexually molested the two victims who reported the crimes, but also victimized at least eight other girls. One of them was only three years old! Lynch also videotaped unsuspecting young girls playing in his neighborhood, at the mall, at local parades and beauty pageants. An informant told investigators that Lynch sold the homemade videos to a person in New York. Lynch fled before authorities could pick him up. In October 2003, Lynch was arrested in Central Nyack, NY where he was using the alias, David Barnes. Lynch was extradited to Kingsport, Tennessee and imprisoned under a \$200,000 bond. He posted bond and skipped town in June 2004 and hasn't been seen since. Lynch is believed to be working at a flea market. Lynch is 64. He has grey and white hair, wears glasses and may have a beard.

Federico Sebastian Pimienta (Desertion) -- NCIS agents say Federico Pimienta, the United States Marine who was found guilty of killing another Marine, has made his way to London, England. They say Pimienta was able to board a flight from New York's John F. Kennedy Airport to Heathrow Airport on June 5, one day before he was believed to have disappeared from his barracks in Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. Pimienta was found guilty in absentia on June 9, 2005 of the involuntary manslaughter of Russell White while stationed in Afghanistan. Russell White was a high school student in Delaware on September 11, 2001. After that fateful day Russell decided he was going to help hunt down the man responsible for killing twenty-three hundred Americans. Russell knew he was going to join the Marines. However, Russell did not realize the man who would inflict the most harm on him was not Osama Bin Laden. Instead, it was Federico Pimienta. NCIS agents say Pimienta was cleaning his gun when it discharged and killed Russell while the two were in their hut at Bagram Air Base, north of Kabul. Russell was lying in his bunk and tossing a football in the air. He had just received the ball from his parents. Pimienta, who was attached to 3rd Battalion, 6th Marine Regiment, had been warned about playing with his 9 mm handgun. During the court proceedings one witness also claimed that Pimienta had deliberately stuck a gun in his face. Pimienta had been counseled several times by superiors for twirling his sidearm on his finger and drawing it from his holster like a cowboy, according to court testimony. However, the only witness to the shooting was Lance Cpl. Stephen Groover. He did not see the shooting because he was cleaning his own gun at the time Pimienta's weapon fired. Pimienta

reportedly told Groober not to say anything because he was afraid to go to jail. Groober also testified that Pimienta frequently violated a rule in which Marines were only supposed to carry weapons ready to fire when in immediate danger, meaning the weapon would have the safety on and no bullet in the chamber. Another Marine, Cpl. Ian Dunton, testified that Pimienta had stuck a loaded gun in his face a few weeks before the shooting. Pimienta was convicted and sentenced to 12 years in prison. His rank was reduced from lance corporal to private. Agents were able to obtain computer records that showed Pimienta had purchased an airline ticket to London. They kept the information private because it was a round trip ticket with a return date for June 23. Agents were waiting for Pimienta at Heathrow Airport to see if he had a change of heart and would come back to face justice. However, Pimienta never appeared. Pimienta is originally from Uruguay and agents fear he may try return there. Russell White's family is offering a \$2,500 reward for information leading to Pimienta's arrest. Pimienta is 23, 5'7" and 212 pounds.

Andre Harris (Homicide, Robbery) -- The Hacker family ran a small Jamaican restaurant in the Bronx, New York. They worked long hours, so on July 23, 2004, they were hoping to spend a quiet evening at home. Osmond Hacker was talking business in the bedroom with a relative. His wife, Valry was watching the Yankees game. One of their daughters was in another bedroom looking out the window waiting for her older sister to walk down the street so she could go down to meet her. She walked out of the bedroom and said goodbye to her Mom and Dad. It was the last time she would see her father alive. As the teenager opened the door to leave the apartment, two men who took out guns and demanded money approached her. Mr. Hacker heard some commotion and came out to investigate. A struggle ensued and 17 shots were fired. Four bullets hit Mr. Hacker. His wife immediately came to his side to try to save him but it was too late. Mr. Hacker died at the scene. While she was trying to save him, Valry was hit with two bullets. She was wounded in the arm and chest but survived. The suspects got away with one thousand dollars. Police were on the hunt for the two men. They were able to identify the alleged triggerman because he made a serious mistake. He had a mask on but apparently at one point the mask slipped up, showing his face. Several people identified him as Andre Harris. Harris also goes by the name Derrick Witter and is also known as Iko Green, and "Jigga". Harris has children and girlfriends in Cleveland, Ohio; Bronx, New York; and Washington, D.C. Police believe that he may have been seen at a nightclub in Manhattan. Harris is 25, 5'6" and 130 pounds.

William Ray Plemons (Murder, Kidnapping, Parole Violation) -- William Plemons is wanted by Phoenix, AZ authorities for the murder of his second wife, Ermalinda Macatangay. While Plemons was in prison for robbery, assault and escape, he developed pen pal relationships with at least two women. He married one while still in prison and was granted parole in April 2003. After his release, he left his first wife and took up with Ermalinda. He allegedly stole from her bank accounts and ran up her credit cards. On June 24th, Plemons is accused of killing Ermalinda in a fit of rage. Police fear that he may have another female pen pal whose money he is using to survive and run from the law. If not, police believe he may be committing armed robberies. The family is offering a \$5000 reward for Plemons' capture. Plemons has used the aliases John Coleman, David Howell, Ray Plemon, William Keller, William Taylor and "Bubba." He reportedly uses low dosages of methamphetamine to stay awake due to his fear of being alone. He is also known to pay people to drive him around. Plemons has been known to wear Kmart type blue jeans and a pressed collar button down type shirt and to frequently solicit prostitutes.

Plemons is 59, 5'8" and approximately 190 pounds. (See Shows #752, #765 and #789, OADs 2/07/04, 5/22/04 and 12/18/04)

Rufino Castaneda (Rape) -- It all began the evening of November 1, 2000 at a strip mall pub in Mishawaka, Indiana. "Tiffany" was taken by force away from the bar. Two men kidnapped her, put her into a car and began driving away from the scene. Authorities haven't yet identified the driver. Rufino Castaneda sat in the back of the car, restraining and hitting "Tiffany". They drove "Tiffany" to Castaneda's ex-girlfriend's home. The driver left, but Castaneda pulled "Tiffany" into the home. Once inside, Castaneda sexually assaulted "Tiffany" and physically attacked her repeatedly. "Tiffany" fought back and escaped, probably saving her own life. When they arrived on the scene, "Tiffany", clothed only in a cardboard box, led them to the home where she had been attacked. Further investigation linked Castaneda to the scene and he was charged with the crime. Castaneda fled immediately. He was last seen the day before the attack at his job in Bremen, Indiana. He abruptly quit his factory job. He hasn't been seen since. Castaneda, who has used the alias Rufino Castaneda Nova and goes by the nicknames Alejandro, Alex and Rufo, has noticeable acne scarring on his face and may also have an arrow-shaped scar on his face. He is a Mexican national who speaks English poorly, smokes marijuana, and may be working as a day laborer. Castaneda is 30, 5'6" and 150 pounds. (See Shows #716, #724, #725, #759, and #787 OADs 4/26/03, 6/21/03, 6/28/03, 4/10/04 and 12/04/04)

Tamika Antonette Huston

Age: 25

Height: 4'11"

Weight: 125 pounds

Tamika Huston of Spartanburg, SC, is described as an avid dog lover. This is why her friends and family are so concerned that she disappeared in late May 2004 without making provisions for her dog, Macy, who was about to give birth to a litter of puppies. Tamika was first reported missing to authorities on June 14, 2004. On June 20, 2004, her 1991 black Honda CRX was found abandoned in an apartment complex's parking lot in Spartanburg. It had been abandoned there for approximately the same amount of time Tamika has been missing. Several clues have surfaced since her disappearance which leads police to believe that she met with foul play. A set of keys police found in her abandoned car lead them to an empty apartment that was formerly occupied by one of Tamika's ex-boyfriends. A routine search of the apartment turned up blood evidence that proved to be Tamika's. The former tenant claimed that his apartment was vandalized and that he rented a steam cleaner to clean up ketchup that was on the floor. Early in the investigation police received a phone call from an unidentified source who claims that his/her brother claimed that he had killed his girlfriend and dumped her body in Cleveland Park Lake. The lake is located near the parking lot where Tamika's car was found. This is where the clues to her disappearance end. Tamika has an extensive network of family and friends in cities up and down the East Coast including Springfield, VA, Richmond, VA, Ellicott City, MD, Nashville, TN and Miami, FL. They

hope she'll resurface and that she can be reunited with her friends, family and dogs. Tamika is described as a kind and loving person who wanted to save the world. Tamika has white blemishes in her neck area and a tattoo of a tiger or lion on her right thigh. (See Show #797, OAD 3/05/05)

Shania Joan Supanich

Age: 8

Height: 4'

Weight: 62 pounds

Friday, April 2, 2004 was just one month shy of Shania Supanich's seventh birthday. She was so excited she was counting the days. That morning Shania and her mother, Sandy Pedigo, left their Auburn, Washington home at their usual time. They headed for Terminal Park Elementary School where Shania was a first-grader. When they arrived, Sandy escorted her daughter directly to her classroom, leaned over and kissed her goodbye. Then Sandy left to head to her job operating a forklift in a warehouse. Sandy and her husband, Mark Supanich, had been having problems, leading to their separation and shared custody of Shania. Because of Mark's alleged recent displays of anger, their shared custody of Shania was revised by a Tacoma judge. Mark was told he would still be allowed to see his daughter if he participated in court ordered anger-management and parenting programs. That Friday afternoon, Mark was scheduled to pick up Shania for a weekend together. He had agreed with Sandy to return Shania at 6 p.m. on Sunday at a neutral location. That Sunday, Sandy drove to a prearranged drop-off spot - a McDonald's parking lot. She sat in her car and waited for her daughter. As the hours passed Sandy realized her estranged husband would not be showing up with Shania. Sandy says she was not greatly surprised. Local law enforcement authorities were informed about the missing child and on that Tuesday morning Sandy went to court. A felony warrant was eventually issued for the arrest of Mark Supanich. Investigators searched throughout the state for Shania. Family, friends and acquaintances were questioned. Weeks passed and all leads only led to dead-ends. Pleas were made to the public for help in locating the missing girl and fliers and posters were circulated nationally on websites. The weeks turned into months and still there were no signs of Shania and her abductor. Police consider Shania to be in grave danger and have serious concerns for her safety. She and her non-custodial father might still be in the local area, or may have traveled to Michigan where he has ties. There is also the possibility they could be roaming around North America, or in Canada or Mexico. Shania has a gap between her front teeth and a birthmark on her upper right arm. Her shoulder-length red hair could have been cut very short. Police say her father may be forcing her to pose as a boy.

CAPTURED:

Malaika Tamu Griffin (Murder) -- Malaika Tamu Griffin is wanted for the murder of 25-year-old Jason Horsely. In the winter/spring of 1999, Griffin was renting a room in a house next door to Jason and his girlfriend, Deborah Loisselle. On April 20, 1999, Deborah had her first encounter with Griffin as the two women were standing in their front yards separated by a fence. Deborah says Griffin, whom she'd never seen nor met before that day, immediately threatened to kill her dogs and began cursing and hurling racial slurs. Jason and Deborah are Caucasian; Griffin is African-American. Over the next 28 days, Griffin had several other run-ins with Jason and

Deborah that they say she initiated over parking on the public street and Jason unloading his tools on the public sidewalk in front of her house. None of the arguments made any sense to Jason and Deborah because they insist they never trespassed on her property and the parking spaces should have never been a matter of dispute because Griffin didn't even own a car. Hers had been repossessed. On the evening of May 18, 1999, Jason was organizing his carpentry tools on the sidewalk in front of Griffin's house when she came outside and began screaming at him. Deborah heard the commotion and came out of her house to stick up for Jason. After a brief but intense argument, both women stormed back into their respective homes and Jason continued organizing his tools. Griffin came back outside minutes later armed with a laser-sighted 9mm pistol and shot Jason in the back at point-blank range. He never saw her coming. The bullet pierced Jason's heart and killed him almost instantly. Then, Griffin ran to the home of an acquaintance, Monique Thomas, and carjacked her at gunpoint. Griffin abandoned the car in Iowa and hopped a bus to Chicago where her trail went cold. When police searched Griffin's room in Denver, they were shocked to find a stockpile of ammunition, diffused hand grenades, a 9mm assault rifle and books commonly associated with terrorists, *The Anarchists' Cookbook* and *The Poor Man's James Bond*. They also found spiral notebooks full of Griffin's secret writings about a coming race war and the killing of white people. None of her colleagues or close friends ever heard her express the types of racist rhetoric she wrote about in her notebooks. Griffin is a world-traveled lady with a Magna Cum Laude degree in chemistry. She has worked in laboratories and a pharmacy in the past. Griffin is an avid outdoorswoman and survivalist who buys top of the line camping gear and firearms. She has bad credit and declared bankruptcy in 1999. She doesn't smoke, but may drink occasionally. According to authorities, Harper fled town with his girlfriend before charges could be made. After his girlfriend began to fear for her life, she left a note with a manager in a restaurant who notified the police. The police pulled their car over shortly afterward, arresting Harper. Harper was officially charged with murder, but bonded out of jail and took off.

Las Vegas, Nevada...HEATHER TALLCHIEF...The FBI in Nevada and Las Vegas police are looking for Heather Tallchief, a 28-year-old armored car driver, and her male roommate who disappeared on October 1, 1993, along with a Loomis Armored Inc. van filled with \$3.15 million dollars.

Elizabeth, New Jersey & New York, New York...UNKNOWN NEW YORK / NEW JERSEY SERIAL RAPIST...Women in New York and New Jersey say they're on edge yet again following the latest in a sick series of rapes. The newest victim survived what sounds like one of the most vicious attacks yet. Police say a 26-year-old woman was heading home from a Chelsea club early Friday, but never made it home that night. Cops say the rapist snatched her off of the street at knifepoint, forced her into his car, and raped her. But the horror didn't stop there; investigators say he then threw the naked woman in the trunk of his sports car and drove around. It's uncertain where he went while the woman was trapped in the back of the vehicle, but when he let her out of the trunk, police say he raped her again. After that, he drove the woman to Elizabeth, New Jersey where he finally released her. Police have been able to link this latest attack to the serial rapist because it fits the mold of other attacks. However, there is a lack of physical evidence because they say the attacker always wears a condom. Cops say they've had reports of at least eight similar incidents from women in New York and New Jersey. They say two of the victims were only 16-years-old. At this point police are sorting through other cases that could be linked to this serial rapist.

Las Vegas, Nevada...JENNY LIANG...Police say that Jenny Liang, a Las Vegas blackjack dealer murdered her live-in boyfriend, Patrick Sheen. Laing vanished from Las Vegas after purchasing a plane ticket to Hong Kong.

Stanwood, Washington...GABRIELLA MERCEDES MISSING...On May 11, 2005 Gabrielle Mercedes attended her third period class at Stanwood High School in Washington State. But her fourth period teacher grew concerned when Gabriella was not there. Now, cops are trying to figure out what happened to Gabriella within the short time between classes. Gabriella's mother, Mary Mercedes, first thought her daughter could have left with a friend, but she never

called home. Gabriella never showed up for her birthday on May 19 nor did she attend an auction at which she planned to sell a pig. Seventeen-year-old Gabriella is developmentally delayed. She has the capacity of a 10 or 12-year-old and takes medication for Attention Deficit Disorder. Her mother, Mary, says she is prone to having panic attacks. Mary worries Gabriella might have fallen in with the wrong crowd or may even have been abducted. Detectives say they have spoken with friends and family, but there have been no leads. The Mercedes family has put up fliers and posters around the area.

Philadelphia, Pennsylvania...JOE EAST...Joe East is wanted by the Philadelphia Police Department for the murder of his ex-girlfriend, 20-year-old Tamara Parrish. Her family says Tamara became involved in a relationship with East while she was in high school. But, as she matured and entered her freshman year in college, friends say Tamara attempted to sever the relationship. Police say East refused to let her go and began stalking Tamara. On the night of June 3, 1994, police say East repeatedly called the Parrish family residence using the pretense that he needed to borrow ten dollars from Tamara. Then, around midnight, police say East showed up at Tamara's home and shot her to death. Tamara's brother and sister witnessed the murder.

Abilene, Texas...JENNIFER SERVO...According to Abilene police, Jennifer Servo, a 22-year-old TV reporter for the Abilene NBC station was found dead in her apartment building. Servo had been strangled and had suffered a head trauma. Jennifer was found fully clothed, but an autopsy turned up bruises on her body that indicate she had been sexually assaulted before she was killed.

Palmer Park, Maryland...IN THE LINE OF DUTY – STEVE GAUGHAN... Corporal Steve Gaughan was shot and killed during a routine traffic stop. A 15-year veteran, Corporal Gaughan was assigned to the Special Assignment Team in District VI. The father of two adopted children, Corporal Gaughan served as the director of a homeless program at his church. In 1994, he received the Metro Council Government Award for outstanding drug enforcement officer. When he was not in uniform, he coached little league baseball and basketball. His father and three uncles were also police officers.
