Cruz's criminal history spans more than seven states and is known to have at least 12 aliases. One eyewitness of the crime came forward and helped police develop a rough sketch of the suspect. Now they need your help to identify this brutal killer.

Now the violence is spreading across the border into Texas. The gang's leader, Eduardo Ravelo was recently added to the FBI's "Top Ten Most Wanted" list. The FBI says he and his gang are running drugs, extorting money, and making hits on enemies. Police believe that capturing Ravelo will be the first step in breaking down this dangerous gang.

Madison, Wisconsin... LEO BURT... On the morning of August, 24, 1970, the "New Year's Eve Gang" set off a bomb at the University of Wisconsin. The explosion was the worst case of domestic terrorism until the Oklahoma City Bombing in 1995. The radicals were placed on the FBI's "Top Ten Most Wanted" list. Within seven years of the bombing three of the culprits were captured, but the fourth, Leo Burt, escaped. After 40 years, authorities still haven't been unable to track down Burt, who is known as the "Ghost of Wisconsin." Long Island, New York ...SPIRO GERMENIS... Spiro Germenis used his investment company to allegedly swindle \$9 million out of retired and handicapped people. These parents came together initially to support each other in their time of grief and mourn but now they've banded together in the fight for justice. Chicago, Illinois...UNKNOWN DEONTAE SMITH KILLER... On Aug. 1, 2009, 19-year-old Deontae Smith was gunned down while attending a local block party. The shooting happened after a massive fight escalated into hardcore violence. Though more than a 100 people were at the party, no one has stepped forward to name the shooter. Police attribute this deafening silence to the "no snitching" code of the Chicago's streets. AMW teams with Tonya Burch, Deontae's mother, to track down the murderer of her son.

This in no way stopped Wells from his sick behavior. He was arrested once again in 2007 and charged with the rape of a 10-year-

Bonus money would also be paid to educators whose students show a significant rise in test scores. Basic pay for all teachers would also rise under the pact. Over a five-year period (retroactive to 2007), pay would rise by 20 percent.

4/7 Ehrlich reelection

Former Maryland Governor Bob Ehrlich is going after his old job, Wednesday he officially announced his bid for governor. The Republican is challenging Democratic Governor Martin O'Malley, who beat him four years ago. During a campaign kickoff rally in Rockville with a few hundred supporters, Ehrlich called this "history part two." The former governor attacked O'Malley's administration for raising taxes, unemployment and spending. After the speech Ehrlich refused to answer questions from reporters only saying, "I'll answer questions later." His press secretary then said it would not be Wednesday. Speak to reporters in Annapolis, Governor Martin O'Malley took a jab at Ehrlich, saying he'd answered about 20 more questions than his opponent.

Ed Markey (D-Mass.), the agency said it is "not aware of any evidence that anti-bacterial washes were superior to plain soap and water." Markey's office released the correspondence with the FDA and the Environmental Protection Agency. The agencies first started looking at regulating the key ingredient in those anti-bacterials called triclosan nearly 30 years ago. Despite animal studies that show triclosan can harm brain and reproductive system development, the FDA and EPA have not come to any conclusions on the chemical's effect on humans.

Drinking and driving can kill. To drive home that message, students at Sherwood High School in Sandy Spring, Maryland are getting a two-day lesson to show how deadly tragedies can result from being drunk behind the wheel. "Every 15 Minutes" is a national program launched to force kids to confront the reality of death from making bad decisions. The program is named after the statistic when it began in the 1990s, that someone in the United States died every 15 minutes from an alcohol-related accident. The statistic is now almost every 40 minutes, so it does reach a significant number of teenage drivers. At Sherwood, they simulated a multiple-car traffic accident. Students played the part of the drivers and the victims, who had to be pulled from the wreckage by firefighters.

4/21 UMD College Riot

Maryland State Police are investigating how the University of Maryland has handled surveillance video from the night of March 3. That is the night when students poured into the streets to celebrate Marylands big basketball win over Duke. Police are taking a look at how the university has handled a subpoena related to the case. The university released new video on Wednesday. It is surveillance video from one of 350 cameras on and nearby campus. Lawyers representing the students subpoenaed the surveillance video. The university handed over some of the video but not all of it. Even now, two minutes of the universitys surveillance tape is still missing. But a spokesman said it is not the portion of the tape from the time when student Jack McKenna was allegedly beaten by Prince George's County Police.

4/20 DC Principal Death

Montgomery County Police continue to pursue leads in the murder of a popular D.C. school principal. Investigators are now going through Brian Betts computer and phone records in hopes of finding a link to his violent death. The 42-year-old was found shot to death in the bedroom of his Silver Spring home on April 15. Investigators are working on the theory Betts was killed by someone he knew and let into his red brick colonial home. Investigators are certain Betts was alive up until 11:30 p.m. on April 14. The rest is a puzzle they are trying to solve.

4/16 Mogo Schools Sexting

Montgomery County police are investigating sexually explicit pictures of students that may have been distributed and even sold at two schools. The investigation involves students at Pyle Middle and Walt Whitman High Schools.

4/16 DC Principal Death

D.C. schools officials say a man found dead in his Silver Spring home was the principal of Shaw Middle School. Montgomery County Police say a co-worker found 42-year-old Brian Betts dead in his home in the 9300 block of Columbia Boulevard on Thursday evening after he failed to report to work. Preliminary autopsy results show the cause of Betts' death was homicide and he was killed by gunshot. Montgomery County Police are working on the theory that Betts was killed by someone he knew. Police say Betts' SUV is missing. The last time anyone saw Betts was on Wednesday night when he was barbequing with friends in his backyard. Betts also sent a text message sent to Chancellor Rhee at about 8:30 p.m. Wednesday. Coincidentally, Betts' house is the same house where a father and daughter were murdered in 2002.

4/15 UMD Riot Police

Two Prince George's Co police officers have been named in connection with the beating of a University of Maryland college student. A person came forward with video showing police beating a student during a celebration after the Duke basketball game. The student did not appear to confront police before he was beaten.

4/15 9 year old FFX Hacker

A third grader apparently outsmarted Fairfax County Schools. Police said he broke into a school computer system and got into the accounts of teachers, staff and even the school superintendent according to the

Washington Post. According to court documents, the nine-year-old did it all from a home computer. "I guess we need more security on that," said a surprised parent at Churchill Road Elementary School. Fairfax County schools notified police in March, after discovering its Blackboard Learning System had been hacked. A court affidavit said the boy got into the accounts of at least 33 school staff members, most at Spring Hill Elementary School where he attended last year and at Churchill Road Elementary, where the boy is in third grade.

4/12 JMU Riots

Police have used pepper spray and tear gas to disperse what they say was a rowdy crowd of thousands who gathered for an annual open air party near the James Madison University campus. Lt. Kurt Boshart of the Harrisonburg Police Department said about 8,000 people gathered Saturday afternoon for an off-campus party that usually draws only 1,000 to 2,000. When fights broke out, Boshart said police tried to break up the crowd and some party-goers threw bottles and rocks at officers, leading them eventually to resort to tear gas. Boshart says more than 30 people have been arrested and charges are pending.

4/12 Kid brings gun to school

Prince William County police say a 12-year-old boy brought an unloaded handgun to school Monday and pointed it at his head before a teacher took it away. Police were called to Potomac Middle School shortly before 8 a.m. Monday. They say the boy showed the gun to other students at the bus stop. He and the other students rode the bus to school, and when they got off, he pulled the gun out from his pocket and pointed it at his head. A teacher took the gun away and brought the boy to the office. Police say the boy will be charged with possession of a weapon on school property.

4/9 Middle School Pot Bus

Drugs in a locker in a middle school. Ironically, it came on the same day that the school hosted a drug awareness program for parents. It's not even high school. You just wonder to what extent the parents lose control, said one neighbor of the school. Investigators say a teacher at Bates Middle School in Annapolis learned the drugs might be in the locker. The teacher notified an administrator who escorted the student to the locker. Police describe what they found as a relatively small amount of marijuana and cash. The student was charged with possession and possession with intent to distribute. That's because it was packaged in small quantities. The student was charged and then released into the custody of his mother.

4/7 DC Teachers Contract

The new proposed contract between D.C. and its teachers union could wind up paying some classroom teachers as much as \$147,000 a year, according to Chancellor Michelle Rhee. First-year teachers could earn as much as \$70,000. With \$64 million promised by a group of foundations, the school system plans to implement an incentive pay system that would reward teachers for choosing to educate students attending at-risk schools. Bonus money would also be paid to educators whose students show a significant rise in test scores. Basic pay for all teachers would also rise under the pact. Over a five-year period (retroactive to 2007), pay would rise by 20 percent.

4/7 St Albans Student

Police swarmed three prestigious private schools on the campus of the National Cathedral today. Armed officers surrounded the buildings with students inside on lockdown. Someone reported a man outside with a gun. Now two students are charged with having what turned out to be a bb gun on campus.

4/1 Howard U Crime Alert

Howard University is on alert after masked men carrying guns confronted students on campus. Police believe the same group is behind several other robberies near the campus last night. There are ten reported robberies in about three hours, mostly targeting black and hispanic men working in pairs.

Drinking and driving can kill. To drive home that message, students at Sherwood High School in Sandy Spring, Maryland are getting a two-day lesson to show how deadly tragedies can result from being drunk behind the wheel. "Every 15 Minutes" is a national program launched to force kids to confront the reality of death from making bad decisions. The program is named after the statistic when it began in the 1990s, that someone in the United States died every 15 minutes from an alcohol-related accident. The statistic is now almost every 40 minutes, so it does reach a significant number of teenage drivers. At Sherwood, they simulated a multiple-car traffic accident. Students played the part of the drivers and the victims, who had to be pulled from the wreckage by firefighters.

4/21 UMD College Riot

Maryland State Police are investigating how the University of Maryland has handled surveillance video from the night of March 3. That is the night when students poured into the streets to celebrate Marylands big basketball win over Duke. Police are taking a look at how the university has handled a subpoena related to the case. The university released new video on Wednesday. It is surveillance video from one of 350 cameras on and nearby campus. Lawyers representing the students subpoenaed the surveillance video. The university handed over some of the video but not all of it. Even now, two minutes of the universitys surveillance tape is still missing. But a spokesman said it is not the portion of the tape from the time when student Jack McKenna was allegedly beaten by Prince George's County Police.

4/20 DC Principal Death

Montgomery County Police continue to pursue leads in the murder of a popular D.C. school principal. Investigators are now going through Brian Betts computer and phone records in hopes of finding a link to his violent death. The 42-year-old was found shot to death in the bedroom of his Silver Spring home on April 15. Investigators are working on the theory Betts was killed by someone he knew and let into his red brick colonial home. Investigators are certain Betts was alive up until 11:30 p.m. on April 14. The rest is a puzzle they are trying to solve.

4/16 Mogo Schools Sexting

Montgomery County police are investigating sexually explicit pictures of students that may have been distributed and even sold at two schools. The investigation involves students at Pyle Middle and Walt Whitman High Schools.

4/16 Lanham Standoff

Police and SWAT units were called to Woodland Landing Apartments in Lanham, Md. where authorities believed there was a man barricaded inside an apartment. Residents were locked out of six buildings as witnesses said police were with bullhorns trying to talk to the man they believe was inside the apartment. Sources have told FOX 5, the man may have came home to find his daughter at the apartment with her teenage boyfriend where a scuffle occurred. Police checked inside the apartment, but the man was not inside. The teen girl was sent to get help with social services while the teen boy went to the hospital with minor injuries, but is expected to be fine.

4/16 DC Principal Death

D.C. schools officials say a man found dead in his Silver Spring home was the principal of Shaw Middle School. Montgomery County Police say a co-worker found 42-year-old Brian Betts dead in his home in the 9300 block of Columbia Boulevard on Thursday evening after he failed to report to work. Preliminary autopsy results show the cause of Betts' death was homicide and he was killed by gunshot. Montgomery County Police are working on the theory that Betts was killed by someone he knew. Police say Betts' SUV is missing. The last time anyone saw Betts was on Wednesday night when he was barbequing with friends in his backyard. Betts also sent a text message sent to Chancellor Rhee at about 8:30 p.m. Wednesday. Coincidentally, Betts' house is the same house where a father and daughter were murdered in 2002.

A third grader apparently outsmarted Fairfax County Schools. Police said he broke into a school computer system and got into the accounts of teachers, staff and even the school superintendent according to the Washington Post. According to court documents, the nine-year-old did it all from a home computer. "I guess we need more security on that," said a surprised parent at Churchill Road Elementary School. Fairfax County schools notified police in March, after discovering its Blackboard Learning System had been hacked. A court affidavit said the boy got into the accounts of at least 33 school staff members, most at Spring Hill Elementary School where he attended last year and at Churchill Road Elementary, where the boy is in third grade.

4/12 JMU Riots

Police have used pepper spray and tear gas to disperse what they say was a rowdy crowd of thousands who gathered for an annual open air party near the James Madison University campus. Lt. Kurt Boshart of the Harrisonburg Police Department said about 8,000 people gathered Saturday afternoon for an off-campus party that usually draws only 1,000 to 2,000. When fights broke out, Boshart said police tried to break up the crowd and some party-goers threw bottles and rocks at officers, leading them eventually to resort to tear gas. Boshart says more than 30 people have been arrested and charges are pending.

4/12 Kid brings gun to school

Prince William County police say a 12-year-old boy brought an unloaded handgun to school Monday and pointed it at his head before a teacher took it away. Police were called to Potomac Middle School shortly before 8 a.m. Monday. They say the boy showed the gun to other students at the bus stop. He and the other students rode the bus to school, and when they got off, he pulled the gun out from his pocket and pointed it at his head. A teacher took the gun away and brought the boy to the office. Police say the boy will be charged with possession of a weapon on school property.

4/9 Middle School Pot Bus

Drugs in a locker in a middle school. Ironically, it came on the same day that the school hosted a drug awareness program for parents. It's not even high school. You just wonder to what extent the parents lose control, said one neighbor of the school. Investigators say a teacher at Bates Middle School in Annapolis learned the drugs might be in the locker. The teacher notified an administrator who escorted the student to the locker. Police describe what they found as a relatively small amount of marijuana and cash. The student was charged with possession and possession with intent to distribute. That's because it was packaged in small quantities. The student was charged and then released into the custody of his mother.

4/7 DC Teachers Contract

The new proposed contract between D.C. and its teachers union could wind up paying some classroom teachers as much as \$147,000 a year, according to Chancellor Michelle Rhee. First-year teachers could earn as much as \$70,000. With \$64 million promised by a group of foundations, the school system plans to implement an incentive pay system that would reward teachers for choosing to educate students attending at-risk schools. Bonus money would also be paid to educators whose students show a significant rise in test scores. Basic pay for all teachers would also rise under the pact. Over a five-year period (retroactive to 2007), pay would rise by 20 percent.

4/7 St Albans Student

Police swarmed three prestigious private schools on the campus of the National Cathedral today. Armed officers surrounded the buildings with students inside on lockdown. Someone reported a man outside with a gun. Now two students are charged with having what turned out to be a bb gun on campus.

4/2 Church Sex Abuse

Archbishop Donald Wuerl today responded to a sex abuse protest across from Saint Matthew's Cathedral by crossing the street and praying with some of the protestors. He has not been shy about discussing sex abuse in the church, mentioning it several times since taking over the Archdiocese of Washington four years ago.

4/1 Howard U Crime Alert

Howard University is on alert after masked men carrying guns confronted students on campus. Police believe the same group is behind several other robberies near the campus last night. There are ten reported robberies in about three hours, mostly targeting black and hispanic men working in pairs.

4/1 S. Capitol St Shooting

DC police believe they know the identity of the fourth person involved in a deadly drive by shooting in Southeast. Three suspects, including a teenager are already in custody. Law enforcement sources say the man police are looking for is also a suspect in the murder of Jordan Howe. He's the 20 year old killed last week on
