Adding that such incidents have intensified since Hamas's terrorist attacks on Israel on October 7th. Similar suits have been filed against New York University and the University of Pennsylvania.

The U.S. Supreme Court takes up a crucial case impacting the 2024 election today. The issue is whether states can keep former president Donald Trump off the ballot. The justices will hear arguments over a Colorado Supreme Court decision. It hinges on a constitutional amendment that prevents former office holders who engaged an insurrection from holding office again. It all has to do with President Trump's role in the January 6th attack on the US capital. The ruling will depend on how the word insurrection is defined whether January fits that definition and if the Justice's rule Trump played a major part.

A judge dismissed several charges against former president Donald Trump in the case over alleged efforts to overturn the 2020 election results. Afton County Superior Judge Scott McAfee dropped three charges against Mr. Trump and three against his attorney Rudy Giuliani. They relate to alleged efforts to pressure State officials to change election results. The judge said prosecutors failed to give enough detail to substantiate the charges but could appeal the ruling. Trump still faces 10 counts including racketeering and filing false documents.

That means Republicans will only be able to lose two votes on any party line measure as Congress still has yet to deal with major spending bills in the weeks ahead.

2024 Presidential race Republican candidate Nikki Haley says she's still running after losing to Donald Trump Saturday by 20 points in her home state of South Carolina. Rejecting calls to exit the race Haley held a rally Sunday evening in Michigan, which holds its primary on Tuesday. Haley says it's not the end of her campaign story. It was her fourth major state loss in a row and polls show she trails in Michigan by a wide margin. Trump has now swept all of the GOP's early season primaries. Haley says she'll keep going until at least the March 5th Super Tuesday primaries next week, when 15 states vote. Meanwhile Republican National Committee chairwoman Ron McDaniel announced he's stepping down after Super Tuesday. McDaniel has served in the position for seven years. Trump has already endorsed a new slate of leaders at the RNC.
