This retransmission consent election is for all communities within the Stations’ “television market” (as defined in 47 C.F.R. § 76.55(e)) served by cable systems and/or other video distribution systems owned or managed by or affiliated with Operator including those comprised of the following headends: MARSHALL, and any other headend for which Stations could elect must carry under the Rules referenced below.

Accordingly, Stations hereby notify Operator that, pursuant to Section 325(b)(3)(B) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the “Act”), and Section 76.64(f)(2) of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission (the “Rules”), Stations elect to assert their rights under Section 325(b)(1)(A) of the Act and Section 76.64(a) of the Rules to require that Operator obtain Stations’ express consent before retransmitting their signals. This election of retransmission consent is for the period January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020.
