Her dad told him that she is smothering her and his mom told her the same thing. This made Brent feel depressed. He turned to marijuana and then recently turned to cocaine. Brent said that this girl means so much to him and can see a future with her. Dawson said that when the parents from both sides are saying to back off, and Brent's response is to turn to drugs, there are obvious issues. Dawson said that Brent needs to deal with his drug issues first.</p> <p><b>TITLE: In Debt, Has No Money</b>            Ariel's son's birthday is later this month, but Ariel is in about \$10,000 debt and has no money. Ariel is a teenage mother and isn't sure how to get gifts for her son's birthday. Ariel has two jobs and goes to school. Dawson said that the best gift she can give her son is a mom who isn't under stress. Dawson said that there are ways to cut down on the amount she is spending and Ariel needs some coaching. Dawson recommended going to <a href="http://DaveRamsey.com">DaveRamsey.com</a>.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Talking To Guy That Dated Her Friend</b>            Emily met a guy that was dating her best friend but they broke up. After that, Emily started talking to him and now they are dating. Emily's best friend has told her that she shouldn't date him because it is her ex. Emily doesn't want to lose her friendship but she wants to date this guy. Dawson said that Emily's best friend is being controlling, and that her friendship isn't worth much if she is making those kinds of demands.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend Mad At Him</b>            Harry's girlfriend called while he was driving home and asked him to come over, but Harry said he had already committed to give his co-worker a ride. His mom is an abusive alcoholic who beat him when he was little, and there is still a lot of verbal and emotional abuse happening. Rebecca is concerned about having a family with him and exposing their future children to his family. Dawson said Rebecca is using wisdom in knowing that just because she loves someone doesn't mean she should marry him. Dawson said if he isn't willing to get help then Rebecca should not think about marriage.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Been Addicted To Cocaine For Six Years</b>            John has been on cocaine about six years and he can't seem to get off of it. John wants to stop, but isn't sure how and thinks he might need to go to rehab. Dawson said that John needs to look up Alcoholics Anonymous or Narcotics Anonymous and go to them for help. He said the alternative is ending up in jail or worse.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Life Plan Changing, Unsure Of Future</b>            Tyler is a graduate student. He said that he had a life plan for the next 20 years to go to med school and become a doctor. After a year of grad school and working for a surgeon he has decided his plan isn't what is meant to be. Tyler is trying to figure out what to do next and has doubts about the future for the first time. Dawson said that it sounds like Tyler is growing as a person during this time period, and that he will look back eventually and see the path God had him on.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Parents Divorcing, Custody Battle</b>            Levi's parents are getting a divorce and this coming week they are having a custody battle over who he will end up with. Levi is very nervous about this, and is planning to tell the judge that he wants to live with his dad. Levi's mom has thrown him out of the house before and he feels like living with his dad is a better option. Bridget told her boyfriend's parents right away, but they are encouraging her to get an abortion. Bridget's boyfriend's dad even came in to their apartment and ridiculed them about the way they keep house and told them they can't handle a child. Dawson said that they are angry that they can't control the situation and the decision is out of their hands. He told Bridget to stand up to them and let them know she is going to be responsible for the baby, and then to stay away from them because it is between her and her boyfriend, and God.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Sad That She Hardly Ever Sees Her Dad</b>            Hayley and her brothers would spend every other weekend with their dad until he got remarried. Her brothers didn't like the woman he married, and she tried to pull him away from his kids. Her dad has become an alcoholic and nearly got in a wreck with them all in the car. Now Haley hardly sees her dad and they used to be very close. Haley tells her mother that she is fine but she really is very sad. Dawson said that Haley should start preparing to talk to him but not to do it alone, he said to make sure you have another adult with them while her father is dealing with the alcohol issues. Dawson also said that Haley needs to tell the truth to her mom about how she is really feeling.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Been Clean But Feeling Urge To Use</b>            Tracy just got off a weekend vacation and has a two-hour drive ahead of her. She has been clean for two months, but is really feeling the urge to use. She tried to call her sponsor but she isn't answering. Tracy is trying to think through all the steps, but she is feeling trapped in her vehicle while she tried to drive home. Dawson said that his staff can talk with her as long as she needs, and can act as her "sponsor" for tonight.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Show Has Helped Turn Her Life Around</b>            Rachel is calling in to say thank you. She has listened to the show for four or five years and it has helped her turn her life around. Rachel said that by listening to the advice he has given it has encouraged her to turn her life around and stay out of trouble.</p>

Destiny says other people are telling her that her boyfriend is a liar and a cheater and that he doesn't really care. Dawson said I get the vibe that he is not as committed as he needs to be. Dawson said plan that he won't be there and you have 3 kids. Where can you get support? You need a plan to follow, start with getting wise and supportive people around you.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Fiancé Cheated, Got Two Girls Pregnant</b>            Trish has been engaged for 2 years and found out that he cheated on her. The girl got pregnant and ended up having an abortion. He also has another child that is a week older than their child. Dawson said he is a serial womanizer. He lived through the abortion thing to get another girl pregnant and then got you pregnant. His feelings are below the belt. He is not spiritually or emotionally ready to be a father. It's going to end eventually and I'd rather you be in front of it and go ahead and end it now.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Friend Thinking About Suicide</b>            Milana's friend told her he was done with it all and couldn't handle it and was thinking about suicide. Milana said she talked to him and he opened up to her and it changed him from not thinking about it. Dawson said but he could easily slip into the danger zone. He is being flooded with all kinds of issues. Dawson said remember before people commit suicide they seem serene so just because he seems happy, doesn't mean he is out of the woods. Dawson said in love, we are going to bust him and tell people that are bigger than you and me...his parents, a pastor.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Mixed Signals From Girl</b>            Nathan said when this girl is with him, they are happy but when they are away from each other, then it's basically like they are just friends. Nathan doesn't want her to go down the wrong path and doesn't want to see her go with other guys that will hurt her. Dawson said you can't really prevent her from being hurt. Dawson said tell her you want to date her seriously but while you are making up your mind, I am going to date around. Dawson said that will get her attention.</p>

Listening to the show helped her let go of people she doesn't need in her life. Thank you.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend's Emotions Affecting Him</b>            Brandon's girlfriend is going through a custody battle. Her ex-boyfriend won't allow her to see her child and hasn't for a year. Brandon's girlfriend is taking out her frustrations on him, and it's to the point where Brandon doesn't want to even go home. Dawson said that she needs to get a good lawyer but also a good counselor. He told Brandon that her situation doesn't give her the right to emotionally beat him up, and it isn't healthy for either of them. Dawson said that they may possibly need a time out for a while, if she refuses to get counseling and change the way she is treating him.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Wondering If Birth Mom Has Changed</b>            Veronica's birth mom was a drug addict and had 7 children. Veronica wants to see if she really has changed but also is concerned about getting hurt again. Dawson said he thinks it is worth a try to slowly get to know her, but recommends that she not do it alone and to rely on the support of her family. Dawson also said that she will need to work on forgiving her, but it is going to be by taking baby steps.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Boyfriend Does Not Say "I Love You"</b>            Jamie's boyfriend is in the army. They have been dating for 6 months, and she says that she loves him often but he never says it in response. Jamie said that if she asks him if he loves her, he says yes. Dawson said that maybe he is afraid to say he loves her or isn't completely sure yet. He could also have an issue with intimacy or affection, which can sometimes be a result of his family upbringing. Dawson advised Jamie not to push it, but to wait to see where it goes. Dawson said that if the issue doesn't resolve itself and her needs aren't being met she may eventually need to walk away, and he reminded her if you have to force someone to say "I love you", do they really mean it? Dawson said it sounds like he is just scared and not ready for that commitment quite yet.</p>

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<p>Stress Military Family Relationship</p>	<p>10/19/14</p>		<p>Hour 2</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Fiancé's Mom Is In A Coma</b> Cari fiancé's mom is now in the hospital in a coma after an accidental overdose. Cari is trying to stay strong for her fiancé and his family. Cari said she had a break down but has been trying not to cry again. Dawson said tears can be your best friend, because it releases emotions that have been stored up. You don't have to white-knuckle it or tough it out. You have to eat right, sleep right, get exercise. If you are shot emotionally and physically then you will be of no help to your fiancé.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Made Mistakes But Has Changed</b> Alex made a lot of mistakes when he first joined the Army. He said he has changed and is on his game all the time now. His leadership doesn't see him making himself better; they only see the mistakes of his past. This whole ordeal is shaping your life because you are making decisions for the better. You are 22, not 82. You can overcome these challenges. You have made a big leap already and in time, you will move forward. You are getting character building and that is priceless.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Ex Got Custody Of Her Kids</b> Sarah is going through a custody battle. Her ex got an order of protection against her and says she abused her kids. Dawson said what proof does he have? Sarah said her daughter has boils on her bottom from a bacterial imbalance and has had them for about 6 months. They have recently been granted a guardian adlitem but she has only contacted Sarah once and it was 2 weeks ago. Dawson said keep ringing her bell and you need to get a lawyer too. If you need a loan then do it.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend Keeps Changing Her Mind</b> Brynlee's girlfriend kissed him Friday morning and went to work. After work, everything changed and she broke up with him and said it's because he doesn't have a job. Then she said she'll get back with him if he has a job, then if he has a job for a month. Dawson said what does your gut say? Brynlee says his gut says there is someone else. Dawson said that is my guess too. She is acting suspicious with her phone and acting weird. Dawson said I think it's over.</p>
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<p>Family Relationship Stress Military</p>	<p>10/19/14</p>		<p>Hour 3</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Uncle Now Going To Prison</b> Cody's bio father went to prison for bank robbery. Cody said at the time, his uncle (his father's brother) decided he didn't want anything to do with their family because of what his dad did. Strangely, Cody's uncle just got arrested for armed robbery and will be going to prison for a long time. He has two children. Cody wants to help his uncle's children. How to reach out to them? Dawson said what about your aunt. Cody said she was always very sweet to him. Dawson said I would reach out to your aunt first. Tell her you want to help since you have been through it.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Struggling Financially On Her Own</b> Elsa moved out of her parent's house this summer. Her parents told her they would pay for school but everything else is her responsibility. She said it's harder than you think it is to move out on your own. Dawson said, are you in debt? Elsa said technically yes, she owes a hospital bill. Dawson said maybe if your parents realized that you might have to drop out of school to pay your bills then they might allow you to come back home. I would also sit down with your parents and ask for their wisdom.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Family Drama In His Youth Group</b> Travis is dealing with family drama of the youth in his church. Parents of one family have left each other to be with other people in the church. Travis said the kids are looking to him for help. Travis is bleeding for these kids and they need more than just a pat on the back. Travis is drained and needs prayers. Dawson said you need a support team around you. You are giving too much without too much in return. You need someone to fill up your cup. We are going to get you support from our audience.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Opportunity To Join Special Forces</b> Dusty has a 10 month old daughter and is not with the mother of the child. Dusty has the opportunity to go into Special Forces, which would take him away a lot. Would it be better to stay and see her or take this opportunity to secure a better future for her? Dawson said short term pain for long term gain. Dawson said I would go with the Special Forces and work out the details with your daughter's mom.</p>
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<p>Stress Friendship Relationship Addiction</p>	<p>10/19/14</p>		<p>Hour 4</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Has An Aggressive Eating Disorder</b> Sarah has been dealing with a pretty aggressive eating disorder for the past 4 years. It started with a very bad relationship. She said it's inconsistent and she can't get it under control. Dawson said if you don't get help, you could die. She said it's horrible. She spends money on food just to throw it away. She can't get help from a professional because of her job. Dawson said one of our HopeLine staff is trained and a volunteer but not a professional. You need go-to people when the triggers happen. We will try to put together a team of people for you.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Has Two Friend That Drink And Drive</b> Jeff has two friends that drink and drive. He has taken some pretty decent measures to try to get them to stop drinking and driving. He knew his friend was at a party drinking and knew he was going to drive home. Jeff said he called the police and told them. The cops couldn't find him. Dawson said you are not only helping your friend but also someone that they could kill. The next step is saying I love you but I'm not going to hang out with you until you want help. Dawson said I'm glad he has a friend like you.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Slept With Ex, Might Have Herpes</b> Ally was with a guy and knew breaking up was for the best but they still had that sexual attraction. They slept together a week ago. This past Wednesday, he told her he was 95% sure he has herpes. He said he did sleep with someone else 3 days before her. Ally thinks she has herpes. Dawson said your body doesn't know about the deal. Your body doesn't know that he has herpes.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Can't Stop Drinking Every Night</b> Mike recently moved and got a great job. He is a good server and is a hard worker. He moved to quit all of the things from the past but can't quit drinking. Dawson said moving can help but you brought your baggage with you. Mike said he can't help but buy 2 or 3 beers each night. Dawson said some of that money from tips and otherwise you are throwing away. Dawson said you are going to get worse and worse and you are going to lose your job and you could lose your life. Dawson said you need to get in to AA and get serious.</p>

The baby's father also just had a baby with his new wife. Daisy says that he doesn't want his name on the birth certificate because he doesn't want his wife to find out. Daisy isn't sure how to collect child support because his new wife will find out if she does. Dawson said that perhaps if she doesn't ask for child support he will go away, but if she wants financial help she is going to have to file for child support. Dawson said that this guy is not going to leave his wife to be with her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Unsure Of Marriage, Due To His Family</b> Rebecca is concerned about marrying her boyfriend because of his family. His mother has a past as an abusive alcoholic. Rebecca is afraid to consider any future children being around them. Rebecca's boyfriend doesn't believe that he needs to see a counselor to get through this. Dawson said that Rebecca is being wise to consider that the family comes with the person that you marry. Dawson said that Rebecca is using wisdom to listen to these red flags, and that unless he is willing to work on himself and get help Rebecca doesn't need to marry him.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Having Doubts About Future Plans</b> Tyler is a 23-year-old graduate student who thought he had his life plan figured out. After working for a surgeon and a year as a graduate student, he decided his plan needed to change. This is the first time he has ever had doubts about where his future is headed. Tyler said he is spending a lot of time in prayer and is trying to be patient while waiting for direction. Dawson said it sounds like he is growing spiritually and as a person right now, so just because he doesn't know what to do when he gets done with graduate school doesn't mean he is on the wrong track.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Custody Battle Over Him</b> Levi's parents are getting a divorce, and there is a custody battle over where he will live. Levi has lived in the same house his whole life and might have to move and change schools. Levi wants to live with his dad and will have to tell the judge that this week. Dawson reassured Levi that he doesn't need to blame himself and none of this is his fault. Dawson told Levi to make sure he tells the judge the truth about where he wants to be and to keep talking with people as he works through this.</p>
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<p>Relationship Abuse Relationship Relationship</p>	<p>12/28/14</p>		<p>Hour 5</p> <p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: In Reoccurring Pattern Of Scaring Girls</b> Devin feels like he is in a reoccurring pattern of scaring girls off. One girl told him that she has enough problems of her own and can't take on his problems. Devin is tired of being rejected, and he doesn't want to be rejected by any more girls. Dawson suggested finding a girl who is a good friend who can help coach him through finding a girl to date. He also recommended that for the first several months of a relationship, 70% of the conversation should be about her and he needs to be a good listener. Dawson said that Devin should be upfront with the girls about his fear of rejection.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend Having Flashbacks Of Abuse</b> Stefan's girlfriend is having flashbacks from previous abuse and rape, and it is very difficult for him to handle. Stefan feels scared when it happens and isn't sure how to handle it. Stefan isn't sure if he should stay with her. Dawson feels Stefan is in over his head. He advised talking to a counselor or minister and coming up with a plan with what to do next time this happens. Dawson doesn't want her issues to drag him down, and said he can be there for her and be a listener, but also needs to point her to somewhere she can go to get help.</p> <p><b>TITLE: College Student Battling Depression</b> Sara is a college student who battles depression. She recently started dating a guy who has PTSD from serving in Iraq. Recently whenever they have an argument, Sara's depression seems to worsen. Sara feels she can see herself with him long term but is wondering if this is the right time. Dawson told Sara that you can't give away what you don't have and right now she is emotionally depleted.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend's Mom Doesn't Like Him</b> Dakota is a senior in high school and his girlfriend is a junior. They have been dating for about a year. He broke up with her at the beginning of the summer because he felt he was falling in love and it scared him. Now they are back together, but her mom doesn't like Dakota at all and has set ridiculous boundaries on their relationship. Dawson said that his girlfriend's mother was crushed by the way her daughter was hurt when he broke up with her, and she doesn't want to see her daughter go through that again. Dawson said to back off a little, but also to write a letter or talk to the mother to come to an agreement on the rules.</p>
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
