Alyssa has been with her new boyfriend for about 6 months, he treats her really well, but she is scared to be with someone again. Dawson said that Alyssa has been traumatized even more than she knows. Dawson said that she needs to work with a counselor on this, and if her new boyfriend wants to stay around he needs to be a cheerleader for her.</p> <p>TITLE: Pregnant, Being Evicted From Trailer Breanna is living in a trailer by herself, and her boyfriend is in jail for marijuana and an assault charge against her. Breanna is pregnant and her family doesn't care about her. Breanna is being evicted from the trailer and doesn't know what to do. Dawson said that the first thing she has to do is to take care of the baby and herself.</p> <p>TITLE: Wants To Be A Musician Dillon has spent his life dealing with diabetes and working toward his goal of being a musician. Dillon is concerned about being able to make his dream come true and being able to make enough money to live on a musician's salary due to the cost of taking care of the diabetes. Dawson said that Dillon needs to take a step back and get some new perspective. He recommended that he make a list of everything he is dealing with, prioritize it, and cut out what he can.</p> <p>TITLE: Fallen In Love With Guy, Was Drug User Brittney is a single mom to a one-year-old baby boy. She is dating a guy from work and has fallen in love with him, but is concerned because he has a history with drugs. Brittney said he has been sober for a while but she is still concerned that he could slip up and how that could impact her and her son, as well as all the positive forward steps she has made. Dawson advised not living with him until if or when they get married. He suggested having a lot of "hoops" for him to jump through in order for the relationship to continue progressing. Dawson told Brittney that she is risking a lot by taking a gamble on this man.</p>

Megan's doctor told her she wasn't pregnant but that she had an STD. Megan says that the virus is curable, but she hasn't told her parents. Megan is feeling the side effects of the virus, and doesn't want to bring it up to her family. Dawson told Megan that the sooner that she can tell her family, the better off she will be. He believes that Megan's family will be behind her as she fights off this virus.</p> <p>TITLE: Deal With Stress Without Relapsing Dee's mom was diagnosed with M.S. Dee had a surgery this past fall and became addicted to pain pills. Once Dee's prescribed pills were gone, she began taking her mom's Percocet. Dee has been clean for about a month now, but her mom was recently diagnosed with cancer in addition to the M.S. Dee isn't sure how to deal with the stress without relapsing. Dawson said that Dee is in a battle because of her addictive personality, her history, and the stress of her mother's situation. Dawson said we'll help her with a strategy on how to handle this.</p> <p>TITLE: Thank You Dawson For Advice Chad called in a while back because he had 3 jobs and was taking care of his girlfriend and his grandmother. At the time Dawson advised him to find a financial counselor. Chad followed that advice and his financial advisor has helped him get down to one job. Chad wanted to let Dawson know that his advice worked and say thank you.</p> <p>TITLE: Boyfriend's Family Doesn't Like Her Amanda's boyfriend's family doesn't approve of her. Amanda believes she is pregnant with his child. He is currently in jail for being \$1000 behind in child support from another relationship. Dawson said that there are a lot of strikes against her boyfriend and that she doesn't really need to get hooked up with a guy who can't support but also whose family also doesn't support her. Dawson said both parties in a relationship need to be able to take care of themselves before they get together.</p>

Dawson also said until he embraces the fact and recognizes that he is an addict he won't go down the road to sobriety.</p> <p>TITLE: Dad Has Never Been There For Her Lauren's dad has never been there for her, and has been in jail most of her life. He recently told Lauren that he has terminal cancer and has only a short time to live. Dawson said she needs counseling and she needs mentors who will walk with her through these things. Dawson said that until she takes some steps to recover from the abandonment she isn't ready to meet with him.</p> <p>TITLE: Heard Ex-Boyfriend Still Loves Her Deja was dating a boy for several months, but got drunk and made out with someone else. Mark is looking for someone who is outdoorsy and adventurous, who can be goofy but is intelligent, honest, and kind. Dawson said to make a list of the adjectives he is looking for to describe the type of woman he wants to be with. He also recommended getting to know the women he goes on dates with but not pushing it too far and getting stuck.</p> <p>TITLE: Can't Get His Ex-Girlfriend Off Mind Marcel is dating a wonderful girl who he has been with for about a year and a half. Marcel wants to commit to her but he can't get his ex-girlfriend out of his mind. Dawson said his ex-girlfriend is just a fantasy that he has built up in his mind and erased all the memories of the problems that they had, and that there is no woman in the world who can compete with a fantasy. Dawson said as he gets healed from girl number one than the girl he is seeing will have a chance.</p> <p>TITLE: Trying To Earn Ex's Trust Back Traci and her boyfriend were together for five years and now are broken up. He had two children from a previous relationship and Traci had three. Traci took on the role of stay-at-home mom for all 5 kids, and her boyfriend was working full time to support them all. Traci's ex was stressed out financially, and Traci bounced some checks trying to pay bills, so now he doesn't trust her. Dawson said that not only is Traci having to earn back his trust, but also he needs to prove to her that he can forgive.</p> <p>TITLE: Her And Her Daughter Are Homeless Kay's son passed away, and now her and her daughter are homeless. Kay has gotten in to drugs, and they are living in a hotel. Kay tells herself that if she holds down her job and gets time with her daughter, the drugs are just an extra-curricular activity. Dawson said healing can't happen while she is on drugs, and she is lying to herself if she doesn't think she has a problem. Dawson is afraid she is going to lose her daughter. He told her she needs to be honest with herself about her addiction.</p>

Addiction Grief Relationship Relationship	1/11/15		Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Brother Started Using Drugs Aliyah's 20 year old brother was living in another state and was having a hard time there, Aliyah invited him to move in with her but since he has done that he got into drugs. She has recently told him he isn't allowed to stay with her anymore but she feels responsible since he moved to live with her. Dawson said that Aliyah's brother will have to hit the wall before he changes. He encouraged Aliyah to stay strong in her stance and not enable him.</p> <p>TITLE: Mom Died From Cancer Rachel's mom passed away last April from a rare form of cancer. Rachel took care of her mom when she was sick, but during that time Rachel was doing drugs and alcohol. Rachel feels guilty because she thinks if she had been off of drugs she could have taken care of her mom better and perhaps she would have lived longer. Dawson said that Rachel was not responsible for the cancer and that regardless it would have run its course.</p> <p>TITLE: Thinks Girlfriend Might Be Cheating Jeff thinks his girlfriend might be cheating on him. They live together in a one room apartment, she comes home late from work, and isn't as intimate with him as she once was. Jeff has been dating her two and a half years and he just recently met her parents. Jeff's friends are saying that she is saying bad things about him and she won't let him look at her phone. Dawson said that those signs all point to the fact that she is cheating.</p> <p>TITLE: Keeps Seeing Ex-Boyfriend At School Rebecca dated a guy for a couple of years. They broke up but they see each other at their college classes every day. Rebecca really wants to move on but she doesn't know how. Rebecca is seeing someone else, but she is scared to open up to him and is having trouble wanting to be in a relationship with someone else. Rebecca's new boyfriend is sweet and encouraging. Dawson said since they dated for a couple years it might take at least that long to get over him. Dawson advised Rebecca to stay away from him as much as possible, but also not to beat up her new boyfriend because of the issues with her old one.</p>

<p>Relationship Family Self-Harm Career</p>	<p>1/18/15</p>		<p>Hour 2</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: In Love With Girl Who Is Mormon Jose has been in love with this girl for the last 5 years. They never officially dated but Jose said she was his first love and first kiss. The reason they haven't dated is because her family is Mormon. Jose has thought about converting because he loves her. Dawson said that he can't fake a belief in her faith, and that is not a way to start a marriage.</p> <p>TITLE: Fighting With Mom Gets Physical Hope and her mom have had a hard time getting along since her dad died in 2007. She said sometimes it even gets physical when they fight. She isn't sure how to get out of the situation. Dawson said that she needs to have a relationship with her mom but perhaps from a distance. Since she is 18, Dawson advised her to move out and build a team of supporters around her, and then very slowly set up boundaries and restart her relationship with her mom.</p> <p>TITLE: Dating A Girl Who Self-Harms Christian dated a girl who was self-harming, and Christian told her that whenever she was going to do that to call him instead. Christian eventually got his life straight, stopped drinking, and started dating an amazing girl. They have a great relationship but he recently found out that this girl is also self-harming. Dawson said that Christian needs a woman who will challenge him to be better than he is, and someone who is as healthy. He told Christian that he is attracting girls with needs and that is not good for him. He advised that they take a "time out" while she gets some counseling. Dawson said that by Christian enforcing the "time out" period it will show her how serious it is.</p> <p>TITLE: Wants To Play In The NBA Blair wants to play in the NBA. He is a truck driver and making good money, but he knows there is a lot of life out there for him. Blair is a street ball player and has grown up with and played with several guys who are now in the NBA. He wasn't able to play in high school because of his grades. Dawson recommended trying to go talk to a college coach and some of the connections he has at the NBA, and come up with a plan to follow but if he is going to do it he has to do it now. Dawson said he should follow his dream and see what happens.</p>
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<p>Relationship Relationship Addiction Family</p>	<p>1/18/15</p>		<p>Hour 3</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Parents Are Against Her Relationship Amber's boyfriend has cancer. Amber's parents are against their relationship because her boyfriend is Puerto Rican and they don't believe in mixing races. When they met him, her mom stopped talking to her for several days. Amber believes that he is her soul mate and they are engaged. The relationship is long distance, and she wants to move in with him. Dawson said that her mother over reacted but that he advised her to think long and hard before going against your parents.</p> <p>TITLE: Having Sex With A "Friend" Violet has a really good friend who was in the "friend zone" and now they are having sex. They have agreed that above all, their friendship comes first, but now there are time periods when he will shut down and she won't hear from him. Amber isn't sure where they stand. Dawson said that intimacy messes with your emotions and stirs up things deep within you. He recommended taking a step back to being friends. He said they need to slow down and work on their friendship again and let it grow into a committed relationship.</p> <p>TITLE: Girlfriend Overdosed, He's Overdosed Nate's girlfriend overdosed and died of a heart attack when he was 14. Nate has done various types of drugs to cope with the situation. Nate said he has overdosed before as well. Another girl he dated after this cheated on him. Nate now has trouble even talking to girls because he is afraid that if he gets in another relationship the girl will either die or cheat on him. Dawson said that Nate's grief and healing has been stunted because of his drug use. Dawson said he can't be in a relationship until he has something to give.</p> <p>TITLE: Mom Can Be Cruel And Hateful Nicole has been taking care of her mom, who is an addict, since she was 14. Nicole does the best she can to help her, but if she doesn't do it in exactly the way her mom wants then her mom becomes cruel and hateful. About a year ago, Nicole decided she couldn't carry on with the situation. Nicole's coping mechanism is to write it off as "that's just the way she is." Dawson said that Nicole should pray for her, and remember that her mom is mentally ill, then focus on obtaining her own healing.</p>
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<p>Medical Grief Addiction Career</p>	<p>1/18/15</p>		<p>Hour 4</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: May Only Have About 12 Years To Live Natasha has SMA Syndrome. She said that she has an artery that can collapse and stops her from eating and drinking, and every few months she has to be hospitalized. The doctors have told her she only has about 12 years to live. She is thinking about not going to college and not pursuing having a family of her own. Dawson reminded Natasha that it isn't the quantity of life, it is the quality of life. He also talked about making the most out of each day. He also said the doctors could be wrong and that she just doesn't know what God has planned for her.</p> <p>TITLE: Grandfather Passed Away Last Night Brittany's grandfather passed away last night. She isn't sure how to move on, and she feels like it is a dream. Brittany lives with her grandparents and that makes this extra hard to handle. Dawson said that she is in shock, and that is a blessing. The shock helps protect us as we process through the situation and it is the first stage of grief. Dawson encouraged Brittany that she will get through this but it will take some time. He also told Brittany to get her emotions out and don't hold them in.</p> <p>TITLE: Has Relapsed, After 18 Months Clean Levi is struggling with alcohol. He was clean for 18 months and in the last few weeks has relapsed. He hasn't gotten to the point where he has gotten in trouble with it yet, but in the past he has had 6 alcohol poisonings and 9 overdoses. She has been clean for about a month and a half. They have five children. Sonya's husband began stealing to support their habit and is in prison. Dawson said at least they got caught before someone had an overdose, and that her husband being in prison might have been what enabled him to get off the drugs. She wanted to share with others that God loves them and they are not alone. For those who have experienced sexual abuse, she wants to encourage them to speak up for themselves and to know that it is not their fault.</p> <p>TITLE: Has Girlfriend But Likes Other Girls Brian is trying to get through high school, and has a girlfriend. However, Brian likes other girls. He is honest with his girlfriend about his unfaithfulness because he feels it is right for her to know. Brian is trying to fix everything that he has done wrong in the past. Dawson said at his age it is okay to date around, but he needs to release his girlfriend so that she doesn't continue to be hurt by him. He said to make it clear to her that their relationship isn't exclusive. Dawson told Brian not to bring needless drama in to his life or hers. He has been dealing with depression and through listening to Dawson's advice to others who are depressed he finally sought counseling help. Counseling has really helped him. Dawson reminds everyone that counseling is not a dirty word.</p> <p>TITLE: Found Out Baby Was Not His Chris is with a girl, she was pregnant and said it was his. He spent the nine months preparing to be a father. Two months after the baby was born he found out that the baby was not his. He talked to his family and decided to stay and be a father to the kid. Now he has turned to taking painkillers and heroine, to deal with the betrayal he felt with the child not being his. He has become addicted, but she does not know because he fears he will lose her and the child if she finds out. Dawson told Chris he cannot break this habit on his own and should come clean to his girlfriend and seek professional help. If does not get then he will lose her regardless.</p> <p>TITLE: Trying To Move In With Fiancé Amanda and her fiancé are trying to move in together. His parents are doing everything they can to stop them from moving in—took away his phone and car. She wants to feel worthy of their respect. Dawson told her that them respecting her is not the problem and she is not going to win the war against his parents because this is a spiritual issue for them. Dawson told her to stop the war and marry her fiancé.</p> <p>TITLE: Has To Have Complete Hysterectomy Ana was diagnosed with cervical cancer 4 weeks ago. At first it did not seem that bad, but now they find out the cancer has spread to her uterus. She is having a complete hysterectomy. She wanted to have a big family. Not being able to have kids makes her feel like less of a mom. She is searching for hope. Dawson that even though it looks dark now there is a light and to get healthy before she worries about adoption.</p>

It seems all they want to do is be on their electronic devices. It's making them lazy. She wants them to feel like there is more to life, but she doesn't want to be a bad person. She wants them to want that on their own. Jessica says she understands that Melissa wants them to get outside and get some fresh air and use their imagination. Dawson said you are not called to be their best friend. You are called to be an authority figure. Dawson said set times when they are not allowed to be on their devices. Help them get a balanced life and not become addicted to the internet.</p> <p>TITLE: Grew Up In A Drug Environment Dominique grew up in the drug culture. Her mom was a druggie. Dominique recently got clean. She has 3 sisters growing up in that same environment with her mom. Dominique has been told by her mom that she cannot see her little sisters anymore. Her sisters are 11, 8 and 6 years old. Dawson said it seems you need to get them out of there. She said she called DHS. Dawson her sisters are better off somewhere else, and that Dominique will have to blow the whistle and get those kids out of there. Plus, he doesn't trust a live-in boyfriend around 3 little girls. Dawson said to talk to a lawyer and get a plan to get them out.</p> <p>TITLE: Trying To Be Friends With Ex Alex and his girlfriend of two years broke up in November. She left for Army basic training. He remained faithful while she was gone, but she kissed a guy. They are still trying to be friends because they were friends before they started dating. She is bragging to him and everyone about her new boyfriend and saying how much happier she is with him. Dawson said that the relationship is over. Now is not the time to keep her as a good friend. Alex needs to take time to heal.</p> <p>TITLE: Thank You Dawson For Encouragement Bevin wanted to thank Dawson for all the encouragement he has given her and all the people who call in. She says Dawson is a true blessing. She loves that Dawson talks to everyone and does not sugarcoat the truth. She says to everyone in a relationship that is not working, that if it's meant to be, it's meant to be. Dawson agreed and says it takes time to heal from relationships too.</p>

They have become very close and he is like a father figure to her, and has even offered to walk her down the aisle if her father can't. Her parents are concerned that he is just getting close to her to use her. She knows her parents and friends would want the best for her. Dawson reiterated that point to her—that her parents are good people and her friends know her and can see when something is happening when even she can't. Her family and friends' fear gives Dawson pause and he said when in doubt, don't. There is too much doubt in this relationship with this man to feel comfortable.</p> <p>TITLE: Show Helped More Than Counseling Jacob had a wreck a few years ago with his then pregnant fiancé and both his fiancé and the unborn baby were killed. Jacob called Dawson for advice then. Jacob has now met a wonderful girl and she has helped him through difficult times and helped him through his drug addiction. He says the show has helped more than any counselor he ever sought out and says Dawson has a way of getting through to him. He has been drug free for three months and wanted to thank Dawson for all he does.</p> <p>TITLE: Turned Her Life Around Kimberly called about 7 years ago and Dawson told her to give an update. Kimberly started going to church, found her own direction, and started turning her life around. She is now married with five children, has bought a house, and is working as a nurse. Dawson says her new life can be attributed to the grace of God and her willingness to go to church and turn her life around.</p> <p>TITLE: Husband Attempted Suicide Twice Shantell's husband tried to commit suicide. They found out that he has bi-polar disorder, stage 2. He attempted suicide again, this time in front of her son. Her husband is mad at her for not letting him die. Now her husband is in an institution trying to get back on track. Dawson says to try to keep him in the institution as long as she can and that they may have people who she can talk to as well. There is only so much Shantell can do in this situation besides being real towards her husband and letting him know she, their family, and her son want him to live even he does not want too.</p>
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
