Jonathan feels lost and in a dark place. Dawson told Jonathan to keep listening; he said he would ask the listeners to call in with their advice and experience with losing a loved one.</p> <p>TITLE: Boyfriend Cheated On Her Kali's boyfriend told her he got a job in another town, and for a week the only communication they had was text. When Kali would try to talk to him she felt like something was wrong. Today he admitted that he has been cheating on her. He said he was going to get help with his depression and other issues, and he wants Kali to take him back. Kali said that she would support him getting help but wouldn't make any promises. Dawson said that it sounds like he doesn't grasp how much he has hurt her. Dawson said that there needs to be a 6-month to 1-year effort on his part before Kali could even consider getting back together with him. He told Kali not to focus on the fantasy of the good times they had, but the reality of what happened.</p> <p>TITLE: Peer To Peer Advice For Jonathan Destiny lost her mom in a car accident when she was younger. Destiny was only 7 when it happened and it took her years to move past it. She eventually had to realize that talking was the best thing for her. She went to counseling and learned some coping skills. She also learned to do some of the things she enjoyed doing with her mom and that helped her a lot. She encouraged Jonathan to hang out with people who loved his cousin and can share the good memories about him.</p> <p>TITLE: Thank You For The Show Shawn has listened to the show for a while and wanted to thank Dawson for all the help over the years. Shawn has had some suicide attempts as a result of being bullied. Since then his life has turned around and he has seen a lot of blessings come into his life. He wanted to encourage anyone struggling with these things that they aren't alone and to look for the good things in life.</p>

She and her mom fight, and then she attacks her mom both verbally and physically. Daniel's girlfriend's mom blames her outbursts on Daniel and tries to restrict their time together. Dawson feels like Daniel is at his breaking point and that something has to give. He said the physical outbursts make him very nervous and feels that they need a time out.</p> <p>TITLE: Husband Is Back After Rehab Again Becca's husband was in a rehab program and got out on Thursday. She wants to come up with a plan because they have been through several rehabs and programs over the years. Her husband is a good man and loves her and her children well but their biggest struggle is his addiction. He was molested from the age of 4 and abandoned by his mother. Dawson said that he has to continue with the rehab and deal with all of his past issues in order to conquer his addiction.</p> <p>TITLE: Hiding Depression From Friends Crystal isn't sure how to move on and be a better person. She is depressed but doesn't talk to her friends about it because she is afraid to be a downer. Dawson said that if she doesn't start talking to her friends it will kill her. He said they don't know the depth of what is going on with her, but that is what friends are for.</p> <p>TITLE: Brother Wants To Have Sex With Her Jessie's younger brother lives 30 minutes away with their grandparents. Jessie's brother keeps asking her to have sex. Jessie keeps telling him it's not ok to talk to her about that. Their birth mom died and they are adopted. Dawson said that this type of thing is never ok and that her brother needs a lot of help; and Jessie needs help because she has been wounded by this. Dawson said that Jessie needs someone in the family that can help talk to her younger brother about this. He encouraged Jessie to bring all of this to the light.</p>

Matthew has 2 kids but they are struggling in their marriage. He lost a great job over this. Now he is doing landscaping to keep their heads above water financially and just recently got a full time job at a warehouse. Matthew says that people doubt that he is trying to work on his issues and fix things. Dawson said that in time the doubters would see that he is making positive steps. He told Matthew to tell his wife that he is doing whatever it takes to love her more and keep their marriage together. He said to tell her upfront that he knows that he blew it and would be willing to go back to marriage counseling. He said that Matthew's wife will not be over this right away and that it will take some time.</p> <p>TITLE: Dating A Guy Who Sleeps Around Mindy met a guy and it turns out they both work for the same companies. They had spoken on the phone before at work and she didn't realize who he was when they met on the app. Mindy said he works full time and can only seem to find time for her when it is for sex. Mindy talked with one of her coworkers about it, and has heard from them that he has been sleeping with another lady there as well. Whenever Mindy tries to define their relationship he said that this is all he has time for right now. Mindy isn't sure if she should stop seeing him.</p> <p>TITLE: Peer To Peer Advice For Mindy Paris said that no matter how "hot" this guy is she needs to look at his intentions. She said the more Mindy sleeps with him the more attached she will get. Paris said if this is how it's starting it won't end well, and she should let him be someone else's problem.</p> <p>TITLE: Peer To Peer Advice For Mindy Tabitha advised Mindy to talk to him about how she feels and let him know that she wants a relationship. They have a child together and he isn't there consistently. She is the only one working to support them all, and she caught him with another woman at her friend's wedding. Now Leanne found out she is pregnant again. He has been doing drugs and drinking and Leanne doesn't know what to do. She moved out of the house about 6 months ago but he wants her to come back. He says he wants to change but she isn't seeing any of that really happen. Leanne isn't really sure what to do. Dawson told Leanne that he would ask the listeners to call in with their encouragement and advice.</p> <p>TITLE: Feeling Helpless About Past Abuse Courtney's mom was abusive toward her until she was 13 when her parents split up. Once her mom left, her dad started sexually abusing her. Courtney ended up telling a teacher what happened, and this teacher took her in. Now, Courtney isn't sure if she should have a relationship with him. Dawson said that she doesn't need to pretend everything is ok or put herself in a position where she can be violated again. Dawson told Courtney that next time she sees him it should be with a counselor or lawyer who can stand up to him on her behalf.</p> <p>TITLE: Peer To Peer Advice For Leanne Liz was in a similar situation. She was married and her husband was physically there but emotionally he was not. She said emotional abandonment and abuse is as real as physical, and she encouraged Leanne to get her kids in a healthier situation. She reminded Liz that she can't change him, and he needs to make those changes himself.</p> <p>TITLE: Peer To Peer Advice For Leanne Jonathan's fiancé of 6 years kicked him out because he wasn't holding up his end of the bargain. Jonathan said he was smoking weed and couldn't hold down a job. Jonathan said that being kicked out is what really motivated him to change and do everything he could to prove to her that he can be a good man. Jonathan advised Leanne to cut him off and if he really wants to be in her life he will do everything he can to change and improve.</p>

<p>Addiction Bullying Peer Advice Peer Advice</p>	<p>1/15/17</p>		<p>Hour 2</p> <p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Drugs Are All He Knows, Needs Advice John was a drug addict and sent to prison as a teenager, but that didn't stop him. John was out of prison for a short time before he was caught with more drugs and got sent back. When he was in prison his brother was killed in a high-speed chase while he was high on meth. Now that he is out again he is trying to be better but isn't sure how to cope with life without drugs. He has never had a job because he has always sold drugs for income. John has done everything he could to live clean since he got out of prison. He isn't sure how to maintain his sobriety and survive without drugs being a part of his life. His parole officer continues to tell him he doesn't deserve to be out of jail and is no good. Dawson invited the listeners to call in with their encouragement for John.</p> <p>TITLE: Being Bullied At Work Brandon is a firefighter. He has complained to his superiors about his coworkers messing with him. He knows some of that is part of what goes on in fire departments but Brandon feels like it is excessive. Brandon thought about going higher up the ladder but is afraid it will come back on him. Dawson told Brandon to talk to each guy one on one and say that enough is enough and he feels bullied. Dawson said if that doesn't work than he should go up the ladder all the way to the top if that is what it takes.</p> <p>TITLE: Peer To Peer Advice For John David has had the same path as John. He was a 4 time convicted felon. He told John not to let anyone tell you who you are and what you can be. He said if it wasn't for his wife he would be dead, with her help he pushed hard to recover his life.</p> <p>TITLE: Peer To Peer Advice For John Andrew went to prison from the time he was 19 until he was 24. He was able to succeed and make it in life when everyone told him he was no good. He said to use all the negative words said to him as fuel to give him energy to put work into changing his life.</p>

Her friends keep sending her screen shots of texts he is sending to other girls, but he says he is not cheating on her. Dawson said there is no reason for her friends to lie to her because they care about her. Dawson said to be transparent with him about what her concerns are.</p> <p>TITLE: Stripper Mom Deserts Daughter Zachary married the girl of his dreams. They had a child together and that encouraged him to marry her. His wife has left him multiple times, and he has walked out twice. The most recent time she beat him up. She has been gone about a month and a half now. Zachary has her daughter all the time and she didn't even ask him about her for 3 weeks. She is a stripper and smokes weed and then berates him on Facebook. Zachary plans on getting a divorce but now she wants to see her daughter. Zachary has two kids from a previous relationship who he rarely gets to see and he doesn't want to do the same thing to his wife. Dawson said he has to protect his daughter. Dawson invited the listeners to call in and give their advice.</p> <p>TITLE: Peer To Peer Advice For Zachary Tiffany said that God has placed Zachary in his daughter's life as provider and protector and he needs to put that responsibility first. She also encouraged him to get a lot of documentation on the things his wife is doing.</p> <p>TITLE: Troubled Marriage Not Improving Jessica has been married for 5 years. She feels like each year she pushes herself to give it one more year to get better. She has found pictures on his phone of other women. He was deployed and she thought when he got home things would be different, but now things seem worse. They fight about money and he doesn't even come out of his bedroom to spend time with the family. Jessica got a job but he doesn't want her to work. Dawson said that she needs a support system around her and suggested possibly involving herself in a local church. Dawson encouraged her to get some counseling for her marriage and work on getting the support she needs. Jessica said that maybe she will need to start the counseling on her own and maybe eventually her husband will join her.</p>
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<p>Relationship Family Positive Suicide</p>	<p>1/15/17</p>		<p>Hour 4</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Scared To Leave Abusive Relationship Ceiera has twin girls. She has been living with their dad for two years. When he gets upset lately he has been hitting her. Ceiera is afraid that if she leaves he will come after them; she has left before and he always finds her. She met another man at her job. She is scared to leave her girls' dad but knows bringing a new guy into their life will cause new issues. Dawson said regardless of the new man, she has to take care of the situation with the girls' father. Dawson said there are organizations in her area that will help her get away from the abusive man. He said it is too dangerous for her and her children to stay there. Dawson also said that only after she gets out of this situation and has time to get stable should she even think about contacting the new guy.</p> <p>TITLE: Mom Stole Her Identity Athena's biological mother left her and her half-sister's dad adopted her. Athena's mom came back into her life and stole her identity to commit fraud. Athena suffers from anxiety and PTSD and hasn't really had luck with talking to anyone about her issues. Dawson said that there is so much going on that it is too overwhelming for her to deal with. He said that she needs a counselor to help her sort through all her problems.</p> <p>TITLE: Thank You For Your Help, Dawson Tami is calling to say thank you. Two years ago Tami called in and Dawson gave her advice and prayed with her. She said it does get easier and things are a lot better now. She said looking to God and also going to therapy and talking things out helped.</p> <p>TITLE: Suicidal and Depressed About Life Lauren is struggling with suicidal thoughts. Lauren takes care of her daughter and her niece. Her daughter's dad is a drug addict and hasn't seen them in over a year. Lauren's daughter has special needs and a feeding tube. Lauren's water got cut off and she can't find a job. She feels alone and depressed. Dawson said she needs a team of people around her. Terri says that her husband tells her he wants her back, but he has been messing around with another woman. Dawson said that Terri's husband has said cruel and awful things to her and her son, and it is Terri's job to protect her child. He has cheated on her and violated her respect and because of that Dawson said that the relationship has to end. Dawson advised Terri to focus on getting healthier and moving on.</p> <p>TITLE: Depression Still With Her After Years Nicole struggles with depression and anxiety and is looking for advice on how to get help. She has dealt with it for over 10 years, and it is now starting to physically impact her. Nicole has talked to her minister, and thought it might be post-partum. Dawson said to go back to her minister and explain that this has lasted several years, and to ask her to walk through finding a counselor and/or a psychiatrist who can evaluate her situation and get her the help she needs.</p> <p>TITLE: Grandmother Dying Of Liver Cancer Jessica's grandmother has stage 4 liver cancer.
