They met online, and she is flying to meet him in about 2 weeks. He is Muslim and Paige is Christian and he is fine with that. Her friends support her but her family is not happy about this and the fact that she is traveling so far. She said that she has no red flags about taking this trip. Dawson said that he would get some advice from other listeners, but also said that when your parents and people who are close to you aren't ok with something she needs to think twice about it.</p> <p>TITLE: Recovering Alcoholic Needs To Focus Phillip has been an alcoholic for several years and gave it up last year. He met a woman who saw him at his worst point, and about a month before he hit his one-year anniversary he stopped talking to her. AA suggests that you wait a year before getting into a relationship. Now she is seeing another guy but she still wants to be best friends and Phillip is really unhappy about having lost the opportunity to be with her. Dawson said that this is not healthy for him and he could be putting his sobriety at risk. He encouraged Phillip to focus on bettering himself and staying sober right now.</p> <p>TITLE: Advice For Paige Sylvia did the same thing a few years back. She met a guy from Tunisia on line and flew over there. She stayed 4 weeks and it ruined her life. Sylvia said that men from Tunisia think American women are rich and have a history of doing these types of things to get money. She said it is very dangerous and she would never do this again.</p> <p>TITLE: Advice For Paige Lorrie suggested that Paige do a Facetime with him to see his face and make sure she knows who she is talking to. She said Paige needs to know where the US Embassy's are, and have duplicates of all her documents and passport info. She said there are kidnapping schemes all over the world and Paige needs to think with her head rather than her heart.</p>

They became best friends and Kyle started to “like” her more than she does him. He would like advice on how to break his romantic feelings for her and still remain friends. Dawson said that it would take time and Kyle should be kind and loving toward her, but not chase her or obsess over her. Dawson also suggested finding a good friend, counselor, or teacher to talk through what he can learn through this situation to better equip him for the next relationship.</p> <p>TITLE: Cheating Boyfriend Wants Her Back Brittany started dating her ex 5 years ago and they have been on and off all of this time. He cheated on Brittany with 3 of her good friends. He used to do a lot of drinking and drug use, and he got physical with her. They are currently broken up but now he wants to get back together with her. Dawson said that Brittany would be a fool to take him back. He said that he hasn’t shown her respect in any way and he isn’t going to change.</p> <p>TITLE: Fiancé Is Not Her Mom’s Favorite Jeannie feels torn between her mom and fiancé. They started dating when they were 18 and got engaged a short time later. Her mom doesn’t like her fiancé because they fought a lot when they first started dating. Dawson feels like she should just tell her fiancé she needs time to concentrate on her mom and then once that relationship is in a better place they can discuss where to go from here.</p> <p>TITLE: Feels Like Ending It Like His Dad Did Lane is feeling suicidal. When he was younger his dad committed suicide. The people around him joked around about his dad’s death. People harass him on social media and in person. Lane knows he has a lot to look forward to, but sometimes he thinks maybe they are right and he should choose suicide. Dawson told the audience that Lane will speak with the hope coaches who are experts in dealing with suicide, but he also invited the listeners to call in with their encouragement.</p>

His dad is in his last days and under hospice care. Hanlen knows his dad is a believer and where he is going but it is still the unknown. Dawson said that even though his dad is going to heaven Hanlen will still be here dealing with this loss. He reminded Hanlen that he was able to work through the grief of losing his brother and eventually come out on the other side, and that will happen again. Dawson said he is going to have others call in with their advice and encouragement.</p> <p>TITLE: Fighting Parents Caused Him To Leave Cody called last month about his parent's fighting and Dawson advised him to go stay with someone else at the time. Cody took his advice and went to stay with his grandfather for a little while and then with another friend. His dad seems to be doing better but his mom wants Cody to come back home to keep his dad in check. Dawson told Cody not to move back home. He said to keep the door open to his relationship with his parents but to continue to give them the space they need to work on themselves without him getting involved.</p> <p>TITLE: Encouragement For Hanlen Patrick has experienced loss and wanted Hanlen to know that nothing except time will stop the hurt. He advised Hanlen to have a little token from his dad that he can look at and smile and remember the good times with his dad.</p> <p>TITLE: Thinking Of Joining The Military Josiah hasn't been getting along with his dad. He kicked him out once when he was 17 and his dad told everyone he ran away instead of the truth. Josiah got a car and the loan was in his dad's name. Josiah is trying to pay off the car but now his dad is threatening to sell the car out from under him. Josiah is thinking about joining the military. Dawson told Josiah that he needs a plan; he thinks getting into the air force is a good idea. Grief Family Positive Self-Image	10/9/16		Hour 3	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Multiple Losses Are Hard To Live With Gage lost his best friend six years ago. They had gotten into a fight. Gage felt bad and called his mom and asked what he should do, and Gage's mom suggested he go over and work it out. Gage walked in and his friend shot himself right in front of Gage. Then a year ago Gage's friend's younger brother killed himself. In a few days they are having a memorial service for both boys. Gage is also being kicked out of the house so he isn't sure if he should travel to the memorial service or if he should stay home and pack. Dawson said that Gage is grieving both of these deaths as well as the situation with his family. He told Gage he would ask the listeners to call in with their advice.</p> <p>TITLE: Struggling With His Child's Mother Jeff and his child's mother have struggled to get along. Jeff says that she was acting like she was going to hurt their son, so Jeff went over to her house and was put in jail. Now his mom has temporary custody of their son. Jeff wants to continue to grow and co-parent and be on the same page with her. Dawson told Jeff to get a good lawyer who can tell him what to do, and continue to try to provide stability for his son and build the relationship with his son's mother.</p> <p>TITLE: Encouragement For Gage Sam said Gage should not feel guilty, because you can't be held responsible for anyone's actions, only your own. Sam said that he should go to the memorial to get closure. She said that the family may talk bad about him but at least he can feel he did the right thing. Dawson agrees but advised Gage not to go alone, but to bring friends with him.</p> <p>TITLE: Insecure Due To Sister Stealing Her Man Heather dated a guy who seemed great and got along with the family. Heather's boyfriend ended up sleeping with her sister. Heather's sister says she was raped but in Heather's eyes it was consensual. She feels her younger sisters are much prettier than her. She likes a new guy and is afraid he will go for her sister. Dawson reminded Heather when she cuts herself down it also cuts her date down for choosing her. Dawson also suggested patching things up with her sister.</p>

Relationship Family Family Relationship	10/9/16		Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Ex-Girlfriend Won't Stop Calling John's girlfriend left him with no warning. They had lost a child about two months before that, and John's alcoholism resurfaced. In the last few weeks she keeps calling him. John is still in love with her but something deep inside tells him not to talk to her. Dawson said that John should spend time working on himself without having to deal with the drama she brings to the table. He recommended getting a message to her saying he won't talk to her while he works on himself.</p> <p>TITLE: Abusive Dad Won't Attend Her Wedding Abby's dad divorced her mom 3 years ago after 30 years of marriage. He is drinking heavily and was verbally and physically abusive. Abby is getting married and always dreamed of dancing with her dad at her wedding but he doesn't want anything to do with her. Dawson said that Abby shouldn't expect anything from her dad. Dawson suggested that Abby work on forgiving her dad, and also to get into premarital counseling so that she doesn't carry this into her new marriage.</p> <p>TITLE: Open Adoption Challenges Baylie did an open adoption with her 6-year-old and her 2-year-old. Recently, the adoptive family accused Baylie's mother of abusing these children when she stayed with them in Colorado. Baylie's mom passed a lie detector test and Baylie wants to stick up for her mom but also wants to support her children. Baylie has gone to visit her children yearly and isn't sure how to deal with this. Dawson said going there now might make things worse. He said she should talk to a lawyer but advised not getting in the middle. Dawson said it is painful but she has to let her mother and the adoptive mother work this out.</p> <p>TITLE: Girlfriend Feeling Smothered Timothy was released from prison about 6 months ago. He met a woman who is 10 years older than him whose husband abused and cheated on her. Timothy is trying his best to love her and treat her well. It went fine for a few months but now things seem to be going downhill and she feels smothered. Dawson said that this relationship went way too fast and needs to back up.</p>

He and his wife are currently living with them because they lost their jobs. Tori got a good job and has recently even been promoted. No matter how much Tori tries to prove himself, they continue to feel it's not good enough. Dawson said that Tori needs to do whatever he can to get out of his in-laws house. He said that saving money is not enough of a reason to allow his self-esteem to be trashed in this way.</p> <p>TITLE: Abusive Dad Threatening Son Patrick is a cutter. His best friend died in 8th grade and that's when he started. When his dad found out he threatened to beat him and kick him out of the house. He stopped cutting about a month ago. He lives with his dad but is very afraid of him. When he was 9, his dad once got so mad at him that he broke his arm. Patrick's mom lives in another part of the state. She has been through rehab and is doing really well. Dawson suggested that Patrick go stay with his mom. He told Patrick that he can't stay with his dad if he feels so threatened.</p> <p>TITLE: Boyfriend Depressed From Accident Logyn's boyfriend was in an accident, which has caused chronic pain, and he is in a deep depression. He isn't working either. Logyn still sees him as he was before the accident and isn't ready to give up on him even though he cheated on her in the past. Dawson said that her boyfriend has to want to make a change and there is even a possibility that she is enabling him to stay stuck in the place he is. Dawson told Logyn to call back when she is ready to make a change.</p> <p>TITLE: Fiancé's Family Is Stirring Up Trouble Ashley has been with her fiancé for 5 years. His ex has been involved and is really close with his family. Somehow they convinced his family to hate her. His ex is invited to all the family functions but Ashley is not. Now her fiancé isn't really talking to his mom. This other girl is harassing Ashley and she is getting the cops involved. Dawson said the person paying for all of this is Ashley. He suggested telling her fiancé that they need a time out until his family can resolve this issue.</p>
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<p>Positive Relationship Relationship Relationship</p>	<p>10/16/16</p>		<p>Hour 3</p> <p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Turning Her Life Around Gives Hope Katelyn has been using drugs since she was 15. She went to treatment for two years but she relapsed. Some family friends reached out to her and she moved in with them. Since then she started going to church, has gotten saved, is taking parenting classes and is now starting college. She wants to encourage anyone listening who is fighting this battle that there is hope. Dawson said that so much of the healing she needs from all of this is spiritual.</p> <p>TITLE: Ex Girlfriend Still Hanging Around Chris's ex girlfriend cheated on him about a year and a half ago while he was out of the country. They broke up but she is still around and is causing issues with Chris's new girlfriend. She goes to school where he does so he feels like he can't avoid her. Dawson suggested a restraining order. He also suggested trying to find some mutual friends who love her and will talk to her about the situation and how it is making problems for him.</p> <p>TITLE: Divorcing But Getting It Together Arianna is going through a divorce. She was unemployed but now has a new job. She is going back to school to get a GED but still her depression is bad. Arianna is the one who ended the relationship because he wouldn't get a job or help with their son. Now he has a lot of people trying to testify against her that she is a bad mom. Dawson encouraged her to look at all of the good things that are happening and the progress she is making.</p> <p>TITLE: A Bad Situation For Her Children Victoria and her boyfriend had a big fight and he tried to get physical. Victoria told him if he didn't change she was going to leave him. They have 2 children together. She has been having sex with her boyfriend's best friend and business partner. Dawson said that this is going to break her kids' hearts, because their father isn't going to be around in the same way he has been. Dawson said this new guy isn't solving her problems but is uncovering them. He stressed how serious this situation is. He suggested she go back to the new guy and tell him it is over and what they are doing is wrong. Then Dawson said she and her current boyfriend should go to counseling and let this be brought to the light in that way.</p>
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<p>Relationship Relationship Depression Addiction</p>	<p>10/16/16</p>		<p>Hour 4</p> <p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Controlling Behavior Could Be Red Flag Madison and her boyfriend have been together for two years. Because his ex-wife cheated on him he doesn't talk about marriage and whenever it comes up he shuts down the conversation. Madison doesn't want to get married today, but just wants to have a conversation about where their relationship is headed. He doesn't want Madison talking to other people about their relationship. A lot of her friends don't like him. Dawson said that it sounds like her boyfriend has a lot of control issues. He also said that if he doesn't want to talk about marriage, then his answer is no.</p> <p>TITLE: Marriage Off To Rough Start Kyla struggles with anxiety and depression due to past sexual and physical abuse. She recently married again. They had a fight and Kyla slapped him. She says he is trying to do everything he can to make this work but Kyla knows she is taking out her past on him. Kyla's daughter has been traumatized by her past relationships as well. Dawson said that because they both realize their mistakes and that they need help there is a glimmer of hope for them. Dawson suggested that Kyla move out and they get counseling for both of them and for her daughter, then once they are in a better place they can consider moving back in together.</p> <p>TITLE: Depression And Lack of Social Skills Christian has been going through depression. He was bullied all throughout school. He is trying to figure out what he can do to improve his ability to communicate with people and make friends. Dawson suggested going to see someone who can do blood tests to see if he has an imbalance in his chemistry. He also suggested that he go to counseling for help with his depression and social issues.</p> <p>TITLE: Married To An Addict Is Difficult Tanner has been married for a little over a year. He has discovered that his wife is addicted to pills and has a gambling problem. Tanner feels like his marriage is based on a lie. He has a lot of trust issues now. Dawson said she has an addictive personality but the relationship is still worth fighting for.
