Dawson reassured her that she doesn't need to go to a church with a lot of rules to be a Christian and that she should lovingly "stick to her guns" about her faith. Dawson reminded her to stay loving and kind, but when her mom starts preaching to her, to remind her mom that she is there because she loves her but not to hear this type of preaching.</p> <p><b>TITLE: College Freshman Dating HS Freshman</b>            Brian is 19 years old and dating a 15 year old. Bailey said she has tried to talk to her mom about this but doesn't feel like she is getting through. Bailey has thought about suicide and cutting to help relieve the pain of this rejection. Dawson said Bailey needs to find another mother figure in her life to help fill this hole and needs to talk to her mom about this and tell her honestly how she has been contemplating suicide.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Feels Life In Downward Spiral</b> Adam's dad passed away just before he graduated high school. Adam says that his dad was his best friend and ever since his death he feels life has been in a downward spiral. Whenever something goes wrong and he doesn't have his dad there to help him work through it he has bad thoughts about hurting himself. Dawson said he needs to stop communicating with his ex-girlfriend because she is just kicking him when he is already down. Dawson said he needs some counseling.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Hasn't Been Connecting With Mom</b> Carli's mom is her best friend, but she hasn't felt like she has been able to connect with her since her husband passed away. Carli wants to know how she can do a better job of supporting her. Dawson said Carli needs to realize she isn't responsible for her, but she needs to just be present for her and let her know that she loves her and is praying for her. Dawson also said that Carli needs to make sure she is around people who encourage her as well.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Just Found Out She Is Adopted</b> Ali found out 4 days ago that she is adopted. Ali's adopted father passed away a couple of years ago. Ali's mom doesn't want Ali to have anything to do with her biological family because she is afraid of losing Ali. Ali's biological father and brother are going to be coming through town and she isn't sure if she wants to meet them. Dawson said to comfort and reassure her mom that she isn't going to lose Ali. Dawson recommended that Ali and her mom attend counseling together.</p>

A couple months ago, he and his wife had a daughter who only lived about six hours. Ryan's wife wants to try for another child but Ryan feels it may be too soon. Dawson suggested he compare what happened with the death of their baby to the physical wounds they can see on the outside... the loss of his leg. Dawson said this is still a time for Ryan to be healing, and if they need to, they can go to counseling to work through this.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Went Through Nasty Divorce</b> Nate went through a nasty divorce in 2012. His ex-wife was having multiple affairs and living a double life. They were together for 5 years and married for 6 months. Nate received full custody of his daughter. Nate has been dating someone since July, and she was in a similar situation with her ex. Dawson said Nate has not forgiven or let go of girl #1, and he needs to be honest about that with his girlfriend so that he doesn't lose her. Dawson said there is too much wounding to heal on its own, so they both need to get in to counseling.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Ex Is Pregnant</b> Christopher's ex is 4 months pregnant and has told him that she doesn't want anything to do with him. Christopher is planning to have a paternity test once the baby is born. Dawson recommended that Christopher get a lawyer and get a clear plan of action together. Dawson also said to make sure his name is included on the baby's birth certificate.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Baby's Dad Denying Child Is His</b> Magda is 6 months pregnant and the baby's father is spreading rumors about her, sharing personal information, and denying that the child is his. Dawson recommends Magda stay away from this guy because he isn't the type of person to love and support her, and he will only continue to hurt her. Magda is staying at a home for pregnant teens, and Dawson said he believes they can help her make a plan for her next steps when the baby is born.</p>

Jasmine's mom made her move out because her step dad was being verbally and physically abusive toward her. Jasmine is worried about her younger sister who is living in the abusive home. Dawson pointed out that Jasmine's mom had the soundness of mind to move Jasmine out and get her to a safe place. He also recommended that she talk to her sister and make sure she knows that if these same things ever happen to her to come to her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: May Have Eating Disorder</b>  Natalie has read about symptoms of an eating disorder on-line and says she has the symptoms. Natalie says that her mother is too involved in her life. Natalie said that eating is an area of her life that she can control and make decisions. Dawson said it sounds like she is looking for control in an area. He also said that many counselors tie eating disorders to relationships with a mother. He recommended that it is time for Natalie to talk to a minister or counselor, because not taking care of herself physically will eventually catch up with her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Parents Didn't Know She Was Dating</b>  Kristina broke up with her boyfriend earlier this week. Kristina said they argued often and she blames herself. Kristina has a good relationship with her parents, but they don't know she is dating because they are strict. Dawson said the sneaking around behind her parents back can cause additional stress in her relationships. Dawson recommended that she focus on working on her relationship with her parents rather than working on dating right now.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Fiancé's Story Keeps Changing</b>  Kelly's fiancé's grandmother recently passed away and she willed her home and funds to her and her fiancé. However, Kelly is concerned that her fiancé is not being truthful with her and she isn't sure if their relationship is going to last. Kelly feels the story changes and grows all the time. Dawson said this story sounds fishy and that it sounds like if he is a liar, he needs some help to figure out why he made up this story.</p>

Family Family Relationship Abuse	4/13/14		Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Rebuild Relationship With Family</b> Aaron says he has been in and out of foster care his whole life. He would like to see more of his family but his biological father is on drugs and Aaron doesn't know how to handle that. Dawson recommended that Aaron needs a coach and said they can provide that through the Hope Line. Dawson also said to take very slow steps toward rebuilding his relationship with his family, considering their history.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Taken To Secluding Herself</b> Kim is trying to figure out how to cope with her situation. Kim was forced out of her dad and step mother's rules since she couldn't follow their rules. Now she has moved in with her birth mom and she has taken to secluding herself from everyone. Dawson encouraged Kim that she is now in a better place, and to ask her mom to help her find someone who she can talk with about her feelings about her birth father cutting her out of his life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Ex Is Now Seeing Her Sister</b> Ashley was in a 5 year relationship that broke up about two weeks ago, and they have a 3 year old son. Ashley says her ex-boyfriend didn't have his priorities right. Now Ashley has found out that he is seeing her sister and she doesn't know what to do next. Dawson said that it is expected that she would hurt after 5 years and the betrayal by her sister, but that her three year old has to be her first priority. Dawson reminded her that these are the formative years for her son and she may have to cut back on school and make him a priority.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Feels Unsafe Around Guys</b> Allison's mom dated a child molester when she was 5 years old and she was raped by him for about 2 years while her mother was at work. Ashley's brother eventually found someone to tell about what is happening. Ashley and her brother were taken from their home and put in to foster care. Allison is afraid and isn't sure how to be safe with a guy. Dawson recommended that she obtain a lot of counseling to help her work through what she has been through and her fears that have come about as a result of what has happened to her in the past.</p>

He has no idea why she did it. He might have unintentionally taken out some anger on her in their phone conversations. It's killing him every day that he doesn't know what happened or if they could have fixed it. Dawson said, in time you will be glad you found out about this, not every woman is wired to be married to a marine. She probably realized she was not equipped to be the wife of a marine. Start praying now for the girl you are going to marry.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Sober For 90 Days</b> Jeff is 90 days sober from alcohol and drugs. He said when the lows happen then he is better equipped to handle them now. Jeff said he does NA meetings pretty much every day. He wants to encourage others that it's better being sober. Jeff said he has given his will and himself over to God (step 3 in NA). No matter all the bad stuff he has done in his life, God has still forgiven him. Dawson said yes and if he has forgiven you then you can forgive yourself.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Relationship With Parents Not Good</b> James' relationship between his dad and step-mom and him has not been good. They don't want to talk to him unless they need something from him. James wants to build a better relationship with them. Dawson said, sit down with him and lovingly ask how you can make their world better and ask what you can do to make your relationship with them better. You are not going to live or die by their words but try it and see what happens.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Started Drinking Again</b> Chris started drinking when he was 16 years old and started again recently. He and his girlfriend broke up a few months ago and since then he has been drinking and things have been going downhill. Dawson said do what you were doing before that worked for you. Dawson said until you are dead, you are alive and if you are alive then there is hope. Do the things that you did while you were sober and do it with accountability and get back to AA.</p>
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<p>Family Positive Family Suicide</p>	<p>4/20/14</p>	<p>Hour 3</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Wants To Be Strong For Mom</b> Vanessa wants to remind her mom about the bad things her dad did to her mom, because her dad hasn't been around so her mom is only remembering the good things about him. Dawson said tell your mom you love her and respect her and tell her the reasons and tell her that you need her around. Here is a great quote by Jesus: "You will know the truth and the truth will set you free." For you not to tell her how you feel would be unloving and disrespectful.</p> <p><b>TITLE: You Are Not Insignificant</b> Abby was listening to the show last week and heard Dawson come on the air. She said she loves what Dawson is doing. She wants to let everyone out there to know you are never alone, you are not insignificant, you are not too fat, and you are not not good enough. There is always someone out there for you. You just have to take that first step and once you do that you will not want to stop walking.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Sister Tells Coworkers Her Business</b> Brittany's sister will tell everyone else they work with about Brittany's business. How does she tell her sister to stop running her life without coming across rude or pushing her away? Brittany said she does have a wise friend, a grandfather type. Dawson said talk it all out in depth with him and see if he will meet with you and your sister. Dawson said you talk to your sister from your heart and tell her what you told me that you are responsible adult now.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Feeling Suicidal After Many Suicides</b> Sarah was a senior in high school, 2 years ago and she lost 3 friends to suicide and a friend was murdered, all within 6 months of each other. And tonight she found out a guy she goes to school with just committed suicide. She started smoking and partying and drinking and stealing a few years ago and she even felt suicidal at that time. She does not want to bring the pain that her friends brought to her to other people in her life. Dawson said you have not been able to uncouple it; the cloud is hanging over your head and raining every day. We need to work one on one on each of these crises.</p>
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<p>Positive Relationship Relationship Family</p>	<p>4/20/14</p>	<p>Hour 4</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Best Friend Hit By 18-Wheeler</b> Virgil's best friend got hit by an 18-wheeler at the beginning of the year. Dawson talked to another person about a similar situation and it helped Virgil through this situation with his friend. His friend is partially walking and he is talking. Dawson said it could have been a divine appointment you had listening to the radio show. Dawson said he is miracle guy that's for sure and I appreciate that you are part of the show.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Boyfriend Serving Jail Time</b> Avery has been on and off with her boyfriend. He got arrested this year for selling and doing drugs. He is serving jail time now. Everyone has told her she needs to break up with him and leave him. Avery said she tried to move on but she cried nonstop for a few days. Avery doesn't want to hurt him and she doesn't want to hurt anyone else. Dawson said: I'm not worried about you hurting him. Dawson said you do need to walk away. Your family and friends are right and if they are all saying it then that means something.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend Always Wants To Quit</b> Jeremy's girlfriend always wants to give up and quit the relationship when things get rough. She doesn't talk about it or deal with it; she just ignores it for a while. Jeremy said he feels he carries all the weight. Dawson said you know what to do; it's one of those times where everyone is telling you the same thing. You are carrying the whole relationship and you have a troubled girl on your hands and it's tearing you apart and you are done with it. You need to end it.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Dad Is An Alcoholic And Sick</b> Kayla's dad is an alcoholic he has cirrhosis of the liver and he also has Hepatitis C. And because he still drinks his medicine is not effective. Kayla has tried to be there for him but she had to move far way because her step-mother told some lies about her. Dawson said: you need to send him a message that you love him but you are preparing for him to die and maybe that will get his attention. And then you tell him you can't be there for him all the time since you are so far away.</p>

His parents paid for his first year of college but now are not. He failed his classes last year. Dawson tells him to let his parents know that he is thankful for what his parents have done for him, and that he wants to stay in school, he can work a job while he is going through school and show his parents that he is trying. Dawson says that he has never seen anyone get help that didn't want the help, and his brother doesn't want the help right now. Dawson says that you reap what you sow, if you reap good stuff then you'll get back good stuff.</p>

Her daughter got diagnosed with Leukemia and is 5 years old. She has to go through chemo for 2 years. They currently have a year left of chemo, she is in maintenance now to make sure things are fine. Her aunt and dad also got cancer this year. She is feeling low now. Dawson says that she has to do things to take care of herself and to nurture herself. Dawson says that she needs to reach out because she is exhausted.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Torn Up Over Losing Family Members</b> Christa lost family members and is torn up inside over it. Dawson says that we don't know why these things happen, but we can ask God for help and we can pray and cry and write out our feelings. She can get counseling or join a grieving group. Dawson says that it will take time and that things will get better and she will learn the deeper things of life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Fiancée Pregnant, Hasn't Told Family</b> Warren's current fiancée is pregnant and is scared to tell her mom. He is hiding it from his family as well. Dawson says that every day that his fiancée doesn't tell her mom is another day of disrespect to her mom, and the stress that she is going through by hiding it is going to hurt the baby. Dawson says that if she doesn't tell, then he should. Dawson says that he should sit down with his fiancée and her mom and let her know. Warren says he doesn't know what he should say. Dawson tells him to talk to his parents and then let his fiancée know that they both need to talk to her mom soon.</p> <p><b>TITLE: In Love With Troubled Girl</b> Jason met a woman a few years ago, who was in a bad situation, so he helped her out. Her family made a big scene out of nothing and she ended up putting a protective order against him and then DHS got involved. He was in school and when she found out she started showing up at his school. Dawson says that he is dealing with a troubled girl from a troubled family and his life is now affected by this. Dawson says that he is in a mess and needs a plan to deal with things, and when he marries a woman he marries the whole family.</p>
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
