Family Addiction Suicide Family	10/4/15		Hour 2	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Invite Adoptive Parents To Wedding?</b>            Tangee's adoptive mother was abusive in many ways. Tangee is getting married and she wants her adoptive family there but is afraid they will cause drama. Tangee's fiancé thinks that she should cut her adoptive parents out of her life. Dawson told her that she has to respect her fiancé's opinion. Dawson advised that they not be invited to the wedding because it is just going to stress everyone out. He also suggested that she get some counseling to get healed from the years of abuse.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Feels Better About Life When He Drinks</b>            Austin is in a relationship and already has two kids. Austin's dad was an alcoholic and his mom was a drug dealer. Now, Austin is an alcoholic. He says when he drinks he feels better about life. Austin has 2 DWI's currently, but wants to give his kids the life that they deserve. Dawson said that he needs to get help right away and to go to AA and follow the plan they give or it will only get worse.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Is There More She Should Have Done?</b>            Natalie has had a lot of friends who have committed suicide. Natalie tries to be a good friend and a listening ear for people. Recently, a close family friend committed suicide. Natalie feels like she maybe could have done something more. Dawson said that it is obvious that Natalie is a very tender-hearted person. He told Natalie that she has to get a little toughness if she wants to be the person who can help others. Dawson doesn't want Natalie to blame herself when these things happen.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Angry With Grandmother</b>            Larissa's mom passed away in May from bone cancer. Larissa's grandmother volunteered to go take care of her mom but then moved away with this guy and left her mom hanging. Larissa is very angry with her grandmother now that her mom has passed away. Larissa knows that she needs to forgive but she doesn't know how. Dawson said that forgiveness means giving up your right to get even. Dawson said what her grandmother did is inexcusable but it's not unforgiveable.</p>

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Addiction Relationship Positive Family	10/4/15		Hour 3	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Addicted To Painkillers</b>            John has an addiction to painkillers. It started with an injury when he was 18. John has stolen from his parents to support his addiction as well as pawning their things. John knows he needs to stop, and he wants to stop. Dawson told John he was going to end up in jail, a psych ward, or the morgue if he doesn't do something about this now. Dawson said that they would try to find him a counselor.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Hard Time Connecting With People</b>            Jessica doesn't have any good friends. Even in college she had some surface level friendships but nothing deep. Jessica doesn't feel like she connects with anyone, even at work or in her family. Jessica doesn't care and she knows it is unwise to live in solitude. Dawson told Jessica that she is robbing others of what she has to offer, and that is selfish. Dawson said that people are perceptive and are reading that she doesn't want to have a deep relationship. He said that most people are too insecure to fight through the barriers that she has.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Thank You For The Help</b>            Becky called a few weeks ago with boy issues. She had 3 boys who were pursuing her at the time, and Dawson advised her not to date any of them. Becky said that her call with Dawson gave her the courage she needed to tell these guys how she felt and what she was looking for in a relationship. Now, Becky feels a lot better and says thank you.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Trying To Make Mom Proud</b>            Breanna and her mom have never had a super close connection. Breanna has tried to do everything possible to make her proud. Breanna has been the troublemaker in the past, has partied and gotten in to drugs. Breanna also is deaf in one ear and they also make comments about this disability. Breanna isn't sure how to make her proud. Dawson said that Breanna needs to do some things to help herself, but to do it for herself and not to impress her mom. Dawson reminded Breanna that she can't control her mom's attitude, but that can't stop Breanna from doing what is right to improve herself.</p>

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Grief Stress Family Self-Harm	10/4/15		Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Void In Her Life Since Sister Died</b>            Tatum took 2 years off school to care for her sister before she died. Tatum has felt a void in her life once her sister died. Tatum said that she knows she has a special place in her heart to help others and wants to be an RN. Dawson said that Tatum needs to allow herself to celebrate the beauty that has come through the pain. He reminded Tatum that what she went through was very hard but that her sister also brought great joy to her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Doesn't Feel As If She Belongs Anywhere</b>            Clay-Leah has been homeless for the last 3-4 months, and has been living in her car. Clay-Leah doesn't feel like she can ever help others since she can't even help herself. Clay-Leah doesn't feel like she belongs anywhere. Dawson said that someday Clay-Leah will help many people who are in a similar situation. He told her that there are ways to turn her challenges into positives if she can stop thinking negatively.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Still Not Sure Who Her Birth Father Is</b>            Tamara's mom introduced her to 3 different guys as "her father." She found out for sure one wasn't, the other was her brother's dad, and there was a third guy who she eventually pushed away. She started to reach out to this third guy again, but then she found out he passed away. Tamara still isn't sure who her birth father is. Dawson said he senses there is a big ache in Tamara's heart over the confusion in her life, and what her mom did to her. He also recommends that she find counseling to help her forgive her mom.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Feels Worthless, Has Cutting Addiction</b>            Alissa feels worthless and has an addiction to cutting. She was raped multiple times. She was in an emotionally and sexually abusive relationship for about 3 years. Alissa doesn't go regularly to her counseling appointments. Dawson advised Alissa to call her therapist and make that next appointment. He told her that she is blaming herself, and there is no excuse for someone to violate her.</p>

Relationship Friendship Abuse Family	10/11/15		Hour 2	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Guy Said They Need To Have Sex</b>            Blair is really interested in a guy who told her the other day that they had to have sex in order to be happy. Blair has kept her virginity through high school, but this guy is saying that having sex is the only way to truly be in love. Dawson said that he doesn't love her, or he wouldn't be asking her to violate her standards. Dawson asked Blair to think ahead to her wedding night and what kind of memories she wants to have in her head when she is having sex with her husband for the first time.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Surrounded By Men, Needs Girl Friends</b>            Sarah joined the military in college and is now working toward becoming a police officer, and is surrounded by men. Sarah doesn't really have a female friend in her life. Sarah has been trying to find female friends but feels like she is too masculine for women but too feminine for men. Dawson told Sarah to keep trying to find new female friends as well as male friends who are outside her workplace. He suggested going to a new church and broadening her horizons.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Man Of Her Dreams Abused Her</b>            Jill met the man of her dreams then a month or two after they got married he started physically abusing her. He has broken many of her bones and strangled her several times. Now her ex is in prison. Jill has no contact with him, but is still having a hard time getting over him. Dawson said that Jill has a fantasy about who this guy is, and she keeps thinking he is going to turn in to this "dream man," but that man doesn't exist. The only man that does exist is the one who beat her up.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Drugs Impacted His Mom's Mind</b>            Tyler's parents are divorced. Her mom remarried and while she was married her ex-husband got her into some drugs. They have since divorced and her mom is now clean, but he feels like the drugs have impacted her mom's thought processes. Tyler said now that anytime something happens, he is accused of talking down to her and being disrespectful. Dawson said to take his mother out for a lunch date or a movie every other week- not to solve problems but just to give her some attention and build a relationship with her.</p>

When she was 10 or 11 years old, she was going through her parent's divorce. Every Sunday she would listen to the show while she fell asleep. Taylor realized her life wasn't so bad when she heard what others were going through. She said the things Dawson said helped her get through her situation.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Met A Girl Recovering From Addiction</b>            Jonathon fears success. He met the girl of his dreams. They are both recovering from drug addiction. Jonathon goes to NA meetings and they don't encourage two addicts to be together during recovery. Dawson agrees with NA's policy that it would be very difficult for two addicts to be together so early on in their recovery. He also asked Jonathon how much drama he is ready to handle right now in his life. Dawson suggested that Jonathon ask NA for a sponsor that he can connect with so he has someone to help him through this.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Feels Like She Is Failing</b>            Jamie's dad had his second stroke in May. He also had a heart attack and is in a rehab center about an hour away. Jamie is trying to take care of her younger brother. Jamie said that every time someone asks her how her dad is doing she feels like she is failing. She is struggling not relapsing to her old lifestyle of partying and drinking. Jamie doesn't feel like she is making the right choices for her dad. Dawson said that Jamie is overdoing it, and there are other people who need to be helping. He is afraid that Jamie is going to have a breakdown if she doesn't unload some of these burdens. He recommended getting some counseling to help her untangle all of these issues</p> <p><b>TITLE: Daughter's Mom Has Drug Addiction</b>            Joseph is going through a rough time. He has a daughter, and his daughter's mom has a drug addiction. Joseph had moved out of state for work and a month after he moved she told Joseph that she was pregnant. Their daughter is 9 months old now and he is getting ready to move back. Dawson said that if he moves back, the purpose needs to be to spend time with his daughter, not to be with this woman.</p>

Addiction Family Addiction Relationship	10/11/15		Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Wants To Stop Using Drugs</b>            John's best friend was killed in 1997. When John was 22, his younger brother was killed in Afghanistan. This Christmas, they discovered that John's niece had two tumors on her brain. John doesn't want to continue using drugs, but he isn't sure how to stop. Dawson said that John is trying to numb the pain he has experienced with these drugs, but that John could make their deaths in vain if he overdoses while trying to get past the hurt he is feeling.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Her Brother Is The "Golden Child"</b>            Naomi's brother is seen as the "golden child." Her grandparents have threatened to kick her out of the house multiple times, most recently because she spent the night at her boyfriends and was late to school. Dawson told Naomi that she needs to continue to thank her grandparents and ask them what she can do to help make peace. Jessica also suggested that her grandparents might have higher expectations for her than they do for her brother, because they know she is going to go far in life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Mom Kicked Him Out, Found Drug Stuff</b>            Zachary started messing around with painkillers then dropped out of college and started using harder drugs. Currently he is using heroine. Zachary's mom found his drug paraphernalia and kicked him out of the house. Now he is staying at her sister's ex-boyfriend's apartment, and he is a drug dealer. Zachary can't even get his mom to answer her phone. Dawson said that Zachary needs to find a NA meeting first thing in the morning. He believes that once his mom sees that he is truly trying to get help then she will start to listen.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Feels A Void From Lack Of Father</b>            Gabby feels emotionally numb since her last relationship ended. Her biological father has not been a part of her life, and she has always felt like she needed a man in her life to fill that void. Dawson said that Gabby is doing the right thing by pulling back from dating while she takes some time to heal. He suggested that she get counseling to deal with the issues of being abandoned by her biological father. Dawson also said a healthy woman will attract a healthy guy.</p>

He has been diagnosed with paranoia issues, and it's affecting his current relationship. Dawson told Akram to see a psychiatrist to help with his medical issues, but also said he needs to see a counselor to deal with his past and trust issues.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Fiancée Just Disappeared</b> Landon joined the military in high school. Lacey isn't supposed to sit or stand for more than 30 minutes. She is trying to survive on her own but it's not working. She doesn't have insurance and the medical bills are piling up. Dawson said that she needs a team of people around her to support her. He said that she could find those people if she went to a local church. Dawson said he would help her find a team of people from the connections he has in her area.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Has Had Drug Addiction For 14 Years</b> Ashley has been struggling with drug and alcohol addiction for about 14 years. She almost died earlier this year. She went to treatment for the first time last year, and was in and out for about 9 months. The longest she has been sober is 60 consecutive days. Dawson said that Ashley knows everything he could say about drug addiction, and he is afraid she will die soon if she doesn't do something now. He told Ashley that it is a miracle that she is still alive. He told Ashley to call the people in her life, such as her ex-sponsors, right now to tell them she is done with this lifestyle.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Mom Says He's Not Welcome</b> Matthew's mom kicked him out when he was 12 years old. Matthew wants to have a relationship with his mother, but every time he tries to talk her, she discards him. And has said he is not welcome at her house. Dawson said that Matthew has gone through the worst abuse that a person can go through. He told Matthew that his mother is very sick, and that Matthew isn't ready to have contact with her right now.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Hard Time Talking To Girls</b> Keaton has a hard time talking to girls. He freezes up and has to walk away from them. There is a particular girl Keaton wants to talk to. He has talked to her once but is too nervous to talk to her again. Dawson told Keaton to try to connect with her via Facebook. He said sooner or later Keaton has to man up and make a move. He said another thing he could do is hand her a note and let her know that he is very shy but would like to get to know her better.</p>
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<p>Relationship Relationship Relationship Relationship</p>	<p>10/18/15</p>		<p>Hour 4</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Boyfriend Becoming More Distant</b> Kristina is dating a guy who is becoming more distant. He says there are problems but won't expound on what the problems are. Dawson said that he thinks their relationship has hit a crossroads where they either have to go deeper or break up. He told Kristina that what he is doing is showing her that he doesn't want her to come any closer and that he has a fear of intimacy. Dawson said that if she wants the type of relationship that she deserves, she will have to move on.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Boyfriend Hits Her, Is On Dating Sites</b> Elizabeth's boyfriend hits her. They have been together about two and a half years. Elizabeth went to a counselor, who advised her to step away when he starts to get mad. Just last month, Elizabeth found that he is on dating websites, and when she confronted him he hit her again. Dawson said that Elizabeth's boyfriend is a very sick man and Elizabeth can do so much better than this. He told her she needs to get away from him.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Cheated On His Girlfriend</b> Eric cheated on his girlfriend a few weeks ago. He said that she had warned him that if this happened again she would not come back. Dawson recommended that Eric get in touch with her one last time to seek her forgiveness and let her know the things he is working on. Dawson also recommended that Eric get some counseling, and reminded him to not let the shame of what he has done derail him.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Having Some Issues With Loved Ones</b> Steven was recently diagnosed with PTSD. He is a full time fireman, and is having some issues with his family, as well as his girlfriend. Steven doesn't feel like himself anymore, he lashes out in anger and doesn't sleep at night. Last year he was hurt in a fire and hospitalized and she was by his side. Tonight they had a big argument and Steven stormed out of the house. Dawson said his relationships with God and family have to be #1 and #2 in his life. He advised Steven to reassure her of his love for her, and that he knows that he needs to do something to fix what has been going on.</p>

Yesterday he said he wanted to call off their wedding so that he could get financially stable first. Liz feels like he just doesn't want to be with her anymore. Liz said he suggested being in an open relationship. He keeps texting her to tell her that she loves her. Dawson said that Liz needs to cut him out of her life, and recommended that she do it quickly before he causes her even more heartache. He told Liz that every day you are in a dysfunctional relationship, the harder it will be to break it off. Jessica said it is better that she is finding this out now than after the wedding.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Pregnant, Boyfriend Flipping Out</b> Lori was dating someone for about 5 months and really enjoyed this person. She found out last weekend she was pregnant. He is now flipping out about it; he wants Lori to have an abortion. He is saying this is completely Lori's fault and that she is trying to ruin his life. After having this fit he apologized, but a few days later he started harassing her to get an abortion again. Now he is saying he has to go out of the country for work.. Lori has decided to keep the baby. Dawson said that Lori needs to talk to a hope coach but also that she was going to get a lot of encouragement from the show's listeners.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Advises Lori To Not Be Ashamed</b> Nicole has advice for Lori. Nicole is 28 and went through a very similar situation. She gave her baby's father a chance to be there for their son but he didn't show up. Nicole was ashamed so she didn't accept help from her family for the first three years. Dawson advised Jason to go to his dad and ask him to help him meet with the family to share about what he has done. He told Jason to go talk to his dad first thing in the morning.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Raped, Got Pregnant</b> Joyce got pregnant because she was raped. She talked to her uncle, who is cop, and he said that it is too late to collect evidence against the guy. She didn't have insurance to cover it, so it cost her \$10,000 to have the baby. Dawson is concerned that he could eventually find out and come after her for custody of the baby. He advised Joyce to go see a lawyer for her own peace of mind.</p>

Sabrina said he had a really bad relationship history and was afraid to get in to another relationship. In August, she gave him her 2<sup>nd</sup> vehicle to use and once he had his own transportation he stopped talking to her. Sabrina was pregnant and then miscarried. Dawson told Sabrina that it is a blessing that this guy is gone, and that she needs to guard her heart and wait for a good guy to come along.</p>

She decided to keep the baby. Recently she has become distant and unresponsive toward Alex. Dawson told Alex that they never had a foundation to build on. He advised that Alex needs to find out for sure if this is his baby, and told him to get a lawyer and take the paternity tests. Dawson reminded Alex that if the baby is his, his responsibility is to the child and not to the mother.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Cousin Doesn't Like Her Boyfriend</b> Jamie is in love with her boyfriend. Jamie and her cousin live together. Jamie's cousin decided that she doesn't like Jamie's boyfriend and doesn't want him around. Dawson told Jamie to respect her cousin and the relationship that they have. He recommended not trying to talk her into liking her boyfriend or forcing her to be around her boyfriend. Dawson also told Jamie to have caution and to be very careful because her cousin is seeing and feeling something.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Abused By Step-Dad</b> Kerri's step dad physically abused her as a child but no one believed her. Kerri isn't sure why her mom would do allow her to be abused when she knew what was going on. Dawson said that Kerri's mom has a love addiction. He told Kerri that she needs to work through all of this and learn to forgive. Dawson told Kerri that this doesn't have to set the course for her life, but she could be an overcomer.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Mom Didn't Want To Connect With Him</b> David went up to Montana to try to reconnect with his mom but she didn't really want anything to do with him. David is hurt and is trying to figure out what he could have done to make his mom not want a relationship with him. Dawson said this has nothing to do with anything David has or has not done, but everything to do with his mom and her sickness. Dawson said that his mom's treatment of him is inexcusable, but that David needs to work to overcome this pain and find forgiveness.</p>

Savannah went to the courthouse and told them what happened. Anytime she tries to reconcile with her sister, her sister blows her off. Dawson said that Savannah can get some help to work on how to forgive her sister, but also that she needs to understand that her sister is not through getting in trouble. He recommended being kind but firm with her sister, and not allowing her sister to make her into her victim.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Wants To End Friendship With Benefits</b> Ally has had a friend for the past 5 years. They have been friends with benefits for the last 1 ½ years. Ally said at one point they were best friends, but now he is treating her poorly. Ally recently found out that he has been seeing someone else and was lying to her about it. Ally isn't sure how to tell him that she wants to end the friendship. Dawson said it is such a struggle because their souls are intertwined. He told Ally you can't be that intimate and then try to be healthy friends.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Diagnosed With Cancer</b> Kayla was diagnosed with cancer a few months ago. Kayla hasn't told her parents about the cancer yet. Kayla's mom recently got over cervical cancer and Kayla can't seem to find the right time to tell her. Dawson told Kayla that this is too overwhelming for her to handle alone and that she needs to go to her parents immediately to get their support for this. He told Kayla to work on removing the big stressors in her life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Job Opportunity Out Of State</b> Giles and his girlfriend have planned their upcoming wedding and she is 4 months pregnant. Giles has had some job opportunities come up out of state, but she doesn't want to move until after the wedding. Giles has no full time job right now, and with a baby on the way he wants to jump on the job opportunity. Dawson said that Giles has a responsibility to provide for his family, and if that job is really a great opportunity he needs to take it.</p>
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
