He suggested that Andreas get his son into therapy.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Mom Neglecting Home Life</b>            Jessica's mom started dating a guy and is at his place all the time. Jessica isn't used to her mom being gone all the time. She tried talking to her mom about it and telling her that Jessica and her sister need her at home. Dawson suggested that Jessica set a goal to move out of the house. He reminded Jessica that she can't control her mother, and she is the way she is. He told her to look at her mom as a roommate and let go of her expectations.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Controlling Ex Causing Stress</b>            Melissa has 3 children, and the baby's father cheated on her. Suicide Relationship Relationship Addiction	4/3/16		Hour 3	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Friend's Husband Committed Suicide</b>            Emily's friend's husband committed suicide last week due to PTSD from his time in the military. Jess recommended that Emily help her by looking for and going with her to a suicide support group. She told Emily to just be there without feeling like she needs to say anything. Another recommendation is for Emily to mark her calendar for important dates for her friend (birthdays, anniversaries etc) in the first year because those will be very difficult. Finally, they suggested that Emily allow her friend to say whatever she feels at the moment and to be her "safe place" to vent.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Can't Move On From Girlfriend</b>            Jeffrey cheated on his girlfriend. They broke up but Jeffrey is having a hard time moving on. She says she can't forgive him. He isn't sure what to do. Dawson said the only way they could both work through this is with a counselor. He said it is possible to get to a point of having a healthy relationship but not without a lot of work and professional help. Dawson said there is a lot of baggage in their relationship and he thinks that he needs to consider moving on.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Boyfriend Kissed Another Girl</b>            Allison saw her boyfriend kissing another girl at high school. When she saw this she walked away and hasn't spoken to him since. He has tried to talk to Allison but she hasn't let him. Dawson said this was really disrespectful to her. He said to give him a chance to apologize to her but let him know how disrespected she feels.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Used To Get High With Her Best Friend</b>            Joanna is a recovering addict, and she is a single mom. In the past, she and her best friend have gotten high together, but now Joanna is sober and doesn't want to be around that. Dawson said that Joanna is going to have to let this friend go. He said that Joanna needs to think about her baby and herself and do all she can to stay clean. Hopefully, Joanna's friend will see the good example she is setting and desire to make that change as well.</p>

He is looking for help to move on from her. Dawson said that the girl he remembers and is comparing others to is a fantasy. Dawson recommended that Joshua take a break from dating and work on himself for a while, and figure out why he is holding on. He recommended that Joshua get help from a counselor or minister to work through this.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Bad Relationship With Mother</b>            Melissa and her mom have never had a good relationship, even though they have tried to work on it. Melissa got into a relationship with a guy who was in prison for sleeping with a girl who was under age. Melissa's dad has been in and out of prison as well. Melissa's mom didn't know anything about this guy's story other than that he is in prison, and she started threatening to take her car unless she broke up with him. Dawson said that Melissa needs to slow it down and cut all the drama out of her life. He told her to work on her relationship with her mom.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Baby's Father Committed Suicide</b>            Raquelle is 37 weeks pregnant. She has no family in the area, and the baby's father committed suicide when she was only 10 weeks pregnant. Raquelle has been told that if it wasn't for her and the baby on the way that maybe he would still be around. Raquelle isn't sure how to deal with this. Dawson said there is nothing Raquelle could have done and that this man was emotionally unwell.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Lost And Confused Leads To Cutting</b>            Autumn tried to kill herself a few weeks ago. She was cutting and just went too far. Autumn has been to multiple hospitals and is currently in a transitional living program. She feels lost and confused. Dawson said that it is ok to be confused, and that she can go back to the hospital and help kick start her recovery again. He said this most recent incident should be a wakeup call for her. He told Autumn that he can tell she is a fighter and she can win this battle.</p>

Her boyfriend is staying. Her son is 9 and she doesn't really have a relationship with him. She thinks he wants her to move back but is afraid she will leave him again. Dawson told Sarah that mother abandonment is devastating. He said it is a no-brainer that she needs to be with her son, and if her boyfriend really loves her he will get himself together and come out to California.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Newlywed Discovers Husband's Troubles</b>            Niki got married last May. She said her husband was hiding his financial problems, they got evicted, and they went through a custody battle for his son. Niki married the guy but now realizes how much she didn't know about him. Dawson said it is time for Niki to move out to give them both time to work on things, if he isn't willing, she can't stay.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Recovery From Meth Is Possible</b>            Cheyenne is a recovering meth addict and heard Dawson tell others that he couldn't help them unless they wanted to help themselves and Cheyenne agrees! She was arrested at 19 and went to detox. She is now living in a "sober living home" with other recovering addicts and has a job. She still struggles with desiring drugs when she gets depressed. Dawson said that this is an amazing story and that he will be here for her if she has recurring issues.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Depression Leads To Feeling Not Needed</b>            Sean has struggled with depression for four years. He dropped out of high school to get a job to help with his family's money problems. He is almost done with his GED now. He is on Prozac, but feels like he isn't needed. Sean doesn't know his dad. Dawson said that the depression is what is causing him to feel "not needed". He suggested starting to work out and that might help somewhat. Dawson also feels that the lack of a father figure in his life is contributing to this, and that Sean needs to work on forgiveness.</p>

Relationship Grief Friendship Pregnancy	4/10/16		Hour 3	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Cheating Wife Refuses Counseling</b>            Eric's wife cheated on him recently and she had her second miscarriage this week. Eric wants to get marriage counseling but she refuses. Dawson said that Eric could still go to counseling even if his wife won't. He suggested having their pastor over to their house to talk. Dawson said that right now her anger toward God and the miscarriage is messing with her emotions and she doesn't really know what she wants. He told Eric that it is worth the fight and to keep being a rock in his wife's life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Still Grieving Dad's Passing</b>            Tony's dad died suddenly three years ago. Tony is expecting his first child and is sad his dad won't be there. Dawson said that what Tony is experiencing is normal and reminded him that it can take up to 5 years to heal from losing someone. He advised Tony to make a list of all the things he loved about his dad, and when he gets sad he can look at his list and be thankful for him. He also told Tony to look for grief support groups in his area.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Pregnant Friend Has Good Support</b>            Emily's best friend is pregnant. The boyfriend is saying he doesn't know if the baby is his. Dawson said that he doesn't need to be in the baby's life or be on the birth certificate. Dawson said that he doesn't think this guy is going to come back around, but that he is thankful Emily's friend has Emily and her parents as a support group.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Dad Rejects Pregnant Daughter</b>            Manda is pregnant, and when her dad found out he told her that he hated her and wouldn't have anything to do with her until she had an abortion. Her mom told her he did the same thing to her when she was having Manda at 17. Dawson said that Manda needs to surround herself with family members who support her, and also let them talk to her dad and tell him to stop acting this way. He told Manda this is because of his dad's own past mistakes and really doesn't have anything to do with her. Dawson also advised Manda to let her mom be the go-between between her and her dad.</p>

Her step dad is walking her down the aisle, Brittney hasn't had a good relationship with her biological dad and he refuses to come to the wedding although her step mom wants to. Brittney's fiancé's mom refuses to be involved with the wedding as well. Dawson told Brittney to extend forgiveness but not to let them control her. He told Brittney that it is not about her but about these adults and their issues. Dawson encouraged Brittney to surround herself with positive people. Jess reminded Brittney that this day is about her and her fiancé.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Police Are There For You</b>            Bruce is a police officer and has heard a lot of people call in with domestic violence situations. Bruce wants everyone to know that they aren't alone. He shared that the police officers are always there for them and they will take the time to talk and share resources to help people in those situations.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Bipolar And Depressed Single Parent</b>            Mina is a single parent and has bipolar disorder and depression. Two years ago she moved away from her family, but her parents keep pressuring her to move back to the area and she feels they want to control her. Dawson said her parents are probably trying to get her to move closer so that they can help when she has episodes with the illnesses. He suggested that she get someone in her life to help her be accountable with regulating her meds.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Disrespect Causing Marital Strife</b>            Vickie and her husband fight a lot. He has PTSD and she is bipolar. When they argue he is very disrespectful and emotionally abusive. Vickie isn't sure how to address him in a respectful manner to let him know that his language is unacceptable. Jess recommended telling him that if he can't speak nicely then don't speak to her at all. Dawson also suggested taking a "time out" and moving out temporarily to get his attention.</p>

<p>Family Stress Addiction Grief</p>	<p>4/17/16</p>		<p>Hour 2</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Found Biological Dad On Facebook</b> Dre has never met his biological father, but found him on Facebook. Dre's mom wants him to have a relationship with him but Dre doesn't really feel like he has earned the title of 'dad'. Dawson said he doesn't have to go see him if he doesn't want to, but maybe they can start slow by talking on line. Dawson thinks there is more going on inside of Dre and thinks it would be good for him to just test the waters of getting to know his dad. Either way, Dawson advised Dre to get some counseling to prepare him for getting to know his dad and dealing with his resentment.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Overwhelmed And Anxious About Life</b> Matt is struggling with Math and Science. His prom date is in the hospital due to anxiety attacks. She doesn't have a phone so they have to meet to make plans. Also they both work and Matt is playing tennis. Matt is trying to figure out how to get organized. Dawson recommended making a detailed list of everything he has going on and then organize it. He told Matt to just take one day at a time, and that he needs to stop worrying. He just needs to come up with the best possible plan so that he gets through this with less stress.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Heroin Addict Wants To Quit</b> Brad has been dealing with heroin addiction for the last decade. He has gone a week without using anything, but it isn't easy to just stop after a decade of use. He has a good family and a good support system, but it still is a struggle. He has been through rehab twice. Dawson said that Brad needs a year of rehab, even if he has to take a year off of work; otherwise he is going to die from his addiction. He also recommended he get into a spiritually based program.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Grieving Her Mother's Death</b> Kat's mom died from cancer in November. Kat has been drinking and smoking every day since this happened. Kat's mother's one fear was that when she turned 21 she would become a drinker. Kat is living with a foster family and they have given up on her. Dawson told Kat that if she wants to live she has to make a plan to change the way she is living. Dawson said that it is time to go to rehab for a few months, and if she doesn't get really serious about changing she will end up right back where she is now. He told Kat that he would find a partner in her area where she can get further help.</p>

<p>Family Relationship Relationship Relationship</p>	<p>4/17/16</p>		<p>Hour 3</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Dad Negatively Impacts His Son's Plans</b>  Tim's dad is currently deployed to Iraq. When his dad is home, he doesn't spend time with Tim's mom or siblings but he goes out with friends to party. Tim is hoping for an ROTC scholarship and financial aid through the GI Bill, but his dad said he is going to block Tim from receiving that money. Dawson said there is always a way, and if he wants this bad enough he will get it. He recommended going to speak with the recruiters to help plan out a path to get where he needs to go. Dawson told Tim to tell his dad that he is going to respect his dad's decision and is going to find another road to achieve his goals.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Torn Between Mom And Husband</b>  Katie's mom is accusing her of loving her husband's family over her parents and her own family. Her husband is telling Katie to stand up to her mom. Katie's mom has tried to disown her. Katie tries to turn the other cheek because her mom has lost her husband recently. Dawson said that Katie's relationship with her mom is impacting her relationship with her husband. He told Katie that her heart to help her mom is right, but she has to put her relationship with her husband first.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Boyfriend Threatened To Hurt Himself</b>  Elizabeth and her boyfriend broke up today. She said there was a lot of drama in their relationship, and he was controlling. When they were talking about separating he implied that he was going to hurt himself. Dawson said it sounds like he is manipulating her. He said that he doubts her ex is going to hurt himself, but even if he did, it wouldn't be on her shoulders. Dawson told Elizabeth that she is 16 and the reasons she broke up with him are good reasons. He told Elizabeth that she doesn't need the drama that he brings to her life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Can't Get Over Ex-Girlfriend</b>  David dated a girl for a couple of years, and then he broke up with her. David wanted to get her back but now she is dating someone else. Dawson reminded David that whatever issues were there when they originally broke up are still going to be there if they were to get back together. Jess referred David to Dawson's blogs about how to get over a broken heart which has lots of suggestions.</p>

<p>Relationship Pregnancy Positive Stress</p>	<p>4/17/16</p>		<p>Hour 4</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Troubled Boyfriend Needs To Go</b> Taylor has been dating a boy for 6 months. They've been best friends for 5 years. All of a sudden he started changing and wanting her to do crazy things, such as run him over with her car. Taylor said his family struggles with drinking. Dawson said that Taylor's boyfriend is having control issues and is trying to manipulate Taylor. Dawson said Taylor is addicted to him, and needs to walk away and stay away from him. He recommends her working on herself.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Pregnant And Sick Family Far Away</b> Alex recently found out she is pregnant. The next day, Alex's husband found out that his dad has pancreatic cancer. Then Alex found out that her 27-year-old sister has stage 4-colon cancer. Alex and her husband live on a military base and are a long distance from their family. They met with the chaplain and they have a good support system there. Alex is trying to figure out how to help her family cope from a distance. Dawson reminded Alex that she can only do so much, and she needs to stay calm and peaceful for the sake of her baby.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Troubled Past But Now Living In Hope</b> Caitlin is calling in to talk about hope and encourage some people that things can get better. Caitlin and her brother and sister were kidnapped when they were young. She was held for 6 months by her step-grandmother on an Indian reservation. Eventually they were found by another family member. She was also abused by another family member. Caitlin wants to encourage others that you can't control what happens to you but you can control who you are on the inside! Dawson said Caitlin isn't just a survivor, she is an overcomer!</p> <p><b>TITLE: Anxiety And Panic Causing Problems</b> Raymond has had anxiety and panic attacks for 3 years. He isn't sure what causes it, and his family isn't supportive. He is taking strong medications, which he doesn't like. Raymond just got a job but can't afford counseling. Raymond went into the Navy and didn't tell them about his anxiety, thinking it would disqualify him. Dawson said that they have connections where he lives and they can help find him a counselor who will help talk him through this. Dawson said part of his anxiety comes from his broken relationship with his family, but he is not alone and a counselor can help him get some skills to cope with these episodes.</p>

Family Relationship Family Relationship	6/5/16		Hour 3	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: New Husband Wants To Adopt Her Baby</b>            When Kristy found out she was pregnant the father left. Kristy went back to her hometown where she had support. Now he has moved there to be closer to his daughter. Kristy filed for child support and he left town again. Kristy is now married and her current husband wants to adopt the baby. Dawson said that this guy has proven himself to not be interested in the baby's best interest and right now it is more important to do what is best for the baby and allow her husband to adopt.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Has A Child With A Married Man</b>            Quatavia has a baby with a married man. She has been dealing with depression and their last fight got physical. Quatavia isn't sure if she should continue to be with this married man. Dawson said that this relationship is out of bounds. He told her that there is just too much risk (since he's married) and it isn't the best situation for her baby. He told her to not try to get back together with him.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Father Wants Relationship With Her</b>            Makenzie's father sexually abused her from ages 6-10. He went to prison because of drugs. Now her biological dad has gotten out of prison and says he will change and wants a relationship with her but Makenzie isn't sure about it. Dawson said that Makenzie's birth father has not earned her trust. He suggested getting a counselor involved and eventually they could start communicating using email but he recommended that Makenzie not invite him back into her life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: "Friend" Stole Her Boyfriend</b>            Bri fell in love with a guy. One of her friends got close to her with the intention of stealing her boyfriend. He did end up getting together with her friend. She has tried moving on from him with other guys, but she can't. Dawson told Bri that this is a crazy situation, and that she sounds like a love addict. Dawson said this is about her need to be loved. Jessica said that being with other guys isn't a way to move on from him and suggested that Bri take a break from dating to heal her heart.</p>

Abuse Addiction Family Grief	6/5/16		Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Rape Case Going To Trial This Week</b>            Victoria was raped last September and the hearing is this week so she will miss the family reunion. Victoria's mom is also going to miss it because she has stage 4 cancer. Dawson recommended that Victoria's dad speak to the family members at the reunion and let them know why they are missing it. He also said that perhaps Victoria could record a message to the family that can be played at the reunion.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Alcoholism Runs In The Family</b>            Chris' father and other family members struggle with alcoholism. Dawson said that the family history is so strong that Chris definitely needs to stay away from any addictive substances. He suggested making a list of things that could happen if Chris started drinking including hurting God, hurting his future family, and the inability to reach his dreams. He then said to make another list of all the things that could happen if he stays away from it. Dawson recommended having someone he respects that he can call when he is tempted.</p> <p><b>TITLE: My Mother Doesn't Like My Boyfriend</b>            Hannah and her boyfriend have been together for years. Her mom doesn't like him. She never allows Hannah to bring her boyfriend to the house or to family functions. Dawson advised Hannah to get support from her other family members, not to gang up on her mother but to help her talk to her mother with respect. He told Hannah to be kind and calm but very direct with her mother.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Keep Reliving Boyfriend's Fatal Accident</b>            Charlie's boyfriend was in a fatal car accident. Charlie watched it all happen and she can't get the images out of her head. She doesn't know how to be strong for her 5-year-old and his 7-year-old. Dawson said that Charlie needs to tell herself that as heartbreaking as this is, it will get better, but it will take a lot of time. He said she is going to go through all kinds of feelings and right now she is in shock. Dawson encouraged Charlie to find a support system around her that she can lean on.</p>

Positive Pregnancy Grief Relationship	6/5/16		Hour 5	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Hope After Tragedy Can Inspire Others</b>            Caleb's mom was murdered 5 years ago, when Caleb was 14. Caleb tried to kill himself by overdosing on pills and it is a miracle he is still alive. Caleb is now back up on his feet, has a job, and owns his own vehicle. He wanted to tell people listening that whatever they are feeling right now life can change and you can turn things around. Dawson said this is great advice for the listeners.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Pregnant And Boyfriend Broke Up</b>            Marie has been dating a guy for 5 years. Two weeks ago he told her he didn't want to be with her any more and he wants to be able to sleep with other people. Marie just found out that she is 9 weeks pregnant and he is trying to force her to get an abortion. Dawson said this relationship is over, and that Marie's ex has made it very clear. Dawson told Marie that she needs to accept that it is over, and anything else he does is playing games with her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Boyfriend's Dad Died And He Is Angry</b>            Tiffany's boyfriend's father passed away last Christmas and since then Tiffany said his personality has changed for the worse. He is drinking a lot and is always angry. Dawson said on one hand, she could say to him how deeply sorry she is for the loss he is experiencing, but that she can't take the abuse. Dawson feels like Tiffany is doing all the giving and that she deserves better than a one sided relationship. Dawson reminded Tiffany that she can't "get him" to do anything, but he needs to want to do this himself.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend Has A Painful Past</b>            Nick recently got into a relationship with a girl who has been in and out of abusive relationships and raped multiple times. Nick is the first guy that hasn't abused her. Dawson reminded Nick that he can't heal her, and trying to rescue her is going to wear him out. Dawson isn't sure that Nick is the right person to try to help. He suggested that Nick listen and point her to a professional who can help her work through the issues she is dealing with.</p>

Relationship Family Family Family	6/12/16		Hour 3	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Boyfriend Ended Relationship Suddenly</b>            Katie and her boyfriend have been together for two years. On Friday he said he didn't think it was God's plan for them to be together. They had talked about getting married and this came out of nowhere. They moved in together for financial reasons, and it has been a struggle to reconcile that with their Christian values. Dawson said that Katie's boyfriend probably feels trapped and Katie has to let him go, there is nothing else she can do. He also said this may just be a break and maybe they will decide the relationship is worth saving.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Mom Is In Bad Relationship</b>            Edna's mom has been with a mentally controlling guy for a long time. He doesn't like Edna and her siblings, and her mom has chosen his kids over her own. Edna's mom keeps giving her excuses why she can't get out of the relationship. Dawson said that Edna should feel very sorry for her mother because she is a love addict. He said that Edna might need to take a time out from the relationship with her mother, and for Edna's own good to really work on forgiveness toward her. Dawson said doing this would take working with a counselor.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Tough Love Required For Sisters</b>            Anthony is having some trouble with his 21-year-old twin sisters. He isn't sure if he should help them or distance himself for them. They ask him and his mom for money and things and Anthony tries to help them. Anthony's wife says that Anthony enables them. Dawson said it is time for tough love, and they have been playing Anthony for too long. Jessica also commented that Anthony's priority has to be his wife and he is hurting his marriage by enabling his sisters.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Returned Home After Running Away</b>            Sierra ran away from home and was gone for two nights. She decided she wanted to go home, and her parents let her, but they put the house on lockdown and stripped her of all privileges and nice things. Sierra says she learned her lesson, and she learned how many people love and care for her. Dawson advised her that if she can turn her life around and earn her parent's trust again they will eventually start to return privileges to her.</p>

Positive Family Family Addiction	6/12/16		Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Quitting Drugs Results In Improved Life</b> Cory's dad died when he was a teenager and Cory started doing drugs at age 12. Last year he tried to end his life. His brother helped him find a halfway house where he got clean. Now he has a place to stay, a vehicle, and he saw his daughter for the first time in 3 years. Dawson said that the grace of God got him through this situation, and many people like him have ended up dead. He told Cory to remember his blessings and what he would lose if he didn't continue on the path of recovery.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Mom's Drug Addiction Causing Havoc</b> Josee's mom wasn't in her life until she was 18. Her sister let their mom move in and they took care of her, and she ended up stealing from them. Josee had a miscarriage and her mom said she wouldn't have been a good mother anyway. Josee's mom came to live with her but she has been messing with meth and crack, and the police raided the house. Josee wants to see her mom get better. Dawson said her mom cannot live in Josee's house and that she is toxic to her. Her mom can get better but Josee can't be the one to help her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Need To End Contact With Toxic Dad</b> Karagan needs help telling her dad that she doesn't want a relationship with him anymore. He has a history of drug abuse and he is mean and curses out her mom. Dawson said that when she does talk to him, she needs to not do it alone or do it in a public setting. Dawson told Karagan to get what she wants to say down to a sentence like "Because our relationship is so toxic, I cannot continue to be in relationship with you." He also told her if he continues to comeback at her with arguments to just repeat that same sentence.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Trusting Addicted Husband Takes Time</b> Tammy's husband has a history of drug issues and he has gotten help but then falls back into the addiction. Dawson said that it is going to take a longer time than her husband thinks for Tammy to trust him. He told Tammy that they need to get counseling, and if her husband is ready to change he will be willing to go with her. Dawson said that it may be hard and painful but their marriage is worth saving.</p>

Addiction Addiction Relationship Relationship	6/12/16		Hour 5	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Heroin Addiction Ruining Marriage</b>            Teresa and her husband both suffer from heroine addiction. They are looking for a way out and want to be clean. Teresa is unemployed but her husband would have to quit his job to check into rehab. Dawson said if they don't both get help their relationship has no chance. Dawson said that someone bigger than her has a purpose for her to be alive. Dawson said they are going to talk with his connections to see about scholarships for treatment programs.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Cousin Abusing Drugs And Not Stopping</b>            Christian's cousin has turned to substance abuse. Christian has tried to talk to him but he isn't listening. Christian's cousin quit going to church and the people he knew there aren't trying to reach out to him. Dawson said that Christian needs to get his cousin some spiritual help. He suggested getting people at the church to pray for him. He told Christian to let him know that the door is always open and he is praying for him and waiting for him to get to the point where he wants help.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Working On Restoring Trust</b>            Caleb's girlfriend caught him cheating on her a couple of days ago. Caleb's girlfriend reached out to the other girl and they realized the other girl thought she was also Caleb's girlfriend. Caleb and his original girlfriend are still together but things aren't the same. Dawson said that Caleb really needs to own what he has done and tell her how sorry he is for it. Dawson said there is a lot of work ahead of him if he wants to save this relationship. He also suggested asking her what Caleb can do to win her heart back.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Military Man Abused By Wife</b>            Aaron is in an abusive relationship where his wife abuses him. She said that he is not a man and his army uniform is a joke. Aaron believes she is bi-polar but she refuses to see a doctor. Dawson said that she needs to get help, but all Aaron can do is help create an environment where she wants help. Dawson recommended a separation. He said Aaron can't continue to live with her until she gets some help, and in the meantime Aaron should just focus on being a good father to their two children.</p>

<p>Relationship Family Family Positive</p>	<p>6/19/16</p>		<p>Hour 3</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Is It Love Or Addiction?</b> Jessica was married at 18 and has two kids. They got divorced and she started dating someone else. They broke up because he thought she was cheating on him, which she wasn't. He flipped out and went to her work to confront the guy. Dawson said she has to move on from this guy because of his tendency to flip out. He told Jessica she isn't protecting her children if she lets them bond with this guy again. He suggested that she might have a love addiction where she doesn't know how to function without a man in her life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Stepmom Is Controlling</b> Mariah has a controlling stepmother and she feels like her dad has chosen his wife over Mariah. Her stepmother makes up lies about Mariah to get her dad angry with her. She gets emotional support and help from her grandmother. Dawson told her to lean on her grandmother right now and he suggested professional counseling. Dawson reminded Mariah that her dad and stepmom are very troubled and not to give them too much of a hold over her life</p> <p><b>TITLE: Mom Is With Abusive Boyfriend</b> Taylor's mom is with a guy who is abusive and takes his mom's money and Taylor's. Taylor is staying with his fiancé's family because he doesn't want to be around the abuse. The guy is disabled and Taylor's mom has lost her job because of having to care for him. Dawson told Taylor that his mom isn't living in reality, and suggested that he continue to tell her that he loves her but that she is breaking his heart. He also suggested leaning on his fiancé's mom as a mother figure in his life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Life Is Good Despite Past Abuse</b> Michael and his sister were placed in foster care due to abusive parents. His foster parents said he would never amount to anything and beat them. Michael said in spite of this he has been able to accomplish a lot of things and he wanted to encourage others who have gone through the same thing that it will get better. Dawson said that Michael has come out remarkably well considering the trauma he has been through. He told Michael to make it the goal of his life to find a way to forgive these people for all they have done to him, so that they have no control over his emotions.</p>

<p>Suicide Addiction Pregnancy Addiction</p>	<p>6/19/16</p>		<p>Hour 4</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Don't Know How To Help Friend</b> Danielle's friend Brittany attempted suicide. It seems like Brittany is always depressed and Danielle wants to be there for her, but she doesn't know how. Dawson said the best gift that Danielle can give to Brittany is to listen. Sometimes you have to tell someone that there is nothing else you can do for them, and then refer them to someone with more expertise. Dawson also said there is a chance that Brittany could be playing with her for attention. He told Danielle that once your own self-esteem starts to suffer that is a sign it's time to walk away from the relationship.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Can't Stop The Pot</b> Taylor is addicted to marijuana and has been in and out of treatment since 2013. He said his addiction affects every area of his life. Taylor said that the 12 steps helped him a year ago but he has gone back to marijuana. Dawson advised Taylor to go back to step 1 and 2 and focus on the spiritual side of the 12 steps and not skip any steps. Dawson said he is in better shape now than last time because he is more mature and more determined.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Pregnant Girlfriend Is Acting Crazy</b> Richard's girlfriend is acting crazy. She will throw things, hit him, make threats, and try to take his two-year-old daughter away. She is 8 months pregnant with their second daughter. The doctor said it's mood swings. Richard tried to get her a massage and get her nails done and she isn't appreciative. Dawson said she might have a hormonal imbalance that needs medical treatment. Dawson said to stop focusing on what he is doing for her and start to think about what is going on with her emotionally.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Relapsed After Treatment</b> Taylor was on drugs for 10 years. Two and a half years ago he went to a faith-based treatment center. After he finished the program he stayed another 6 months as an intern to help the new people coming in. He came back home and got involved in his church and was doing great but he relapsed. A month ago he was put in jail. He said his Christian faith is the only thing that has worked for him in the past. Dawson said he might have to go back in to treatment. He said Taylor knows what to do but he needs someone to help keep him accountable.</p>

<p>Family Friendship Friendship Addiction</p>	<p>6/19/16</p>		<p>Hour 5</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Feeling Ignored And Unloved At Home</b> Allison has felt ignored by her parents and nothing she can do would make them proud. She leaves for college soon. Dawson said that might be a good time to write them and make a list of all the positives that they have done for her and let them know how much she loves them. He said to find a minister or counselor who will let Allison work through her hurt feelings and toward forgiveness. Dawson said that if she leaves for college honoring them it would open the door for a future relationship. He advised Allison that she could look to other family members that she can make proud, rather than give her parents so much power over her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Helping A Hurting Friend</b> Joshua's friend is going through a breakup. She has been depressed and hasn't been eating, but Joshua and her mom are trying to help her but she keeps pushing them out. Dawson said that often times when someone is hurt and angry they direct that anger toward those who are closest to her. Dawson told Joshua that in time she will recognize what a good friend she has in him. He recommended that Joshua back off and give her space, but to know that he did the right thing to help his friend.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Friendship Seems One Sided</b> Laura and her friend had a falling out. Laura decided to pray for the friendship and they reconnected. Now Laura's friend is telling her that she is trying to balance life and strengthen her relationship with God so she can have stronger friendships however Laura is her only friend. Dawson said that Laura is carrying too much of the relationship and said this girl is controlling Laura and she needs to make some new friends. Dawson recognized that this girl has emotional issues and told Laura to not allow those issues to impact her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Went Back To Drugs After Clean Time</b> Caleb was clean from drugs for 7 months, but he relapsed when he and his girlfriend split up. Dawson told Caleb that he needs to get help with his addiction. He suggested turning himself into a rehab center or talk to someone at a church. He said the best thing to do is look back to when he was healthy and work to get back to that place.</p>

They are both trying to work on family relationships, but her parents aren't accepting of him and his family shuns them behind their backs. Dawson said that the only thing that is going to help their family to see her differently is time. They are going to want to see her consistently sober and recovering for a long time before they are willing to trust again.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Arrested Last Night, Kids Taken Away</b> Kelsea was arrested last night. The officer pulled her over for not stopping. He accused her of being drunk but Kelsea doesn't drink. The paper she got said that she didn't show her driver's license, had expired insurance, and failed to stop at a light, but he told her he was arresting her for a DWI. He refused to give her a breathalyzer, and took her kids away because of endangerment. Dawson said to get a really good lawyer, He said that since they didn't give her a test, the judge won't accept that and Kelsea really needs to follow the legal advice the lawyer gives her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Dad Is In And Out Of Her Life</b> Audrey's dad has been in and out of her life. He comes around every few years. He stopped paying child support, and he comes up near where she lives every other weekend but doesn't even stop to see her. Audrey's birthday was today and he didn't even show up. Dawson told Audrey that she needs to find some emotional support. He suggested going to her church or youth minister and telling them that she needs to talk to a woman in the church who will listen to her and walk with her through the process of forgiving her father.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Friends Trying To Influence Him</b> Maxwell's friends are a year or two older than him and are trying to get him to do things that he doesn't want to do. They try to get him to vandalize political signs, and they got him started on chewing tobacco and now he is addicted. Dawson said Maxwell has to have enough courage to say they don't want to hang out with him anymore and here is why. He told Maxwell that many of the calls he takes are because people made wrong choices due to hanging out with the wrong people. He encouraged Maxwell to go against the crowd and be his own person.</p>

<p>Family Relationship Pregnancy Family</p>	<p>6/26/16</p>		<p>Hour 4</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Feels He Is Disappointing His Family</b> Kevin is a full time truck driver for the last 3 years now. He can't help but feel he is a disappointment to his family because he is gone so much. Dawson said the sooner he can marry his fiancé the better, because it will make her feel more secure. Secondly, Dawson thinks that Kevin could look for a driving job where he is home more frequently, but until then, he suggested making sure he is 100% present when he is at home.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend Needs Him To Be Happy</b> Hunter says that when he and his girlfriend are apart, she says she feels incomplete. She basically says she needs him with her in order to be happy. She had a bad family life and her dad has some drinking problems. Dawson said that only she is responsible to make herself happy and she is putting way too much pressure on him to fill a hole in her that he can't fill. Dawson advised Hunter to "listen and point" to someone more qualified to counsel her and help her deal with her deep issues.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Pregnant With Ex's Baby</b> Madison hooked up with her ex at a party and now she is pregnant. She has another boyfriend now, but she is pretty sure the baby is her ex's. Madison's parents told her she needs to find a way to let both boys know. Madison's ex was abusive toward her in the past. Dawson feels like Madison needs to be prepared to lose both of these boys from her life. He also feels like Madison's ex is a player and doesn't even deserve to know, but if she does want to let him know he needs to hear about it from a lawyer who lets him know he is going to pay child support and/or give up rights to the baby.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Wants To Move Without Hurting Dad</b> Tyler moved in with his dad about a year ago because he couldn't find a job when he was living with his mom. Now he has a job, but realizes he doesn't want to settle down where his dad lives, he prefers to live by his mom and friends. Tyler isn't sure how to tell his dad this without hurting him. Dawson said that what Tyler's dad wants most from him is respect. He recommended starting the conversation by telling his dad how much he loves him and is so thankful for the specific ways he has influenced his life. He then said to tell him why he wants to move and that it has nothing to do with anything his dad has or hasn't done.</p>

She found out today that he didn't want Sam to come home from a visit to her mom's because his ex was going to stay at their house for the weekend. Dawson said what he is doing to her is pathetic. Dawson said the fact that he was too drunk to be with her during the miscarriage is disgusting, and that he would tell her not to come home so an ex could stay there is even worse. Dawson told Sam that this relationship is over.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Can Be Together After High School</b> Austin and a girl started falling for each other but never really let it go past friendship. Austin moved away. She says she wants him to be there for her to support her but doesn't want him to tell her how she really feels. She said she will be with Austin after high school, but right now she has a local boyfriend because she says she just can't be alone right now. Dawson said she can't expect to have it both ways, and she can't string Austin along until after high school. He told Austin he needs to give her what she wants and tell her goodbye.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Hard Time Keeping Attitude In Check</b> Dolores is in the military and attitude is something that is stressed there. Dolores is having a hard time keeping her attitude in check- she tends to role her eyes and keep her head down and that gets her in a lot of trouble with the higher ups. Dawson said that it sounds like Dolores has anger issues that have never been resolved. He said her anger is so bad that she does things even though she knows it is going to get her in trouble. Dawson suggested meeting with a chaplain who can help her get to a place of forgiveness.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Friend Upset With Her</b> Courtney and her friend recently graduated college. They did everything together in college but since then she hasn't really talked to Courtney much. Courtney ended up breaking it off with a guy, her friend is upset about it and feels like she treated him unfairly. Dawson said it sounds like Courtney's friend is jealous of her, and probably likes this guy herself. Dawson said that Courtney's friend is negative and toxic and is resentful of Courtney. He told Courtney to be kind but that she may need to release the friendship for a while.</p>
