She wants to know if she should believe him or if she should see these things as red flags. Dawson said this man seems to be a liar. She needs to get out of the relationship right away.</p> <p>TITLE: Slept With Boyfriend's Best Friend Hayley turned 18 on Friday night. Her boyfriend was out of town. Her boyfriend didn't want her to be alone on her birthday, so he told her to hang out with his best friend. She went to his house and long story short, they drank a little and she ended up cheating on her boyfriend. She isn't that kind of person and doesn't want to ruin the relationship. Dawson said it is too late for that. She needs to come clean with her boyfriend and deal with it.</p> <p>TITLE: Follow Dreams Or Stay Local? Rebecca has questions about college. She can go to a college close to home or she can go to college far away from home and follow her dreams. Dawson said to follow your dreams but use wisdom; she needs to have a support system. Rebecca said she is an artist. If she goes to college locally she can be a graphic designer or she can go away and be a comic book artist. Dawson said you should go for your dreams; the worst that can happen is to go there and end up moving back.</p> <p>TITLE: Scared Dad Will Choose Girl Over Her Lauren's dad is seeing a woman and she is scared that he is going to choose this woman over her and her brother. Dawson said when he seems to choose the girlfriend over her, she needs to tell him she loves and respects him but that this hurts her. Dawson recommends they get back in to family counseling, and that Lauren needs someone to walk through her with this to talk through it.</p>

She called the Hope Line last week and spoke to Morgan. Since then her and her husband have put their money together and gotten to a hotel, which is warm and comfortable for her children. The show has given her hope and she knows she is not alone. Dawson said he can't imagine being in that position but he knows there is always hope and it sounds like she is beginning to turn things around.</p> <p>TITLE: Dad Had Seizure, Hospitalized Jamie woke up last week to her mom shouting her dad's name over and over. She ran in to the room and found out her dad was having a seizure. Jamie's dad is doing well at this point- he is up, talking, and eating. When they took him to the E.R. they had to put him on a respirator. Dawson said when something like this happens it is a reminder to spend more time with your father because life is fleeting. He also said that she should tell him how much she appreciates him.</p> <p>TITLE: Grandmother Passed Away Tayler's grandmother passed away this morning. Her grandmother taught her everything about being a woman, brought her to church, and was a big part of her life. Dawson said that God, in his grace, has taken her out of her confusion. Tayler regrets not spending as much time with her in the end. Dawson said he would let that go, comfort herself with how much she loved her and the fact that recently she wouldn't have remembered it anyway.</p> <p>TITLE: Father Took Out Loans In Her Name Claire recently found out that that her adopted father took out \$13,000 of loans in her name that she is responsible for. Claire loves her dad but he cusses her out whenever they talk. Dawson said yes, she can and should forgive him, but stay away from him because he is a thief. Since then, he has been very distant. Dawson reminded Leah that the fact he showed up shows he is making somewhat of an effort and may be capable of doing more through time. Dawson said to continue communicating with her father and thanking him for what he has done for her.</p> <p>TITLE: Parents Want His Daughter Adopted Out Jonathan was in a loving relationship for nearly 4 years, but recently lost his fiancé to a drunk driver. He has a 4 year old daughter. Jonathan's parents are saying they would prefer that his daughter be adopted by a two-parent family rather than staying with him, and having to travel and be in day care because he is in the military. Dawson said this sounds very destructive to his daughter. Dawson recommended he look for a "support family" at his church who can help care for her while he is away in the military.</p> <p>TITLE: Girl He's Seeing, Needs Space Paul has been seeing a girl for a few weeks. After going out for her birthday, he left and she got in to a fight with her sister and hasn't spoken to him for 48 hours. He got a text tonight apologizing for blowing him off the last few days and said she "is going through some things mentally" and "needs her space." Dawson advised Paul that it sounds like it went too fast and she is not ready to be in a serious relationship. Dawson said to let her know that he has received the message that he needs more space, and then he should walk away.</p> <p>TITLE: Cheated On Boyfriend, Self-Harming Naomi has cheated on her boyfriend, and she turned to drugs to help her feel better. Naomi and her boyfriend have broken up, but he said he forgives her. Naomi is very hard on herself and carries a lot of guilt. Naomi is afraid she may get to a point where she may attempt suicide. Dawson said this is not something that can be solved alone. Dawson also said that she should realize that if God, and her boyfriend, can forgive her she needs to forgive herself.</p>

Positive Abuse Pregnancy Positive	1/12/14		Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Thank You For Helping Tessa got in a fight with her family a few years ago due to some changes in medication and health challenges, and shortly after she found Dawson's show for the first time. Things in her life continued to spiral downward to the point that she began using meth and attempted suicide. She was able to contact someone from the Hope Line using chat, and shortly after she was admitted to a hospital where she was able to recover and her health issues were resolved. Tessa was calling to thank Dawson.</p> <p>TITLE: Celibate, Boyfriend Raped Her Tina was sexually abused for four years, and this stopped about eight years ago. As a result she has been celibate for the last couple of years. Tina thought her boyfriend understood why, but he ended up raping her. Tina wonders how she cannot allow the abuse of her past impact her future relationships. Dawson said she does not need to let the past define her. Tina needs to recover and needs to find people who have "been there" to help her deal with this.</p> <p>TITLE: Girlfriend Pregnant, Has Scholarship Brantley's girlfriend got pregnant unexpectedly. His girlfriend's parents are insisting that she go to college and take advantage of her scholarship. As of now: she, Brantley and the baby plan to move to Florida together and Brantley will work to support them while she goes to college. Dawson believes that what is best for the baby long term is for her to get an education. Dawson recommended that Brantley speak to her parents and apologize for the situation and submit to them as the authority in their daughter's life. Dawson said until they get married, Brantley is the third priority, with the first being the baby and the second being his girlfriend.</p> <p>TITLE: From Homeless To Enrolling In College Chelsey said that listening to Dawson's show has helped to impact her life in the past year. Chelsey went from being homeless to now enrolling in college and wanted to thank Dawson for the show that encouraged her to believe in herself and not give up.</p>

She had made a resolution to not date for at least a year. Lincoln respects this, but he also isn't sure what to do because he sees a future with her. Lincoln has some job opportunities in other states and isn't sure if he should accept those. Dawson thinks that these job opportunities could be life-changing for him and he should pursue them. Dawson recommended that he tell her that he respects that she needs a year and he is going to accept one of these opportunities. If the relationship is meant to be she will still be there in a year, and it will give them both a chance to heal.</p> <p>TITLE: Thank You For Help Jennifer wanted to thank Dawson because he has helped her. Jennifer said that many horrible things have happened in the last two and a half years but Dawson's show has really helped her.</p> <p>TITLE: Engaged But Fiancé Has Some Issues Alexis has been with a certain guy for a year now, and she is engaged to him. They plan on getting married within a year. They also plan on having a kid. Her fiancé was hospitalized today for drag racing on ice. Alexis' fiancé said that he doesn't want to lose her but he wants to be able to do whatever he wants. Dawson said it sounds like Alexis is looking to him to solve all his problems, and she is just replacing one set of problems with another. Dawson said that this relationship is screaming for a break; Alexis has problems and so does her boyfriend.</p> <p>TITLE: Friend Committed Suicide Yesterday Shawna's friend committed suicide yesterday. Shawna said they aren't sure why but people think it may be due to bullying. Shawna never suspected that he was hurting on the inside because he was happy. Dawson said sometimes when people have finally made a decision to follow through with suicide they often go through a phase of feeling relieved and happy just before they carry it out. Shawna has helped other people avoid suicide and she would have helped this friend through if she had known. Dawson said this is going to make her a stronger person but it is very hard. Shawna said she just wants whoever is listening to know that they are loved and they are somebody.</p>
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<p>Positive Relationship Family</p>	<p>1/19/14</p>		<p>Hour 3</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Was Suicidal But Life Getting Better Rebecca's parents got divorced when she was 15. It turned her world upside down and she began to turn to her last resort, which was suicide. Her grandfather stepped in and saved the day. She wants people listening to know that things get better, and suicide doesn't have to be their answer. Rebecca said her life has gotten better, she is graduated high school and started college and life is getting better.</p> <p>TITLE: Insecure, Boyfriend Acting Standoffish Shanna has had several bad relationships in the past. Shanna said she is a very insecure person when it comes to relationships. Shanna currently has a wonderful man who just got out of the service and has PTSD. Shanna said he has been standoffish for the last few days. She isn't sure how to handle this. Dawson recommended he needs to get professional help, and she needs to let him know that she loves him and is there for him. Shanna wants to know how she gets past her insecurity and not allow this to affect her. Dawson said she needs to get help because she is suffering as well, and she can take this time to work on herself.</p> <p>TITLE: Discovered Bitterness Towards Mom Maya is a Human Services major in college. In class, they were discussing personal wellness and Maya realized that she has a lot of bitterness toward her mother from things that happened in her childhood. Maya feels it is affecting her current relationships. Dawson said bitterness can be carried from relationship to relationship. Maya says that when she tells her fiancé about her past with her mother, he becomes bitter toward her mother as well. Dawson said he is getting angry because he wants peace, and she doesn't need to tell him every issue that she has with her mother. Dawson said first, Maya needs to work on herself. Dawson recommended that she get help in dealing with her bitterness with her mother. Their parents want them to wait an additional two years to get married while Charlie finishes school. They don't want to step on anyone's toes but they cannot imagine waiting two more years to get married. Dawson said usually parents are right about these situations, and if they respect their wishes to wait it will build a good long term relationship with their families and will receive their parent's blessing.</p> <p>TITLE: Doesn't Feel Adequate Or Important Fred feels like an outsider everywhere he goes. Fred was doing things illegal and immoral but has turned away from that life and now is living right. Fred still doesn't feel adequate or important. Dawson said don't look back, look up and look forward. Dawson recommended a counselor could help and said it sounds like he is being too tough on himself.</p> <p>TITLE: Has Suffered A Lot Of Loss In Her Life Dawn has had a lot of loss in her life with friends passing away, and a miscarriage. Her mother passed away about three days ago. Dawn has children to take care of, and is also worried about her dad. Dawson said often when you have this type of loss you don't want to take care of yourself but you need to take care of yourself, eat, and be there for your children. Dawson also recommended asking the funeral home about speaking with a grief counselor. Dawson suggested writing down the attributes about her mother that she loved and striving to implement those attributes in her own life.</p>

He will not sign the divorce papers and doesn't feel he should have to pay child support. Dawson recommended that Elizabeth have him sign the papers saying she will not ask for any child support because she just needs to do what she can to get him out of her life. Dawson said to get a lawyer to help her with this process.</p> <p>TITLE: Anxiety From 6 Hours Mandatory School Eternity has several charges against him and he has talked to the district attorney about getting some of them dropped. Since his mom didn't show up to court dates he was locked up for 6 months. He has to be logged in to the online school website 6 hours a day and this gives him panic attacks, however the probation officers said they can't help with that. Dawson recommended after the 6 hours of schooling he should get some counseling. Dawson said to do whatever it takes to get his record cleared and serve his punishment so that he can get this all behind him.</p> <p>TITLE: Worried About Future With Girlfriend Allen recently moved back to KY from North Carolina, where he lived for one or two months. He moved to North Carolina looking for a new start and while there he fell in love with a girl named Samantha. Now that he has moved back to KY he is worried about what their future will bring- although his heart wants to stay with her his mind knows it will be hard with their career paths to stay together in the future. Dawson said his mind knows the truth and his heart is playing games with her. Dawson said most likely they will not be able to sustain this relationship, but they can try it knowing it will take a lot of work.</p> <p>TITLE: Feels His Life Is A Mess Martin feels like life is a mess right now. His electricity has been shut off for a week because he has a lack of funds to pay the bill, and he wants to finish college but has no funds. His girlfriend is also pregnant. Martin also just found out that his mom's liver disease is no longer in remission. Dawson feels Martin is depressed and entangled in these issues. Dawson said he needs a team of people surrounding him and supporting him and that he should visit a financial advisor to start to help with his money issues</p>
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<p>Abuse Anger Relationship Family</p>	<p>3/30/14</p>		<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Does Not Trust Men Nicole has had a hard time getting close to her stepdad. She knows the problem is because she doesn't trust men. Her biological father left when she was 7 and never said goodbye. He left her because her uncle raped her. Nicole has also been molested by a friend and by her grandfather. Her stepdad is very kind and has treated her nicely but she feels uncomfortable around him because of her past experience with other men. Dawson recommended she needs to get a male counselor that she can learn to trust and start to work through these issues one step at a time.</p> <p>TITLE: A Lot Of Anger Issues Have Built Up Anna says her and her boyfriend have been together for about a year and she feels she has a lot of anger issues built up inside that she takes out on him. Dawson said that Anna is holding on to unforgiveness from past friendships and she needs to work on that, as well as on identifying the signals when she starts to feel stressed out and angry.</p> <p>TITLE: Boyfriend Cheated With Many Girls Matasha's boyfriend told her in a text message he has been cheating on her and that he has slept with between 8-30 girls in the last 5 months. He has told her he still loves her and wants to be with her. Matasha doesn't want to lose him because she loves him. Dawson said it sounds like she has already lost him and that he is trying to tell her he doesn't want to be with her and trying to make her so mad that she will leave him. Dawson told her to accept the fact that it is over, and ask her girlfriends to help her stay away from him.</p> <p>TITLE: How To Stop Being Father-Figure? Gavin took care of his younger sister when he was 7 or 8 years old. He was like a father-figure to her for a while. Now their mom is married and Gavin's step dad is trying to take the father position in his and his sister's life. Gavin gets in trouble for acting in a fatherly way told his younger sister and being very hard on her. Dawson reminded Gavin that he is not the father in the situation. He recommended that he try to take the position of only saying encouraging things to his sister, and taking his other concerns to his parents so that they can be the authority figure in her life.</p>
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
