When they go to visitation Ashley's mom and siblings blame her that they are in foster care. Dawson recommended that Ashley talk to the judge about what she wants, but to be very careful about going back to her mom until she is sure her mom is ready to admit what happened to them and deal with the issue.</p> <p>TITLE: Boyfriend's Family Doesn't Like Her Allie and her boyfriend have been together for about a year, but recently his parents started to really dislike her. Yesterday, he came home for the weekend and Allie spent a lot of time with him but his family ended up yelling at her. His girlfriend is scared to tell her mom, who is strict, that they want to live together. Dawson suggested going to speak to her mom and asking for her wisdom and counsel and showing her respect. Dawson reminded Billy to have a lot of humility and respect and he thinks Billy will see a big difference in her attitude towards him.</p> <p>TITLE: Absent Dad Wants To See Child Now Kelsey has a 4-year-old daughter. The baby's father left when she was an infant and hasn't seen her in 3 years. He recently got married and now wants joint custody. She is trying to get full custody but allow for visitation. Dawson said that the father will get some sort of visitation rights, so Kelsey might as well accept that. He told her to continue to talk to her lawyer about the best scenario, and try to think about the positives that could come out of her daughter having a relationship with her father.</p> <p>TITLE: Staying Clean Means Goodbye To Past Woody has been clean from cocaine for a year now but needs to know how to tell his friends not to bring drugs around. Dawson said Woody shouldn't even be around people who are reintroducing drugs into the picture. Dawson told Woody that the only "friend" they care about is their drugs. He said there is no nice way to tell his friends that they can't come around him if they do drugs.</p> <p>TITLE: Suspects Husband Of Cheating Holly recently was admitted to the hospital as a result of an overdose. Holly suspects her husband is seeing someone else but has never been able to catch him. A while back he left for 4 days straight. Holly isn't sure if she should continue with her marriage or if they should go their separate ways. Dawson told Holly that they should at least have a legal separation to get his attention and allow them each to work on themselves.</p>

He suggested that a good compromise might be waiting a year out of respect for her parents and to give them both time to focus, plus the distance will be a good test.</p> <p>TITLE: God Helped Him Turn Life Around Delan called in to let listeners know they aren't alone. He has had problems with friends and relationships that caused him a lot of pain but he was able to get through it. He nearly took his life, but then he started reading the Bible. He said that God is what got him through that time. Every morning he reads Joshua 1:9 which remind him not to be afraid or discouraged.</p> <p>TITLE: Learn From The Relationship Ending James and his girlfriend broke up today. James got upset because she spends so much time with her family that he never gets to see her. James realizes he was being a little self-centered. Dawson said James should move on from this relationship. He recommended that James sit down with a counselor or minister and discuss what he has learned from this situation and what he can do differently next time.</p> <p>TITLE: Responsible For Too Much Lately Melissa's mom left when she was 11, and her dad recently had a stroke. She drives an hour and a half between home, hospital, work, and school. Dawson said Melissa can't keep up the pace and recommended going to see her dad every other day to cut down on the travel. Dawson is afraid Melissa is on the edge of a breakdown and has taken on the responsibility of being a parent when she doesn't need to. He also told Melissa to consider cutting back hours at work and school. Dawson told Melissa that she needs a counselor to help her.</p>

He was in a serious relationship for several years and she broke up with him while he was in Germany. Daniel tried to focus on his career and bettering himself for a while but he has been desiring to get out in the dating world again, but he is struggling with letting himself open up again. Dawson told Daniel that he needs to socialize with women- not in a romantic or intimate way, but just in a conversational way so he can build up trust in them again. He told Daniel that there are a lot of women out there that will be looking for friendship, and it could always grow into something more.</p> <p>TITLE: Came Out On Other Side Of Depression John lost his mom to MS when he was in 4th grade. After that happened his dad left and his grandparents ended up adopting John and his sister. He lost a friend to a drunk driving accident in 7th grade. In 8th grade year he lost another friend who accidentally shot himself. He was engaged and recently broke off that relationship because she was cheating on him. John started drinking and went into a deep depression. Now he has come out on the other side and can see that God has a plan for his life. Dawson said that John's story and his ability to pass through those dark times is an encouragement for everyone.</p> <p>TITLE: Friends Said His Girlfriend Was Cheating Corban has heard that his girlfriend has been cheating on him. They have been together for about a year but had a rough patch recently. A couple of his friends started rumors that she cheated but Corban isn't sure who to believe. Corban broke up with her but she keeps saying she still loves him. Dawson said that if enough people say the same thing, they are probably right. He told Corban that his friends have no reason to lie to him, but he just doesn't want to believe it. Dawson said that the sooner he can get out of this relationship, the better.</p> <p>TITLE: Feeling Terrible Right Now Luis struggles with pain in his body and an anxiety order he has had since he was younger. He is feeling terrible right now. Dawson said that he is going to send him to the HopeCoaches right away because there is a lot he needs to talk about and it is going to take some time. He wants him to get help right away!</p>

They hang out and talk every day, and go out together. Recently she feels they are getting closer, and Susie now sees him as more than a friend. Susie isn't sure if she should tell him about this because he has a girlfriend. Dawson recommended waiting until if and when Matthew and his girlfriend split up. He told Susie to be very patient and then once he is over his current relationship she can ask him to define their relationship.</p> <p>TITLE: Suspects Girlfriend Is Cheating Cody is dating a girl who is only 17. They have been off and on and he suspects that she is cheating on him. He also thinks she might be stalking him. He isn't sure if he should keep trying or if he should walk away. Dawson said that Cody doesn't need this drama in his life, and since she is underage there is potential for him to get in trouble down the road. Dawson recommended getting out of this relationship as soon as he can.</p> <p>TITLE: Friends Forcing Him To Take Sides Kameron's friends are fighting with each other and are trying to force him to take sides. Kameron has been in and out of the hospital due to having strokes and he attempted suicide earlier this year. He slit his wrists but his brother found him in time. Dawson said that Kameron doesn't need any more stress in his life. He told Kameron to have one on one conversations with each of his friends and let them know that he needs to get out of those relationships until after Kameron can get the help he needs.</p> <p>TITLE: Husband Cheating, Afraid To Leave Lindsey has known her husband since 3rd grade. Within the first year he started texting other girls. When she was pregnant with her daughter, he asked some girl to send him pictures. When she was pregnant with her son, she says he made out with another girl. In September, he was secretly sleeping with someone. Lindsey said that if she left, she feels like he would try to use his money and power over her. Dawson said that Lindsey needs to go talk with a lawyer. He told Lindsey that this guy is showing her total disrespect.</p>

Every time they've broken up she has fallen for his promises but this time Michelle put her foot down and kicked him out. Now he is begging Michelle to take him back. Dawson told Michelle how important it is for her to remember how she is feeling right now and not to let him sweet talk his way back into her life. Dawson said she is doing the right thing by removing him from her life.</p> <p>TITLE: Saw Someone Jump To His Death Sean was recently in jail due to an unpaid traffic violation and he saw someone jump to his death when he was in prison. Sean sees the scene replay in his head and can't sleep at night. He is self-medicating with drugs. Dawson said that Sean really needs to get into some counseling and needs to work through this pain. Dawson also talked to Sean's wife and told her to be strong and make sure Sean deals with this pain he is holding inside; he also warned her to not allow this to define their relationship.</p> <p>TITLE: Caregiver For Dying Grandmother Shara's grandmother has cancer of the mouth and Shara is the person caring for her grandmother. She wanted her mom to come to see her but she won't. Dawson said that her mom is probably not going to come. He reminded Shara that what she is doing for her grandmother is short term because her grandmother doesn't have much time left. He told Shara when she gets overwhelmed to lean on her sister and aunt, and to remind herself that this is short term. Dawson recommended that Shara start working on forgiving her mom, and also remembering to take care of herself.</p> <p>TITLE: Husband Sleeping With Ex Kimber found out her husband has been sleeping with his ex-girlfriend since before they got married. He has been telling this other woman that he loves her and was going to leave Kimber for her. Kimber hasn't made a decision on if the relationship is completely over yet. She is also a recovering addict. Dawson told Kimber to really be on her guard about her former addiction coming back to taunt her while she is dealing with this heartache. Dawson doesn't believe that this guy is going to change. Dawson said that Kimber could give him one more shot but he still doesn't think that it sounds good.</p>

<p>Stress Friendship Grief Relationship</p>	<p>7/17/16</p>	<p>Hour 3</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Friend Brought Drugs Into House Sam was hospitalized and was short on rent so allowed a friend to move in to help. The renter was using drugs and the neighbors called the cops. Because they found drugs on the person staying with them, Sam and her boyfriend got arrested. Now that they are out of jail Sam is having a hard time getting the state to give her child back because her boyfriend isn't complying with the probation terms. Dawson said that the only thing Sam can do is break up with him and show the state that she is making her son a priority. Dawson said that her boyfriend isn't putting Sam or their child at the top of his priority.</p> <p>TITLE: On Her Way To Help A Friend Adrienne friend's brothers physically abuse her. Adrienne is at the bus station on her way to Seattle to try to bring Adrienne to her house. Adrienne is a black belt in Tai Kwon Do and isn't afraid to use her training to step in if her friend's brothers lay a hand on either of them. Dawson feels like Adrienne is walking into a bad situation and is afraid she isn't using wisdom. Dawson said that if Adrienne's friend really wanted help she would get on the bus and come back to Georgia. Dawson suggested that Adrienne not go anywhere near the house or family but if she insists on going out there, meet her friend at a different location.</p> <p>TITLE: Lost His Grandpa, Wants To Give Up Nick just lost his grandpa yesterday. They were really close and right now he feels like he wants to give up. Dawson said that Nick's grandpa was a gift from God and it is going to take a while for him to get through it. He also suggested making a list of all of the qualities he loved about his grandpa and to look at that list whenever he gets sad. Dawson told Nick to go to his boss and ask for his help; he said to let him know exactly what is going on and that Nick needs some time to deal with all of this.</p> <p>TITLE: Not Sure If He Can Believe Ex Steven broke up with his girlfriend because she was constantly lying. A few weeks later she called and said she was pregnant and then said she had an abortion. Steven isn't sure what to believe since she has a history of lying. Dawson said that he obviously can't trust this girl and she is very troubled. He said Steven needs to break all ties with her, and if she really is pregnant that will become clear soon.</p>

<p>Grief Suicide Relationship Relationship</p>	<p>7/17/16</p>		<p>Hour 4</p> <p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p>TITLE: Grandmother Passed Away Brooke has been diagnosed with an anxiety disorder and clinical depression since she was 16. Brooke's grandmother, who was her best friend, passed away in November. Dawson told Brooke to slow down and take the time to get the help she needs for her grief. He told Brooke to not overcommit herself or let herself be overwhelmed. Dawson also said he is hoping she will find a good friend when she starts school who will walk alongside her. He also told her to work with a school advisor that she can go to when she needs someone.</p> <p>TITLE: How To Help Suicidal Friend? Nicole has had a best friend for about a year. Her friend recently tried to commit suicide after a break up and Nicole doesn't know how to help her. Dawson told Nicole that her friend needs to look into "Contract for Life" which is a commitment to take steps when you are feeling suicidal. Dawson told Nicole that no matter what happens, Nicole needs to know that she is doing her best for her friend and the weight of it isn't on her shoulders.</p> <p>TITLE: Been On And Off With Girlfriend Tren grew up with his ex-girlfriend and they have been together on and off since 7th grade. They ended up moving in together and Tren said it didn't work well at all. Now they are starting to talk again and he isn't sure if he should keep trying to work things out with her. She lost her best friend and 6 months ago Catie tried to kill herself. She went to inpatient treatment and now is in outpatient treatment, but she doesn't feel it's helping. Jess suggested that Catie go to a suicide survivors support group to learn how others cope, and think how it would impact people around her if she killed herself. Dawson said that Gage is grieving both of these deaths as well as the situation with his family. He told Gage he would ask the listeners to call in with their advice.

She moved in with a best friend's family. When he goes up there to visit he has to encounter his girlfriend's friend's family who are alcoholic and very aggressive toward Dalton. Dalton's girlfriend has 4 months left in high school. Dawson reminded Dalton that this is short term and he needs to sit with a counselor to talk through what is reasonable to do in this short time period. He told Dalton that if he loves her he might have to stay away for the short term so he doesn't aggravate the situation.</p> <p>TITLE: Fiancé Not Willing To Get Counseling Jose proposed to his girlfriend 3 years ago. She has called off the engagement twice. He keeps trying to get her to come to couple's counseling but she refuses. Dawson said that she doesn't want to invest in their relationship. He recommended that Jose tell her he is taking a time out from their relationship and he is going to get some counseling and work on himself. Dawson told Jose that he needs to find a team of people to support him because giving her up isn't going to be easy after being with her for all these years.</p> <p>TITLE: Dawson's Advice Helped Him Grow Michael called a few weeks ago about trying to mend the relationship with his girlfriend's mom. Dawson suggested that Michael write her a letter and explain to her what actually happened, and ask to sit down with her to discuss the situation. Michael's girlfriend's mom gained respect for him because he stepped up to the plate and wrote the letter. Now she has given her blessing for Michael and his girlfriend to continue with their relationship. Dawson said that Michael showed courage, respect and humility.</p> <p>TITLE: Cut Unsupportive Boyfriend Loose Rachel's boyfriend broke up with her 3 weeks ago because she is on probation. Rachel has gone through rehab and was doing better. Now he is posting pictures with his ex and texting Rachel then not responding. Dawson said that he is playing a game with her and trying to control her emotions. He is doing this out of immaturity not love. Dawson said that she needs to cut him off and not respond or react to him.</p>

Shyann had problems with cutting in the past. Dawson said that showing her these pictures is manipulative and abusive. Dawson said that he is scaring her, and it is especially dangerous since she was a cutter in the past. He recommended that Shyann put dating on hold and work on herself. He feels she needs to grow and heal so that she can be in a better position to have a relationship later.</p> <p>TITLE: Boyfriend Becoming An Alcoholic Kerrie and her boyfriend are carnival workers. He has to do a lot of physical work he is not used to and he hates it. He started drinking with the guys, and when she tries to wake him up to go to work he gets angry. Dawson said Kerrie has already been with him a year and hasn't been able to convince him to change his ways. He fears that Kerrie's boyfriend is slipping into alcoholism. He reminded Kerrie that she isn't responsible for him. Dawson's opinion is that he would have to make a total turnaround in order for their relationship to make it.</p> <p>TITLE: Clean Now, Wants To See His Daughter Billy has been split up with his daughter's mother due to his drug addiction. Billy has been clean for 6 months now. Before Billy's problem got really serious she cheated on him often. Billy's ex constantly bashes him on social media and it is making him really depressed. Billy has been trying to see his daughter but she won't let him. Dawson said the custody issue needs to be dealt with as a legal matter, and none of this should be dealt with on social media. Dawson asked the listeners to call in with advice.</p> <p>TITLE: Can't Forgive Sister's Murderer Robin's sister was murdered in April. The police didn't collect all the evidence at the crime scene so the boyfriend who murdered her is not going to be charged with murder; just with tampering with evidence. Dawson said the first thing Robin needs to do is to keep telling her story. He said that although her sister's boyfriend killed her sister, he is also torturing Robin by getting away with this. Dawson told Robin that she is going to need to learn to forgive this man so that he doesn't continue to have this power over her.</p>

Her family said it happened because she is a bad mom. Tiffany found her baby dead when she woke up in the morning. Her mom and dad are saying that they tried to tell her to give her child up for adoption and she should have done that. Dawson said that what Tiffany's family said was totally inappropriate and there is nothing she could have done to stop what happened. Dawson asked listeners to call in with advice and encouragement.</p> <p>TITLE: Smoking And Alcohol Addiction Alex is struggling with smoking. He smokes a pack a day or more if he is out drinking and it costs him up to \$600-\$700 each month. Alex is a promoter and musician, and spends a lot of time out due to his job. Dawson feels that Alex is a borderline alcoholic. He advised getting involved with AA or some other rehabilitation group because nothing will change if he doesn't do something different. Dawson said this problem will not go away on its own and Alex will have to pay a price to get clean, even if that means giving up him music for a time.</p> <p>TITLE: Encouragement For Tiffany Mia lost her son when she was 16. She told Mia that nothing will take away the hole she has in her heart for her son, but she was able to heal and because of her pain she became a nurse so she can help others. She also advised her not to adopt so soon but allow herself to heal first.</p> <p>TITLE: Being Bullied By Sister Stephanie is being bullied by her sister. Her sister calls her names and yells at her. They don't live together, but she does everything she can to bring Stephanie down. Stephanie's mom has never been there for her and her dad passed away. Stephanie has depression and anxiety and is in counseling. Stephanie's counselor tells her to ignore her sister, but she loves her niece and doesn't want to give up time with her.
