This jobs hotline includes language options for English and Spanish. Job openings are always posted on www.nbcunicareers.com, and the Company’s Staffing Center advertises job openings with targeted/specialized web sites in the broadcast industry when necessary. Both stations’ web sites also provide links directly to www.nbcunicareers.com. This recruiting web site, which is available to the public, now allows NBCUniversal internal employees to apply for open jobs, which promotes career advancement opportunities for all employees. NBCUniversal’s Employee Referral Program has been updated and the Human Resources Department at the Employment Unit has sent this new information to the Employment Unit’s population. The program is designed to further the promotion of diverse recruiting by our own employees.

- February 14, 2021, The Philadelphia chapter of the NBCUniversal Black Employee Network, hosted and kicked off the Klein College Spring Career Fair with a “Chat with BEN”. with a purpose of identifying diverse students to work behind the scenes in journalism.
- Temple University Klein College of Media and Communication Spring Internship and Career Fair. Our Human Resources Generalist, Lia Pope, attended this career fair (February 18, 2022) for the purpose of recruiting candidates and interns.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The Employment Unit maintains an established internship program designed to give exposure to college students about careers in the broadcast industry. During the FCC reporting period covered in this report, 10 college students participated in the program during the Fall, Spring and Summer sessions. The NBC 10/Telemundo62 Internship

Program in Philadelphia also exposes interns to senior WCAU and WWSI personnel who address the students and share key career information. Interns participated in the following “Lunch and Learn” sessions: Meet the General Manager of WCAU and WWSI, News Management, On-air Talent, Integrated Media, and resume writing. The interns also participate in a Mini-Newscast. The Program Coordinator is Lia Pope, Human Resources Generalist, WCAU-TV & WWSI-TV, NBCU Philadelphia.

EMMA BOWEN Foundation for Minority Interests in Media

The Employment Unit participates in the Emma Bowen Foundation internship program, a broadcasting industry scholarship program designed to provide part-time jobs and learning experiences to minority high school and college students. The program is unlike other intern programs in that the students work for their partner company during the summers and school breaks from the end of their senior year in high school until they graduate from college. During the four-year-period, students have the opportunity to learn the many aspects of broadcast operations and develop company-specific skills. Students are paid for the work they complete and additionally receive matching dollars from the stations designed to assist them with their academic costs. The station has the opportunity to guide and develop minority students to prepare them for opportunities of permanent placement or Associates Program placement upon completion of their college degree. The station has had one minority student from the Emma Bowen program during the period covered by this report.
