#### 1/7/22

COVID Hospitalizations (health/medical) – HSHS leaders says the system hospitals in Wisconsin and Illinois have a record-breaking number of COVID-19 patients. System leaders say there are 303 hospitalized COVID patients. The previous record was 293, set in November 2020. HSHS doctors say 80 percent of patients are unvaccinated, and they're urging people to get vaccinated or get their boosters.

Thompson Resigns (education) – UW System Interim President Tommy Thompson announces his resignation. Thompson stepped in after the system had trouble filling the job after Ray Cross retired. Thompson will leave the post at the end of March.

Digital Literacy (technology) – A new program is available in Eau Claire County to help community members become more proficient online. The hope it help people feel more comfortable use technology, including to make appointments, order groceries, respond to emails or take classes. The digital literacy program pairs people with UW-Eau Claire students who "coach" them on how to use technology.

Homicide Sentencing (violence) – A judge in Barron County sentences 26-year-old Andrew Brunette to life in prison with the chance for parole after 50 years. Brunette was convicted in November 2021 of killing Garrett Macone. Macone was in a relationship with Brunette's estranged wife. Brunette admitted to shooting Macone in the head while he was sleeping.

#### 1/20/22

Koreen's Law (health/medical) – An Eau Claire woman testified before state lawmakers in support of a bill in her name. The bill would ban the insurance practice of white-bagging. It requires drugs to come for a third-party pharmacy instead of a hospital's pharmacy. This impacted Koreen during breast cancer treatment, and she hopes to help ban the practice. The senate committee did not vote on the legislation yet.

Halderson Verdict (violence) – 23-year-old Chandler Halderson was found guilty by a Dane County jury of killing his parents in July. The jury deliberated for two hours before finding him guilty on two counts of first-degree intentional homicide. Halderson killed his parents and dismembered their bodies after his father found out his was lying about school and work. Sentencing is scheduled for March.

Rail Meeting (business/economy) – Eau Claire hasn't had passenger rail service since the 1960. A local coalition has tried to change that for more than 20 years. During the rail coalition's monthly meeting, the Wisconsin DOT announced the Twin Cities, Milwaukee, Chicago (TCMC) Project. It will add to the current train route between Chicago and Minneapolis. A potential component of the project is a shuttle service from Eau Claire to take people to the Tomah Amtrak station. There's no timeline on when the shuttle service could start, if it becomes part of the project.

#### 1/28/22

Flood Risk Plan (environment) – After a decade, a flood mitigation plan for Arcadia in Trempealeau County is still in the works. The Trempealeau River runs through the city, and heavy rains have caused frequent flooding. The Army Corps of Engineers proposed a four-phase plan to prevent future flooding, but it may take another 10 years to complete. The Corps recently secured some federal funding to help get the ball rolling. The hope is to start phase one in 2023.

At Home Care Program (medical) – A new Mayo Clinic Health System program allows some patients to bring the hospital home with them after surgery. Known as Advanced Care At Home, it offers some patients the opportunity to recover at home when they would typically have to spend a few days in the hospital. The hospital coordinates transport back to your home. At home, staff set up connections to physicians and other care providers, and they also provide things like blood pressure monitoring and oxygen monitoring.

#### 2/10/22

House Blessing Ceremony (family values) – Chippewa Valley Habitat for Humanity hosted a house blessing for a home on Eddy Street. The home was donated to CVH4H in 2021 and remodeled by the organization for Marlie Sabelko and her daughter. Sabelko had been looking for a home since 2019. With help from the Eau Claire Housing Authority, RCU and CVH4H – Sabelko has a safe and affordable home.

UWEC students visit refugees (education/cultural development) – Students with UW-Eau Claire spent two weeks of their winter break at Fort McCoy with the Afghan refugees. The immersion program was put together as an impromptu program by UWEC faculty and staff. Students say they expected people to be sad with everything they've been through, but it was the opposite.

Wolf protections (environment) – A judge restores protections for gray wolves. Citing the Fish and Wildlife Service failed to show the wolf populations could be sustained without protection under the Endangered Species Act.

#### 2/18/22

Thompson Sentencing (violence) – The man convicted in a La Crosse homicide in 2019 is sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole. In November 2020, Shavonte Thompson was convicted in the death of Javier Hall. Thompson eluded law enforcement officers for nearly two months after the homicide before he was found in Illinois.

Home and Garden Show (business) – The Home and Garden Show is this weekend in Eau Claire. The event is hosted by the Chippewa Valley Home Builders Association and features more than 120 vendors ready to help you with any spring projects.

#### 2/25/22

Student Walkout (youth) – Flambeau High School students walked out of school this morning in support of their principal. Earlier this week, the board decided not to renew his contract for next school year. He is currently on administrative leave. Students believe Craig Cahoon is being treated unfairly for cooperating with a previous investigation against the school board president.

Implicit Bias Exhibit (education) – A Smithsonian exhibition will be on display at the Pablo Center in Eau Claire during the month of March. "The Bias Inside Us" exhibit explore implicit bias and how to overcome it.

Milwaukee Police Station Shooting (violence) – The Milwaukee Police Chief says a 23-year-old man opened fire inside Police District 5 Friday afternoon. Officers returned fire. A few blocks away, the suspect was hit by gunfire and taken to the hospital. No one inside the police station lobby was hurt.

#### 3/9/22

Sleep Awareness Month (health) – March is Sleep Awareness Month. The National Institutes of Health finds up to 19 percent of U.S. adults report not getting enough rest. Melatonin use is also on the rise. Doctors attribute the pandemic to disrupting people's sleep habits. Poor sleep can affect your weight, heart and overall health. Doctors recommend getting an average of 7.5 to 8 hours of sleep a night.

New Clinic (medical) – A healthcare grant will pay for a new clinic in Elroy in Juneau County. The grant totals more than \$6 million. More than \$2 million will go to the city for infrastructure to help with construction of the new clinic. More than \$4 million will go to Gundersen St. Joseph to build the facility. It will include exam rooms, behavioral health, chiropractic care and a pharmacy.

Health Improvement Plan (health) – La Crosse County is making a plan to address some of the biggest health concerns in the community. The health department is forming a Community Health Improvement Plan. The plan will focus on three priorities: behavioral health, healthy environments and access to care. A five-year strategy is being put together to help see tangible improvements.

#### 3/18/2022

Buffalo Co. homicide sentencing (violence) – Randall Merrick of Minnesota is sentenced to 30 years in prison in the death of Beth Johnson of the Village of Nelson. In November, Merrick pleaded guilty to reckless homicide in Johnson's death. Johnson disappeared in 2016 when she was living with Merrick at her home in the Village of Nelson. In 2018, a K9 found Johnson's remains on the property. Merrick was charged in her death in 2020.

Health care worker shortage (health) – The medical field is facing a significant shortage. The number of nurses, surgical techs and pharmacists in the health care industry all declined 20-21. Gundersen Health System started a medical assistant program to help fill the gaps.

Sport Show (economy/business) – After two years, the Wisconsin Sport Show is back this weekend at the Chippewa Valley Expo Center in Eau Claire. The event runs Friday through Sunday and features more than 160 booths and 20,000 square feet in outdoor equipment.

Hometown Grant (children) – The School District of Altoona is awarded at \$10,000 Hometown grant from Fuel Up to Play 60. The grant is awarded to school districts with a commitment to youth health and wellness.
