Fake Notices (business) - Fake quarantine notices were placed on several business storefronts in Eau Claire. The Eau Claire City-County Health Department says the isolation/quarantine notices are fake and believes the notices were put up by people opposed to proposed health ordinances in the city and the county.

Chamber Letter (health/business) - The Eau Claire Area Chamber of Commerce is asking the Eau Claire City-County Health Department to pull back proposed health ordinances in the city and the county. Chamber President and CEO David Minor says the ordinances do not include input from the business community.

Outdoor Living Sales (business) - Retailers selling outdoor living accessories, such as fire pits and hot tubs, say sales are booming. Retailers say with more people staying home during the pandemic, they're purchasing more outdoor items to make their backyards more enjoyable and cozier.

10/15/2020

Restaurant Closing (business) – Loopy's High Shores Supper Club on Lake Wissota in Chippewa County is closing. Owner Loopy Kleich says the pandemic is forcing him to close after two years. Kleich says he needs to focus on his other business, Loopy's Grill and Saloon in Chippewa Falls, which will stay open.

Mental Health Training (health) – The Dunn Co. Partnership for Youth is offering first aid training for mental health. The class will teach ways to identify the early signs and the best ways to help someone during a crisis. November and December classes are full, but the partnership plans to add more in the future.

Ridin' for a Reason Donation (medical) – Ridin' for a Reason, which is an annual motorcycle rally in the Chippewa Valley to raise awareness and money in the fight against breast cancer, donated \$15,000 to Marshfield Clinic for its mobile mammography program. This year's event was held virtually. In 12 years, Ridin' for a Reason has raised more than \$150,000.

Cranberry Season (agriculture) – The cranberry season harvest is underway way in Wisconsin. A farmer in Black River Falls says this year's harvest is off to a great start. The WI Cranberry Grower's Association says cranberries is a billion-dollar business in the state.

10/29/2020

Glaze Memorial (violence) – The Rusk County community remembers the life of a fallen deputy. Deputy Dan Glaze was shot and killed in the line of duty four years ago. A new plaque in memory of Glaze was unveiled at the sheriff's office.

Candlelight Vigil (violence) An emergency shelter for victims of domestic violence held a virtual candlelight vigil to remember the 72 Wisconsin lives lost in 2019 to domestic violence.

Get Living Safely Campaign (business) – A business association in La Crosse is launching a new campaign hoping to encourage people to shop locally during the holiday season, while still staying safe by utilizing options such as curbside pickup. The business association hopes people choose community over the convenience of online shopping.

COVID Pet Businesses (business) – Two, local pet boarding businesses opened in late 2019. The businesses share the challenges of having their first year of business during a pandemic, while also adjusting to stay open when fewer people are traveling or leaving home for work and needing a place for the pets to go.

Child Welfare & Virtual School (children) – With many schools implementing virtual learning due to the pandemic, teachers are getting a window into homes and possibly signs of abuse. Teachers are mandatory reporters and trained in what to look for. A local district points out, online communication may make it hard to notice other signs of abuse.

11/5/2020

Field Fires (agriculture) – A warm, dry start to the month November is making conditions drier than normal in the area, which is leading to more corn field fires. As farmer harvest their fields, it can dry out the topsoil. Fire crews say they've responded to more fires than usual this year due to the dry conditions.

Record COVID cases (health) – Eau Claire County reports a record 240 new cases of COVID-19. The previous highest was October 25 with 178 positive tests. Eau Claire County now has a total of more than 4,500 COVID-19 cases.

Thank-A-Teacher (education) – The La Crosse Public Education Foundation provided faculty in the School District of La Crosse with care boxes filled with snacks. The foundation wanted to thank educators as they continue to stay committed to their students. Virtual learning in the district will continue into next year.

12/14/2020

Bands Thank Frontline Workers (health/education) – The Eau Claire North and Memorial bands joined forces to play music for the employees at Eau Claire's three hospitals Monday night. The bands hope the music helps lift the spirits of the frontline workers. One nurse says it's nice to see support for healthcare workers still going strong this far into the pandemic.

12/15/2020

Building Community Fund (business/economy) – The La Crosse Area Chamber of Commerce is teaming up with local construction companies to offer support to local businesses. Small businesses in need of financial assistance have until January 15 to apply. Each grant handed out will be approximately \$7,000.

Water Meeting (environment) – The Village of Bruce Board met to come up with solutions after the community's wells tested positive for manganese. This prompted the village to tell community members not to drink the water. The Board is working to come up with short and long term solutions. For now, community members can fill up water receptacles at the village hall where a water filtration system is being put in place.

12/16/2020

COVID Long-Haulers (medical) – A local woman shares her story of living with COVID-19 symptoms for months after contracting the virus. She says her sense of smell and taste comes and goes. Doctors says COVID affects people differently based on our immune systems.

Spring Break Canceled (education) – UW-Stout in Menomonie cancels spring break for 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The spring semester will start on time in January, but it will end a week earlier – at the end of April instead of in May.

Tools For Schools (education) – Five schools in the area are awarded a total of nearly \$5,000 from the Chippewa Valley Home Builders Association. It's part of the Tools for Schools

program, and the goal is to get more students interested in trying the trade courses offered at their school. Bloomer High School plans to use the funds it received to buy a new laser engraver.

COVID Dentists (health) – Local dentists says people are putting off their regular dental checkups due to the pandemic, which isn't a good idea. The dentists say they're taking every precaution, including wearing multiple masks and face shields and disinfecting surfaces to help keep people safe.

Snow Day Plan (education) – The Eau Claire Area School District says there won't be any snow days for at least this school year. If in-person learning cannot happen because of snowy weather, the day with be a virtual learning day instead. The school district says it has the technology in place, and it doesn't want students to fall further behind by missing more school this year.

12/17/2020

COVID vaccine arrives (health)—The first COVID-19 vaccines arrived in the Chippewa Valley as healthcare workers at three local hospitals rolled up their sleeves to get their shots. Tavern League Hearing (business/economy) – As the WI Supreme Court hears arguments on whether Governor Evers had the authority to limit capacity in restaurants and bars, the president of the Eau Claire City County Tavern League says owners want to work with state and local governments to find ways to slow the spread of the virus while still being able to do business.

12/18/2020

Teen Shot (violence) – An Eau Claire Memorial freshman is shot Thursday afternoon in the Town of Washington. It happened at a home in the 3400 block of Pomona Drive. The Eau Claire County Sheriff's Office says the investigation is ongoing. The ECASD said additional counselors were available Friday and will be available again next week to help students and staff process this traumatic situation.

Pregnancy and COVID vaccine (medical) – An OBGYN with Marshfield Clinic says it's safe for pregnant women to get the COVID-19 vaccine. He says unlike other vaccines that contain a live virus, the COVID-19 vaccine should not negatively impact pregnancy or fertility. He says the benefit of getting the vaccine outweighs the risk of getting COVID-19.

Teacher Award (education) – A fourth grade teacher in La Crosse is one of five Wisconsin finalists for a national teaching award for math and science. The winner will be announced in Washington, D.C. at a later date. The winner receives \$10,000.

Unsafe Wager (environment) – More communities are seeing high levels of manganese in well water, which is forcing advisories when it comes to unsafe drinking water. The DNR says it's stepping up testing for manganese and expects more communities to have issues. Communities are either shutting off wells with the high levels or installing filtration systems as short-term solutions.

12/21/2020

COVID Relief Deal (economy) – Local community members react to Congress's pandemic relief bill, saying they don't think \$600 is enough.

Vaccine Arrives (health) – After delays due to the application process, the first doses of the COVID-19 vaccine arrive Monday in the Coulee Region. Mayo Clinic Health System gave the first vaccines to its employees. Gundersen Health System plans to give its first employees the vaccine Tuesday.

Regis Donation (education) – Students and staff at Immaculate Conception Elementary in the Regis Catholic School System in Eau Claire used money they collected to purchase care baskets for healthcare workers. The baskets include water, hot cocoa, and fuzzy socks.

Solar Donation (education) – The Solar on La Crosse Schools (SOLS) group donated \$500 to Summit Elementary School to purchase new equipment to help the school and the district continue to try to conserve energy.

COVID At-Home Test (health) – Governor Evers announces an initiative to make sure every Wisconsinite can get an at-home COVID-19 testing kit for free. You can have the test shipped directly to your home. Instructions on how to take the saliva test and how to send it in for testing are included.

Drive-Thru Holiday Party (children) – The Chippewa County Department of Human Services held a drive-thru Christmas party for foster families. Usually the part includes Santa, gifts, and activities for about 60 families. Due to COVID, this year's event was a drive-thru event. Santa still helped deliver presents to the children in foster care.

Teachers Donate Meals (children) – Teachers and staff at North High School in Eau Claire teamed up with a local restaurant to provide meals to families in need on the northside of town. The teachers paid for most of the meals themselves.

Christmas Giveaway (children) – The Trempealeau County Sheriff's Office adapted to COVID-19 this year by hosting a drive-thru gift giveaway. Usually, the sheriff's office provides gifts for 150-200 children. Even though this year's event was smaller, it hopes the gifts still offer some relief to families in need.
