Dateline NBC: NBC News correspondents cover topical news, in-depth investigations and newsmaker profiles. Schedule varies.

The Chris Matthews Show: A weekly interview program hosted by MSNBC's Chris Matthews, who puts his 30+ years of Washington experience to work getting inside the story from the nation's most plugged-in journalists. Regular programs include Sundays from 5-5:30 p.m.

Rock Center with Brian Williams: NBC's Brian Williams covers topical news with in-depth interviews and investigations. This program also covers current news stories including human interest, environmental, political and economic interests. Schedule varies.
