Oct. 7

Humane Society Donation (children) – Eighth graders in Arcadia spent the last six weeks learning how to run a business and the importance of giving back. They operated a food truck business and sold ice cream treats to middle and high school students. The eighth graders raised \$345, which is being donated to the Trempealeau County Humane Society.

Bolton Day of Unity (violence) – 40 years ago – October 6, 1982 – Officer Robert Bolton with the Eau Claire Police Department was killed in the line of duty while responding to a domestic disturbance. The Eau Claire Police Department held a special ceremony marking the anniversary, which included words from Bolton's widow.

Referendum Meeting (education) – The Eau Claire Area School District hosted its first of three informational sessions about a referendum question on the November ballot. The referendum is asking for nearly \$100 million to address aging infrastructure. If approved, South Middle School would be the biggest beneficiary with around \$42 million.

House Party Registry (substance abuse) – In partnership with the Eau Claire Police Department, UW-Eau Claire is starting a new system aimed at helping with noise complaints from house parties off campus. UWEC students would have to register through a student portal with the date and time of the party and contact information. When police get noise complaints in the area, officers can contact the person listed as opposed to responding to the party in person.

Cancer Awareness T-shirt fundraiser (children) – The Eau Claire North H.S. football and volleyball teams are partnering up during breast cancer awareness month. Two football captains are selling pink t-shirts for students and parents to wear to the volleyball game and a football game. All the proceeds are going to the mom of one of the football players who was recently diagnosed with breast cancer.

Oct. 18, 19 and 20

Homicide Suspects in Court (violence) – The two people accused of killing an Altoona man had preliminary hearings in Eau Claire County Court. Brandon Gaston of Illinois and Tracey

Clark of Altoona are charged in the death of 79-year-old Dennis Schattie of Altoona. The two are accused of killing Schattie and putting his body in the Rock River in Illinois.

DNR PFAS Briefing (environment) – The Department of Natural Resources launched an interactive data site to see where PFAS impact the state. The human-made chemicals are found in certain products with 98 percent of Americans having measurable levels of the chemicals in their blood from ingesting contaminated food or water.

Mobile Mammography (health) – During Breast Cancer Awareness Month, Prevea Health is highlighting its mobile mammography unit. The bus travels to communities, specifically more rural areas, to help make sure when can get breast cancer screenings. The mobile unit is similar to a hospital setting with the ability to travel out into the community.

Hmong Discussion (cultural development) – A new series at the L.E. Phillips Memorial is hosting a three-part series exploring Hmong culture and history. Building Our Community: Hmong in the Chippewa Valley aims to help people better understand the Hmong people and how they ended up in western Wisconsin.

New Memory Care Facility (health) – Grace Lutheran Communities held an open house to showcase its new memory care facility. In July, the facility began transitioning from a skilled nursing and rehab provide to an assisted living facility. It will now offer 24 beds for traditional assisted living and 24 beds dedicated to memory care.

Solar Tree (environment) – A new solar tree is up and running in Boyd Park in Eau Claire. The 17-foot-tall tree is said to generate the same amount of energy as solar panels on a 25-hundred square foot home. A second tree is set to be installed next year.

Oct. 27

Domestic Violence Program (violence) – The Family Support Center in Chippewa Falls held an open house to showcase its domestic violence program. While it serves and emergency shelter, it also is a prevention and education center. In addition to domestic violence, the Family Support Center offers services for human trafficking and child abuse prevention.

Mayo Clinician Training (medical) – Emergency clinicians took over the UW-Eau Claire campus for training. With help from students, clinicians got a crash course and low frequencies procedures. This aims to help emergency medical staff be prepared for anything that may come through the ER doors. Stations ranged from broken bones to delivering a baby to airway surgery.

Augusta School District Referendums (education) – The Augusta Area School District is asking voters to approve two referendums on the November ballot.

The first question looks to generate \$10.5 million for repairs, renovations and maintenance across the district. The other referendum would impact pre-K through fifth grade students with the addition of a new gym at the elementary school for \$4.5 million.

Nov. 4

60 Days of Giving (business) – One Automotive Group is preparing for its annual holiday giveaway. It's giving away two vehicles this holiday season. Nominations are being accepted for deserving people in need of a vehicle. It's the 11th year for the dealership's car giveaway.

Rural Partners Network (agriculture) – U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Tom Vilsack stopped in Cadott to promote the Rural Partner Network. It's designed to help people in rural communities create local jobs and support long-term economic stability.

Nestle Plant Sold (business) – Ireland based baby formula company Perrigo is buying the Eau Claire Nestle Plant. It acquired the plant in a \$170 million deal. It also includes a \$60 million investment in the Eau Claire site to increase baby formula production.

Girl Scouts Memorial (youth) --- A new 19-foot-tall memorial sits along a highway in Chippewa County in memory of four crash victims. The fatal hit-and-run on November 3, 2018, killed three Girl Scouts and one of their moms. To mark the four-year anniversary, a memorial was installed along County Highway P in the Village of Lake Hallie where the crash happened. The girls were taking part in a highway cleanup project when a vehicle went off the road.

Nov. 7-10

Child COVID Death (health) – Chippewa County Department of Public Health reports the county's first death of a child due to COVID-19. Since March 2020, a total of more than 200 people living in Chippewa County had died as a result of COVID. The county didn't release the child's age or gender, only saying the child is younger than 18.

Micon to the Mall (business) – After the AMC Theater inside Oakwood Mall in Eau Claire closed in October, it was announced Micon Cinemas is moving into the mall. Micon currently has three theater locations in the Chippewa Valley.

Overdose Death Charges (addiction) – An Owen man is charged in a drug overdose death. Jacob Faude is charged with first degree reckless homicide. Law enforcement officers say a passenger in a car that crashed in February in Clark County died from a drug overdose.

Pet Food Drive (business) – More than a dozen Chippewa Valley businesses are participating in this year's Holiday Pet Food Drive. Donation bins are set up to collect pet food, litter and other items. Everything collected will be donated to St. Francis Food Pantry in Eau Claire to distribute to people and their pets. The food pantry provides pet food year-round in hopes of helping people who may be struggling financially to keep their pets in their homes.

Nov. 14 – 18

Parade Crash Sentencing (violence) – The man convicted in the Waukesha parade crash which killed six people is sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of extended supervision. Darrell Brooks spoke at the sentencing, saying he didn't plan to drive into the parade. The judge said the only way to keep people safe was to keep him off the streets.

Oktoberfest Donation (economy/business) – More than 40 organizations got a financial boost thanks to Oktoberfest. The annual event in Chippewa Falls handed out \$20,000 to groups for the time their members donated to this year's event.

Jessica Peterson Book (violence) – More than 10 years ago, Jessica Peterson's ex murdered their three daughters. Peterson wrote a book – Thistles and Thorns – to share more about her daughters and to hopefully help others dealing with loss.

Hunting Preps (environment) – Wildlife specialists with the Department of Natural Resources are reminding hunters to follow safety training during the opening weekend of the gun deer season in Wisconsin. In addition to firearm safety, hunters are reminded to plan for cold and snowy conditions.

Dec. 5-9

Opioid Prevention Workshop (substance abuse) – The Eau Claire City-County Health Department is hosting a workshop on December 15 to teach people how to administer Narcan, which is used when someone is having an overdose. Participants will learn how to use Narcan and will leave with two bottles for possible use.

Christmas Tree Farm (business) – An area Christmas tree farm is seeing fewer trees this year because the previous owner of the farm didn't plant trees in the last few years of owning the farm. It takes 7 to 9 years for trees to be ready to harvest. The farm says it might have fewer trees in another decade because the harsh weather this summer hurt this year's crop.

Drive-Thru Holiday Event (children) – Eau Claire County's Department of Human Services hosted its third annual drive-thru holiday event for foster families. Approximately 80 or around 150 foster families in the county attended the event. It included Santa and gifts from area businesses.

Dec. 16

Teen Shooting Death Verdict (violence) – A jury convicted the man charged in the shooting death of an Eau Claire teenager in July 2021. Austin Vang was found guilty of second-degree reckless homicide. He told first responders he was playing with his gun and forgot it was loaded when he shot 14-year-old Marwan Washington. Sentencing is scheduled for March. Vang faces a maximum of 25 years in prison.

Winter Weather and Health (medical) – As bitterly cold temperatures are expected next week, medical professionals are reminding people to be extra cautious when spending time outside. Watch out for hypothermia, frostbite, and try to limit skin exposure. Take your time when shoveling and watch out for slick spots.

Snow Business (business) – Businesses that specialize in snow removal are staying busy after the Chippewa Valley got more than six inches of snow. You're reminded to follow safe practices when out snow blowing. Snow removal businesses say customers were stopping in for snowblowers and calling for snow removal services.

Farm Tech Days Announcement (agriculture) – Chippewa County is set to host Wisconsin Farm Technology Days in 2024. The local committee announced the Country and Rock Fest grounds near Cadott as the site for the event. Close Farms is selected as the host farm. The event is scheduled for August 13-15, 2024. Farm Tech Days usually generates \$1 million of economic impact to the host county.

Dec. 23

Snow blower safety (medical) – Mayo Clinic Health System says hundreds of people suffer snow blower related injuries each year, most of them amputations. Doctors say those injuries typically happen when the snow blower gets clogged and people try to unclog it.

Child flu Death (children/health) – Wisconsin reports its first pediatric death this flu season. The Department of Health Services is encouraging people, especially children to get the flu shot, which is a match to current strains circulating.

CVTC Graduate (substance abuse) – A former drug addict who spent time in prison is now a Chippewa Valley Technical College Graduate. Adam Gilson received his Associates Degree in Substance Use Disorder Counseling. He says he finally got clean with a program in prison, and he hopes to use his experience to help others.
