We continued on air recruitment on WJLA/WCVA/WVCV/WQ88ED/W237CA to our listeners advising of our commitment to provide public service announcements and the promotion of non-profit, charitable and governmental organizations.

WOJL/WCVA/WVCV produced and aired public service announcements for many organizations in the Central Virginia area including but not limited to the following:

“Local Issues Real People” Sunday mornings at 8am. The program features local leaders, various clubs and organizations and community members discussing a variety topics that are current and relevant to the Central Virginia area. Walk For Hope 5k – Promotion of the annual walk for suicide awareness and prevention. The event was held April 2nd at Yowell Meadow Park in Culpeper. Proceeds go to suicide awareness efforts, youth scholarships and support for survivors.

Orange E-Recycling – Promotion of an electronics recycling event conducted by Orange County. The event was held April 9th at the county landfill in partnership with Goodwill.

Mineral Historic Foundation – The Mineral Historic Foundation conducted a meeting on May 19th encouraging community members to join and help preserve the history related to the Town of Mineral, VA.

Virginia Jeepers – The VA Jeepers Against Domestic Violence conducted a fundraising event on May 21st in Madison. The event was an effort to raise awareness about domestic violence. All proceeds were donated to Services to Abused Families.
