We continued on air recruitment on WJOL/WCVA/WVCV/WKTR/WQ88ED/W237CA to our listeners advising of our commitment to provide public service announcements and the promotion of non-profit, charitable and governmental organizations.

WOJL/WCVA/WVCV/WKTR produced and aired public service announcements for many organizations in the Central Virginia area including but not limited to the following:

“Local Issues Real People” Sunday mornings at 8am. The program features local leaders, various clubs and organizations and community members discussing a variety topics that are current and relevant to the Central Virginia area. Flu Shots – The Rappahannock-Rapidan Regional Health District conducted flu vaccination clinic October 6th and October 16th at locations in Orange and Brandy Station. Vaccines were available free of charge.

Rabies Clinic - The Orange County Animal Shelter conducted a rabies clinic October 16th at the animal shelter. Rabies vaccinations were made available at a reduced cost of \$10.

Madison County FFA - The Madison Young Farmers conducted their annual Harvest Festival on October 15th. All proceeds benefited the Madison FFA.

Right the Record Project – The African American Heritage Alliance in conjunction with the Town of Culpeper held the unveiling of the Right the Record Project on October 29th at the Depot in Culpeper. This project puts a spotlight on African Americans who helped shape Culpeper’s history and community throughout the years.

Trailblazer Trot – The Culpeper Career & Technical Education Center conducted the Trailblazer Trot 5k Fundraiser on November 19th. This fundraiser was to benefit CTEC student dual enrollment scholarships.

Culpeper Business Women Fundraiser - This fundraiser was conducted on November 21st at Prince Michel Winery. The fundraiser provides scholarships to girls from local high schools and funds raised go to support local charities like Girls on the Run, Mom2Mom, Services to Abused Families and Pamper Me Pink.

Free Thanksgiving Dinners – Shiloh Church of Brandy Station provided free Thanksgiving meals on Thanksgiving deals to anyone in need. Meals were made available to pickup.

Cares 4 Kids – In conjunction with Clore-English Funeral Home (Culpeper Toy Chest) and the Orange County Children's Toy Box conducted our annual toy drive. Collection boxes were placed throughout the Central Virginia area. Toys collected in Culpeper County were donated to Clore-English Funeral Home/Culpeper Toy Chest for distribution locally. Toys collected in Orange County were donated to the Orange Children's Toy Box for distribution locally.
