OUTREACH EVENTS/JOB FAIRS

February 15, 2023

WNBC News Anchor David Ushery emceed the New York Urban League's annual "Champions of Diversity" luncheon in Manhattan. WNBC producer Tiffany Zeno and Director of Community and Communications Alexandra Trochanowski attended the event.

February 23, 2023

WNBC News Anchor and Reporter Pat Battle, WNJU Consumer Reporter Liz Gonzalez and Vice President of Digital Ben Berkowitz were panelists at a Montclair State University School of Media and Communication discussion on news literacy and combatting misinformation. The session was made available via stream to local schools and coincides with the launch of a new State of New Jersey law requiring News Literacy instruction in local schools.

In addition to participating in the panel, Ben Berkowitz was later joined by other WNBC and WNJU representatives in several meetings with Montclair State students, discussing career opportunities at NBCUniversal and sharing best practices.

WNBC News 4 and WNJU Telemundo 47 Internship Program

WNBC News 4 and WNJU Telemundo 47 worked together in 2023 to enhance the critical pipeline created when early career/college students join us for the year.

The program has become a Summer and, "Academic Year" internship program, providing experiences for students in the summer and fall/spring timeframes. WNBC/WNJU hosted over 30 interns, with shadowing experiences held at WNJU.

WNBC/WNJU recruit students who are committed to a career in media/broadcasting through experiences in their major studies, college clubs, organizations, prior media-based internships or prior media work experience. Grade point average, community service, and leadership experience are also an important part of the total assessment of student applicants. We identify high potential talent for future staff or temporary hiring opportunities upon graduation. They also become part of a pipeline for opportunities in a multitude of NBCUniversal Early Career programs, including but not limited to, the NBCUniversal Page Program, News Associates Program, Sales Associates Program and Media Tech Program.

Lynn Costa, VP, Human Resources oversees the program for WNBC with Ana Abreu, Sr Manager, Human Resources.

Montclair State University Partnership

NBC 4 New York and Telemundo 47 enjoy a formal partnership with Montclair State University's School of Media and Communications. The partnership established a pipeline for student internships and freelance opportunities. It has also led to the development of a new class on news production - featuring guest instructors from both WNJU and WNBC stations. The stations host periodic "office hours" for students, offering career advice and best practices. Representatives from the stations have also joined on-campus discussions on a variety of topics, including career development, news literacy and the Tri-State's Hispanic Market. Sessions have been listed in the calendar of events.

The EMMA BOWEN Foundation

WNBC News4, in conjunction with the NBCU Local Media Division, are proud sponsors of its longstanding partnership with the Emma Bowen Foundation in developing youth for opportunities in media.

WNBC has had the opportunity to guide and develop students with the option of permanent placement upon completion of their college degree. Students in the program receive an hourly wage, as well as compensation to help defray college tuition and expenses. Mentoring from selected staff is also a key element of the program. During the summer semesters, "Emma" students rotate through various WNBC/WNJU departments while gaining experience in every aspect of media. We look forward to continuing our work with Emma Bowen as we move through 2024.

In 2023, our EMMA BOWEN Intern, Allison Hog, joined us for summer and fall semesters at WNBC. She was assigned to the Newsroom and handled various responsibilities related to breaking news and event planning.

IWNBC and WNJU Diversity Advisory Councils

At WNBC and WNJU, the purpose of our Councils is to be a voice, a lens and a resource for the discussion, ideation, and implementation of initiatives tied to our business, employees and community.

The Councils, in conjunction with the DEI arm of the division held sessions during Spring 2023 to begin and continue DEI conversations. 110 employees from WNJU and WNBC were in attendance. The two councils also started a monthly newsletter for the business highlighting various heritage months, community activities and important information about our own diversity, by highlighting employees and their experiences.
