Throughout the month of March, the island comes alive with festivities, embracing the best of Guam's food, culture, and the enduring Chamorro spirit. Schools, offices, and businesses proudly express their vision of Chamorro culture, adorning lobbies and reception areas with local flora and heritage displays. Shopping centers and hotels host special events, offering cultural demonstrations in traditional weaving, dancing, cooking, and fashion. The annual Guam Discovery Day celebration in the scenic village of Humåtak (Umatac) showcases the Chamorro people's historical value, rich culture, and traditions. Visitors can enjoy guided heritage walking tours, a theatrical re-enactment of Ferdinand Magellan's landing, heritage exhibitions, carnival games, local food, live music, cultural dancing, and even land and water racing events. *MES CHAMORU* is more than just a month—it's a celebration of identity, pride, and the living legacy of the Chamorro people.
