FOCUS ON KANSAS

A 20-30 minute (length varies depending on number of topics covered) locally produced public affairs program usually aired at 6:30 AM Sunday. On occasion, where there are a large number of things to cover or if the topic covered requires more time, the program will begin at 6:00 AM with Perspective (see below) pre-empted. Within this program is a weekly feature aired most weeks, Kansas Profile, a five minute program produced by the Huck Boyd Institute for Rural Development at Kansas State University which focuses on people and organizations making a difference in rural Kansas.
