Daniel Mahan, pastor of St. John's & St. Jude's Catholic Churches led the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, the Litany of God's Mercy, and other prayers for an end to abortion for this special kick-off event for the Lenten 2016 40 Days for Life campaign. Monica Siefker opened up the broadcast, relaying some of the good fruit that these prayer & fasting campaigns have produced both nationally & locally. The Prayer for Religious Liberty was prayed at the end of the hour, followed by a sign-off from Monica.

The Prayer for Religious Liberty was prayed near the end of the hour followed by a sign-off from Monica.
