## Dear KRI:

This is in reference to the request filed on December 13, 2018. KRI requests a further extension of the STA granted on October 6, 2003, to operate with parameters at variance pending the filing of the required FCC Form 302 application (due to pattern distortion caused by recurring equipment modifications to adjacent towers). In support of the request, KRI states that additional time is needed to make an agreement with nearby tower owners to address all problems (and file the application).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- · Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
  the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
  the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and KRI may continue to operate with DA parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced

KKPZ is licensed for DA operation on 1330 kHz with 5 kW (day and night).

power if needed to maintain monitor points within licensed limits. KRI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. KRI must file the application if any changes are needed, or submit an e-mail to my attention to certify the date the station was able to resume licensed operations with negligible changes.

This authority expires on July 28, 2019.
