#### **Issue: Blended Family**

#### **Issue: Personal Finances**

May 2 at 6:00 for 30 minutes, we broadcast a call in question and answer show with a panel of financial advisors to address issues of personal finances like credit, debt, mortgages, budgeting, saving and the economy.

#### **Issue: Time Management**

8:30 on May 18, for 25 minutes, we aired an interview with Author Jen Pollock Michel who showed how to establish life-giving time-management habits and techniques to develop a grounded, healthy, life-giving relationship with the clock.
