WAAY - TV

Outreach Programs

December 1, 2006 thru November 30, 2007

WAAY-TV participated in a Career Fair at the University of North Alabama in Florence, AL on October 17, 2007. The Career Fair was also open to the general public. However, most of those who attended were current students or recent graduates of UNA. General Manager Ray Depa and News Director Wilhelmina Walker represented the station. Resumes from fourteen attendees were collected representing interest in current and future positions ranging from sales to news. In addition to gathering resumes, Depa and Walker answered questions from participants about career opportunities in general in today's media environment.

WAAY - TV participated in the University of Alabama's job fair for the College of Information Sciences on November 2, 2007. The event took place at the Ferguson center on the UA campus. Approximately 110 students and 10 faculty/staff members attended the function. WAAY's New Media Director, Ben Boles, represented WAAY along with Information Sciences Dean Loy Singleton. Approximately 52 students came by the WAAY booth, with 20+ leaving resumes. Since the career fair, WAAYTV.com has posted articles published by soon-to-be graduating seniors. Two resumes have been sent to our News Department for employment consideration.

WAAY - TV co-hosted and offered entry level, summer time, positions at the 2007 Boys & Girls Club Job Fair in Huntsville, AL. Karl Liggin was hired from the pool of candidates. Mr. Liggin trained and worked as a Production Assistant through out the summer until he returned to school in the Fall.

WAAY - TV actively encourages all employee's to cross-train, job shadow or intern in the various departments. In 2007, several production assistants (entry level) and a master control operator job shadowed in the Commercial Production Department and News Department. They are now actively cross training for permanent positions when the need arises.

WAAY - TV's New Media Director, Ben Boles, was invited by Professor Patty Cromwell to participate in an ongoing education series at Oakwood College in March, 2007. He spoke to the Telecommunications & Film Class (Senior Level) about the Communications and Broadcast industry. He invited all attendees to pursue employment at WAAY - TV and has since received several resumes for various positions.
