
On behalf of Ohio University ("the University"), we hereby notify the FCC that noncommercial educational digital television station WOUB-DT, Athens, Ohio has resumed its authorized operation.

On November 9, 2005, the University notified the FCC of the temporary silent status of WOUC-DT due to transmission equipment problems. The University now informs the Commission that, as of November 17, 2005, the problems have been corrected and the station has been returned to service as licensed.

The University is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates WOUB-TV/DT on a noncommercial educational basis. Moreover, the University qualifies as a governmental entity. The University is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1114 of the Commission's Rules, and the facility is exempt from FCC regulatory fees, pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Rules.
