On Feb 13, 2022, a water problem occurred at Green Acres and Summit St, causing contamination of your water. The areas that are affected are as follows: Green Acres from the intersection of Summit St and Green Acres circle back to the intersection of Dodd Dr and Rt 14. Conditions indicate there is a high probability that your water is contaminated. Testing has not occurred to confirm or deny the presence of contamination in your water. Do not drink the water without boiling it first. Bring water to boil for one minute. Use boiled water for brushing teeth, drinking, making ice, washing dishes, and food preparation.
