### **Immigration Today – Air Date: 10/03/08**

Sr. Janet Yurkanin, IHM, director of the Office of Migration and Refugee Services for the Diocese of Trenton and Maria Juega, Co-founder/Treasurer, Latin American Legal Defense and Education Fund break down the myths when it comes to immigration and the new immigrants of today.

### **Tent City – Air Date: 10/10/08**

**Dr. Rumu DasGupta**, parishioner at St. Anthony Claret Church in Lakewood and a professor of Sociology at Georgian Court University; **Dr. MaryAnn Sorensen Allacci**, a parishioner at St. Mary of the Lake Church in Lakewood and an adjunct instructor at Georgian Court University having taught a course on Housing and Homelessness. **Alice Kelsey**, a parishioner at St. Mary of the Lake Church, Lakewood and a long-time housing advocate tell about “Tent City”, an event they participated in recently in Lakewood. “Tent City” was a demonstration meant to bring attention to the needs of the homeless.
