Most caregivers are family members or friends who are working, managing their own families and caring for their loved ones at the same time. For many, the caregiver role doesn't start all at once, it starts with simple things like scheduling a doctor's visit or helping with daily errands, then gradually expands until it becomes a major commitment. On average, caregivers provide 23 hours of care a week, the equivalent of an unpaid, part-time job. Since 2011, we have encouraged caregivers to care not only for their loved ones, but also for themselves. To date, the campaign has targeted several audiences: general market women age 40-60, male caregivers ate 35-60, and Hispanic/Latino and African American/Black caregivers with emphasis on women ages 35 to 60.
