WDNT Issues 1st quarter 2023

- 1. Economic Development. Throughout 1st quarter, we aired a series of messages encouraging listeners to shop local. We also promoted a specific shopping event for Mainstreet Dayton.
- 2. Education. during the 1st quarter we promoted new protocols for local schools, including announcements regarding broadband assistance for low income families. We began pre-promoting registration for the Give A Kid A Chance event to pass out school supplies to students. The station aired an average of 3 announcements per day regarding Adult Education programs. During the entire quarter we promoted gun safety programs. We also aired announcements about school re-entry programs for adults.
- 3. Drugs and Alcohol Abuse. WDNT regularly airs announcements about the perils of Meth and opioid adiction. We also promoted a quarterly expired drug turn in event.
- 5. Environment. WDNT airs regular announcements from Keep Tennessee Beautiful. We also promoted an annual clean up event on Lake Chickamauga. We aired announcements explaining the environmental advantages of electric vehicles.
- 7. Local culture. during the first quarter we promoted multiple performances at Tennessee Valley Theatre as well as a performance at Bryan College. .
- 8. Health. WDNT regularly airs announcements for Blood Assurance. During the 4th quarter we ran additional announcements for specific bloodmobile stops. Exercise programs at Rhea County Community Center were promoted.
