THE QUESTION INVOLVED CALCULATING THE VOLUME OF A BASKETBALL. THE WORDING ALLOWED STUDENTS TO EITHER ROUND THE ANSWER UP OR DOWN, MAKING TWO DIFFERENT NUMBERS CORRECT ANSWERS. OFFICIALS SAY THE ISSUE WAS CAUGHT IN TIME TO MAKE SURE IT DIDN'T HAVE A NEGATIVE EFFECT ON ANY STUDENT SCORES.
