Request for Further Extension of Post-Auction Construction Permit

Mission Broadcasting, Inc. ("Mission") respectfully respects a second and final extension of the post-auction construction permit for station KASN(DT), Pine Bluff, Arkansas (LMS File No. 0000034796) (the "Post-Auction CP") through May 29, 2019. The Commission has previously granted an extension of the Post-Auction CP, which is currently scheduled to expire on January 29, 2019. See LMS File No. 0000063759. KASN is currently operating on its post-transition channel with interim facilities which cover its community of license. See LMS File No. 0000063679, as modified by LMS File No. 0000064325.

Mission is working diligently to complete the Post-Auction CP facilities. A tower crew has been on site for some time, and tower work is slated to occur daily between 8 am and 4 pm when possible. Unfortunately, due to site conditions and weather-related issues that include low temperatures, rain and wind, the tower crew has been 1) unable to complete the requisite tower reinforcements (bracket fabrication and installation) to the existing tower and 2) unable to remove significant portions of the existing waveguide on a daily basis. The waveguide must be removed in order to permanently install the final KASN antenna. In the last several days, six crewmembers, impacted by low temperatures and/or high winds (up to 25 MPH), have been able to remove 200' of waveguide, install 40' of new 8" transmission line and install or prepare for installation of brackets for approximately 300' of the 1600' tower. Despite this considerable progress, completion of the final facilities will not occur by the current deadline of January 29. It is therefore necessary for Mission to request a further extension of the Post-Auction CP through May 29, 2019. There are no reported interference issues with KASN's interim operation, and there are no daisy chain or linked station issues associated with the requested extension. Accordingly, the public interest would be served by a grant of this request.
