### Narrative Description of Program/Segment

Encouraged our listeners on the Morning Show to make a donation to help support the Ronald McDonald houses in Springfield, Missouri. 117 families stayed at least one night in 2022 at one of those homes. We shared the story of the Dietz family from Crocker, MO, whose son was born prematurely and was required to stay in the NICU for three weeks. The Ronald McDonald house helped relieve the Dietz's of the burden of travel and lodging expenses. The primary goal of this segment was to raise awareness of this great service to those who have children in the hospital.

Listeners were urged to report any scammers who contact them.
