Section I. Issues

The above stations have identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- **A. Technology:** The Tri-Cities is currently home to over 1,600 PhDs and 7,000 engineers and scientists. Attracting and keeping these highly skilled workers in the Tri-Cities is key to the area's future.
- B. Crime & Criminal Justice: local Law enforcement has employed and explored the use of new technology and training of non-lethal weapons, but body cameras are still not being used by most local departments and this has some residents asking why.
- C. Education/Student Debt: Columbia Basin College continues to expand and attract students from all over the Pacific Northwest. Student debt has skyrocketed and CBC offers affordable two and four year degrees. CBC is an attractive alternative for local families to consider before enrolling at a private or state college. Parents and students must weigh the pros of cons of educational costs.
- D. Mental Health/Parenting: The Tri-Cities if full of young families and parenting in the online era can be quite confusing. At what age should children have a social media page? How closely should parents monitor what their children view on the internet?
- **E. Diversity:** The Tri-Cities is a diverse community and the importance of discussing and understanding implicit bias is forefront. How it forms, how to identify it and how to address it is key for the area.
