On June 30, 2023, Market President participated in an online training for Valuing Diversity provided by Trust Mineral. The purpose of the course is to help employers understand the concept of diversity and know how to recognize diversity issues that can lead to legal liability under anti-discrimination and harassment laws.
2	Participation in programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to career opportunities in broadcasting	On March 15, 2023, the EU's Market President, Director of Content, and Brand Manager visited Silver Ranch Elementary School to speak with several fourth-grade classes about careers in broadcasting. The group discussed what it is like to be a DJ on the radio, why they enjoy working in radio, what the station does on a day-to-day basis, and answered questions the children had.

The team had a booth at the event and was able to hand out applications to the students and talk about careers in broadcasting. In addition to meeting with students at the booth, the on-air talent performed a live broadcast from the event, inviting people to visit the fair.
