WRDZ 1300 AM airs programs, news and information in following categories:

1. International

II. WRDZ 1300 AM airs talk shows that follow the subjects of public discussion including several inspired by organized events:

Promoting cultural events: pop and classical music concerts, theatre performances, movie screenings that were organized in Chicago-land by WRDZ 1300 AM affiliate European Cultural Foundation, and with other entertainment organizations including: Chopin Theatre, Society for Arts, Paderewski Symphony Orchestra, RAMM Events and Christopher Entertainment. Cooperating with the Polish Film Festival in America on an annual festival of films produced in Poland and screened in Chicago in the beginning of November. The event offers screening of movies in several Chicagoland theaters, press conferences and public meetings with directors, screenwriters and actors. WRDZ 1300 AM offers extensive coverage of these events, airs interviews with guests of PFFA and movie reviews.

Informing the Polish community about educational opportunities: cooperating with the Illinois Student Assistant Commission (ISAC) and the Polish -American Association to inform prospective students and their parents about financing options available and guide them through the processes involved in getting financial assistance. Informing of organized meetings regarding college education in the U.S., the Polish- American Association offers informative meetings on professions in medical field and

administrative and clerical fields. They also offered computer courses for beginners and intermediate computer users for those who are looking to update their existing skills or gain new ones that would help them acquire better paying professions.

III. WRDZ 1300 AM airs an hour long news-informative program three times a day. This program consists of world, Polish, and local information. In addition, there are many interviews with politicians, potential candidates and specialists in the area of world politics. Regularly, twice a week, Idalia Blaszczyk interviews Prof. Jerzy Bekker in her show "Co Slychac?" ("What's up?") and they discuss and analyze political events worldwide and what they mean for regular people. She also conducts regular interview with Prof. Bronislaw Misztal, who is also a chair of Sociology at the Catholic University of America in Washington DC. They review current socio-political situations in America and their meanings for different social groups. This is immensely interesting for immigrants as many of the events taking place in today's America touch those groups directly. In addition, Malgorzata Ptaszynska interviews American and Polish politicians and candidates for the "Popoludniowka" show.

IV. WRDZ 1300 AM has assisted in gaining contributors and sponsors for the Polish charity Gift of the Heart Foundation. This has helped raise funds for the organization to provide hospital procedures, operations and physical therapy for Polish children who cannot undertake such complicated treatments in Poland. The reports on the activities of the Gift of the Heart Foundation are presented periodically on air.

In addition to that WRDZ 1300 AM closely cooperates with the Polish- American Association (PAA) and has helped them acquire more funding necessary for their operation. The PAA is a non-profit organization supported mostly by donation as well as federal and state funding which was recently drastically cut, due to financial crisis. In order to keep the most essential programs helping people the PAA searched for alternate ways of funding. WRDZ 1300 AM has helped to organize a Radiothon on 11/23/2015, which was to raise as much money as possible for the PAA and help those in our community that are in need the most.

The Polish – American Association plays a vital role in the Polish community. The PAA reps come in regularly and talk on air of choices and programs that are available in the Chicago area with regards to immigration, laws and rights, unemployment, help in cases of home violence, substance abuse in adults and teenagers, education and career, social services and social security.

WRDZ 1300 AM in the month of October works closely with Amber Coalition on promoting events, lectures and screenings on awareness and prevention of breast cancer. Since October is a month of breast cancer awareness nationwide, WRDZ 1300 AM also participates in that campaign by airing PSAs and informing listeners of all events that may in any way raise the awareness of breast cancer.

In the Christmas season WRDZ 1300 AM in collaboration with POLVISION TV and POLAMER take patronage over organizing the Christmas Dinner for the Lonely and Homeless, an event organized at the St. Hyacinth Basilica. Many Polish businesses and

individuals donate food, material items as well as money in order to support those in need at this special time of the year. Not only does WRDZ 1300 AM take media patronage but it also pioneers in organizing, rallying volunteers and donors and everyone participating in this event. We aired live segments from that event on December 24th

V. Public Service Announcements aired in the following categories:

1. Health: Chicago Health Challenge, National Kidney Foundation, Illinois and its program of free BP, Urine, BMI and Glucose testing; informing about better care for people with diabetes; informing about free of charge physical examinations and meetings with the reps of Social Security Administration to discuss social security, Medicare and Medicaid at various locations throughout the city.

3. Crime: child abuse, alcohol and drug abuse, drunk driving.
4. Environment
5. Pride in America
6. Community announcements of free of charge classes for Polish residents of Chicago wanting to become American citizens, informing of seasonal parties and other communal events

Most Public Service Announcements come from the Ad Council and some of them are pre-produced by Polish non-profit organizations as well as companies are set to benefit and contribute to the Polish community.

VI. WRDZ 1300 AM is the only full time Polish radio station in United States of America at this time. It serves a potential audience of 1,500 000 with the signal that penetrates Chicago, Illinois-Milwaukee, Wisconsin and Rockford, IL. This mentioned geographic location establishes the largest community of Polish listeners outside of Warsaw, Poland.
